Topic: December 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of December 2010. In December 2010, there were 55 Part I offenses and 364 Part II offenses for a total of 419. This compares with 52 Part I offenses and 356 Part II offenses for a total of 408 in December 2009. The main difference was in the number of burglaries.

There was one robbery that was reported at a business in Watson Plaza. The suspects were shoplifting shoes and shoved the employee out of the way as they were leaving the business. This physical force elevates the stealing to a robbery.

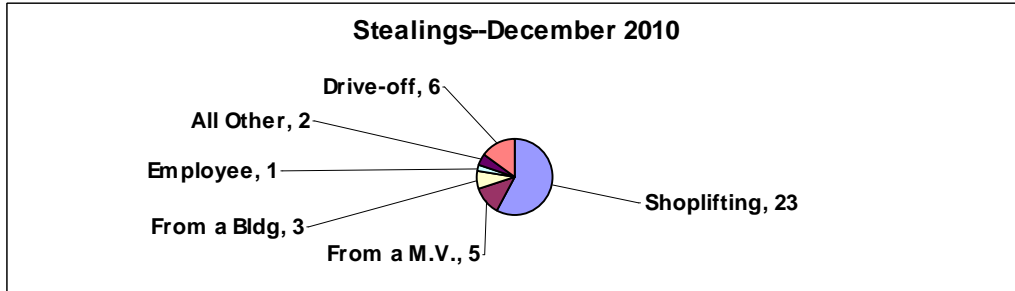
There were two assaults in December 2010 and one involved domestic violence. In one of the cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

There were ten burglaries. There was a mix of residential and non-residential. The first was reported on 12-05-2010 on Grovena. A residence was entered with forced entry but nothing was reported taken. The second burglary was reported on 12-08-2010 on Arban. There was no force used to enter the residence but the copper pipes and some electronics were taken. The third burglary was reported on 12-12-2010 on Anchorage. The suspect forced open the residence and removed the copper pipes and a television. The fourth was also reported on 12-12-2010. Another residence on Anchorage was forced open and copper pipes were stolen. The fifth burglary was reported on 12-22-2010 on Park Crestwood. While the victim was away from the apartment for a short period, someone forced open the apartment door and removed currency, coins and prescription medication. The sixth was reported on 12-25-2010 at a business on Watson Road. The janitor found that the business had been broken into and currency taken. The seventh burglary was reported on 12-27-2010 at another business on Watson Road. Someone forced open the rear door and removed currency. The eighth burglary was an attempt to enter another business along Watson Road on 12-27-2010. The ninth burglary was reported on 12-29-2010 on Fox Park. Someone entered a vacant residence and removed the copper pipes and wiring. The tenth burglary was reported

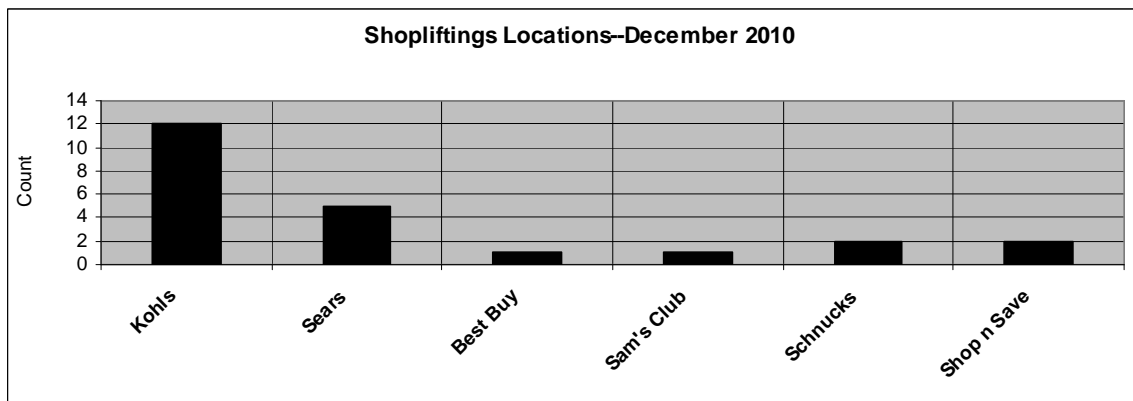
on 12-30-2010 on Cordoba. Someone entered the residence and removed jewelry and credit cards.

