Topic: November 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of November 2010. In November 2010, there were 27 Part I offenses and 350 Part II offenses for a total of 377. This compares with 42 Part I offenses and 341 Part II offenses for a total of 383 in November 2009. The main difference was in the number of stealings, burglaries and traffic stops.

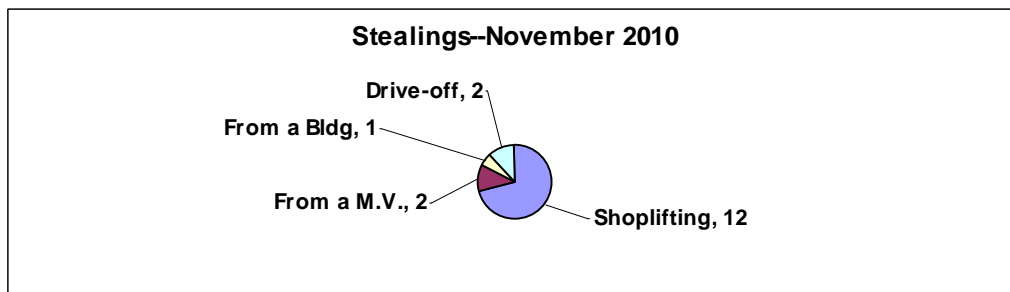
There was one sexual misconduct reported in November that involved teenaged relatives. The case was referred to the Juvenile Court.

There was one robbery reported on 11-11-2010 at a restaurant on Watson Road. At closing time, a male entered the restaurant with a pump shotgun and forced the employees to open the safe and ran from the business. No one was injured and the Detective Bureau responded and processed the scene.

There were one assault in November 2010 and it involved domestic violence.

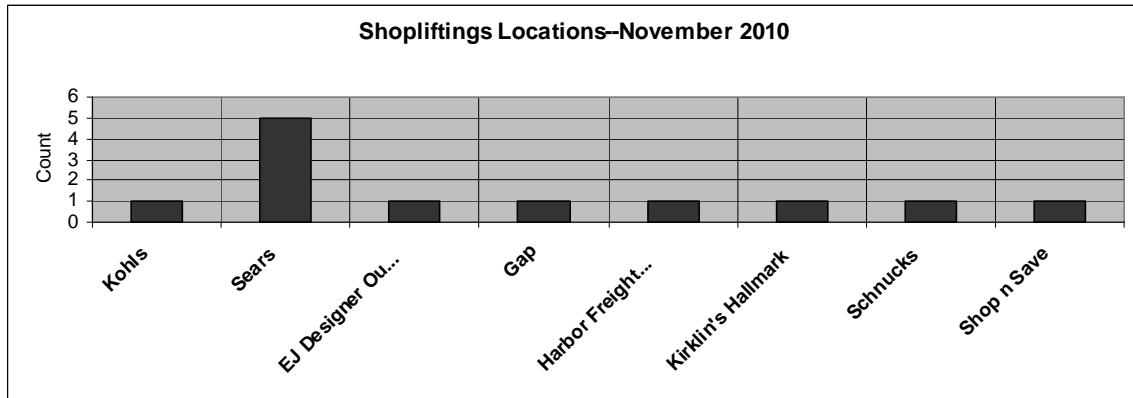
Stealing offenses numbered seventeen in November 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in November 2010:



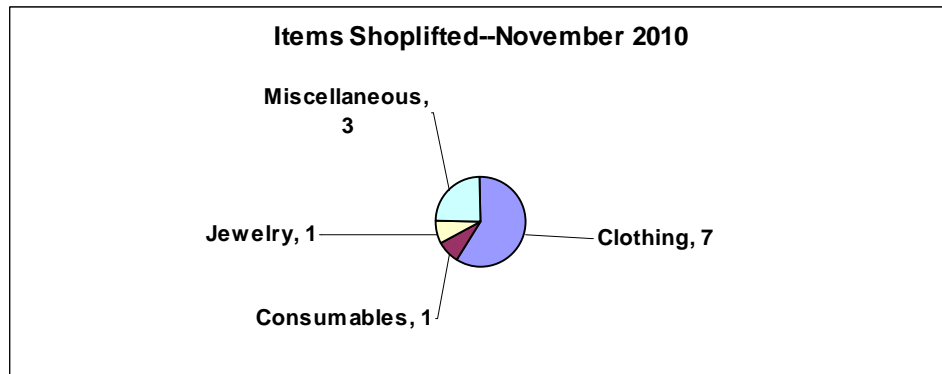
Shopliftings accounted for twelve of the seventeen stealings in November 2010 or 71%.

