Crestwood Liquor License - The City of Crestwood's Liquor Licenses are valid August 1st and expire on July 31st.

The Crestwood Board of Aldermen must approve all liquor licenses. The application form must be notarized.

Please forward the completed application, the State and County license numbers can be noted as pending. Upon receipt of the application the City Clerk's office will issue two approval letters; one to be used to obtain the State of Missouri Liquor License and one to be used to obtain the St. Louis County Liquor License.

Please forward a copy of your State of Missouri Liquor License Application, a copy of your background check used to receive your State of Missouri Liquor License, a copy of your State of Missouri Liquor License and a copy of your St. Louis County Liquor License to the City Clerk's office. At this time the City Clerk will put your request for a liquor license on the agenda for the next Board of Aldermen meeting. The Board of Aldermen meetings are the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month. The City Clerk's office will notify you of the Board of Aldermen's decision.

The license fee can be paid after the liquor license has been approved by the Board of Aldermen. The license fee(s) will be prorated. At that time the City of Crestwood liquor license will be issued. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to phone our office.
