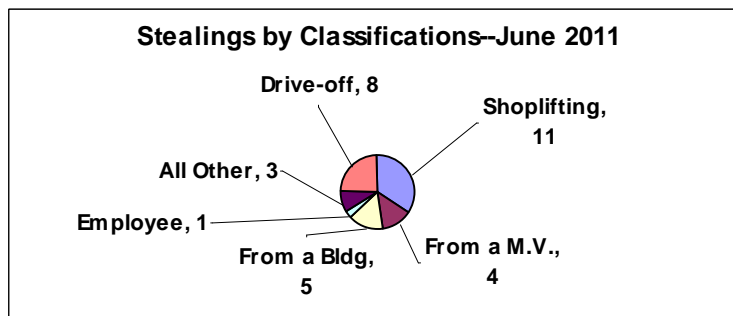
Topic: June 2011 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of June 2011. In June 2011, there were 39 Part I offenses and 394 Part II offenses for a total of 433. This compares with 32 Part I offenses and 372 Part II offenses for a total of 404 in June 2010. The main difference was in the number of stealings, property damages and traffic stops.

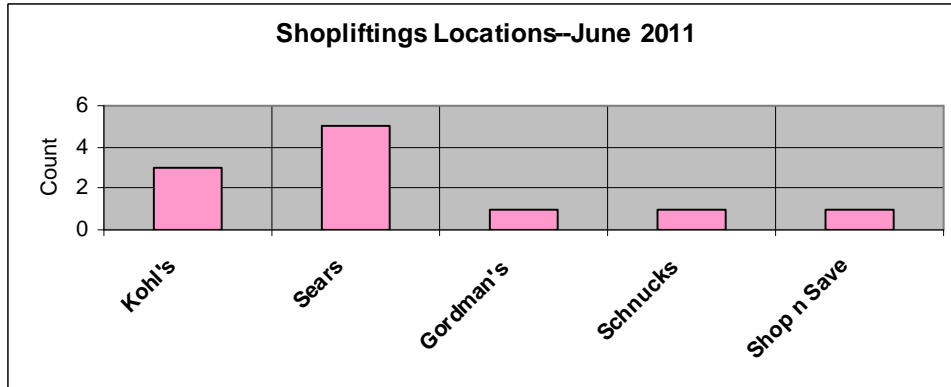
There were three assaults in June 2011 and all three involved domestic violence. In all cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 32 in June 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in June 2011:



Shopliftings accounted for eleven of the 32 stealings in June 2011 or 34%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in June 2011:

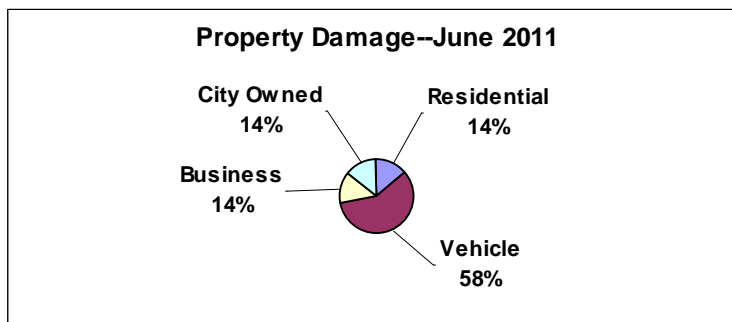


Of the shopliftings, 100% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 82%, adults and juveniles together accounted for 9% and juveniles accounted for 9% of the clearances.

There were seven property damages in June 2011 and they were of the following classifications:



The City Owned property damage was a State Owned electric signal box that had graffiti painted on it.

Part I offenses numbered 39 in June 2011.

Part II:

In June 2011, there were five frauds including three credit card type frauds, one forgery and one identity theft. There were three drug offenses that involved possession of a small quantity of marijuana, prescription medication and a clear substance in a syringe. The three offenses against public peace were all trespassings. There were 74 people related calls that included 71 medical emergencies, one missing person, one sudden death and one attempt suicide. There were twelve animal calls and two juvenile offenses that were both minors in possession of alcohol.

