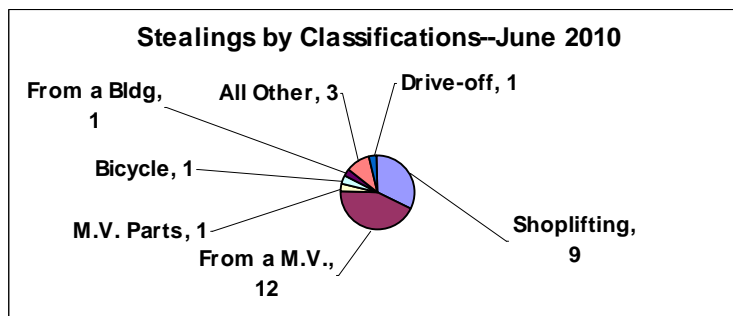
Topic: June 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of June 2010. In June 2010, there were 32 Part I offenses and 372 Part II offenses for a total of 404. This compares with 43 Part I offenses and 340 Part II offenses for a total of 383 in June 2009. The main difference was in the number of shopliftings and traffic stops.

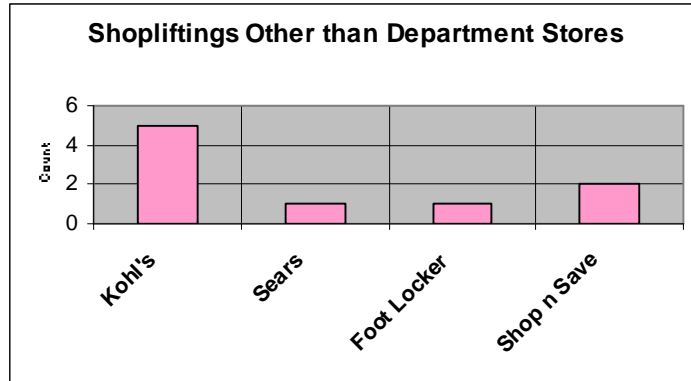
There were five assaults in June 2010 and three involved domestic violence. In four cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 28 in June 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in June 2010:



Shopliftings accounted for nine of the 28 stealings in June 2010 or 32%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in June 2010:

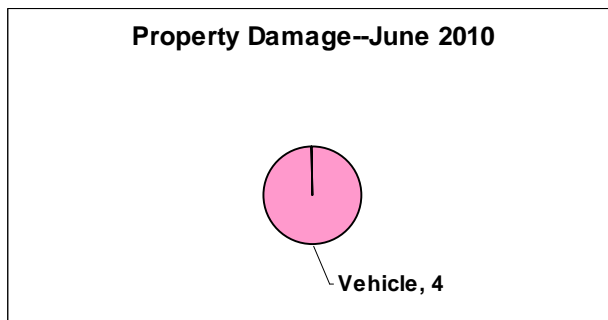


Of the shopliftings, 89% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

There were four property damages in June 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



Part I offenses numbered 32 in June 2010.

Part II:

In June 2010, there was one fraud, an internet transaction fraud and there were two drug possession cases, one was a small quantity of marijuana and the other was a small quantity of synthetic narcotics. The two offenses against public peace were a disorderly conduct and a domestic stalking. There was one DWI case, seventeen motor vehicle accidents, 61 people related calls including 56 medical emergencies, 4 suicides or

attempts and one missing person and there were twelve animal calls. The single juvenile offense was a protective custody.

Part II offenses totaled 372 in June 2010.

In June 2010 in Ward One, stealings numbered three with none at addresses on Watson Road, two in the neighborhoods and one in an apartment complex. Property damages numbered two, none at addresses along Watson Road or in the neighborhoods and one in an apartment complex and one in an industrial park. There was one fraud, one drug violation and one offense against public peace. There were five traffic accidents, eleven people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered nineteen and occurred on thirteen different streets and there were 52 miscellaneous police service calls.

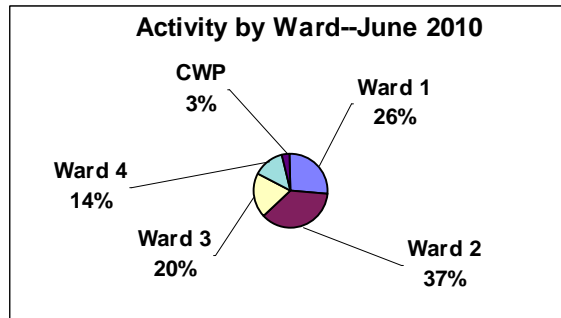
In Ward Two in June 2010, stealings numbered fifteen with twelve at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one in a neighborhood. There was one drug offense, one offense against public peace and one juvenile related offense. There were six traffic accidents, 20 people related calls and six animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered 26 and occurred on thirteen different streets and there were 65 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In June 2010 in Ward Three, stealings numbered five with one at addresses on Watson Road, four in Whitecliff Park and none in the neighborhoods. There were no property damages. There was one DWI case, five traffic accidents, seventeen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 39 miscellaneous police service calls.

