Topic: May 2010 Public Report

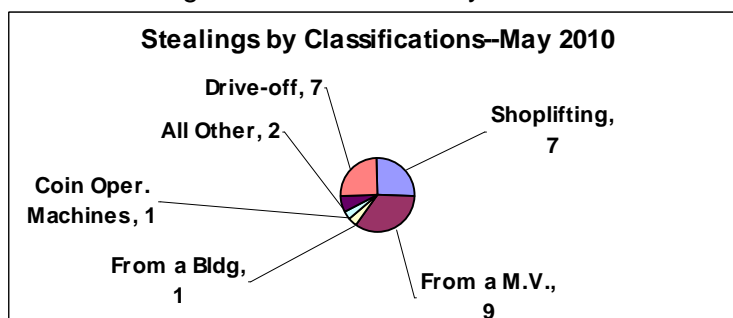
This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of May 2010. In May 2010, there were 44 Part I offenses and 447 Part II offenses for a total of 491. This compares with 40 Part I offenses and 372 Part II offenses for a total of 412 in May 2009. The main difference was in the number of burglaries and traffic stops.

There were three assaults in May 2010 and one involved domestic violence. In two cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

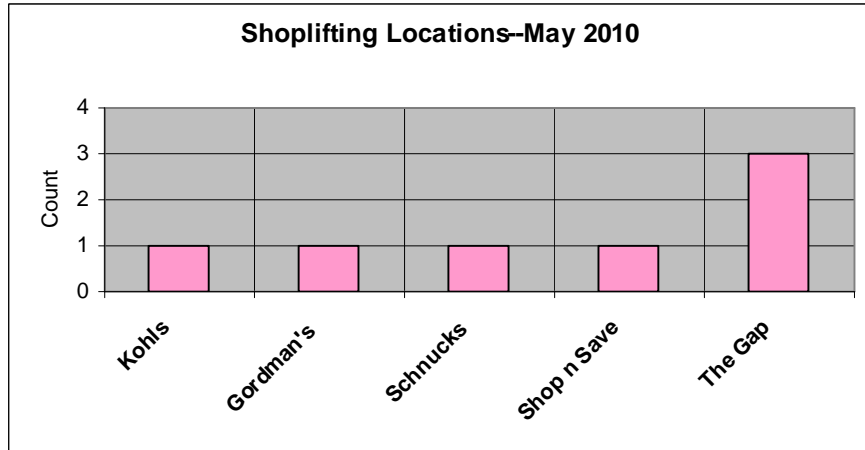
There was one burglary reported in May. On 05-06-2010, the owner found that someone had forced open a window and entered the residence. Money was taken from the residence on Rayburn.

Stealing offenses numbered 27 in May 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in May 2010:



Shopliftings accounted for seven of the 27 stealings in May 2010 or 26%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in May 2010:

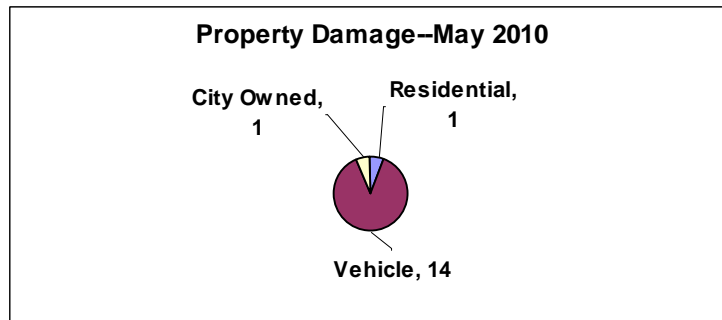


Of the shopliftings, 57% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

There were sixteen property damages in May 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



The City Owned property damage was to a street sign.

Part I offenses numbered 44 in May 2010.

Part II:

In May 2010, there were three frauds reported, two identity thefts and a credit card fraud. The two drug offenses both involved small quantities of marijuana. There were 26 motor vehicle accidents and one DWI case. There were 88 people related calls including 84

medical emergencies, three sudden deaths and one missing person and seventeen animal calls. There were 48 suspicious activity calls, 224 miscellaneous police service calls and one weapon offense involving a flourishing of a handgun in the area of Manda and Glenfield Terrace.

