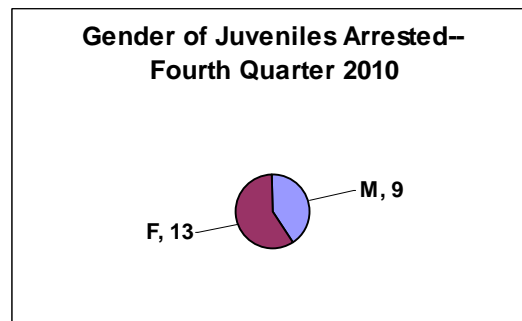
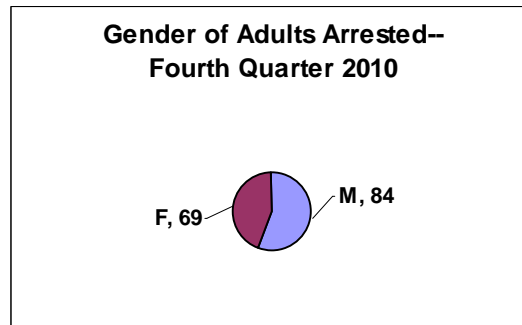
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

The ethnicity of the person arrested was:



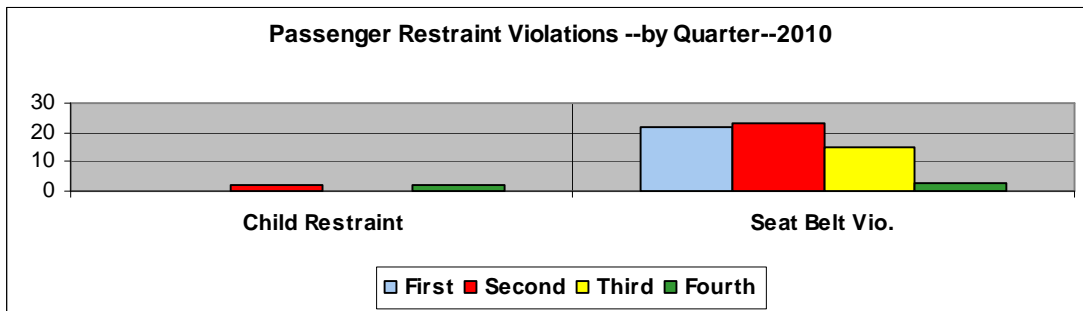
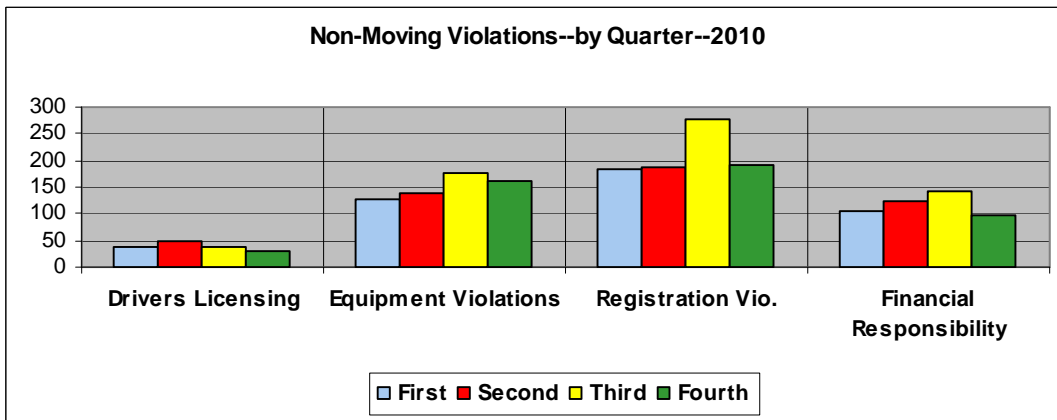
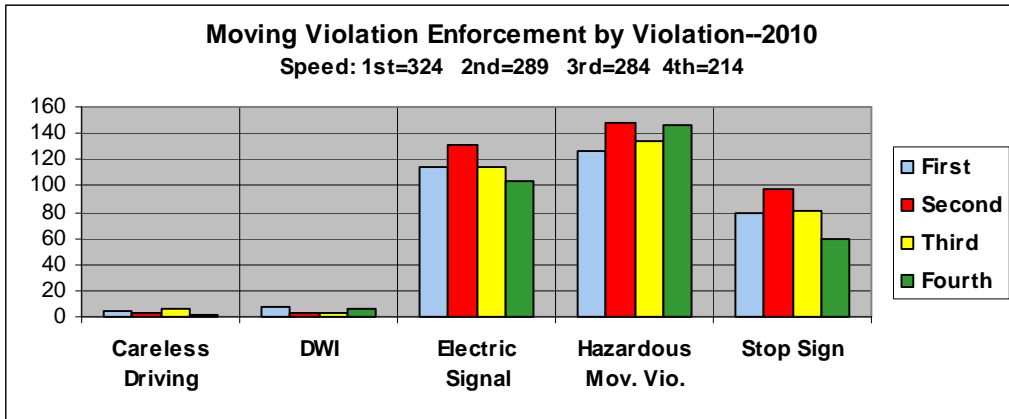
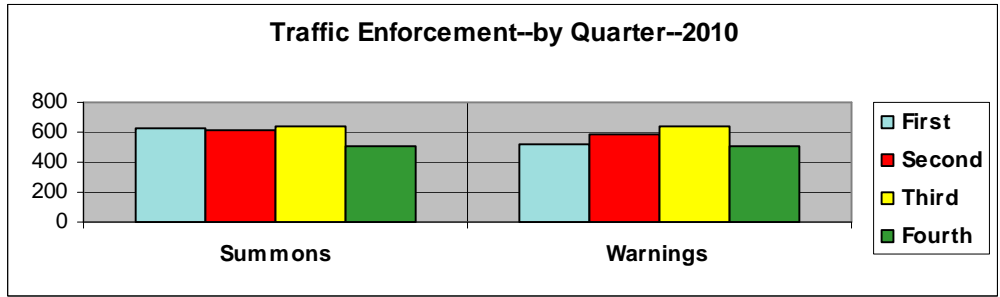