Stealing offenses numbered 40 in December 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in December 2010:

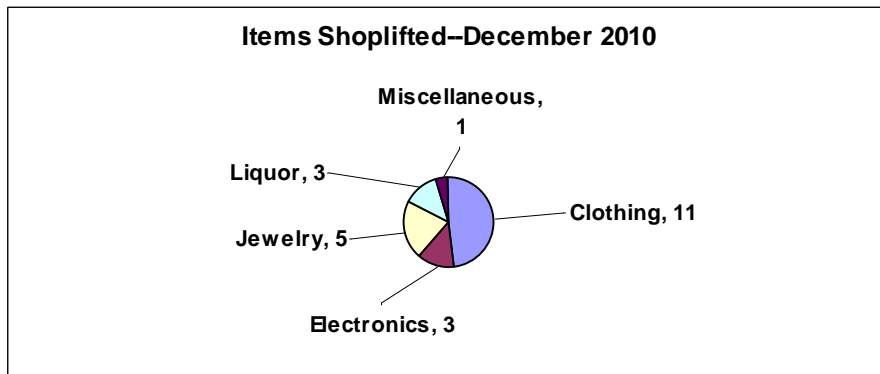


Shopliftings accounted for 23 of the 40 stealings in December 2010 or 58% of the stealings. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in December 2010:

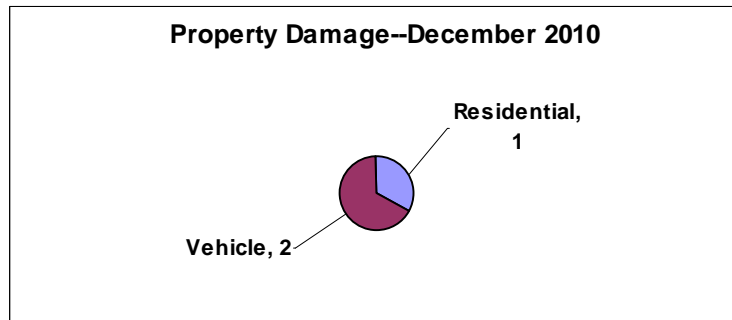


Of the shopliftings, 87% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 75%, adults and juveniles together accounted for 5% and juveniles accounted for 20% of the clearances.

There were three property damages in December 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



There was one stolen vehicle in December 2010. On 12-05-2010, a 2003 Ford Escort was stolen from CWP and was recovered the next day on the Schnucks lot.

Part I offenses numbered 55 in December 2010.

Part II:

In December 2010, there were three frauds reported, one failure to return leased property, one credit Card Fraud and one all other type fraud. There were four drug related cases, three possessions of small amounts of marijuana and one possession of drug paraphernalia. There was one DWI case, seven animal calls and 70 people related cases including 66 medical emergencies and four sudden deaths. There was one juvenile offense, a protective custody, reported. There were 52 suspicious activity calls and 184 miscellaneous Police service calls.

Part II offenses totaled 364 in December 2010.

In December 2010 in Ward One, there were seven burglaries reported. Stealings numbered five with four at addresses on Watson Road and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one with it being in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud and one juvenile related offense. There were five traffic accidents, eighteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on five different streets and there were 53 miscellaneous police service calls.

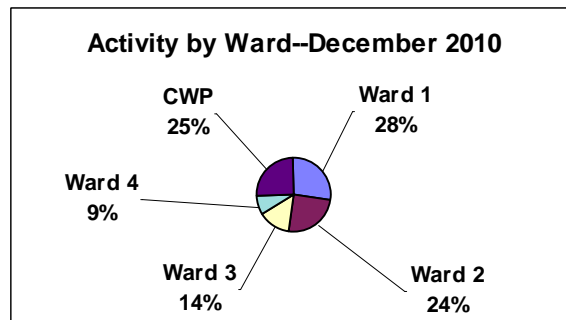
In Ward Two in December 2010, there was one robbery and there was one burglary and one attempt burglary. Stealings numbered 23 with 22 at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address along Watson Road. There were two frauds and two drug offenses. There were sixteen traffic accidents, twenty people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twenty and occurred on eleven different streets and there were 56 calls for miscellaneous police services.