Part II offenses totaled 433 in June 2011.

In June 2011 in Ward One, stealings numbered seven with five at addresses on Watson Road and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two with both addresses along Watson Road. There were three frauds, two drug offenses and one offense against public peace. There were three traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on five different streets and there were 37 miscellaneous police service calls.

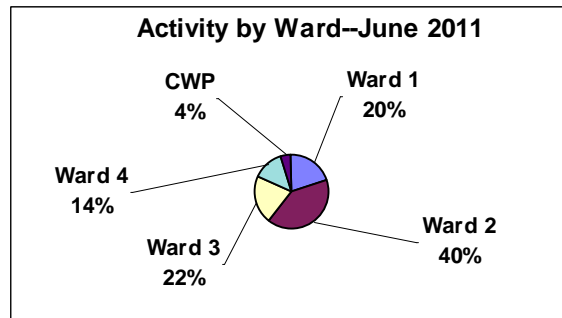
In Ward Two in June 2011, stealings numbered thirteen with twelve at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address in Watson Plaza. There was one fraud, one drug offenses and two offenses against public peace. There were nine traffic accidents, 28 people related calls and seven animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on ten different streets and there were 98 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In June 2011 in Ward Three, stealings numbered four with one at addresses on Watson Road, three in Whitecliff Park and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two, one in Whitecliff Park and one in the neighborhoods. There were two juvenile related and one weapons offense. There were two traffic accidents, 24 people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on eight different streets and there were 42 miscellaneous police service calls.

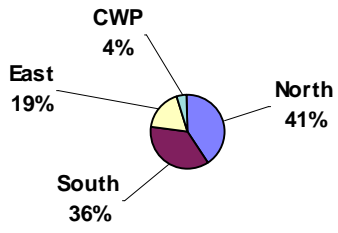
In Ward Four in June 2011, stealings numbered three and property damages numbered one. There was one fraud, one traffic accident, eight people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 36 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered five with five shopliftings and one property damage. There was one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and there were ten police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

Activity by Sector--June 2011

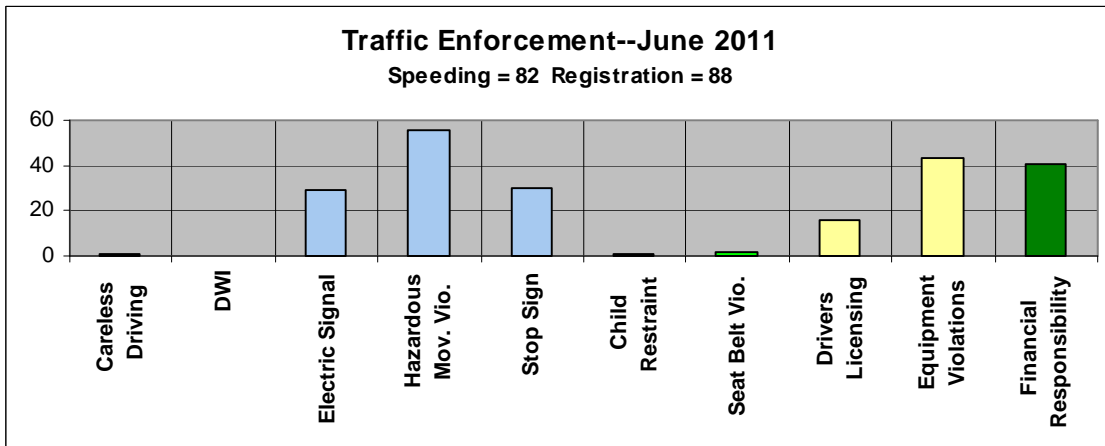
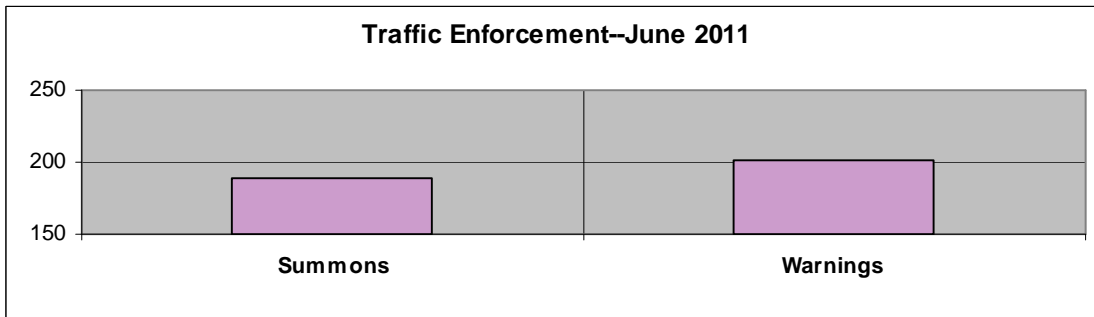