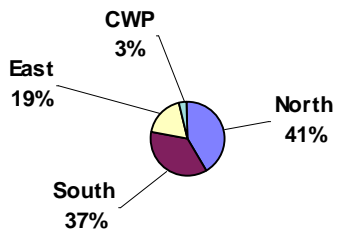
In Ward Four in June 2010, Stealings numbered two and property damages numbered one. One traffic accident, twelve people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on eight different streets and there were 22 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered three with two shopliftings and one from a vehicle and there were no property damages. There was one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered one and there were four police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

Activity by Sector--June 2010

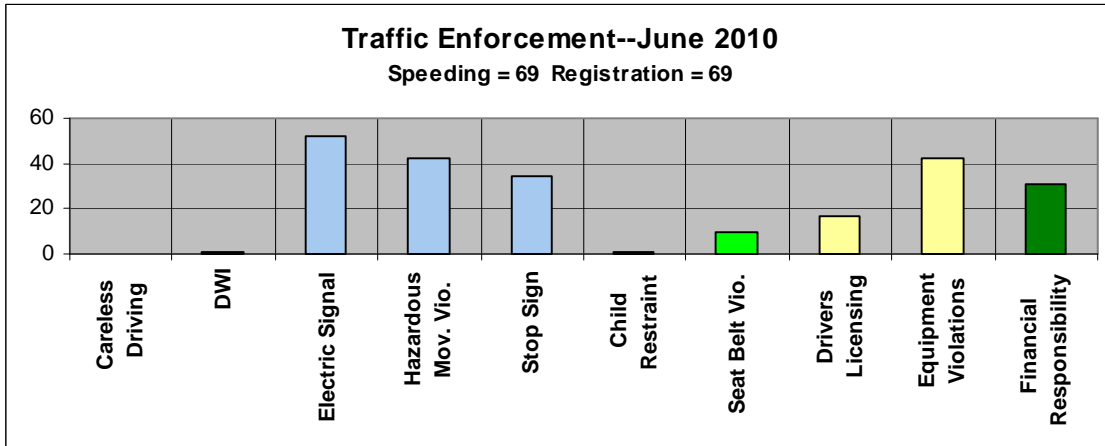
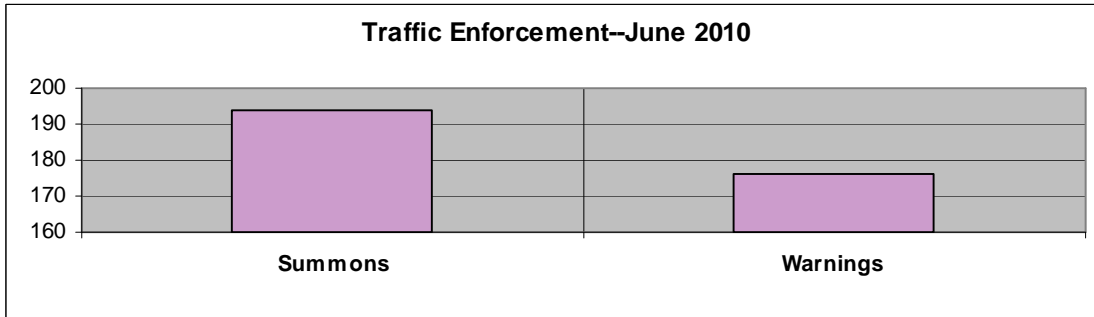