The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in November 2010:

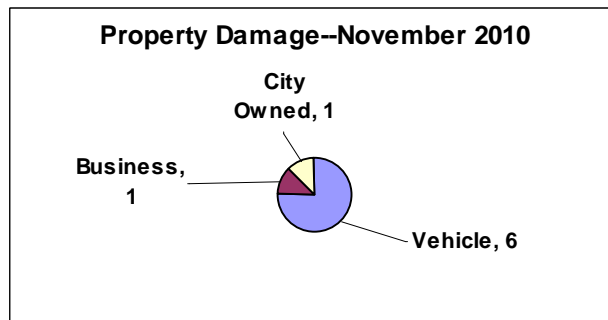


Of the shopliftings, 67% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

There were eight property damages in November 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



The City-Owned property damage was to a reservation board and a playground surface in Crestwood Park.

Part I offenses numbered 27 in November 2010.

Part II:

In November 2010, there was one fraudulent use of a credit device and one drug offense that involved a small quantity of heroin. The one offense against public peace was a trespassing. There was one juvenile offense, a runaway, reported. There was one DWI case, sixteen traffic accidents, 75 people related, including 73 medical emergencies, one sudden death and one suicide or attempt suicide and ten animal calls. There were 36 call for suspicious activity and 182 calls for miscellaneous police services.

Part II offenses totaled 350 in November 2010.

In November 2010 in Ward One, there was one sexual offense and one stealings numbered at an address on Watson Road. Property damages numbered two with both being in an apartment complex. There was one drug offense, one DWI case, seven traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on five different streets and there were 38 miscellaneous police service calls.

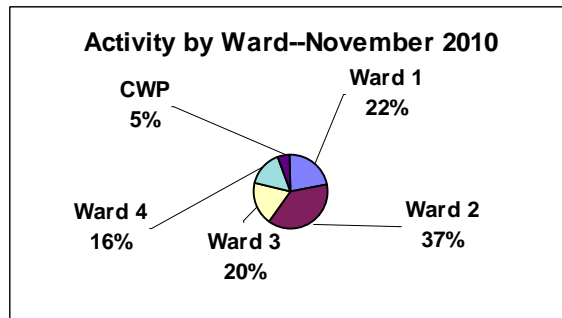
In Ward Two in November 2010, there was one robbery at a restaurant on Watson Road. Stealings numbered eight with eight at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered three, two at addresses along Watson Road and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. There were four traffic accidents, 25 people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on six different streets and there were 82 calls for miscellaneous police services.

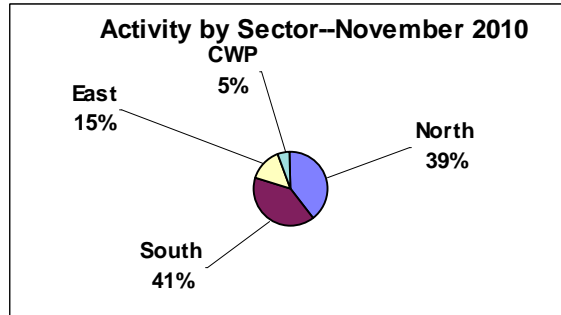
In November 2010 in Ward Three, stealings numbered one and property damages numbered one, both were at a retirement community. There was one fraud, one offense against public peace, two traffic accidents, 23 people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on seven different streets and there were 31 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in November 2010, stealings numbered one and property damages numbered one. There was one juvenile related offense, two traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on seven different streets and there were 24 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered six with all six being shopliftings and there was one property damage. There was one traffic accident and one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered one and there were seven police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

