Topic: April 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of April 2010. In April 2010, there were 30 Part I offenses and 408 Part II offenses for a total of 438. This compares with 20 Part I offenses and 369 Part II offenses for a total of 389 in April 2009. The main difference was in the number of traffic stops.

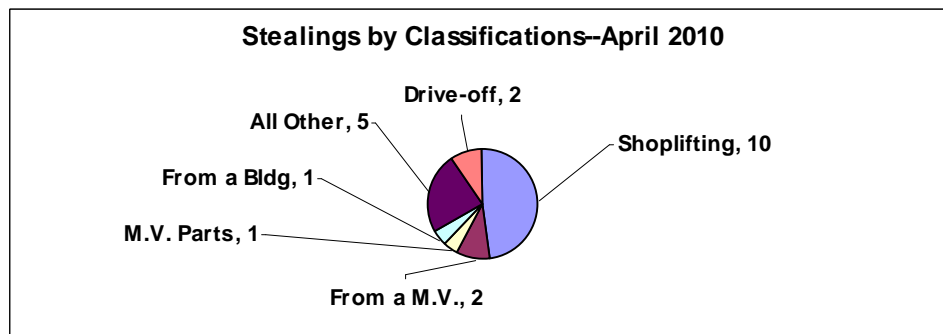
The one sexual type offense was a public urination on the parking lot of a bank on Watson Road. The person was arrested, booked and held for bond.

There were two assaults in April 2010 and both involved domestic violence.

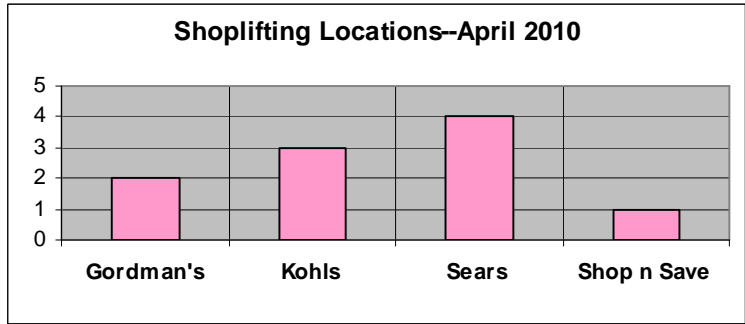
There was one burglary reported in April. A vacant building on Watson Road was entered between October 2009 and April 2010 and the electrical breaker panels were removed. Entry was possibly gained through a roof hatch. The scene was processed by the Detective Bureau.

Stealing offenses numbered 21 in April 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in April 2010:

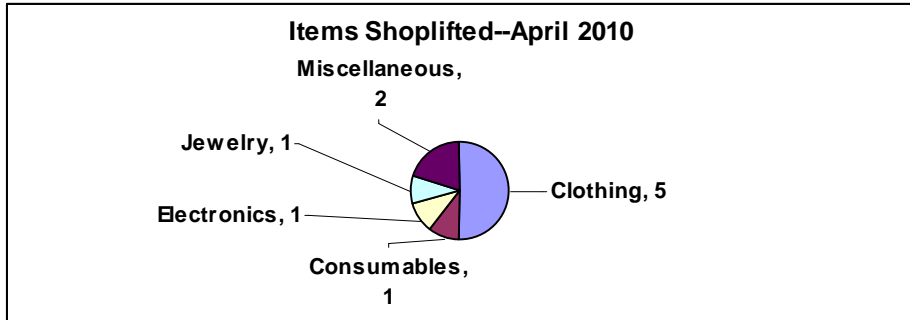


Shopliftings accounted for 10 of the 21 stealings in April 2010 or 48%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in April 2010:

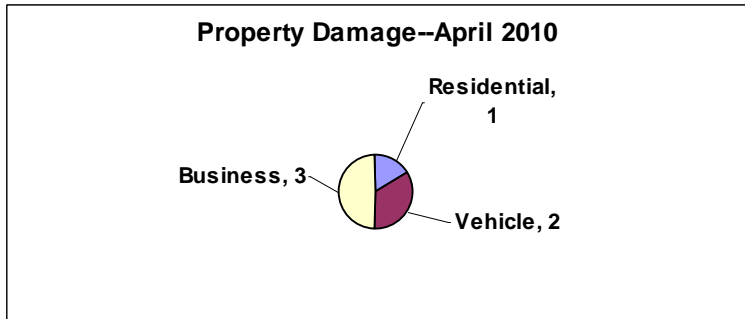


Of the shopliftings, 70% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 86% and adults and juveniles together accounted for 14% of the clearances.

