Topic: April 2011 Public Report

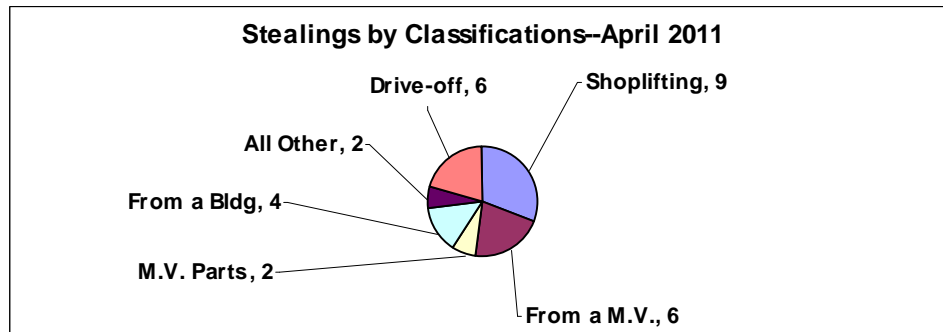
This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of April 2011. In April 2011, there were 32 Part I offenses and 343 Part II offenses for a total of 375. This compares with 30 Part I offenses and 408 Part II offenses for a total of 438 in April 2010. The main difference was in the number of people related calls, suspicious activity, traffic accidents and traffic stops.

There was one burglary reported in April. On 04-06-2011, on Glenwood Drive, someone broke into a residence while the resident was at work. Both a basement door and a window were broken to gain entry to the residence. The resident was not sure what had been taken. Detective Bureau processed the scene.

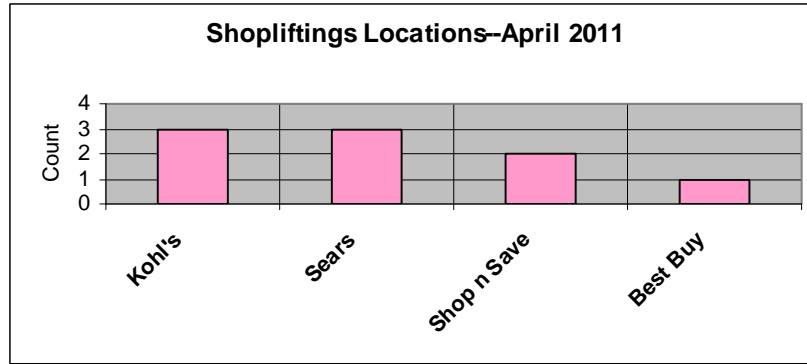
There was one assault in April 2011 and it did not involve domestic violence and the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 29 in April 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in April 2011:



Shopliftings accounted for nine of the 29 stealings in April 2011 or 31%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in April 2011:

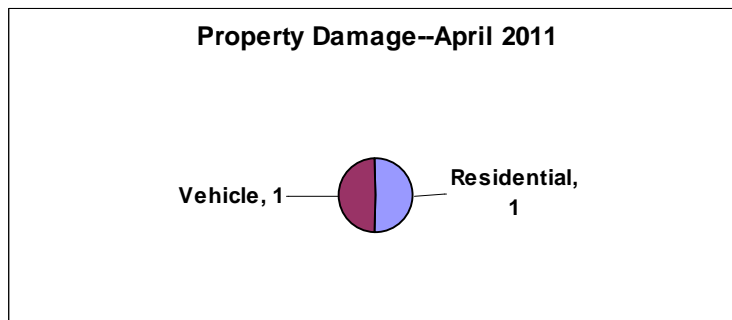


Of the shopliftings, 89% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 74%, juveniles accounted for 13% and adults & juveniles accounted for 13% of the clearances.

There were two property damages in April 2011 and they were of the following classifications:



Part I offenses numbered 32 in April 2011.