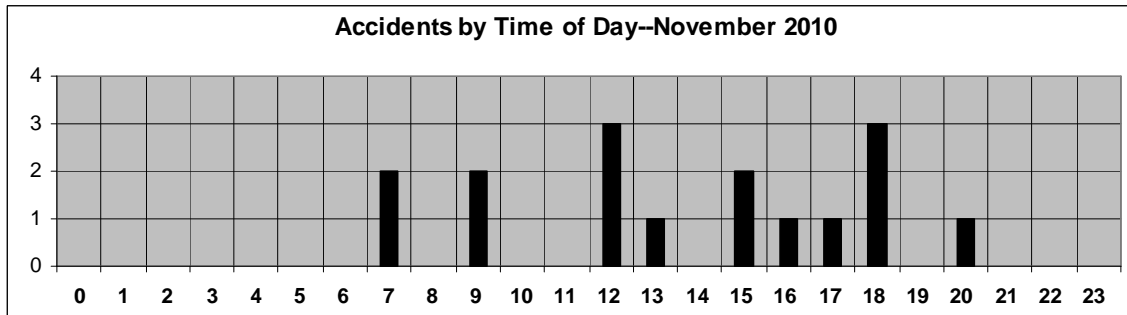

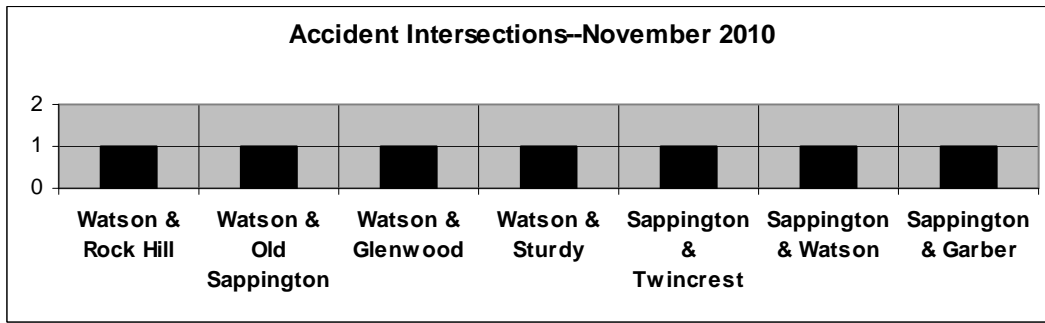
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



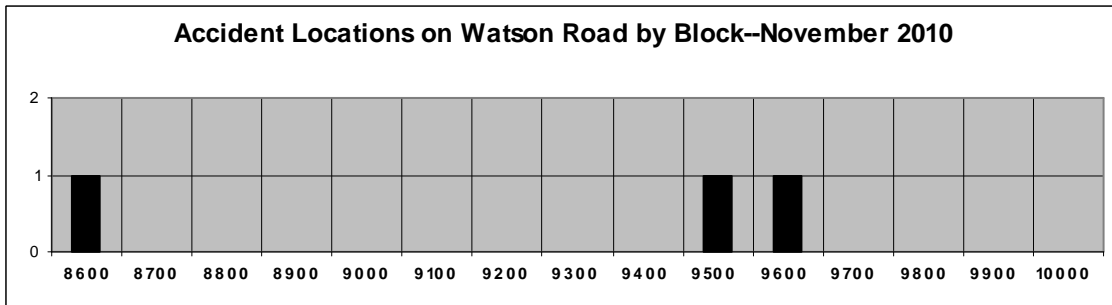

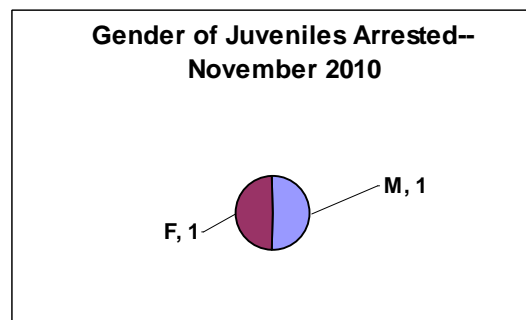
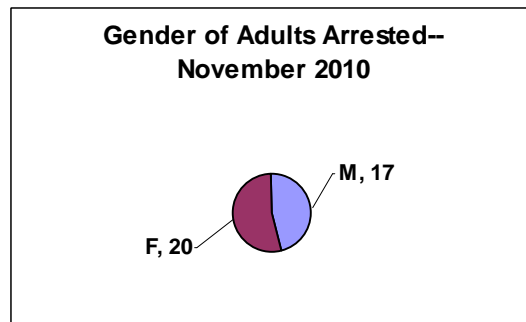
Arrest Information:

Thirty-seven adults and two juveniles were taken into custody in November 2010. Five persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

