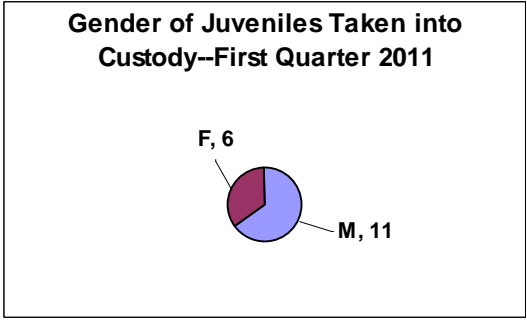
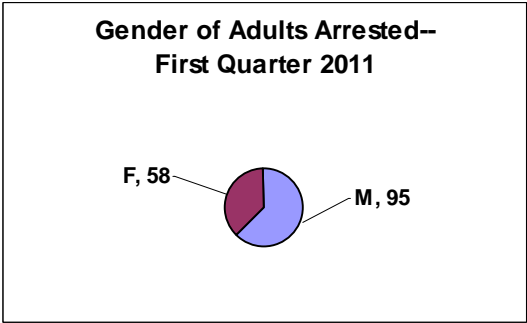
One hundred fifty-three adults and seventeen juveniles were taken into custody in the First Quarter. Fourteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrest.

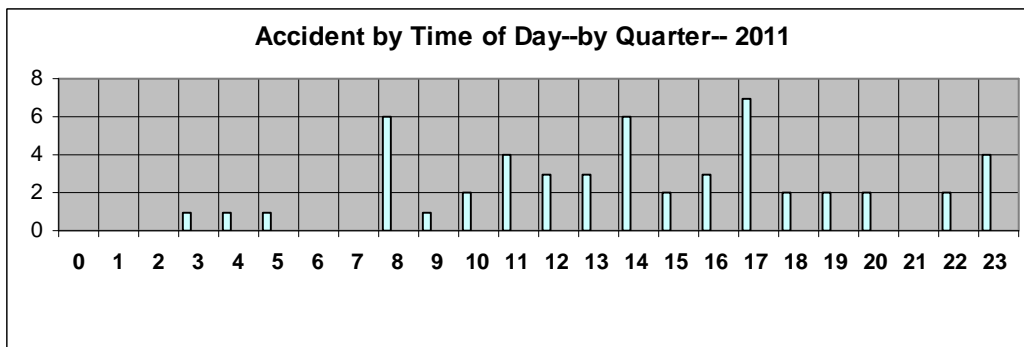

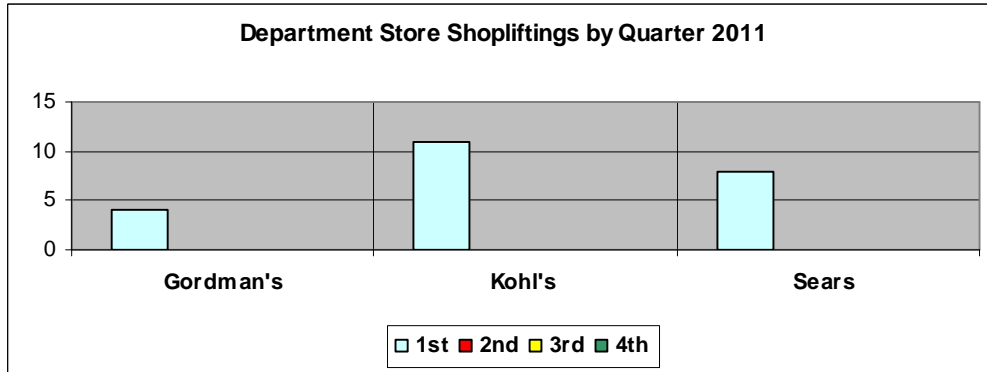
Stealings:

There were 30 shopliftings reported in the First Quarter. This was 55% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:

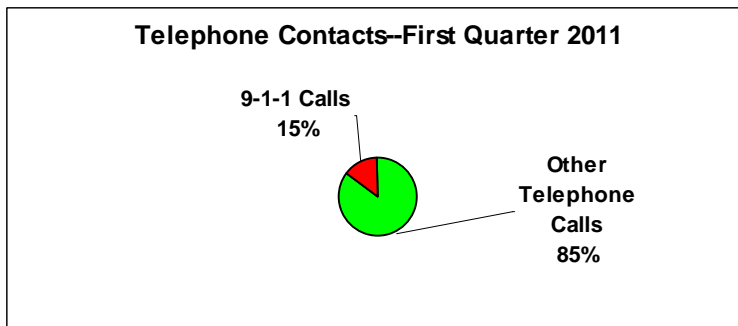

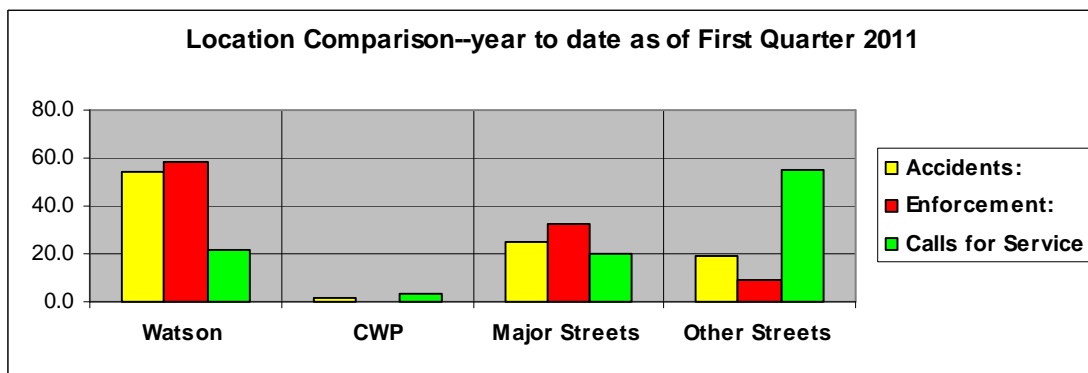


Location Comparison:

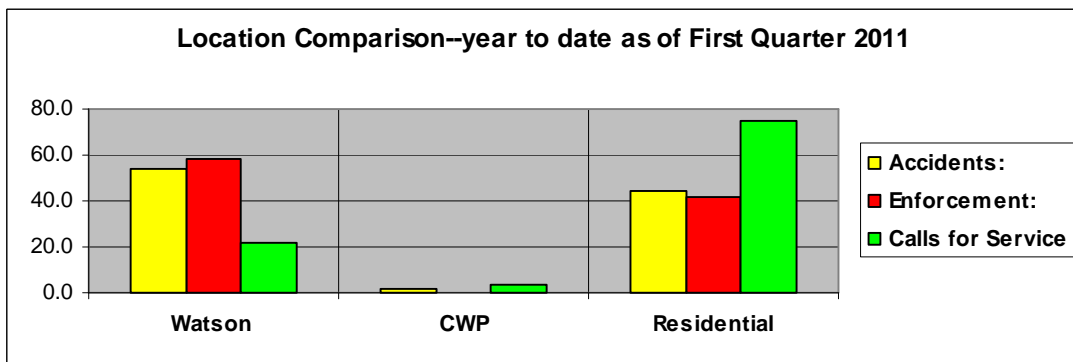