Part II:

In April 2011, there was one drug offense, a possession of paraphernalia case and there was one offense against public peace, a trespassing. There were 59 people related calls with 57 being medical emergencies and two suicides or attempt suicides. There were 24 calls for suspicious activity, 22 failures to appear arrests and four fugitive arrests.

Part II offenses totaled 272 in April 2011.

In April 2011 in Ward One, stealings numbered four with one at addresses on Watson Road, two in an apartment complex and one in the neighborhoods. There were no property damages. There were fifteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 35 miscellaneous police service calls.

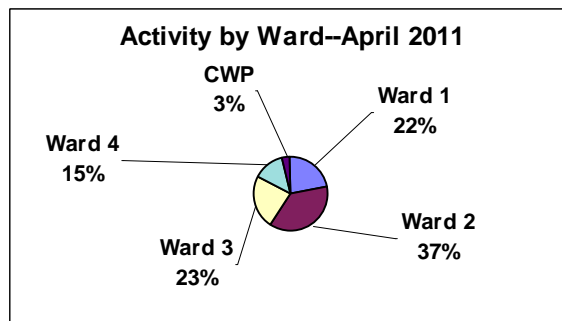
In Ward Two in April 2011, stealings numbered eighteen with fourteen at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address along Watson Road. There were seven traffic accidents, twelve people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on six different streets and there were 70 calls for miscellaneous police services.

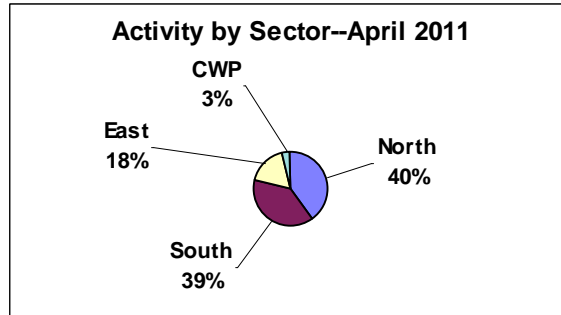
In April 2011 in Ward Three, stealings numbered three with none at addresses on Watson Road, one in Whitecliff Park and two in the neighborhoods. There were no property damages. There was one offense against public peace, two traffic accidents, 23 people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered three and occurred on two different streets and there were 33 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in April 2011, there was one residential burglary on Glenwood. Stealings numbered one and property damages numbered one. There was one drug offense, one traffic accident and nine people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on five different streets and there were 26 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered three with three shopliftings. There was one traffic accident. There were no suspicious activity calls and there were six police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