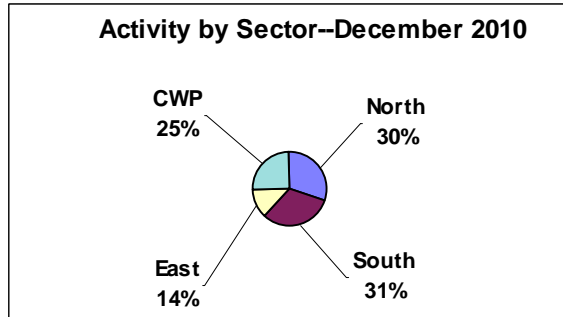
In December 2010 in Ward Three, there was one burglary reported on Cordoba. Stealings numbered five with one at addresses on Watson Road, one in the neighborhoods and three at a residential facility. Property damages numbered one in the neighborhoods. There were four traffic accidents, 23 people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on ten different streets and there were 38 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in December 2010, there was one burglary on Fox Park. There were no stealings reported and there were no property damages reported. There was one DWI, two traffic accidents, seven people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on eight different streets and there were 21 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered seven with six shopliftings and one from a vehicle. There was one stolen vehicle reported. There were two people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and there were sixteen police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

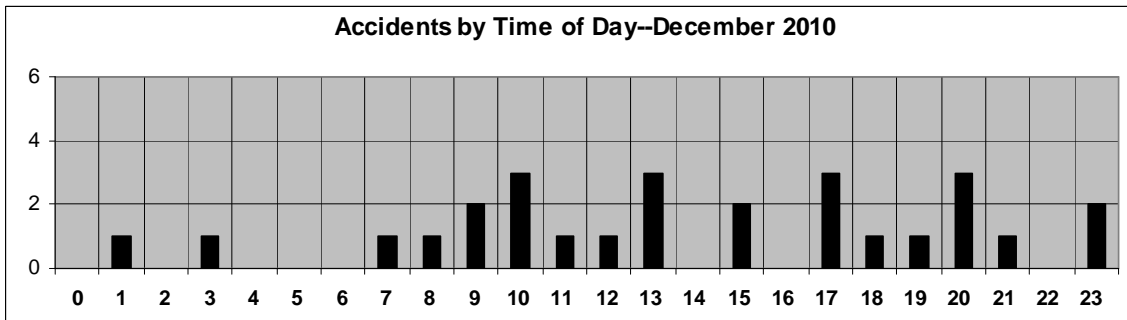

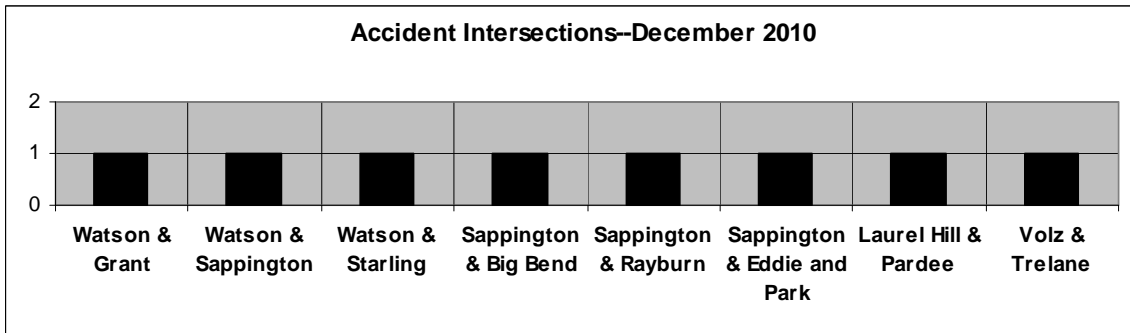
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