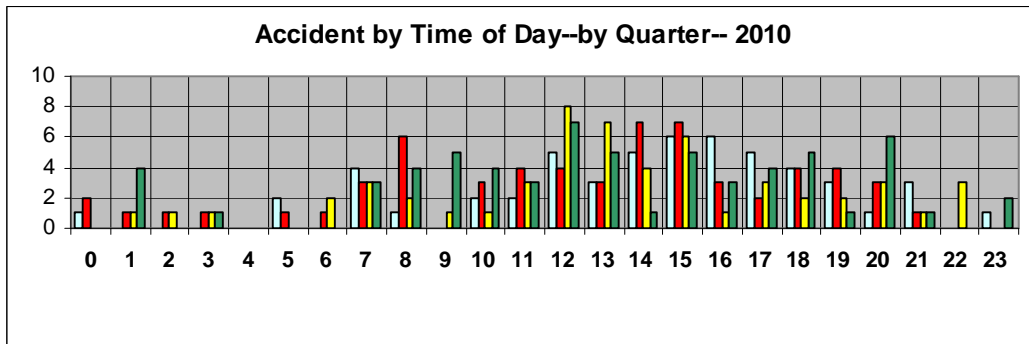

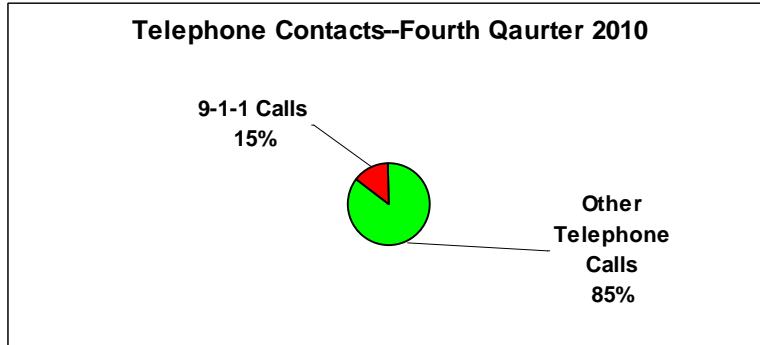

Communications:

In the Fourth Quarter, Communications handled 13,488 telephone contacts and 1395 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 89 telephone calls and fifteen 9-1-1 calls.

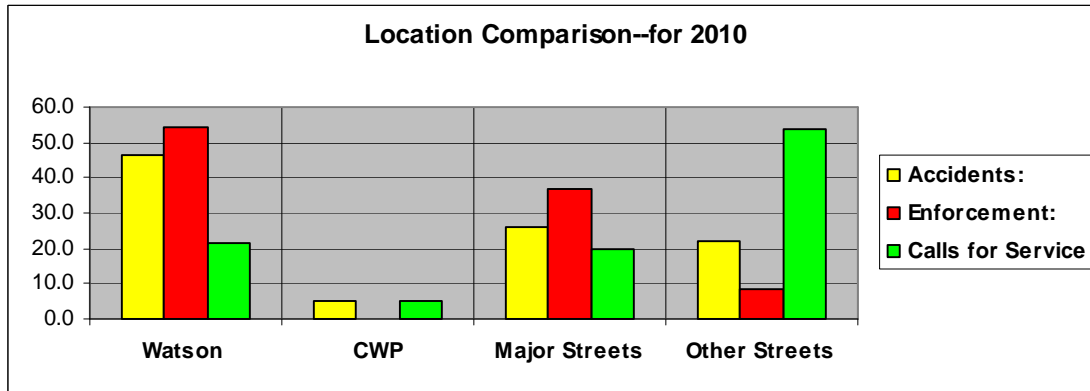

Location Comparison:

Watson is activity along Watson Road and CWP is activity in Crestwood Plaza. Major streets are the following streets that have been used to track accidents and enforcement for a length of time.