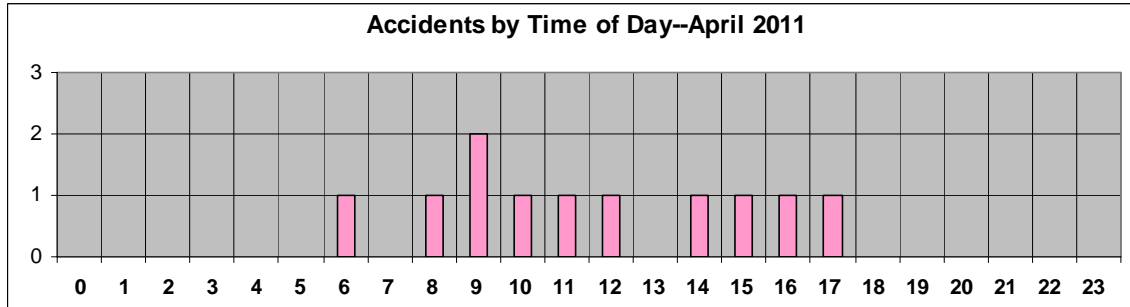

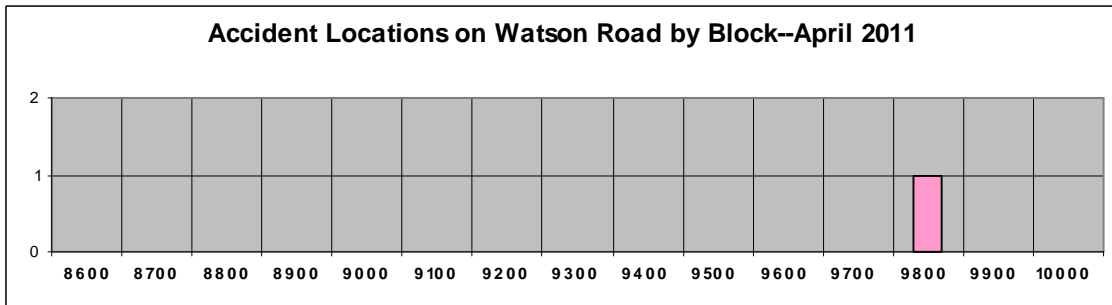

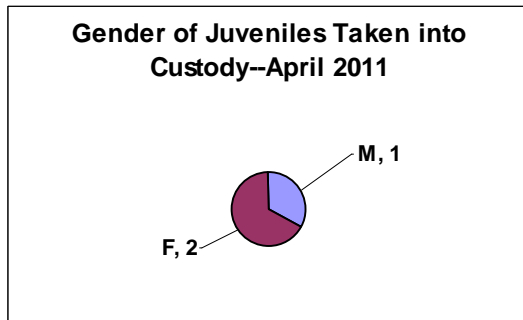
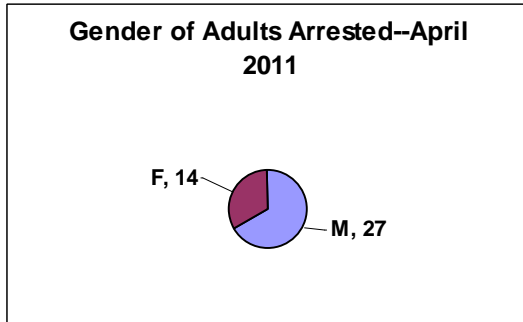
Arrest Information:

Forty-one adults and three juveniles were taken into custody in April 2011. Eleven persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

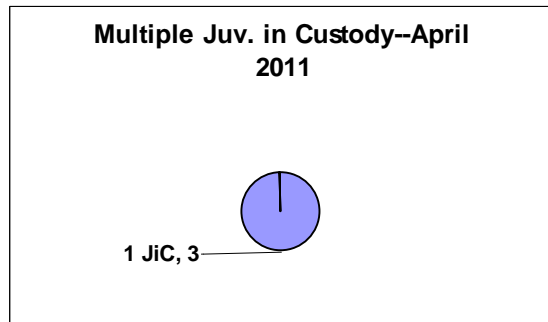
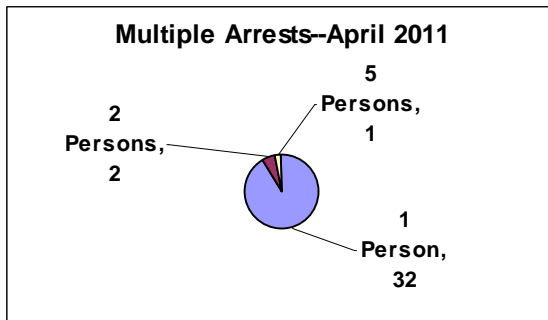
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