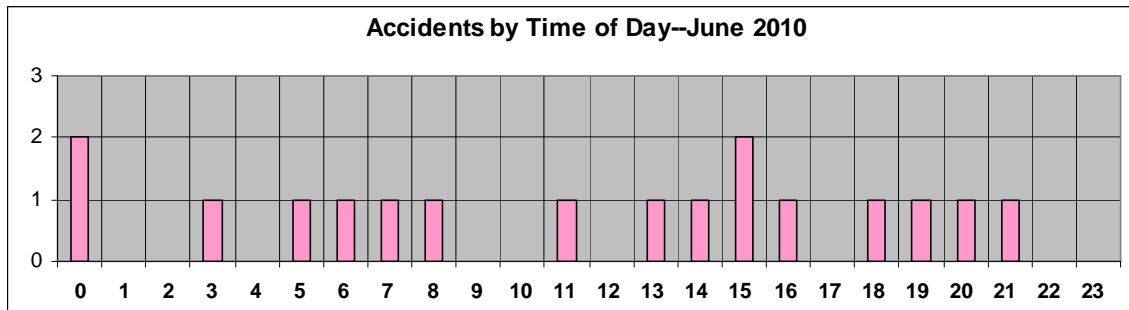

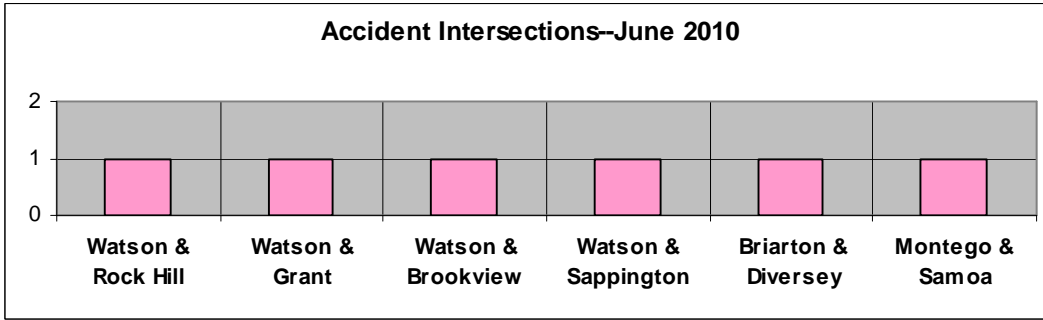
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



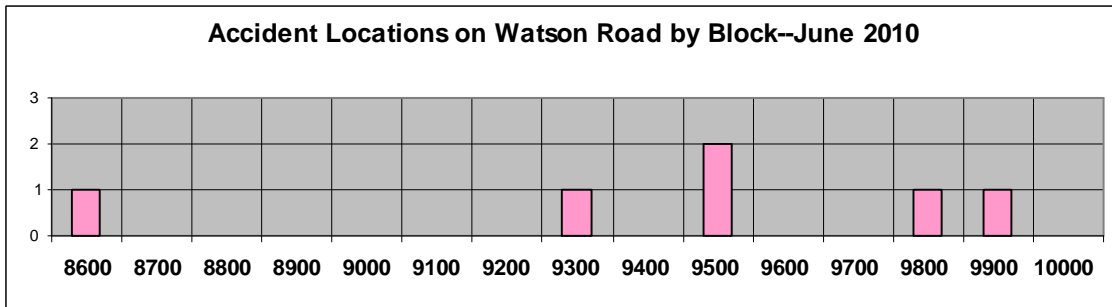

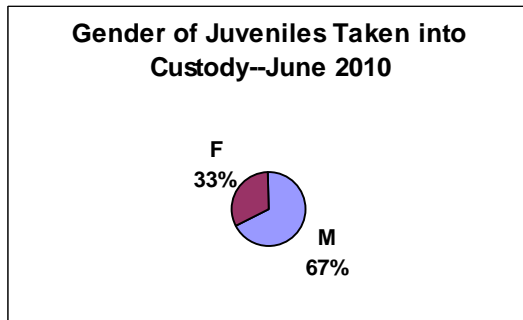
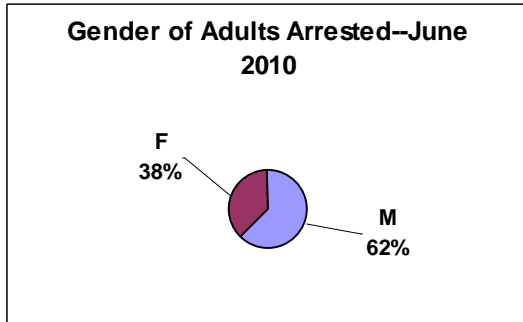
Arrest Information:

Forty-five adults and three juveniles were taken into custody in June 2010. Five persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

