Topic: March 2011 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of March 2011. In March 2011, there were 48 Part I offenses and 433 Part II offenses for a total of 481. This compares with 28 Part I offenses and 415 Part II offenses for a total of 443 in March 2010. The main difference was in the number of stealings and property damages.

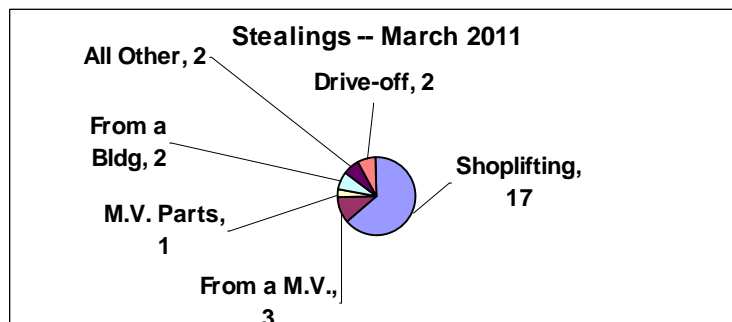
There was one sexual offense in March. Division of Family Services reported a case of sexual misconduct that had occurred between two pre-teen male relatives. The case will be referred to the Family Court for review.

There were three assaults in March 2011 and all three involved domestic violence.

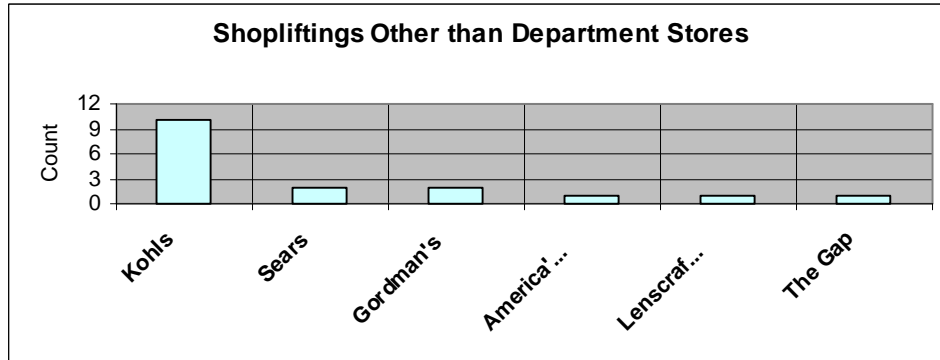
There was one burglary reported in March. On 03-21-2011, the victim reported that while he was at work during the daytime, someone entered his apartment on Park Crestwood and removed a game system, games, a laptop and some DVDs. There were some pry marks on the door and frame and a key broken off in a lock. The Detective Bureau responded and processed the scene.

Stealing offenses numbered 27 in March 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in March 2011:

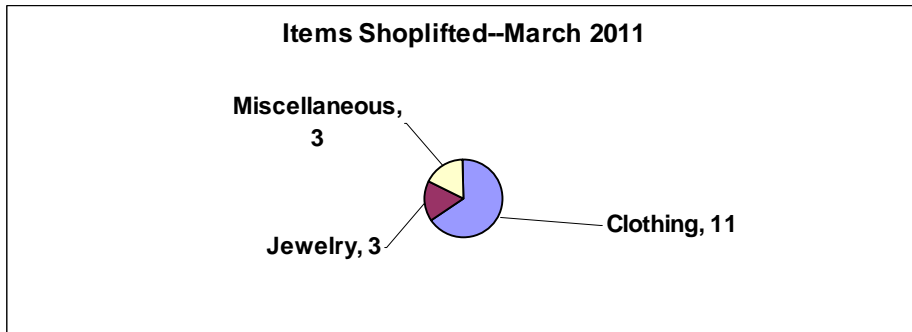


Shopliftings accounted for seventeen of the 27 stealings in March 2011 or 63%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in March 2011:

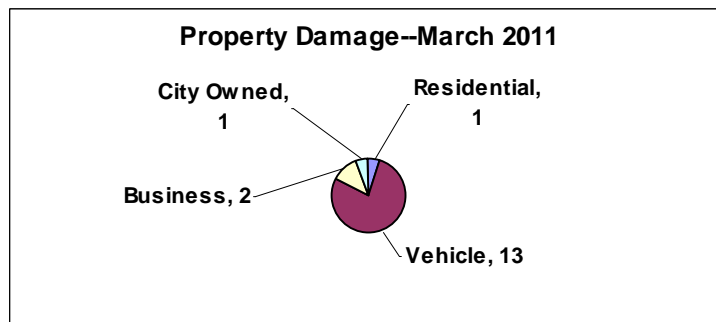


Of the shopliftings, 76% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 92% and juveniles accounted for 8% of the clearances.

