Topic: August 2011 Public Report

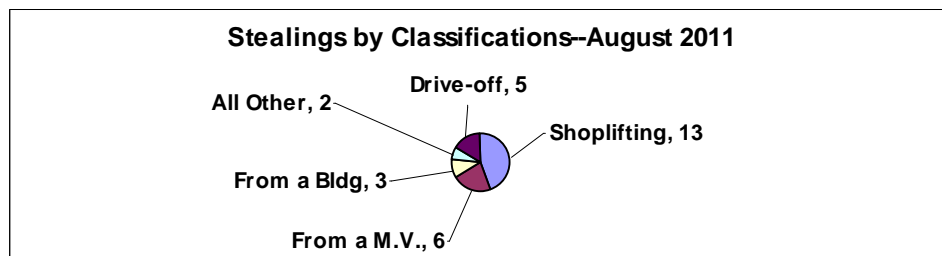
This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of August 2011. In August 2011, there were 38 Part I offenses and 440 Part II offenses for a total of 478. This compares with 33 Part I offenses and 406 Part II offenses for a total of 439 in August 2010. The main difference was in the number of people related calls.

There was one robbery reported in August. On Wednesday, 08-10-2011 during the evening hours, a male approached the pharmacy counter and passed the pharmacist a note indicating that he had a weapon and asked for a narcotic. The pharmacist gave the male the narcotics and he left the store. A vehicle description was obtained. Kirkwood Police stopped a vehicle fitting the description and arrested the male. Warrants were issued by the Prosecuting Attorney.

There were six assaults in August 2011 and three involved domestic violence. In all cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

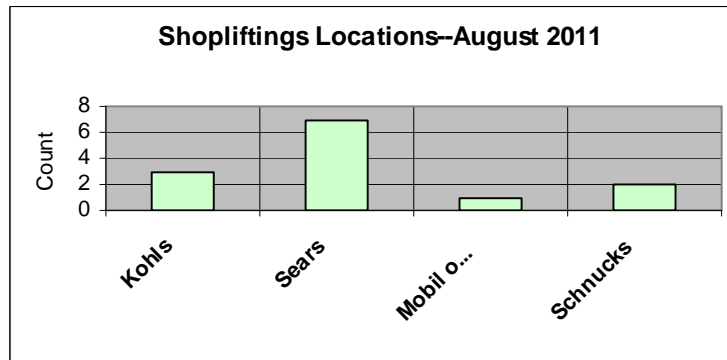
Stealing offenses numbered 29 in August 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in August 2011:



Shopliftings accounted for 13 of the 29 stealings in August 2011 or 45%.

The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in August 2011:

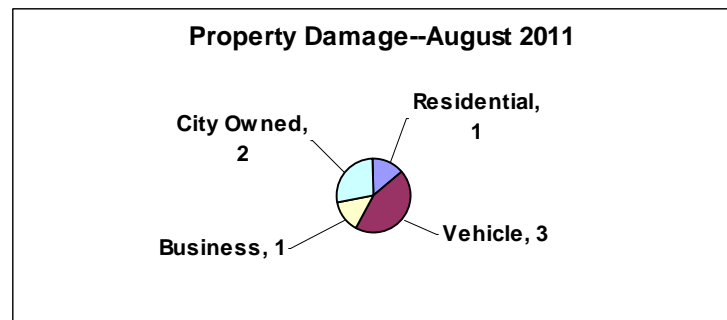


Of the shopliftings, 92% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 75%, adults and juveniles together accounted for 17% and juveniles accounted for 8% of the clearances.

There were seven property damages in August 2011 and they were of the following classifications:



The City Owned property damages were to a street sign and restroom doors in Crestwood Park.

There was one stolen vehicles in August 2011. On 08-26-2011, the victim found that someone had taken her white 2004 Chevrolet Malibu from her parking space. The vehicle has yet to be recovered.

Part I offenses numbered 38 in August 2011.

**Part II:**

In August 2011, there were seven frauds reported, four credit card frauds, two passing bad checks and one identity theft. There were three drug offenses in August and all involved small quantities of marijuana. The three offenses against public peace were two trespassings and one resisting arrest. There were twelve animal calls and 91 people related calls including 88 medical emergencies, two missing persons and one suicide or attempt suicide. The single juvenile offense was a minor in possession of alcohol and there were 53 suspicious activity calls.

Part II offenses totaled 440 in August 2011.

In August 2011 in Ward One, stealings numbered four with two at addresses on Watson Road and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one in a neighborhood. There were five frauds, six traffic accidents, eighteen people related calls and five animal calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nineteen and occurred on twelve different streets and there were 47 miscellaneous police service calls.

