



INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the 2012 Electrical Lighting Fixture Supply and Replacement Project will be received by the Director of Public Services at the Crestwood Government Center, One Detjen Drive, until Wednesday, February 1, 2012 at 10:30 a.m. CDT when they will be publicly opened and read in the Aldermanic Chambers.

The Scope of Work includes the supply and installation of electrical lighting components.

Not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages shall be paid to all workmen performing under this contract in this area according to the rates determined by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of the State of Missouri.

The City of Crestwood is a tax exempt entity. A project exemption certificate will be supplied to the successful contractor.

A bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

The Contractor (and any subcontractor performing any portion of the Work hereunder) shall require all on-site employees to complete a ten (10) hour OSHA construction safety program or similar program as approved by the Public Works Director. Said program must be completed within sixty (60) days of beginning work on the project. Any employee found on the site without documentation of the successful completion of the program shall be given twenty (20) days to produce such documentation before being subject to removal from the site. Failure to comply with this Article will result in the Contractor forfeiting as a penalty the sum of \$2500.00, plus one-hundred (\$100.00) per day, for each employee employed without the required training. The City may withhold all sums and amounts due and owing as a result of any violation of this Article when making payment(s) to the Contractor.

The City of Crestwood shall award any contract based on the proposal that, in its sole discretion, best meets the interests and requirements of the City. The City of Crestwood reserves the right in its sole discretion to reject any and all proposals, to waive technicalities or deficiencies in any or all the proposals, to negotiate with any or all bidders or others for other or more favorable terms or prices, and/or to award the contract to other than the bidder submitting the lowest cost proposal, with or without negotiation.