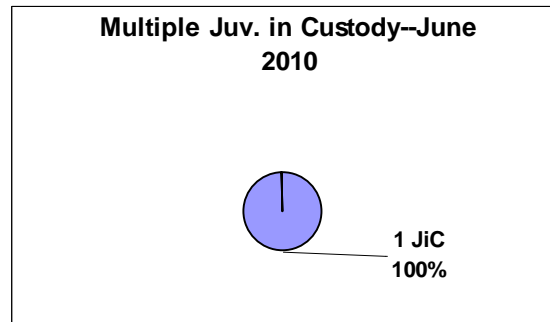
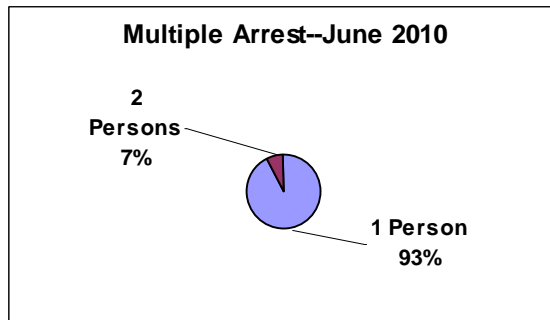
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



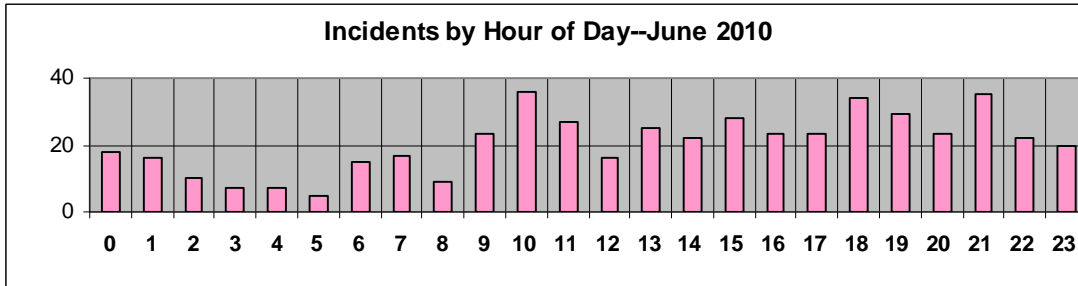
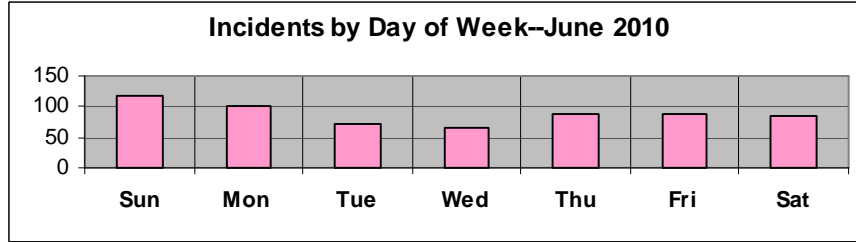
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

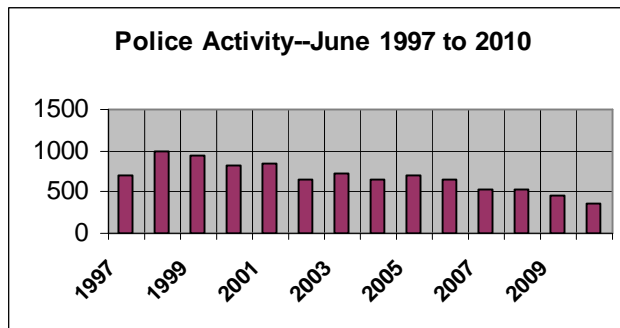
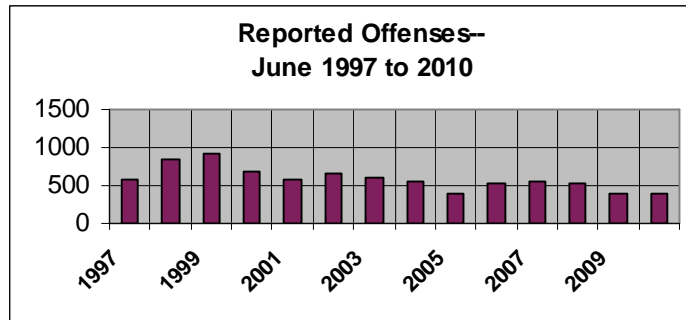