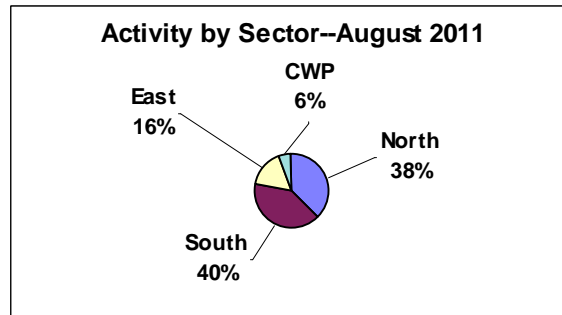
In Ward Two in August 2011, there was one robbery of a pharmacy and stealings numbered thirteen with eleven at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend, one in an industrial area and one in the neighborhoods. There were no property damages. There were two frauds, one offense against public peace and one juvenile related offense. There were eleven traffic accidents, 22 people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered sixteen and occurred on eleven different streets and there were 79 calls for miscellaneous police services.

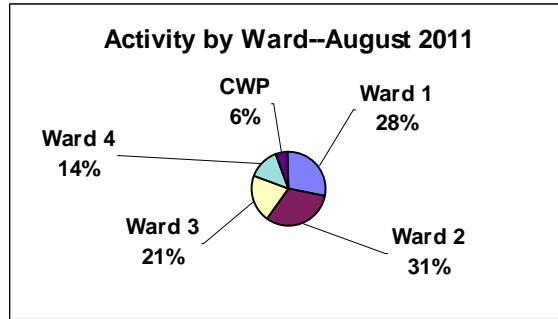
In August 2011 in Ward Three, stealings numbered three with two in the neighborhoods and one in Whitecliff Park. Property damages numbered four, one at addresses along Watson Road and three in the neighborhoods. There was one stolen vehicle from an apartment. There were three drug offenses, two offenses against public peace, four traffic accidents and 32 people related calls and animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered thirteen and occurred on ten different streets and there were 39 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in August 2011, stealings numbered two and property damages numbered two. There was one traffic accident, seventeen people related calls and three animal calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on five different streets and there were 27 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered seven with seven shopliftings and there were no property damages. There were two people related calls, no suspicious activity calls and there were nine police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

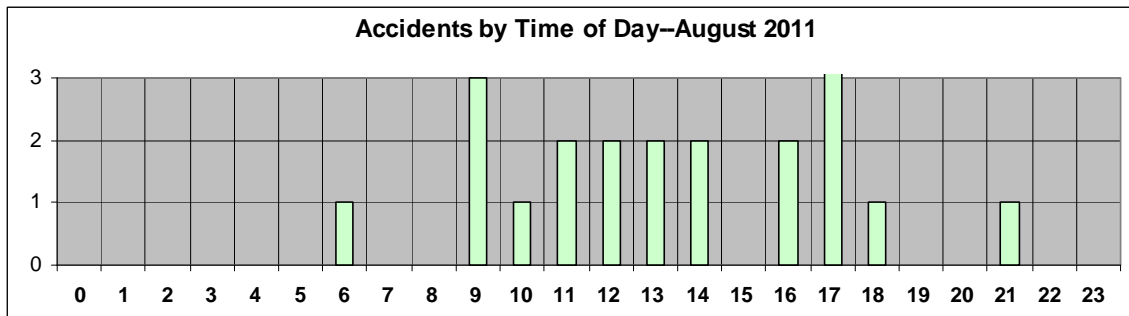

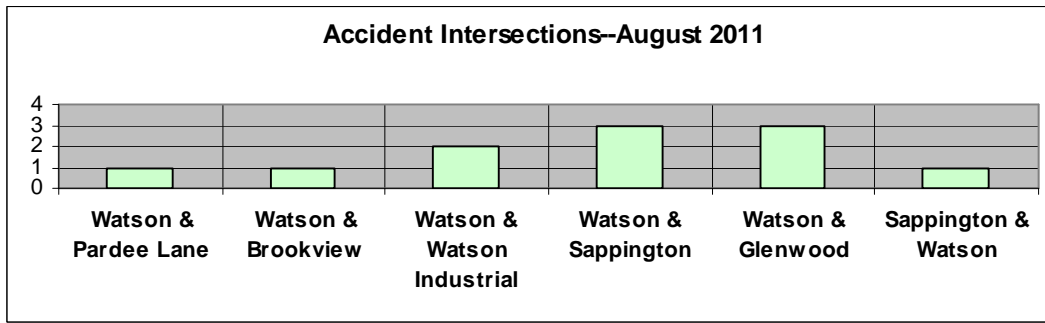
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