There were six property damages in April 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



There was one stolen vehicles in April 2010. A red 2002 Honda CBR954 motorcycle was stolen from a detached garage located on Pardee Road between 04-11-2010 and 04-12-2010. The motorcycle was recovered in St. Louis County venue and was processed by the Detective Bureau.

Part I offenses numbered 30 in April 2010.

Part II:

In April 2010, there were two frauds, one credit card fraud and one identity theft. There were two offenses against public peace, one disorderly conduct and one peace disturbance. There was one DWI case, eleven animal related calls and 78 people related calls, including 74 medical emergencies, three missing persons and one suicide. There were 37 suspicious activity calls and 185 miscellaneous police service calls.

Part II offenses totaled 408 in April 2010.

In April 2010 in Ward One, there was one burglary to a vacant business along Watson Road. Stealings numbered two with both at addresses on Watson Road. Property damages numbered two, one at an address along Watson Industrial and one in an apartment complex. There were three traffic accidents, fourteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on four different streets and there were 54 miscellaneous police service calls.

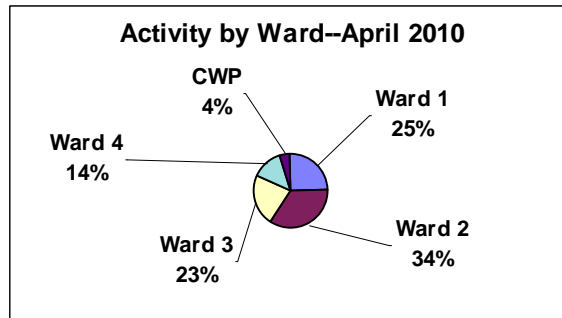
In Ward Two in April 2010, the one offense of a sexual nature was a public urination at a business along Watson Road. Stealings numbered ten with seven at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two, one at addresses along Watson Road and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud, one DWI case, eight traffic accidents, seventeen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on eight different streets and there were 73 calls for miscellaneous police services.

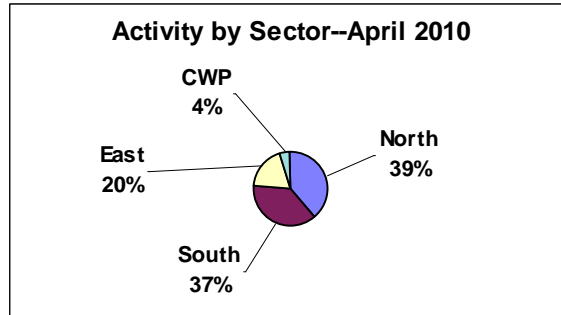
In April 2010 in Ward Three, stealings numbered one and it was in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at a business along Grant Road. A 2002 Honda motorcycle was stolen from a garage and recovered in St. Louis County. There were two traffic accidents, 34 people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on four different streets and there were 32 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in April 2010, stealings numbered four and there were no property damages. There was one fraud and one offense against public peace. There were four traffic accidents, twelve people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on eight different streets and there were nineteen calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered four with four shopliftings and property damages numbered one. There was one offense against public peace, one traffic accident, and one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and there were seven police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