Part II offenses totaled 447 in May 2010.

In May 2010 in Ward One, stealings numbered six with three at addresses on Watson Road, two in an apartment complex and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one with one at addresses along Watson Road. There was one fraud, a credit card fraud, five traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on eight different streets and there were 51 miscellaneous police service calls.

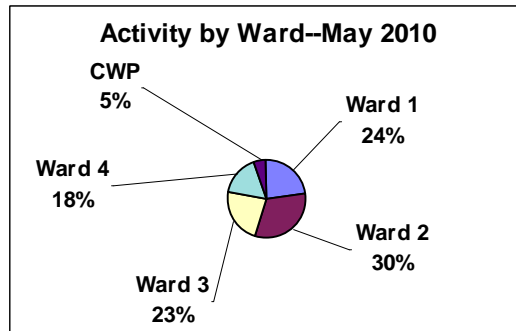
In Ward Two in May 2010, there was one burglary on Rayburn and stealings numbered six with five at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in an industrial area. Property damages numbered four, two at addresses along Watson Road and Big Bend and two in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud, an identity theft and one drug offense, possession of marijuana. There was one DWI case, fourteen traffic accidents, 28 people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on fourteen different streets and there were 75 calls for miscellaneous police services.

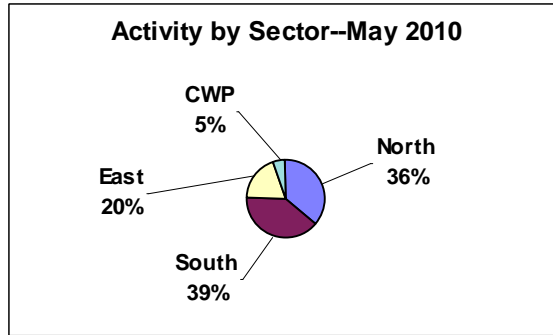
In May 2010 in Ward Three, stealings numbered six with four at addresses on Watson Road and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered seven, six at a retirement center and one in the neighborhoods. There was one drug offense, possession of marijuana, five traffic accidents, 29 people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on nine different streets and there were 42 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in May 2010, stealings numbered five and property damages numbered three. There was one fraud, an identity theft and one weapon offense, the flourishing of a handgun. There was one traffic accident, eleven people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on ten different streets and there were 43 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered four with three shopliftings and one from a coin operated machine and property damages numbered one. There was one traffic accident and one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered four and there were thirteen police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