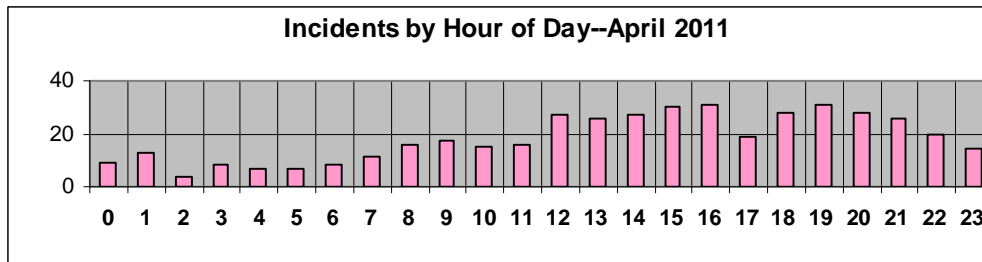
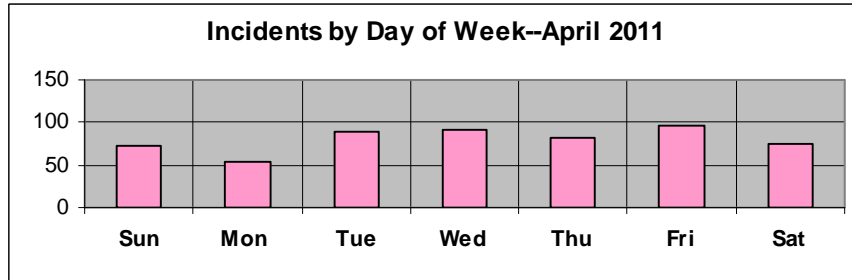
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

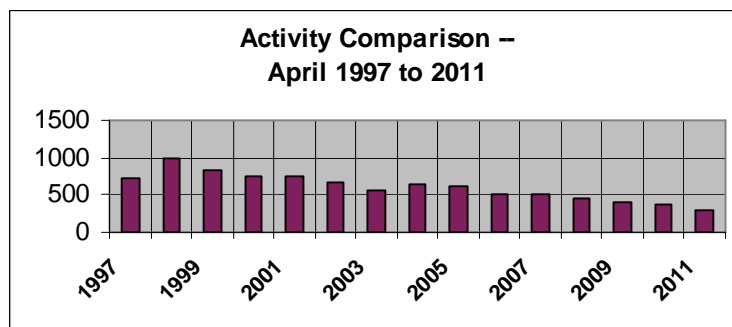
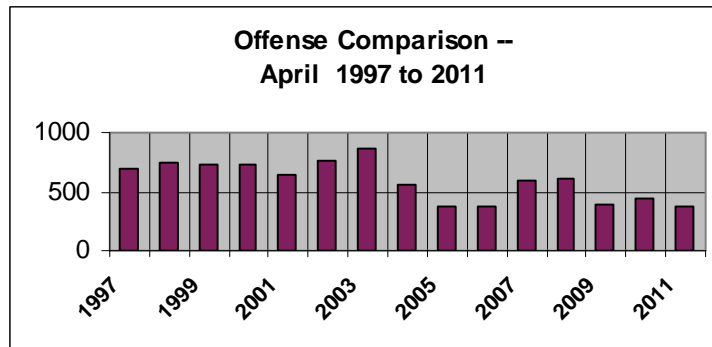

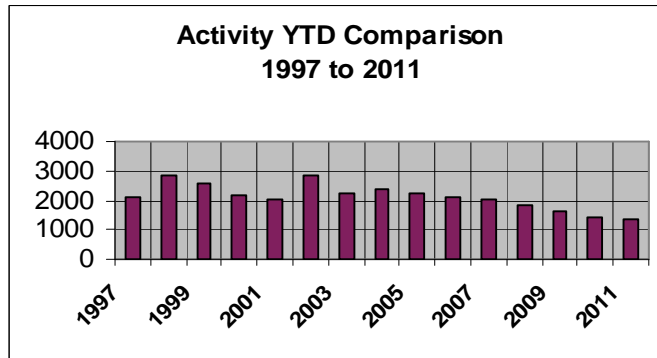
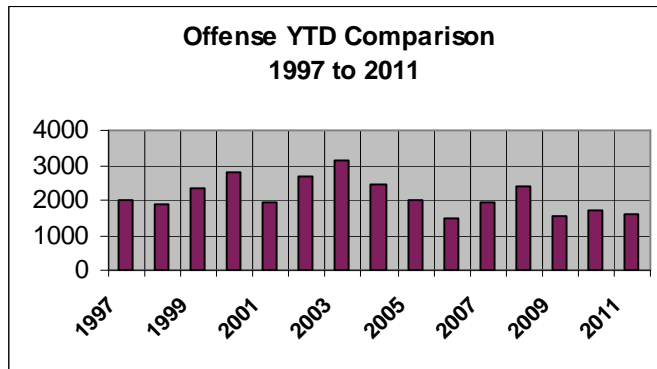