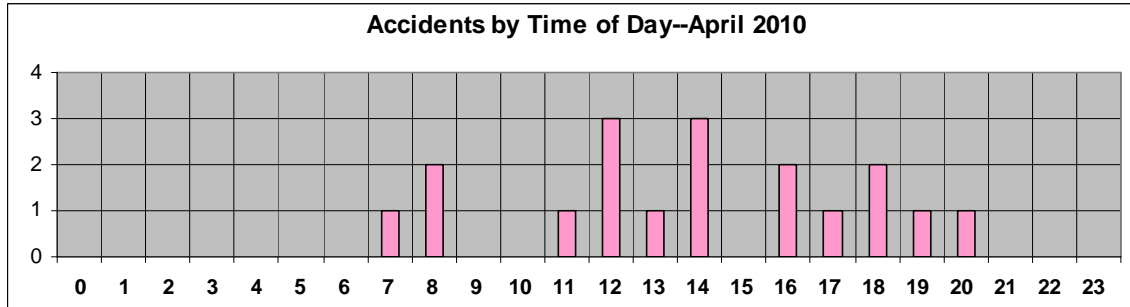

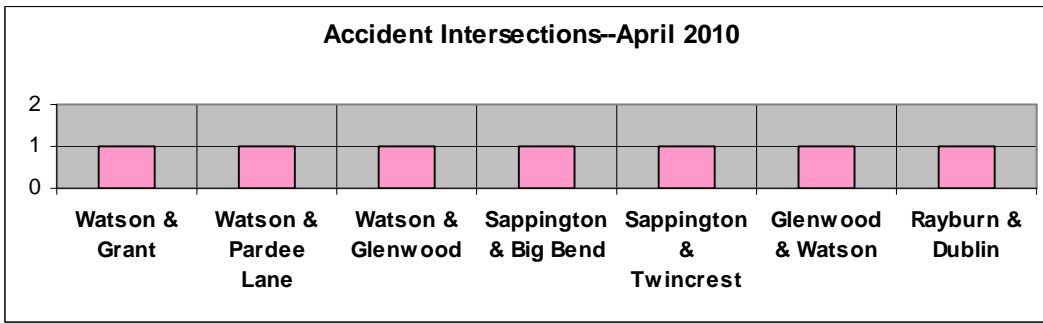
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



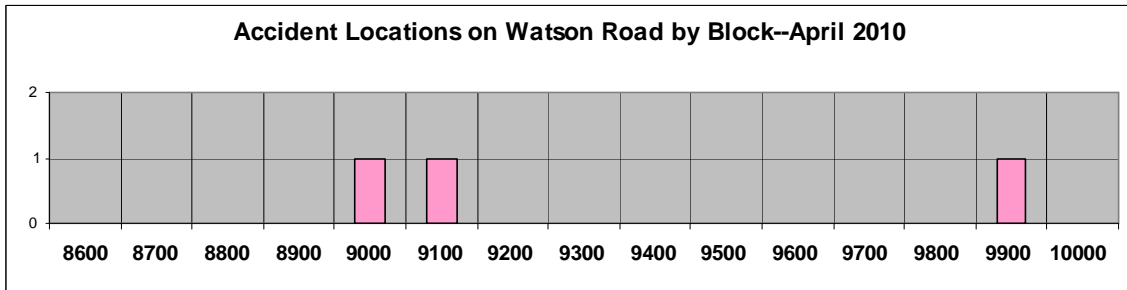

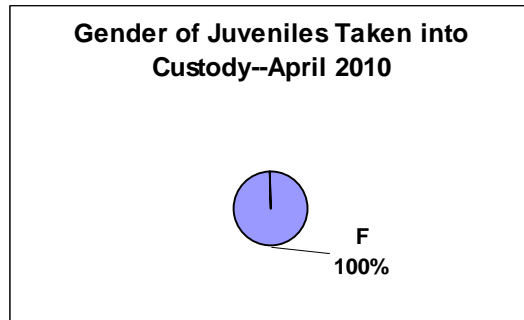
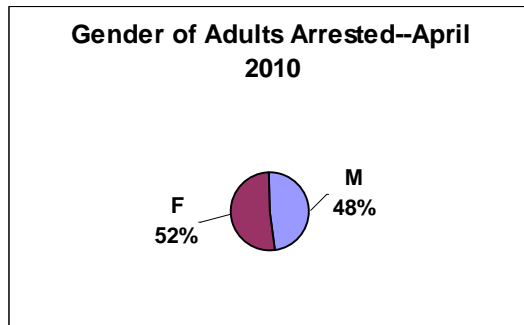
Arrest Information:

Forty-six adults and one juvenile were taken into custody in April 2010. Three persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

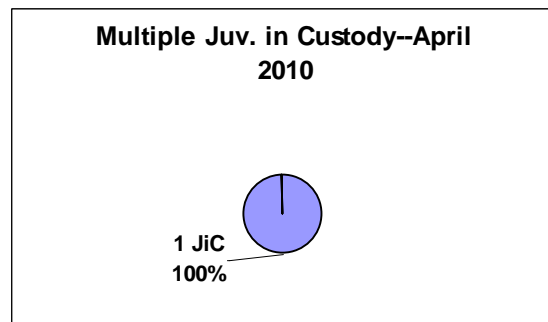
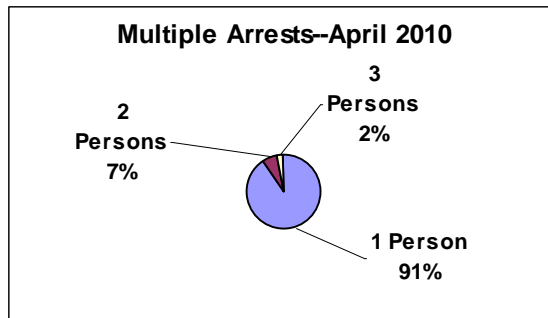
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