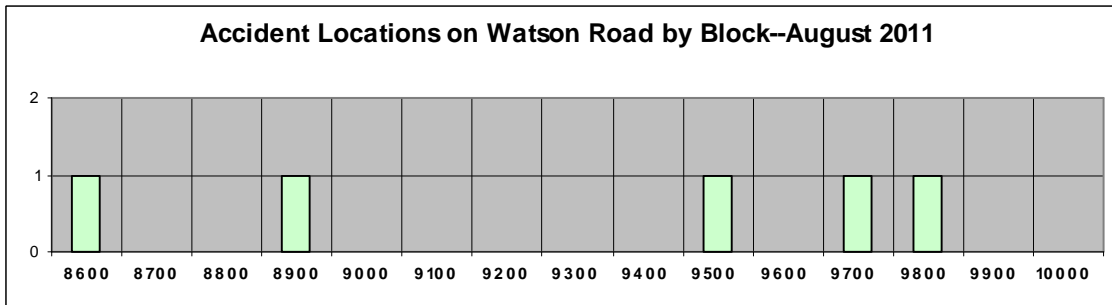

Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



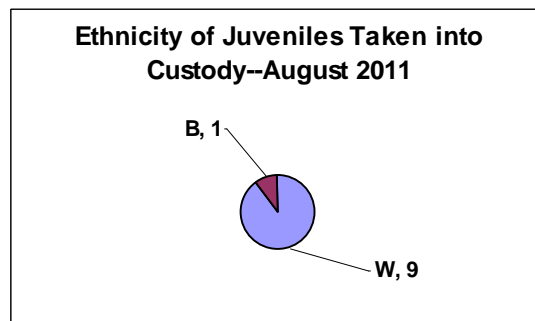
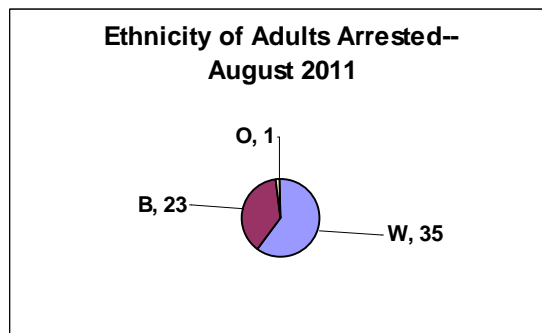

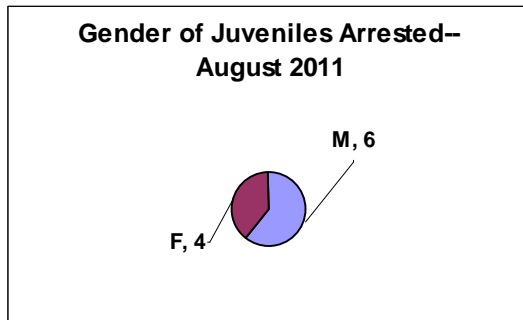
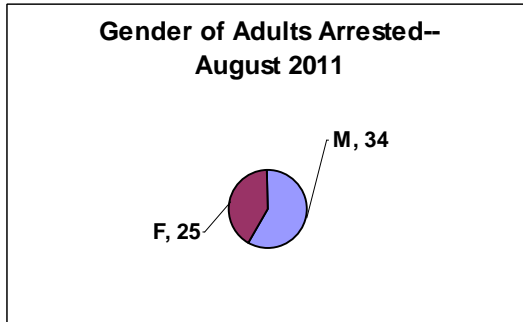
**Arrest Information:**

Fifth-nine adults and ten juveniles were taken into custody in August 2011. Twenty-two persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

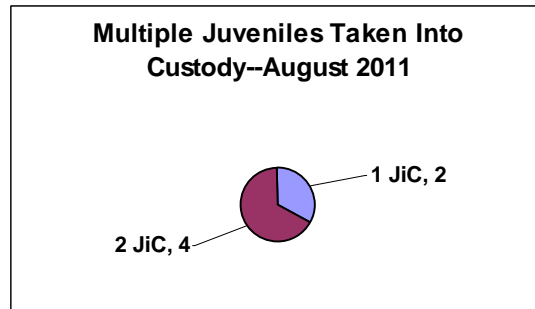
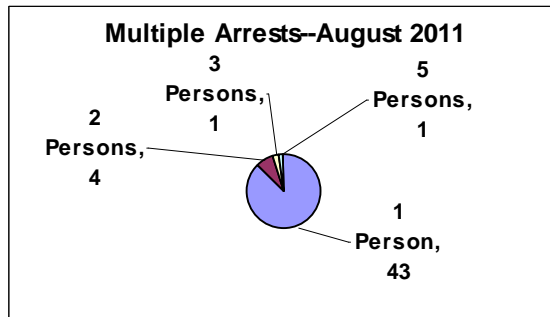
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