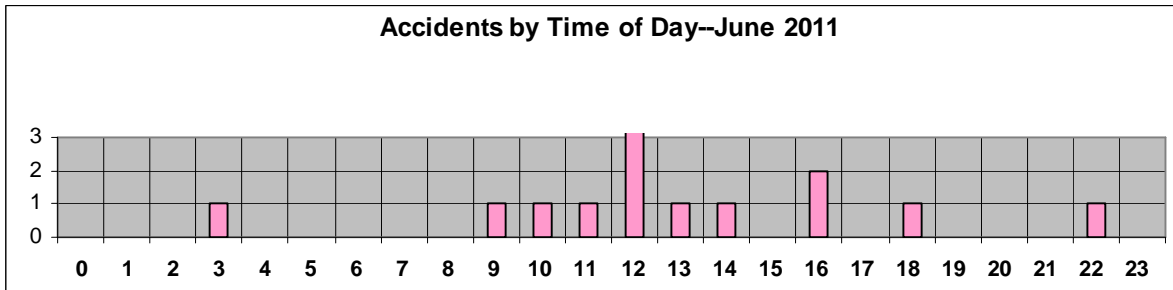

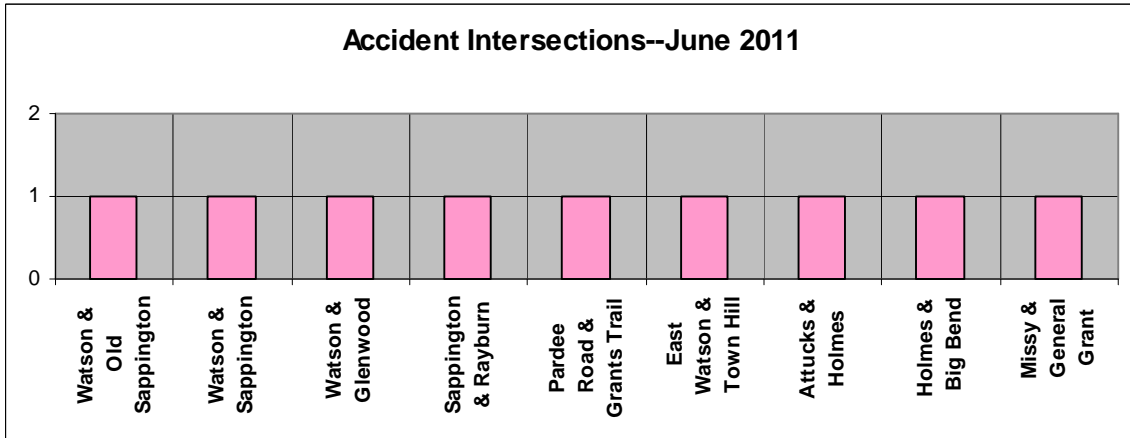
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



