Topic: February 2011 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of February 2011. In February 2011, there were 23 Part I offenses and 370 Part II offenses for a total of 393. This compares with 27 Part I offenses and 415 Part II offenses for a total of 442 in February 2010. The main difference was in the number of shopliftings and traffic stops.

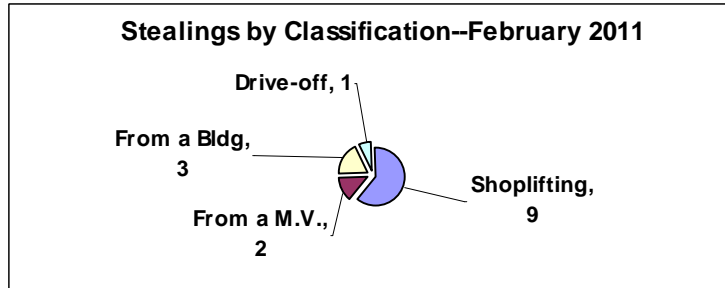
There was one sexual offense reported in February. A camera was located in a restroom of a non-retail business by a female employee.

There were two assaults in February 2011 and both involved domestic violence. In both cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

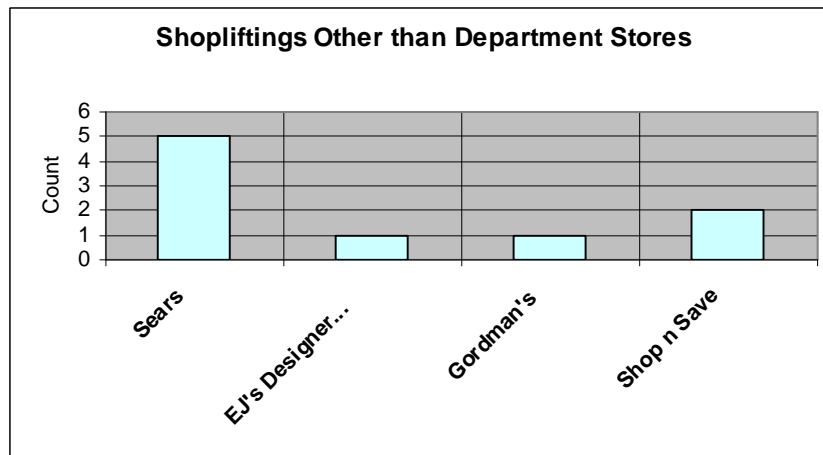
There were three burglaries reported in February. The first was reported on 02-14-2011 on Sturdy Drive. The residence was forced open and jewelry and a rifle were taken. The scene was processed by the Detective Bureau. The second burglary was reported in 02-24-2011 on Gillespie. The resident had stayed home sick and heard a noise and when he went to investigate, he found a male in the residence. When confronted, the suspect left the residence. The victim knew the suspect and the suspect was later arrested and warrants were issued. The third burglary was reported on 02-28-2011 on Diversey. A neighbor reported a suspicious person at the residence and called the resident. The Police were called and the female suspect was taken into custody and warrants were issued.

Stealing offenses numbered fifteen in February 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in February 2011:

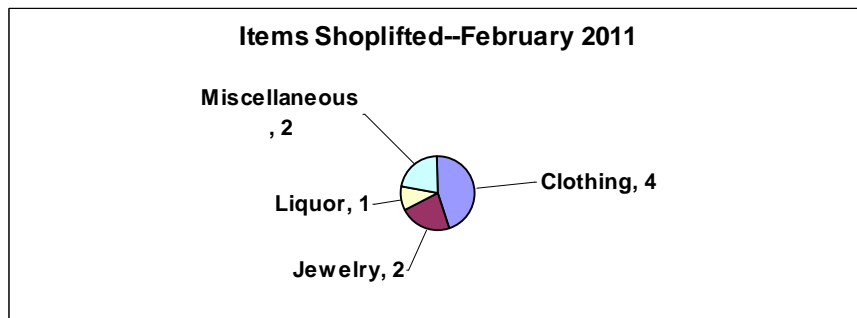


Shopliftings accounted for nine of the fifteen stealings in February 2011 or 60%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in February 2011:



Of the shopliftings, 89% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 87% and juveniles accounted for 13% of the clearances.