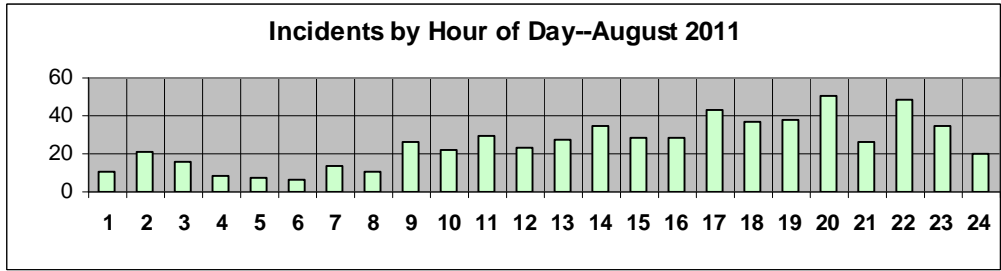
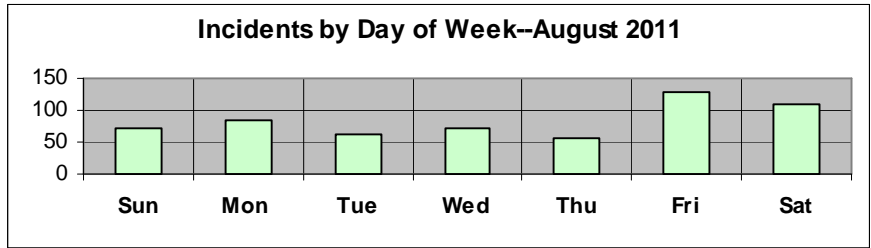
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

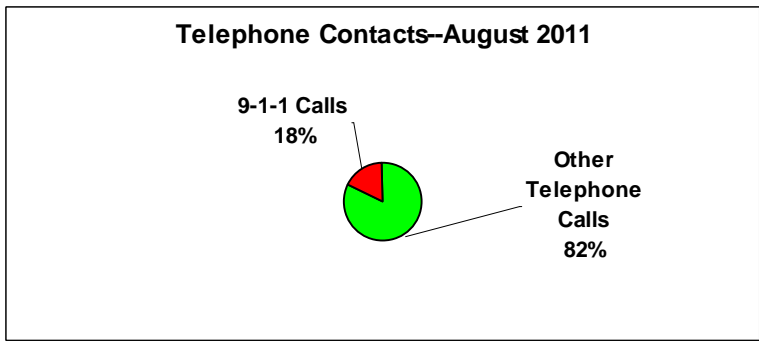

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



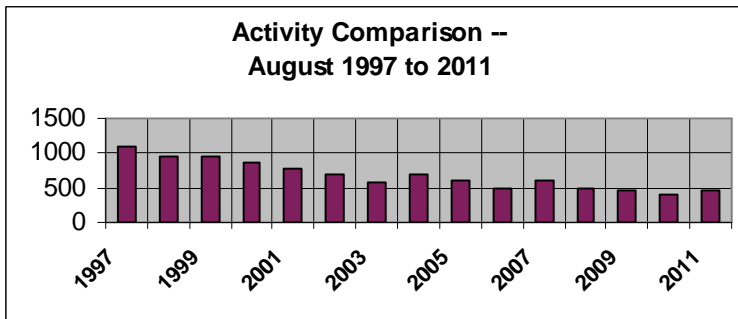
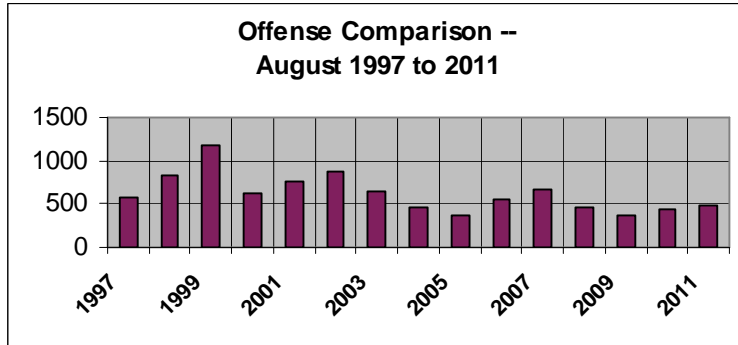
**Communications:**