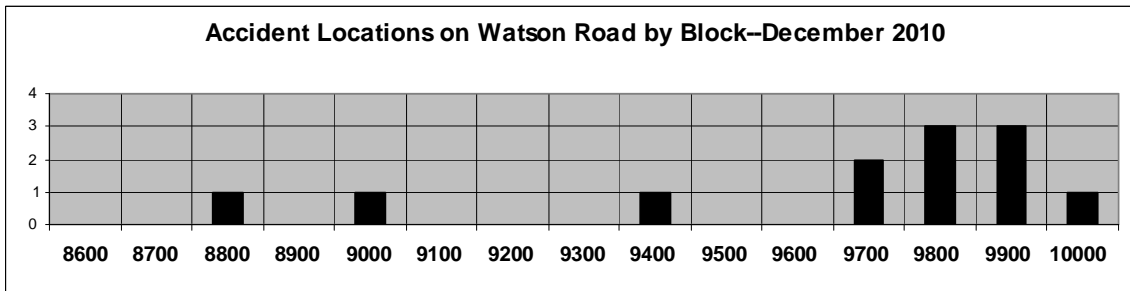

Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



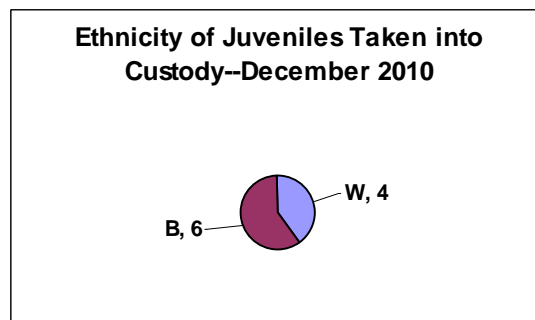
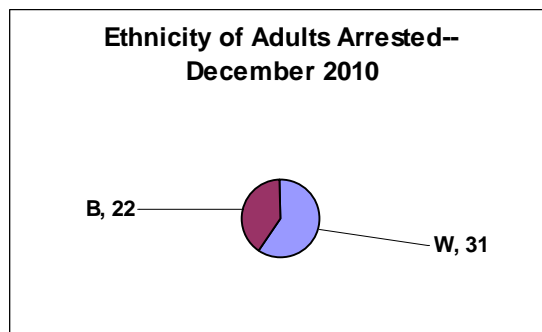

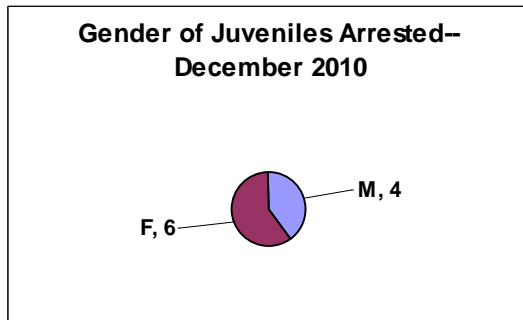
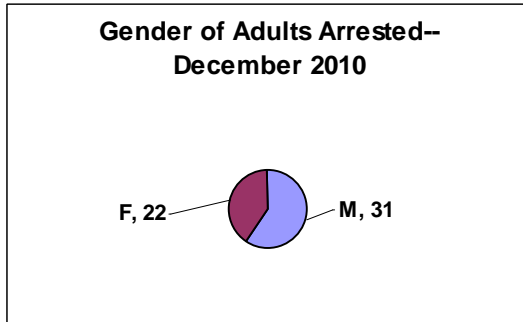
Arrest Information:

Fifty-three adults and ten juveniles were taken into custody in December 2010. Six persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

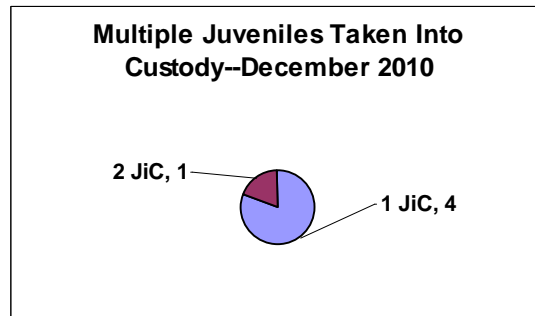
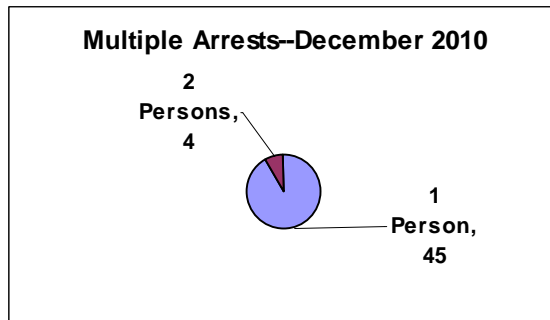
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