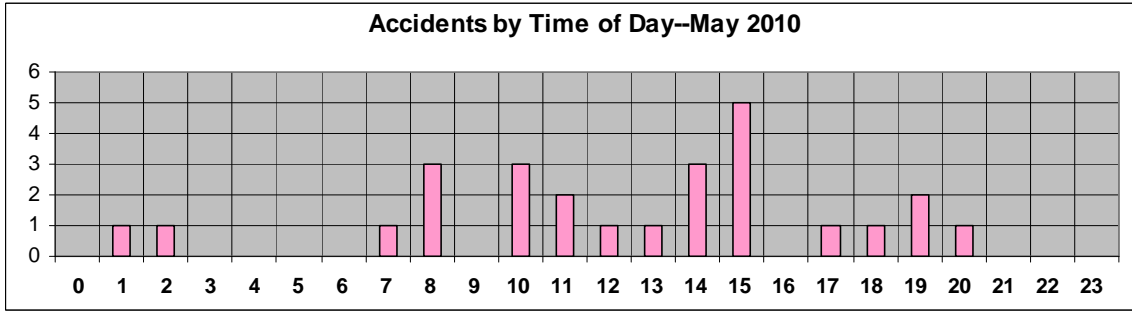

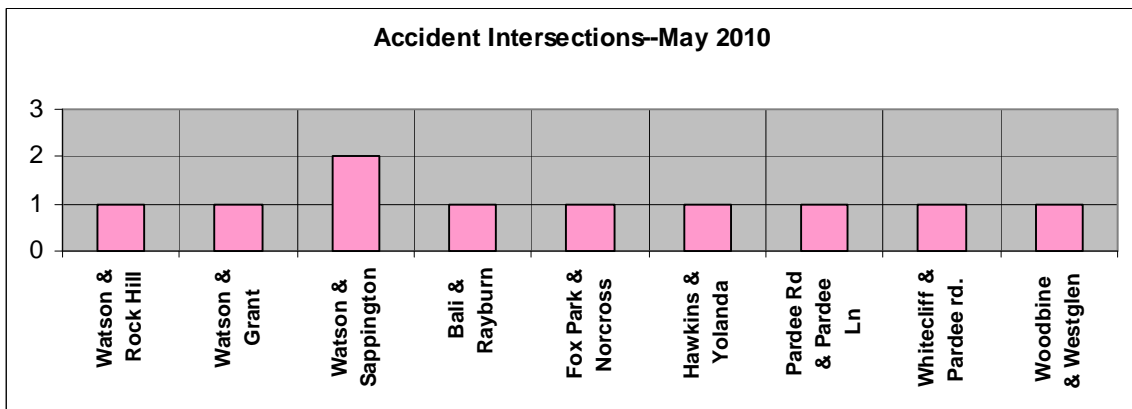
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



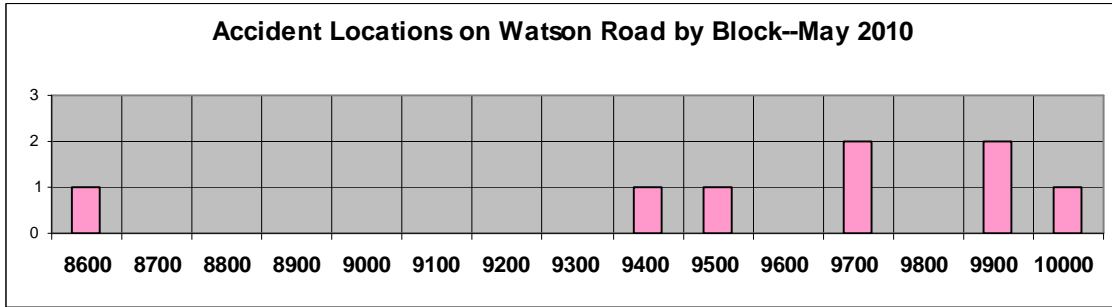

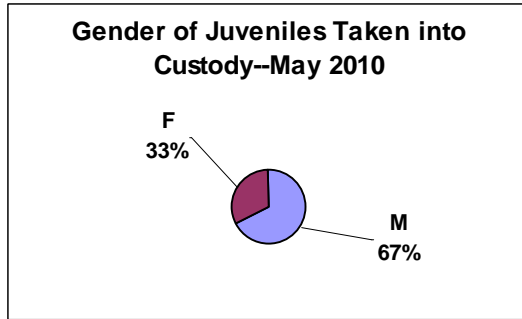
Thirty-six adults and three juveniles were taken into custody in May 2010. Three persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

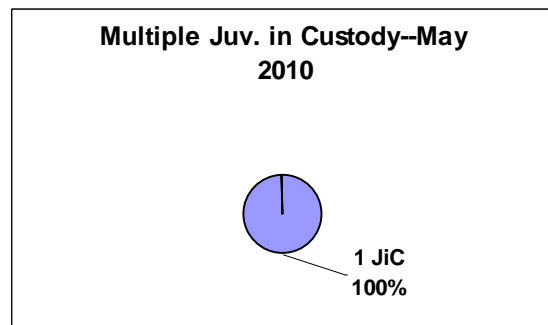
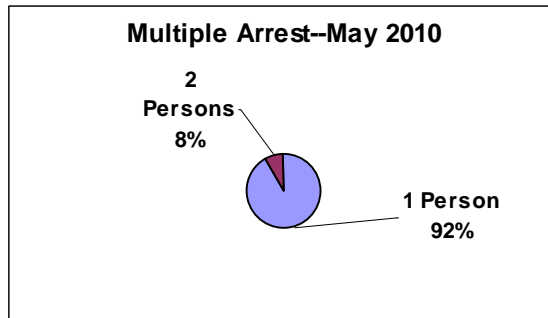