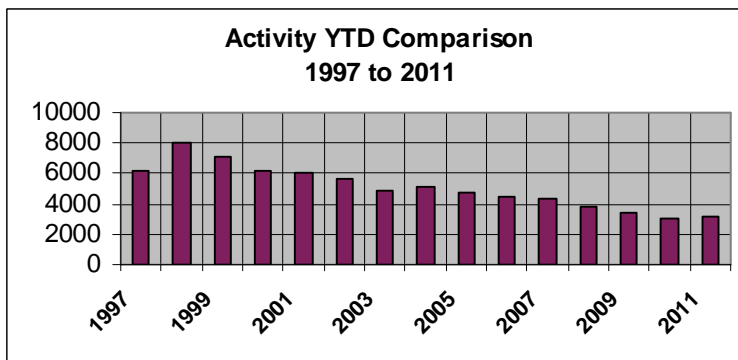
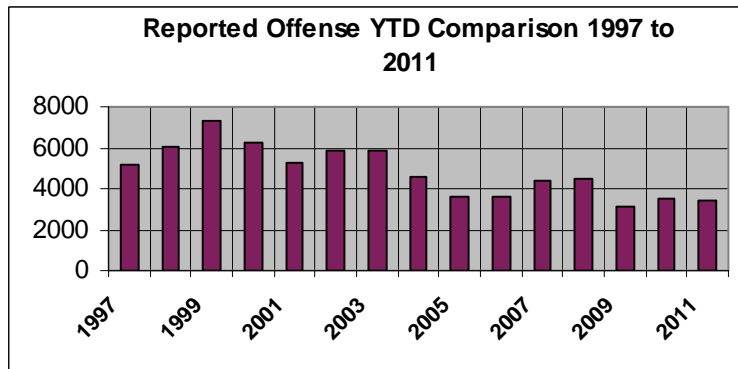


**Offense and Activity Comparison:**

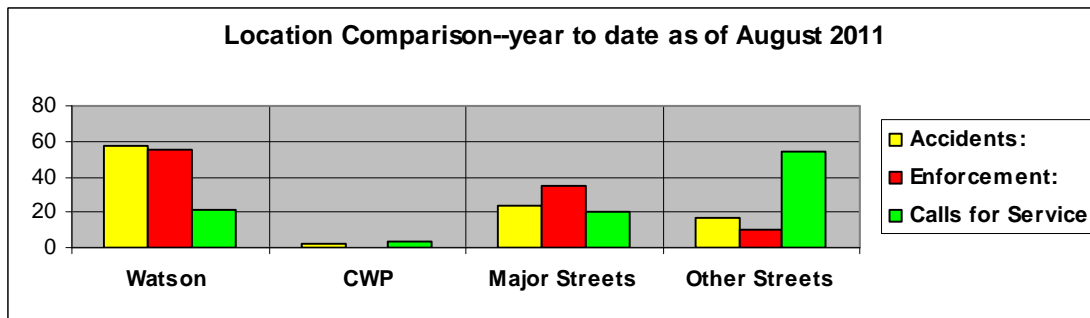


**Location Comparison:**

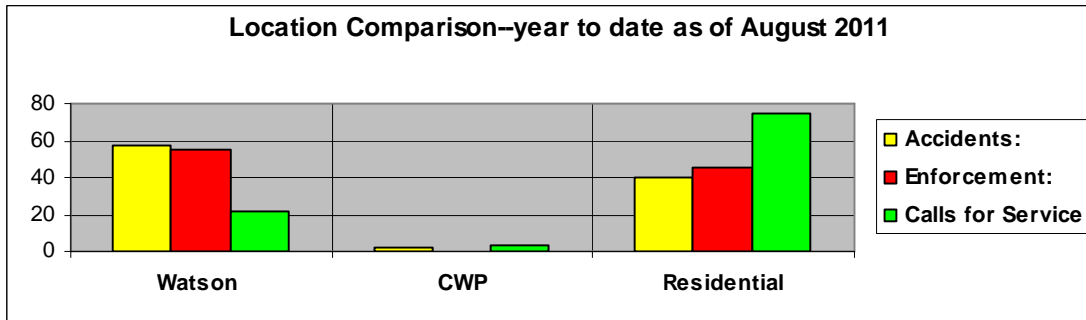