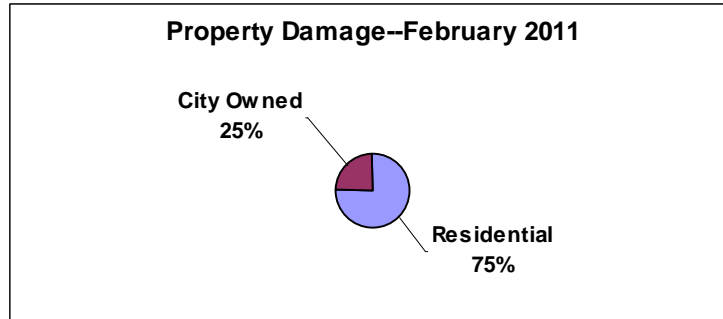

Part II:

In February 2011, there were four frauds reported, one credit card fraud, one passing bad checks, one fail to return a leased vehicle and one all other type fraud. There were three possession of small quantity of marijuana cases. There were 61 people related calls including 57 medical emergencies, two sudden deaths and two suicides or attempt suicides. There were eleven animal calls and 31 suspicious activity calls and 183 miscellaneous police service calls.

Part II offenses totaled 370 in February 2011.

In February 2011 in Ward One, there was one burglary on Diversey. Stealings numbered three with two at addresses on Watson Road and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one with one in the neighborhoods. There was one drug offense, nine traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on four different streets and there were 49 miscellaneous police service calls.

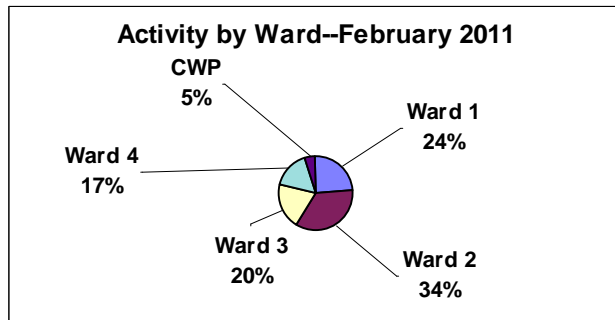
In Ward Two in February 2011, there was one burglary on Gillespie and one sexual offense. Stealings numbered five with five at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one with one in the neighborhoods. There were three frauds and one drug offense. There were four traffic accidents, twenty people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on eight different streets and there were 60 calls for miscellaneous police services.

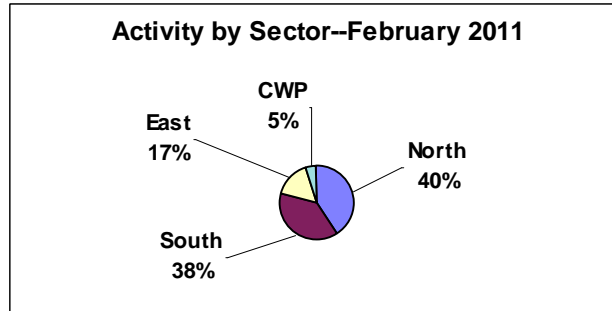
In February 2011 in Ward Three, stealings numbered one with one in the neighborhoods and property damages numbered one with one in the condo complex. There were two traffic accidents, seventeen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on five different streets and there were 38 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in February 2011, there was one burglary on Sturdy. Stealings numbered one and property damages numbered one. There was one fraud and one drug offense. There were nine people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 30 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered five with five shopliftings and there were no property damages. There were two people related calls and one animal related call. There were no suspicious activity calls and there were six police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

CAD Activity by Ward and Sector:



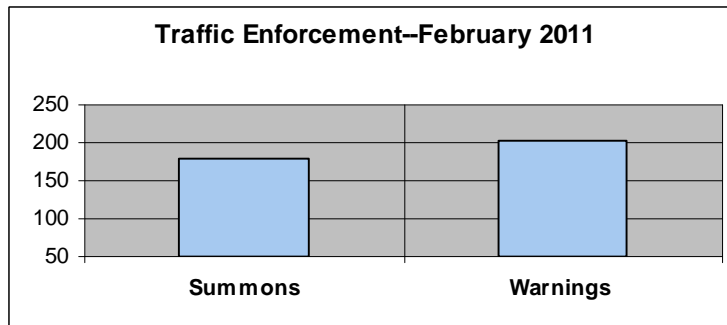


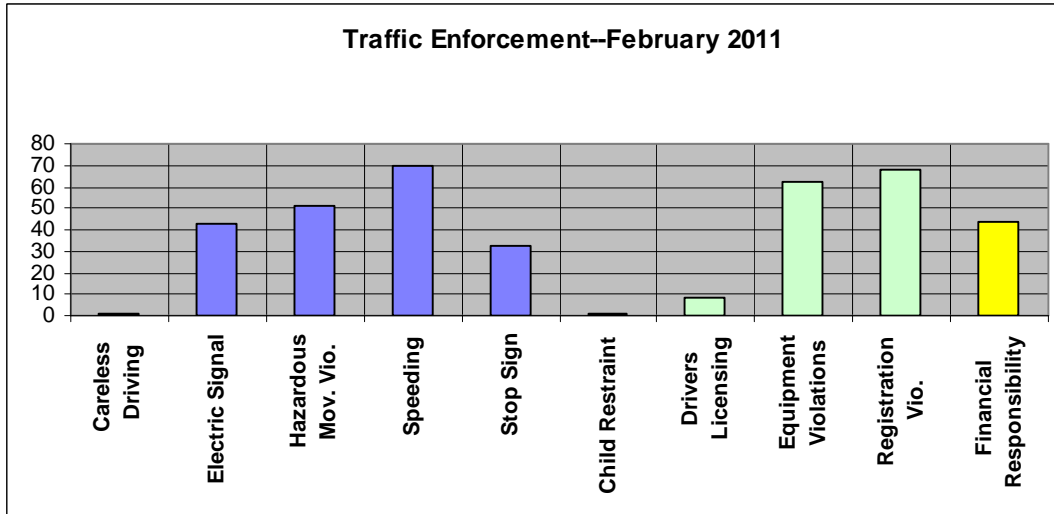

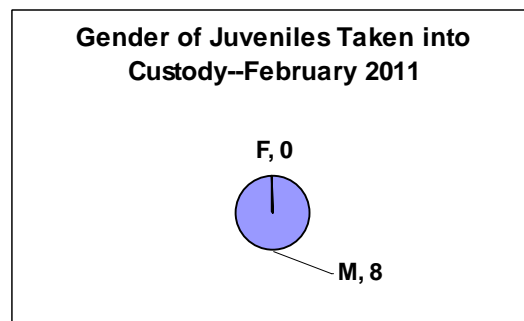
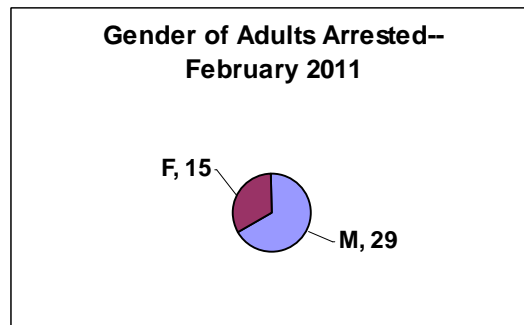
Arrest Information:

Forty-four adults and eight juveniles were taken into custody in February 2011. Eight persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

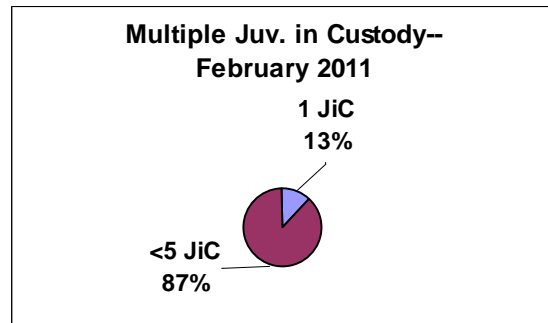
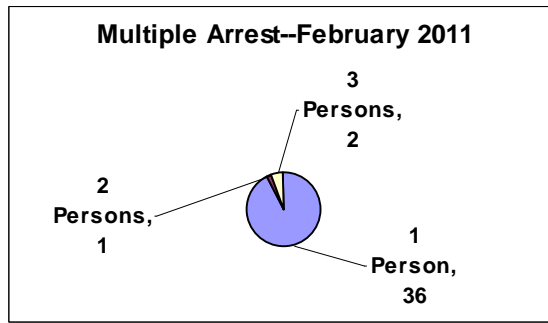
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