There were seventeen property damages in March 2011 and they were of the following classifications:



There was one stolen vehicle and one recovered stolen vehicle in March 2011. The stolen vehicle was a green 2000 Mercury Villager Van that was stolen from a residence on Starling and was found burnt in Franklin County. Owner was not aware that the vehicle had been taken. The recovered vehicle was a white 2010 Hyundai Accent that had not been returned as a rental vehicle. The car rental agency employees found the vehicle and called for the Police. The driver was located and taken into custody. Vehicle was released to the car rental agency employees.

Part I offenses numbered 48 in March 2011.

**Part II:**

In March 2011, there were two frauds reported, one passing bad check and one all other type fraud. The three drug offenses included two possessions of marijuana and one possession of paraphernalia. The three offenses against public peace were two trespassings and one annoying telephone calls. There were fourteen traffic accidents, three DWI cases, and 78 people related calls including 75 medical emergencies, two sudden deaths and one missing person and there were eight animal related calls. There were 44 calls for suspicious activity and 189 miscellaneous police service calls and one weapon offense involving an intoxicated person in possession of a rifle.

Part II offenses totaled 433 in March 2011.

In March 2011 in Ward One, there was one burglary reported on Park Crestwood Drive. Stealings numbered five with three at addresses on Watson Road, one in an apartment complex and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered three with all three at addresses along Watson Road and none in the neighborhoods. There was one stolen vehicle recovered. There was one drug offense and one offense against public peace. There were three traffic accidents, sixteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fourteen and occurred on nine different streets and there were 50 miscellaneous police service calls.

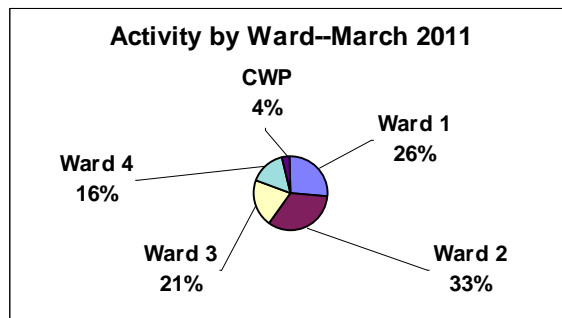
In Ward Two in March 2011, stealings numbered thirteen with thirteen at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered six, five at addresses along Watson Road and one in the neighborhoods. There was one stolen vehicle from Starling Drive. There was one fraud, one drug offense, and two offenses against public peace. There were two DWI cases, six traffic accidents, 26 people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on six different streets and there were 59 calls for miscellaneous police services.

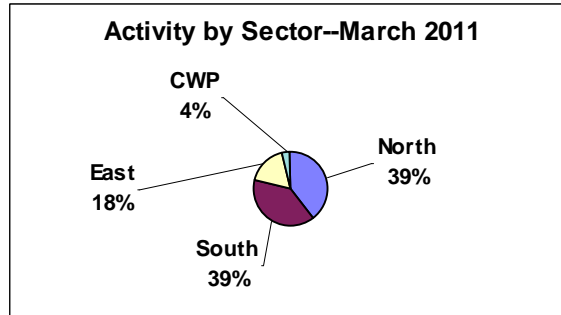
In March 2011 in Ward Three, stealings numbered four with one at addresses on Watson Road and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered seven, six in the neighborhoods and one in Whitecliff Park. There was one DWI case, two traffic accidents, 28 people related calls and no animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on eight different streets and there were 30 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in March 2011, stealings numbered one and there were no property damages. There was one fraud and one drug offense. There was one traffic accident, seven people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on five different streets and there were 45 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered four with four shopliftings and property damages numbered one. There were two traffic accidents and one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered one and there were five police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

