Blood Pressure Screening

The Fire Department provides FREE blood pressure readings between 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays unless an emergency has taken personnel out of quarters at that time.

Smoke Detector Program

A smoke detector installation program is available to qualified residents; i.e. senior citizens and disabled persons. Generally, the program is made available during the Fall Change Your Clock period, but a call to the Department during the rest of the year will bring personnel to your home to install a new detector. The Department provides a smoke detector battery change program during the Fall Change Your Clock period. Personnel maintain a list of past recipients who are called to set up an appointment to change batteries during this time.

Inspections

The Fire Marshal will provide a non-binding home fire inspection upon request to his office at 314-729-4741.

Overflow/Basement Flooding

In the case of water overflow in your home, simer pump loans are available to assist in cleanup with a call made through the Captains office at 314-729-4744.

CLASSES & PRESENTATIONS

- In partnership with the Crestwood Police Department, the Fire Department provides training for the CERT (Citizen Emergency Response Team) program when funds are available for necessary supplies needed for this purpose. Please call the Fire Marshal at 314-729-4741 with any questions.