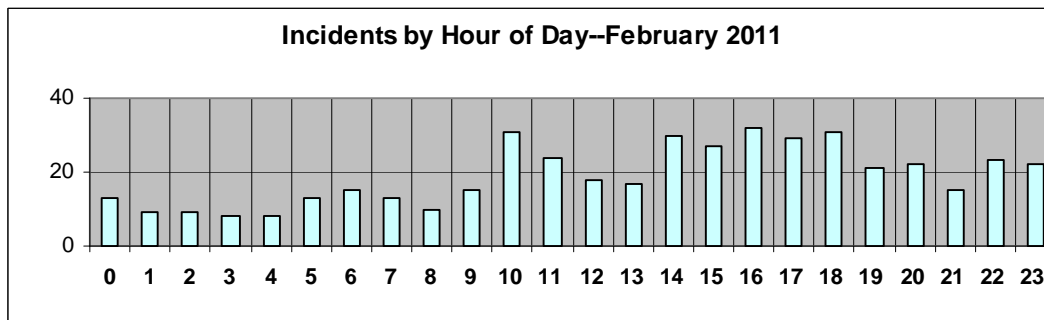
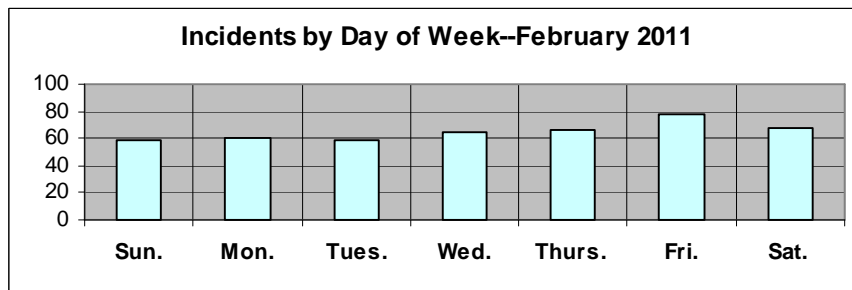
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

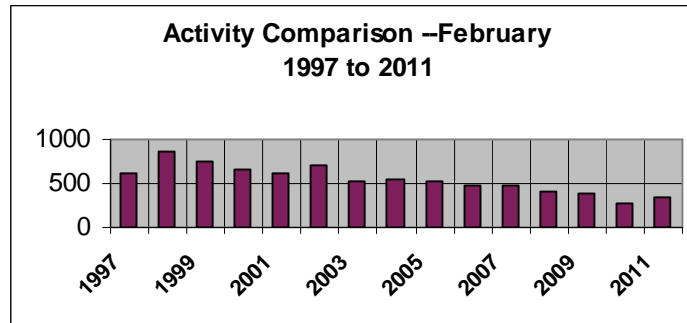
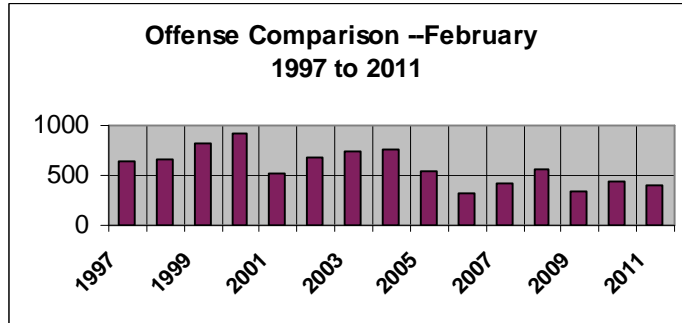