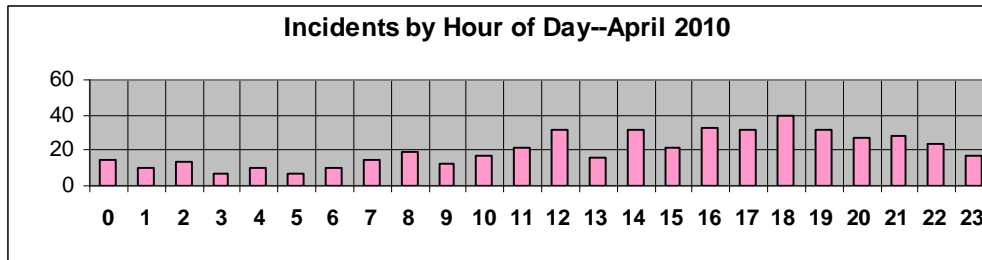
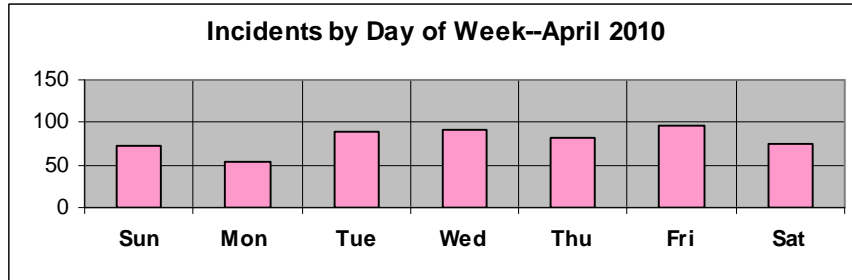
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

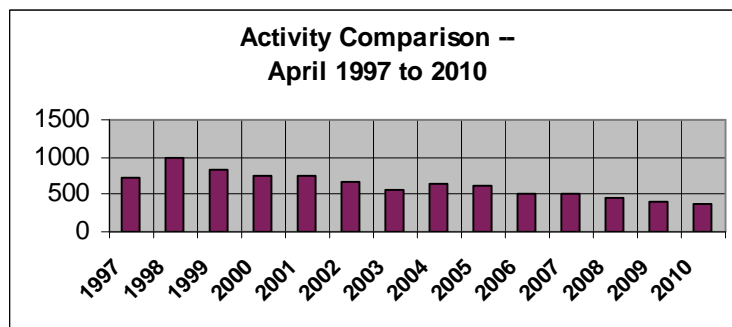
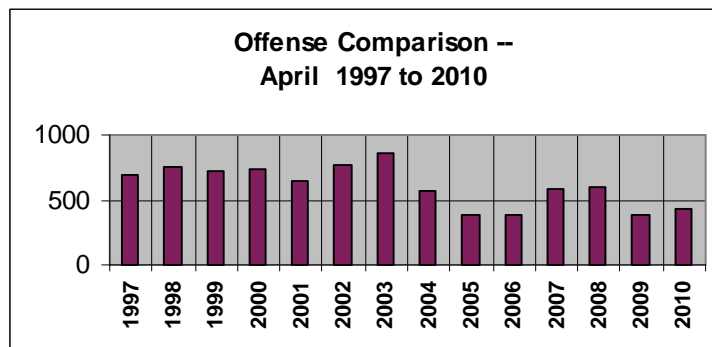