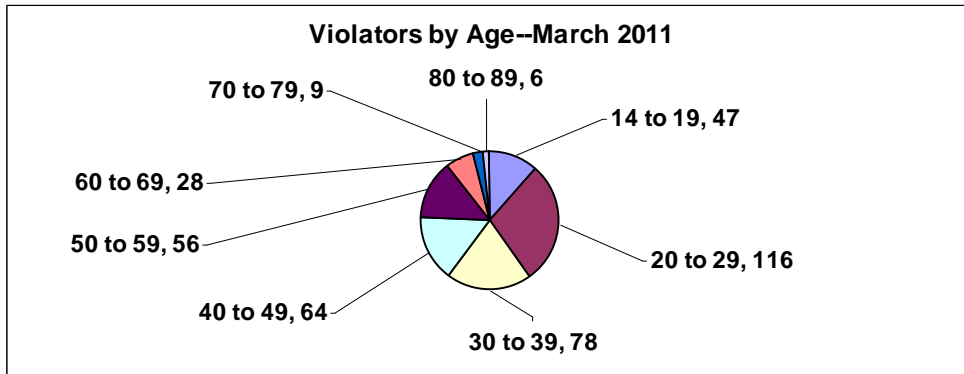

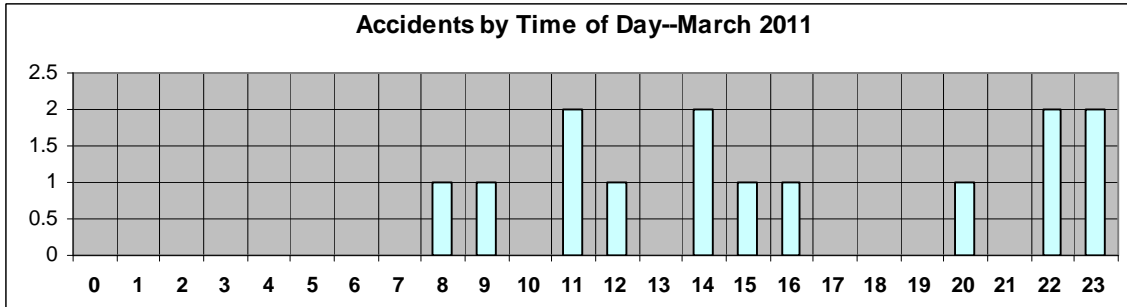

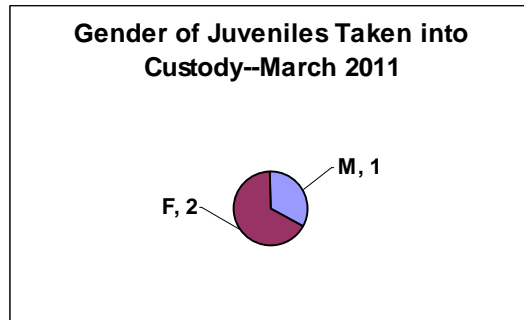
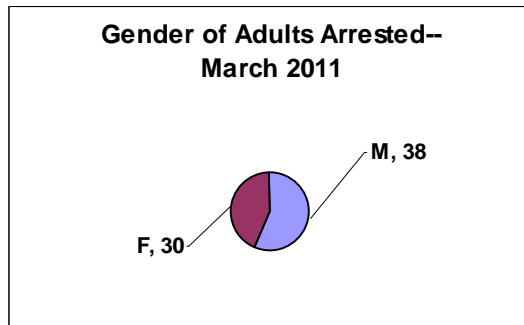
**Arrest Information:**

Sixty-eight adults and three juveniles were taken into custody in March 2011. Three persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

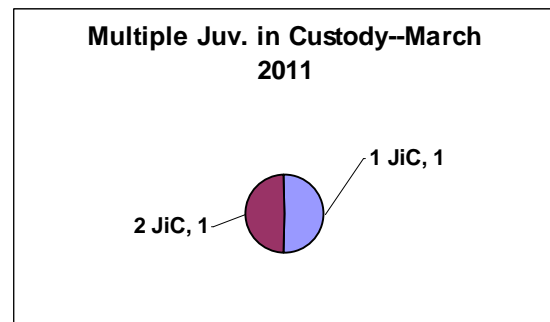
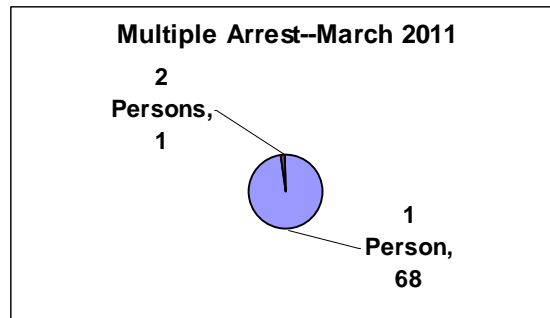
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