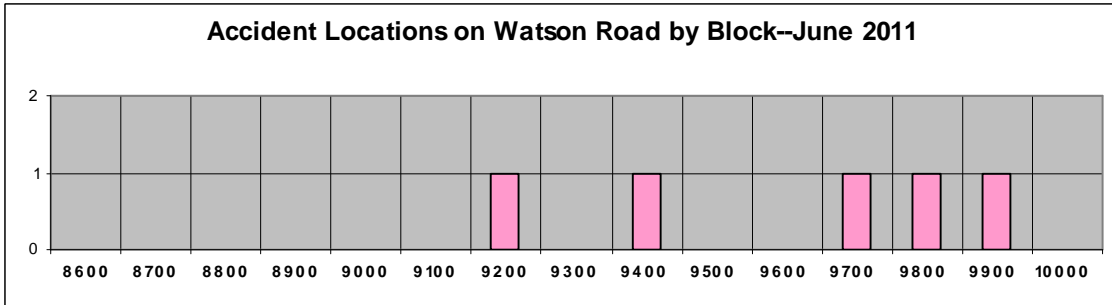

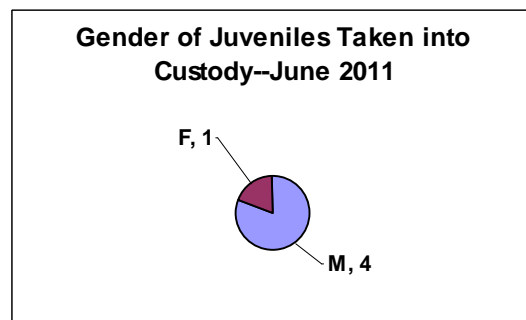
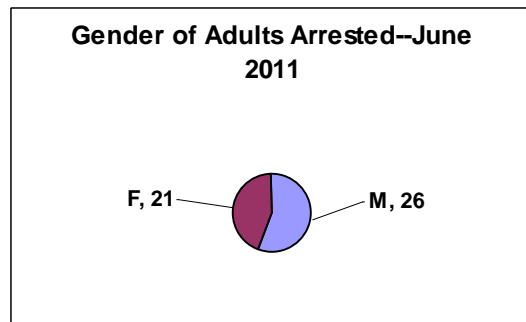
Arrest Information:

Forty-seven adults and five juveniles were taken into custody in June 2011. Eleven persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

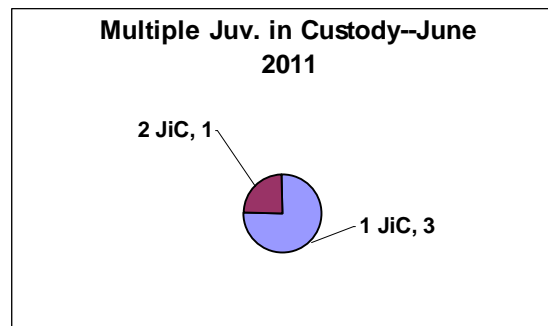
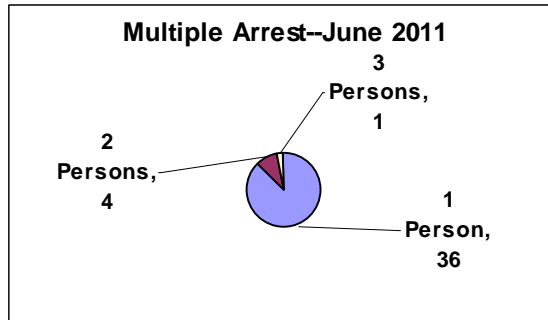
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