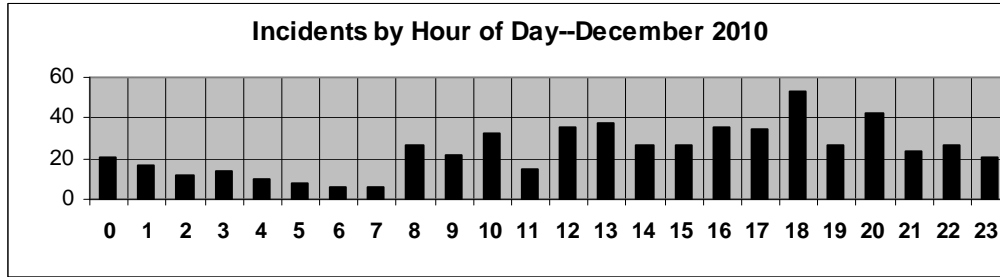
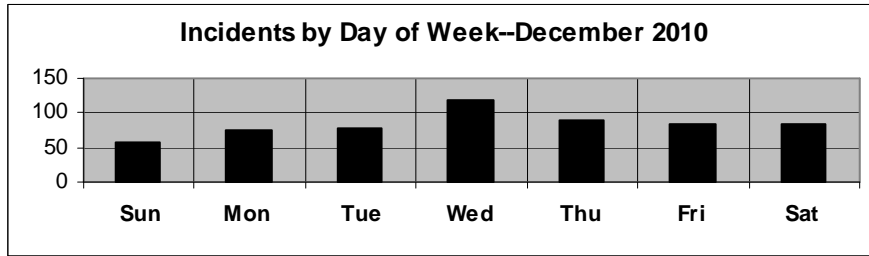
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

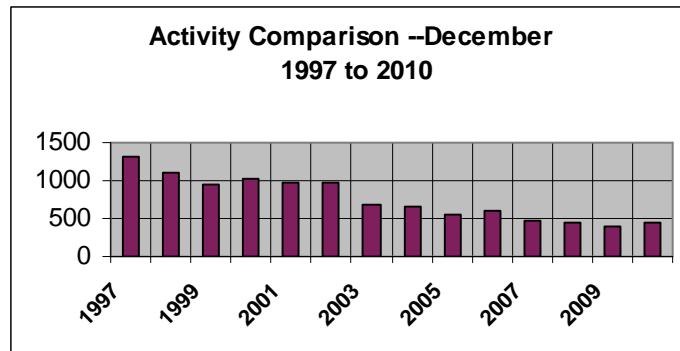
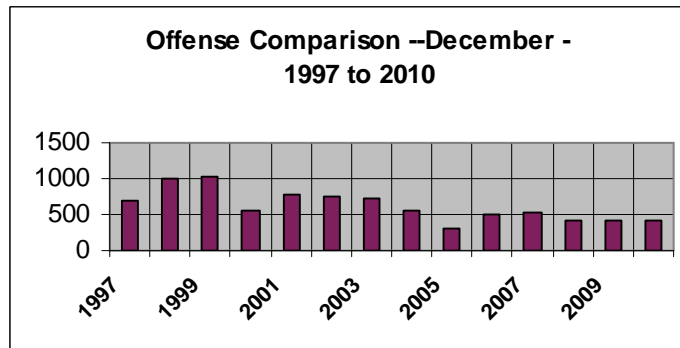

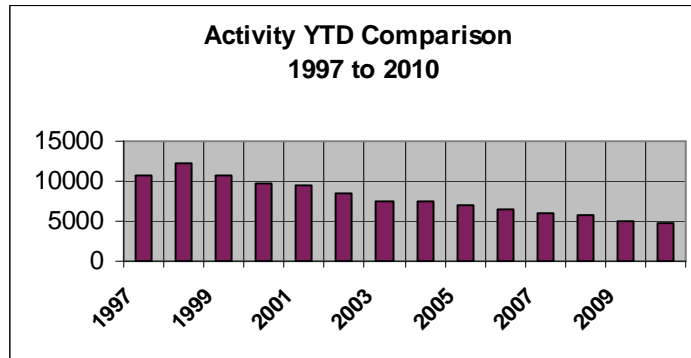
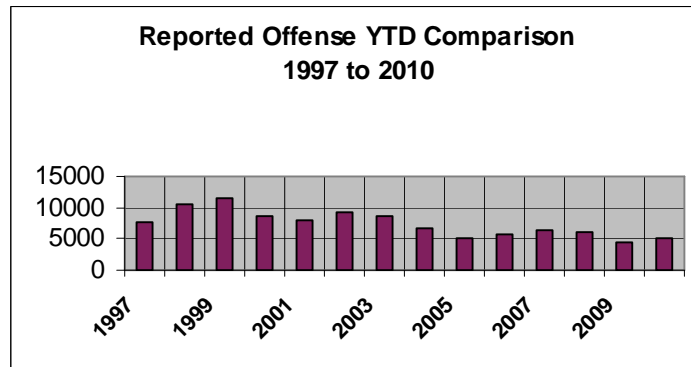