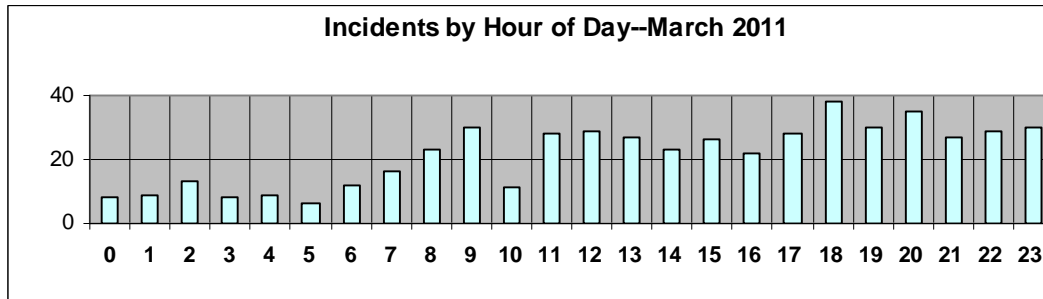
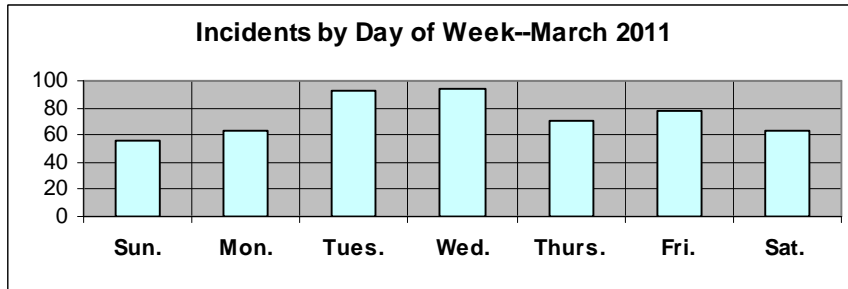
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

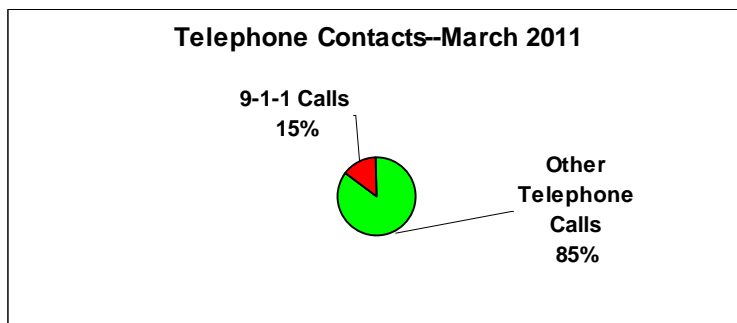

Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



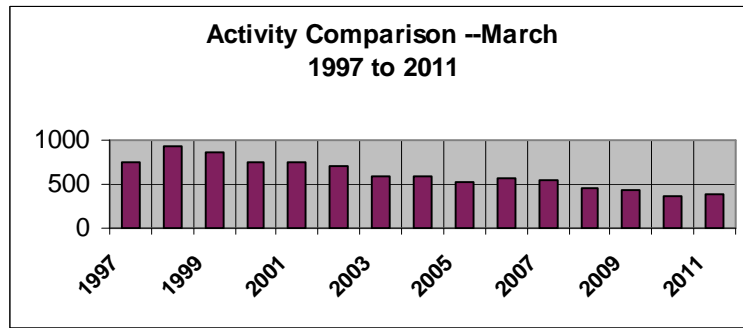
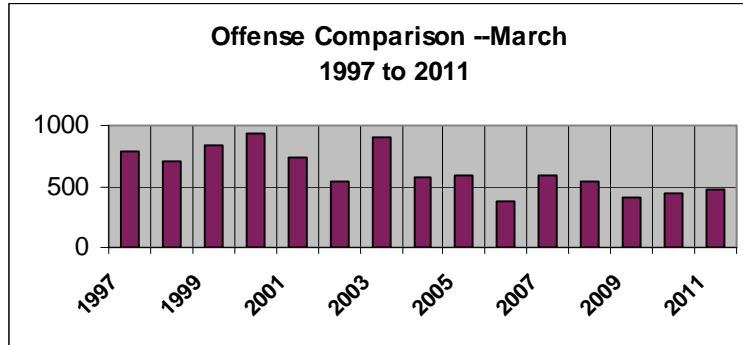
**Communications:**