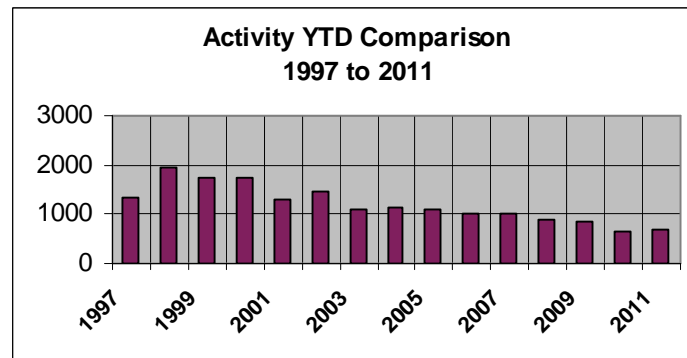
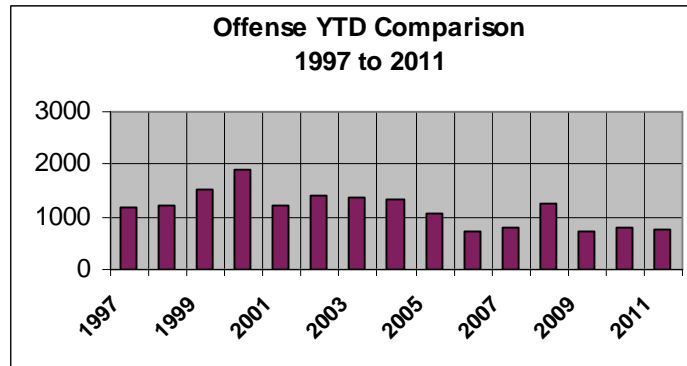


Offense and Activity Comparison:

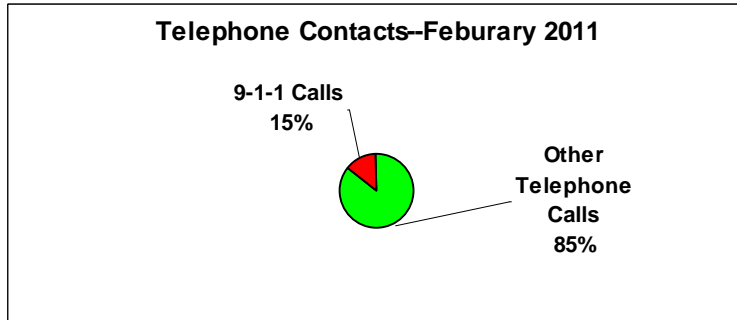


Years to Date:

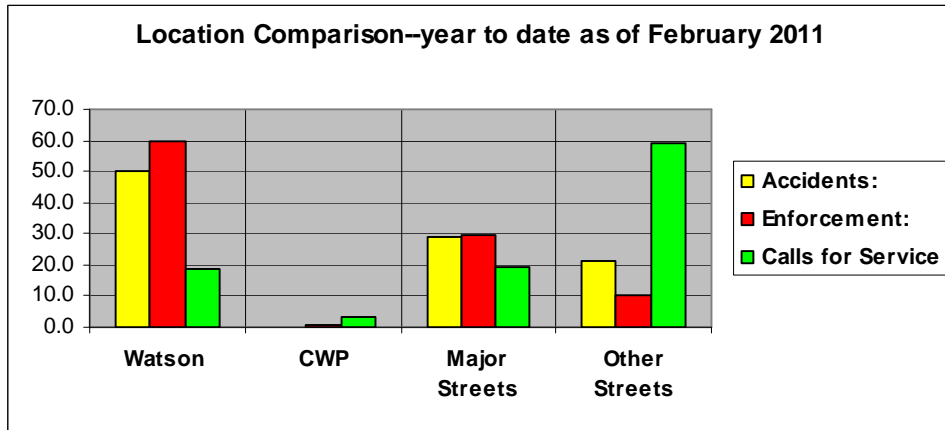


Location Comparison:

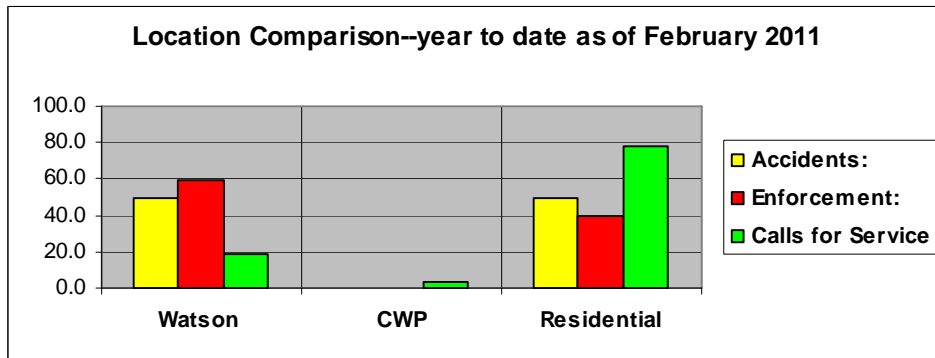