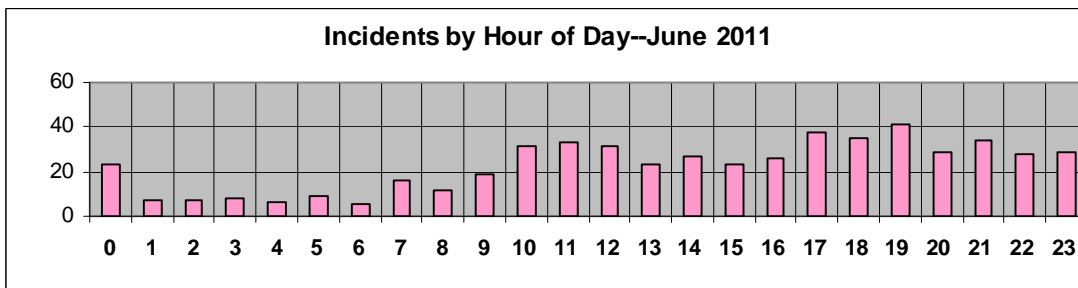
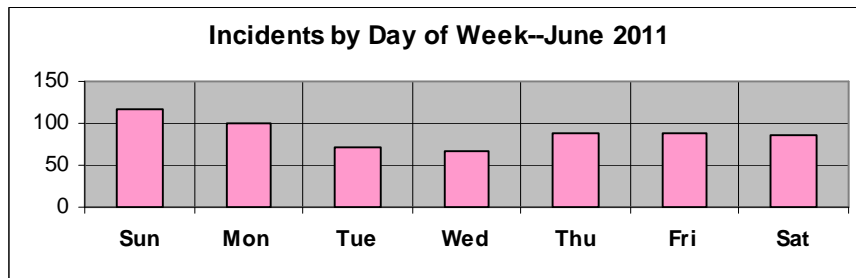
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

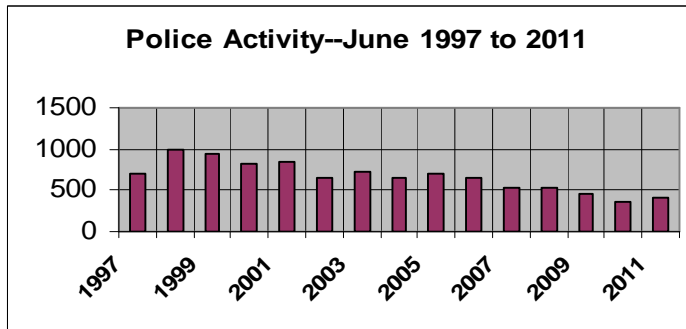
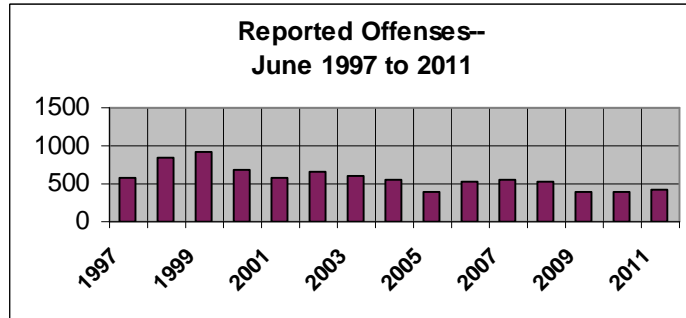

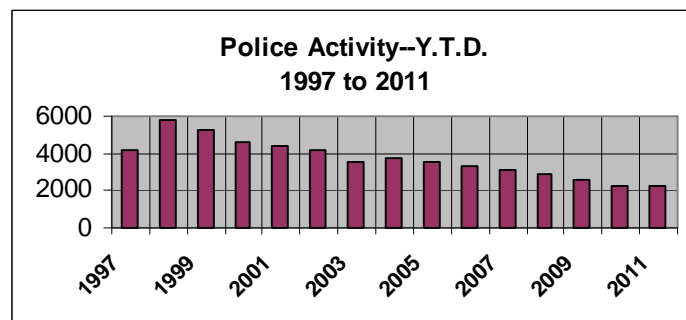
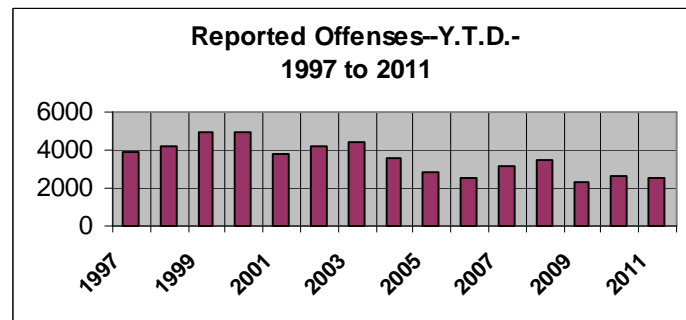