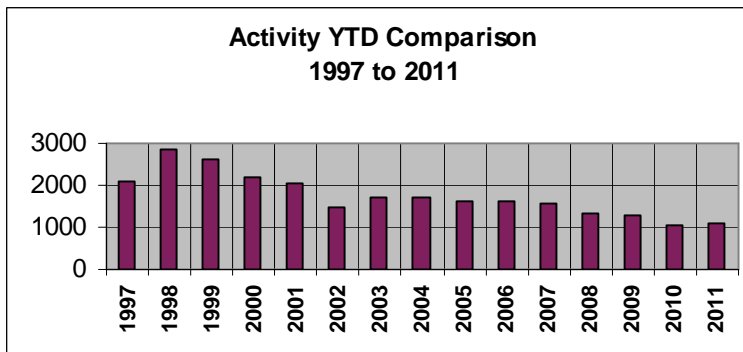
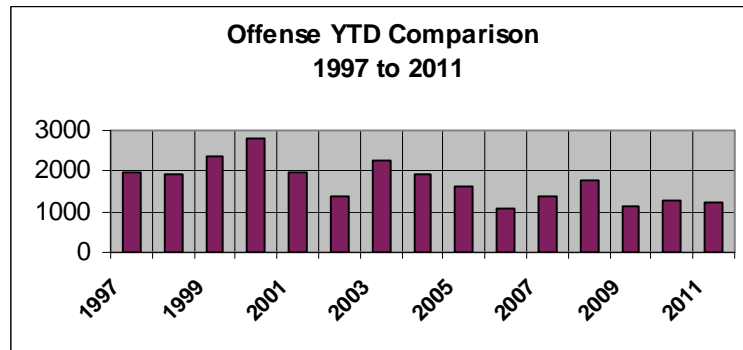


**Offense and Activity Comparison:**

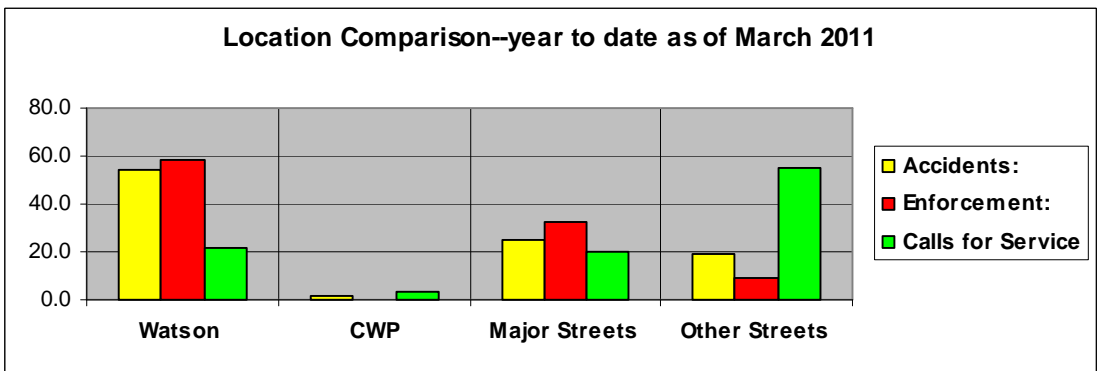


**Location Comparison:**

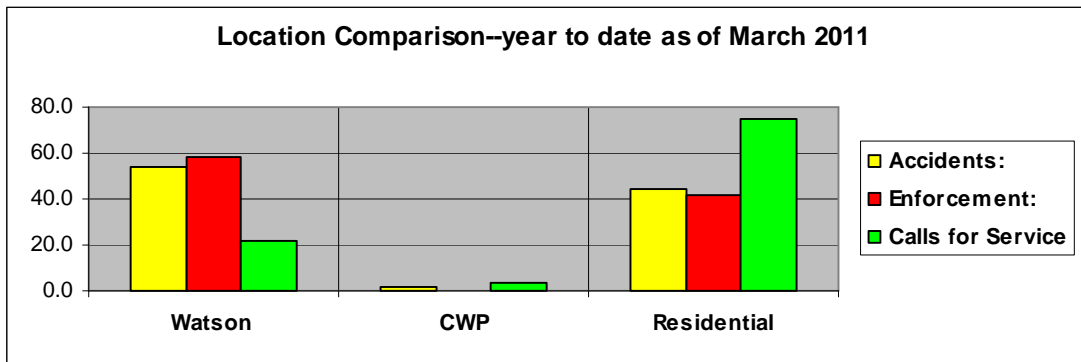