The gender of the persons taken into custody was:





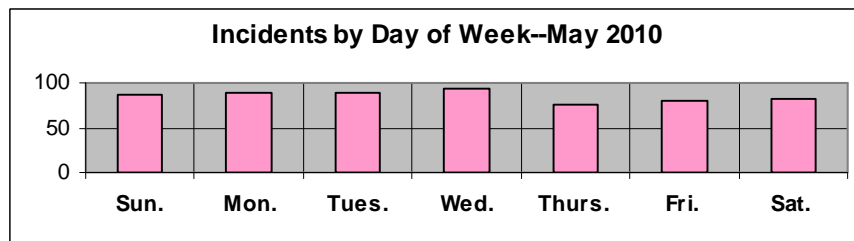
Multiple Arrests:

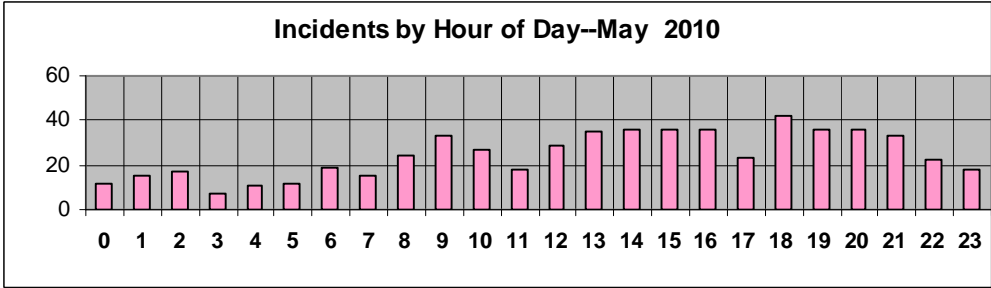


Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

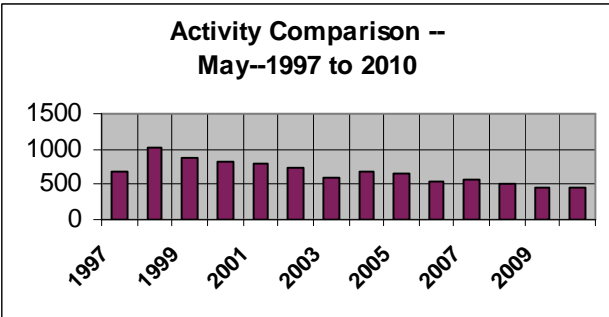
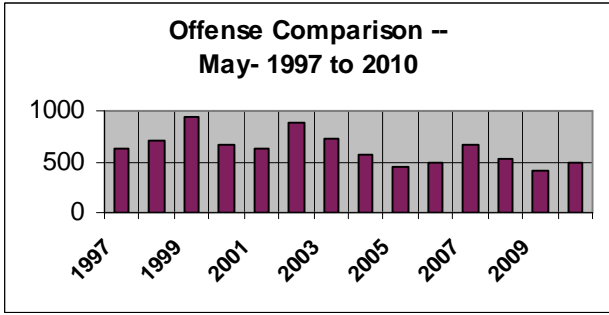
Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



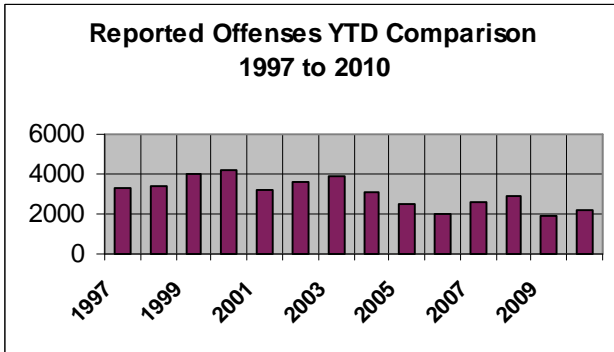


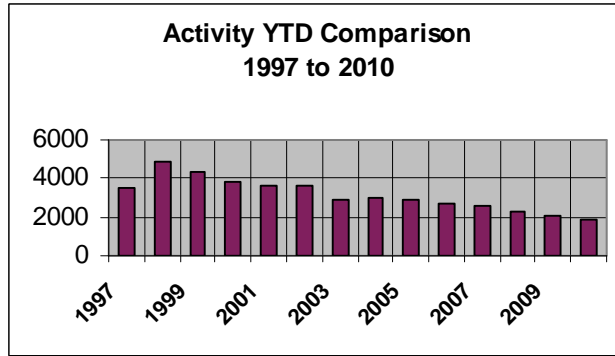
Offense and Activity Comparison:

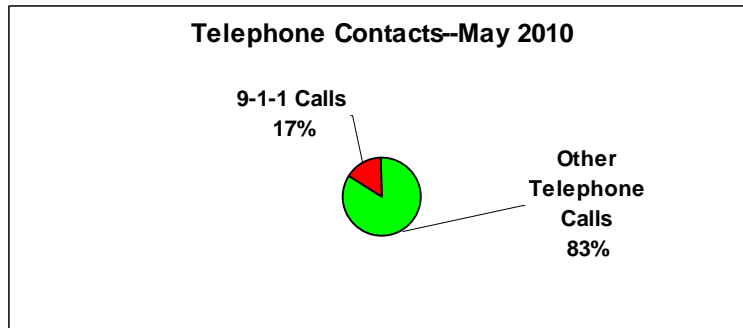

Communications:

Communications handled over 2686 telephone contacts and 534 9-1-1 calls in May 2010. This is a daily average of 87 telephone contacts and seventeen 9-1-1 calls.



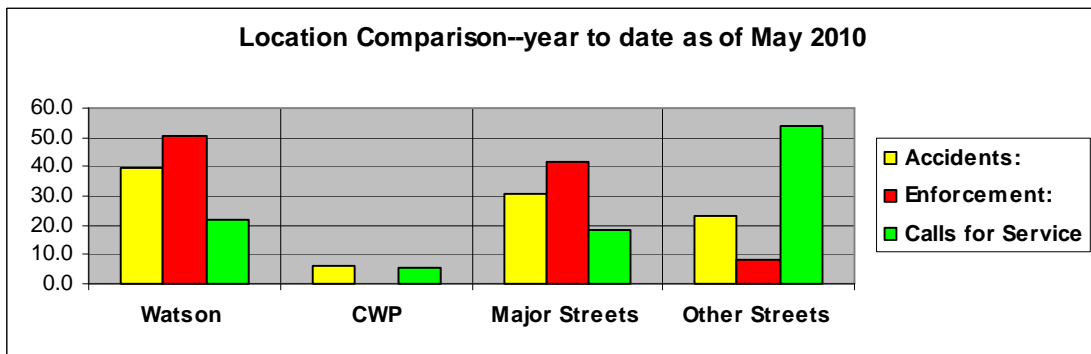

Location Comparison:

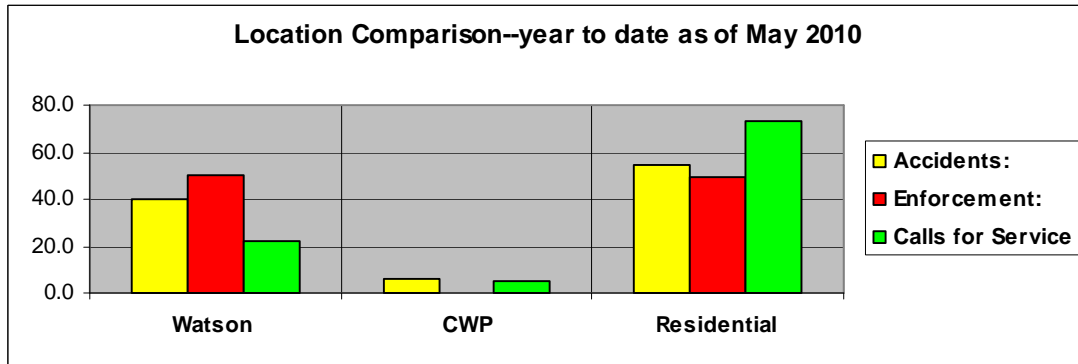