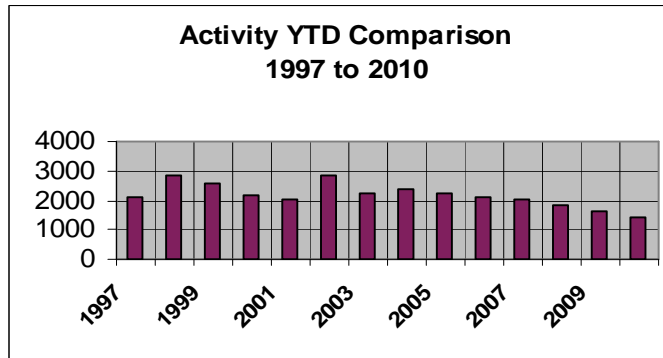
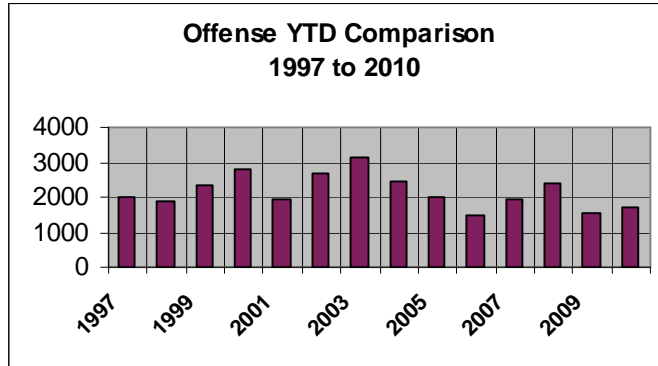


Offense and Activity Comparison:

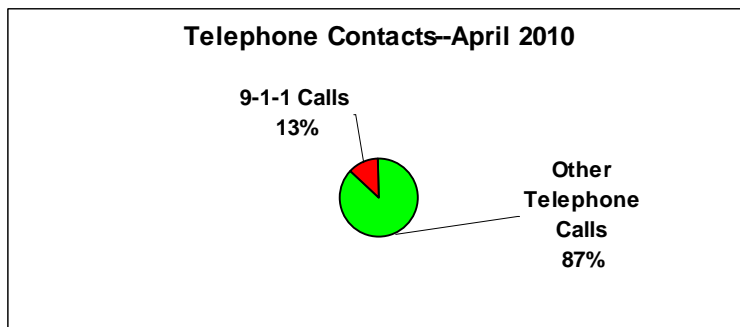


Years to Date:

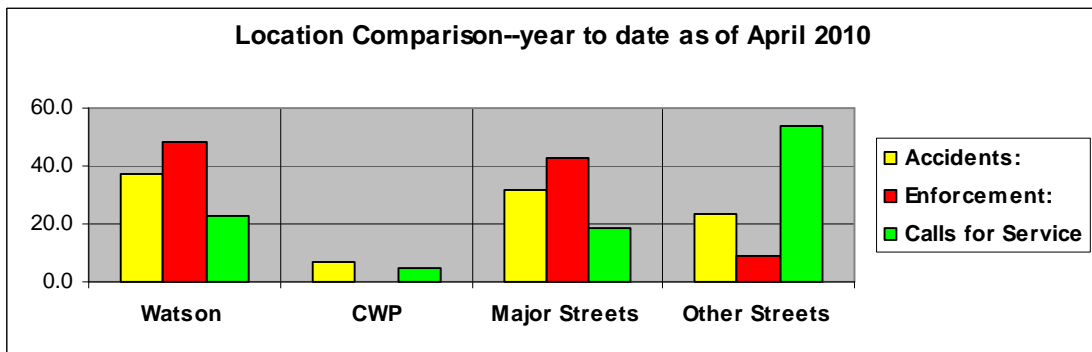


Location Comparison:

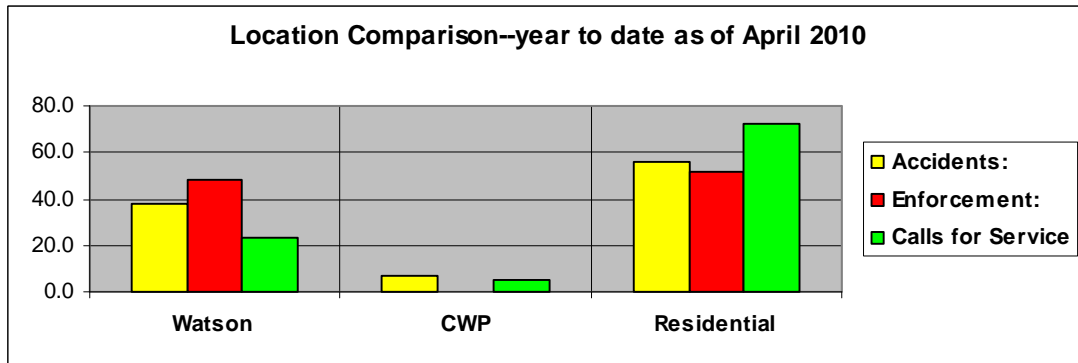