Offense and Activity Comparison:

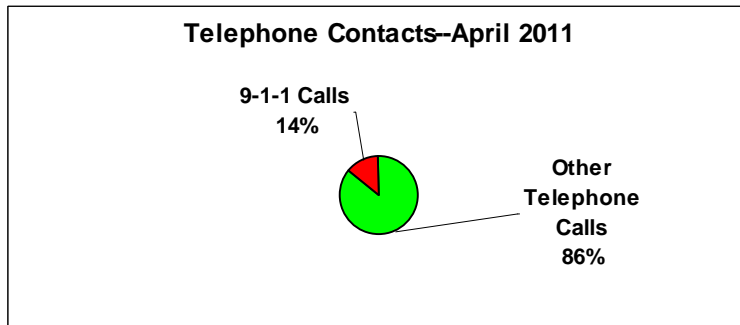


Years to Date:

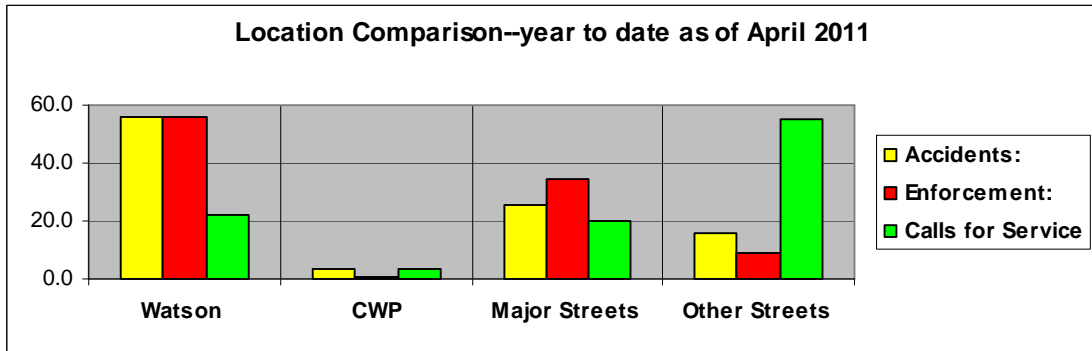


Location Comparison:

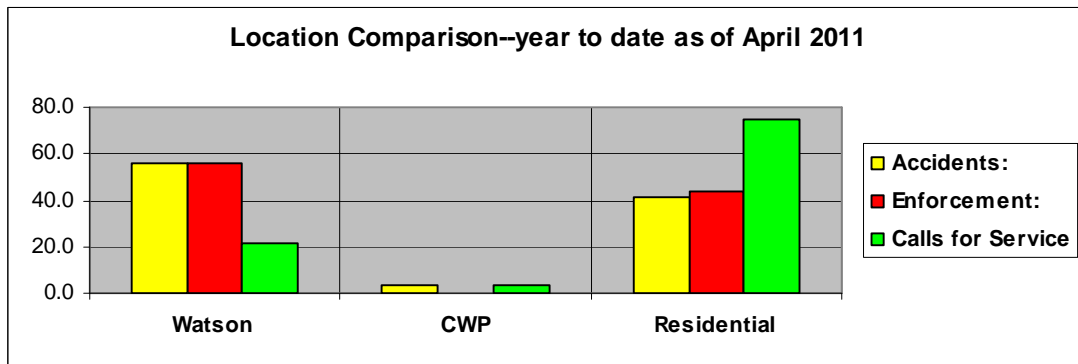