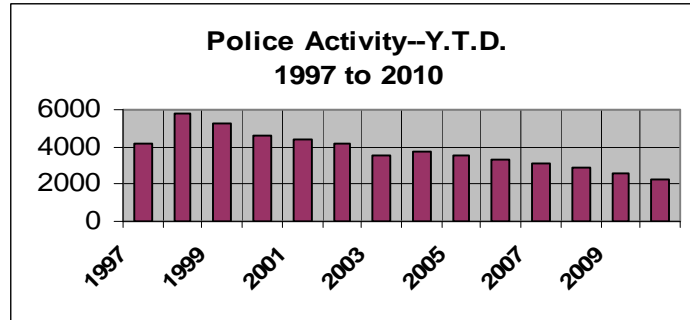
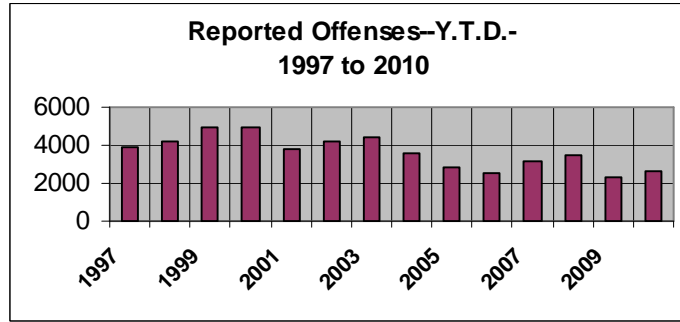


Offense and Activity Comparison:

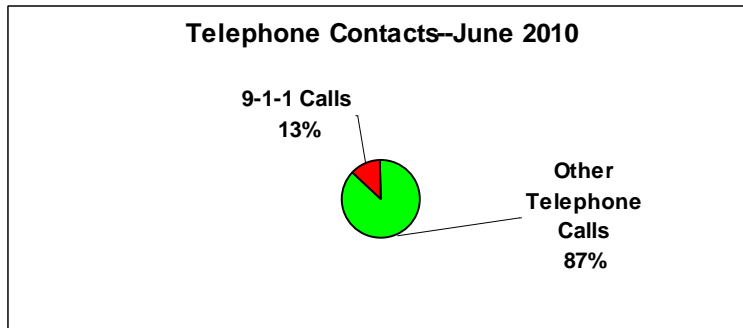


Years to Date:

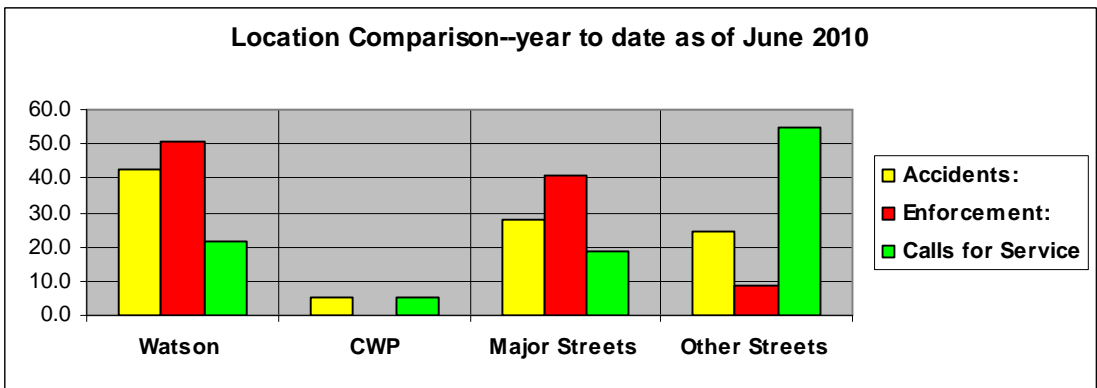


Location Comparison:

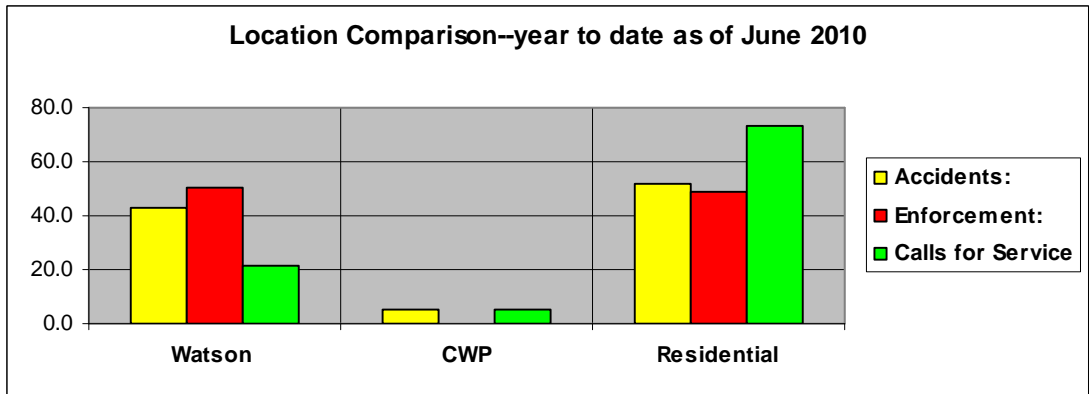