Offense and Activity Comparison:

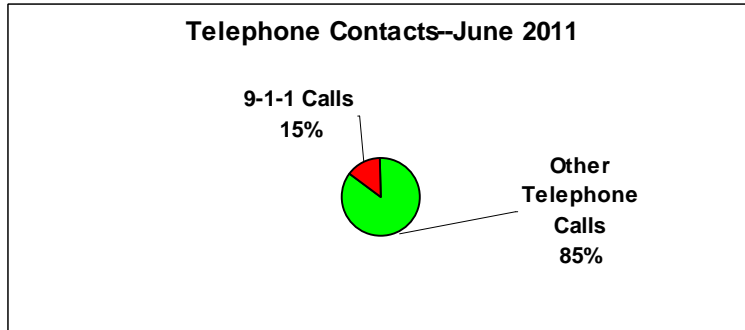


Years to Date:

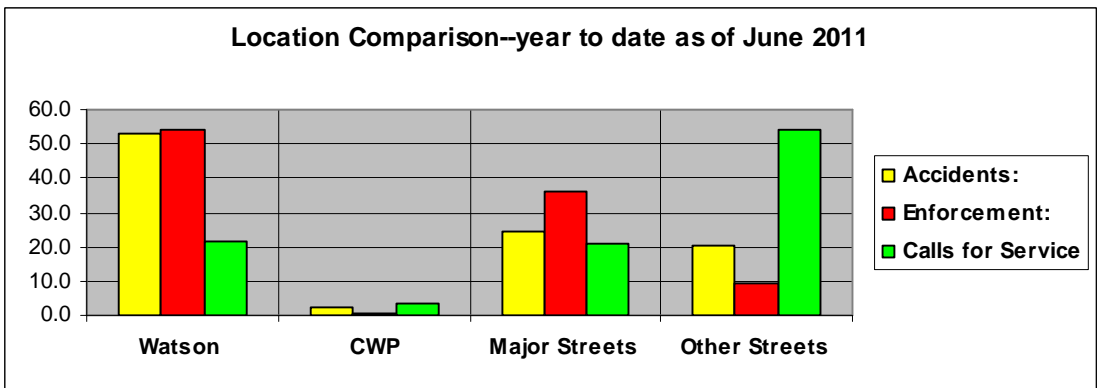


Location Comparison:

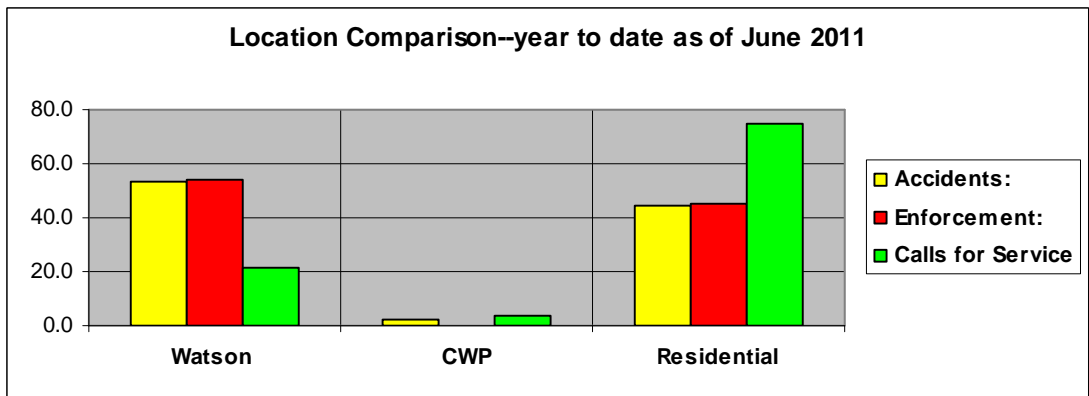