Offense and Activity Comparison:

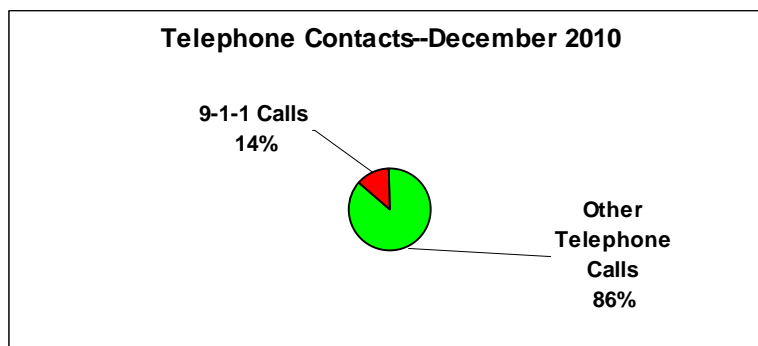


Years to Date:

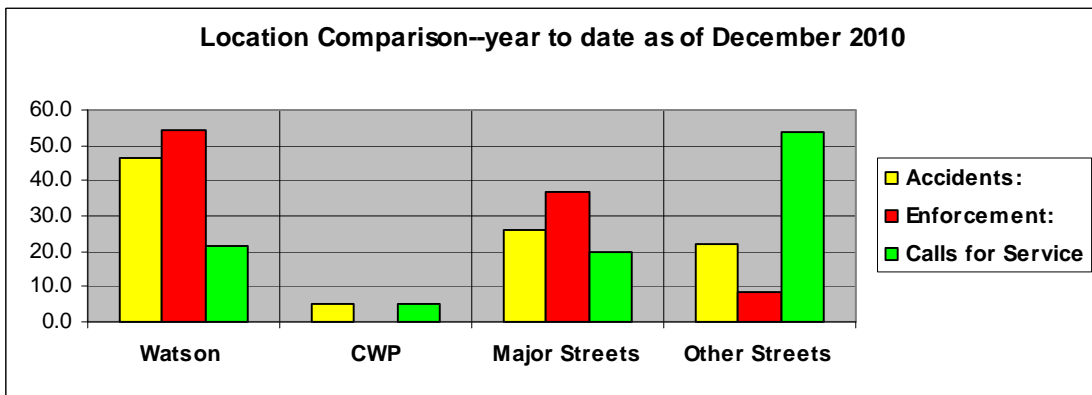


Location Comparison:

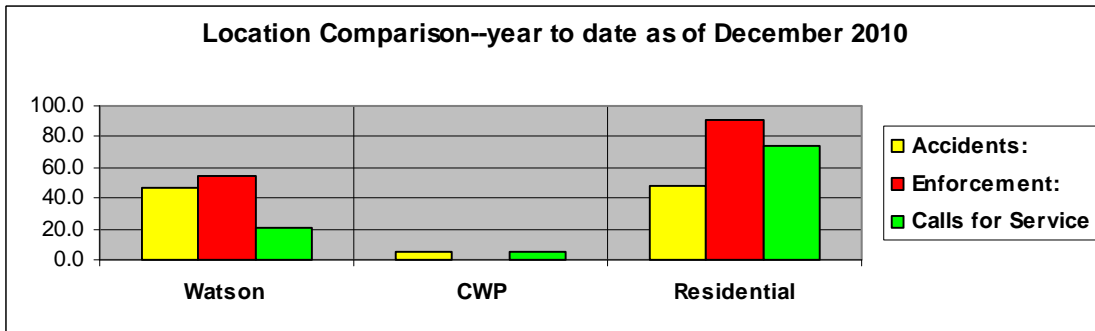