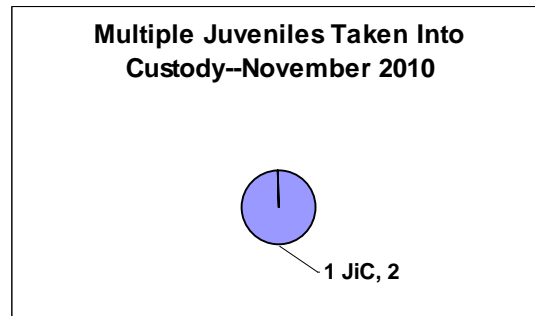
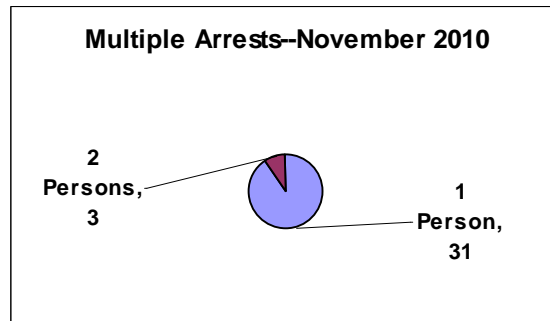
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



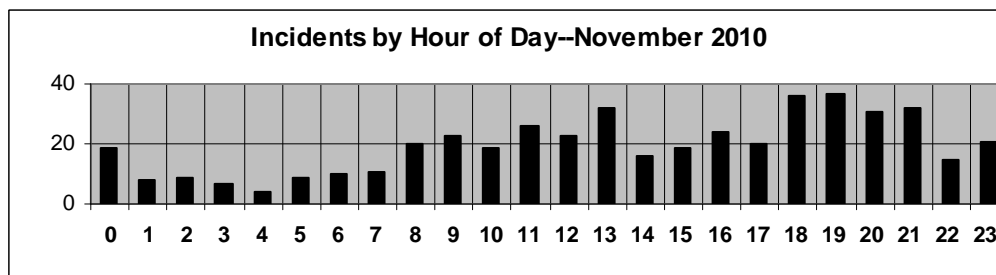
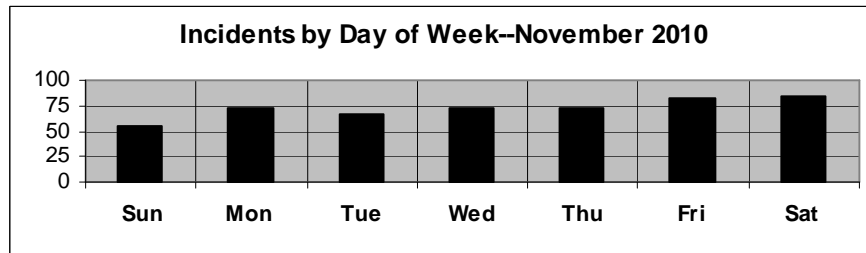
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

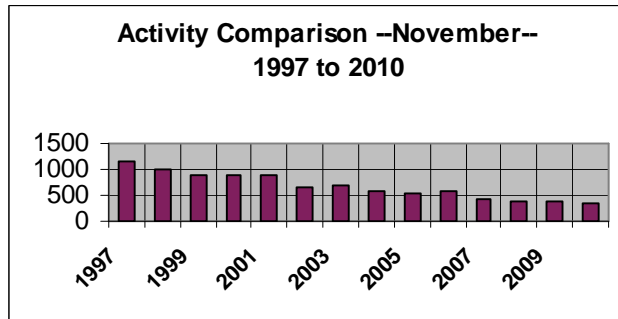
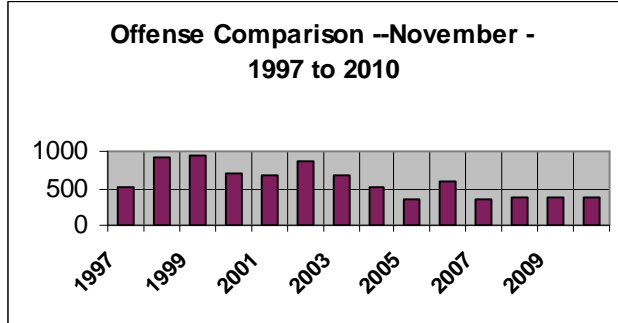

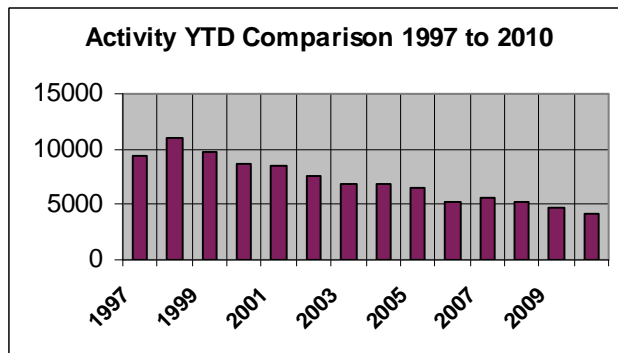
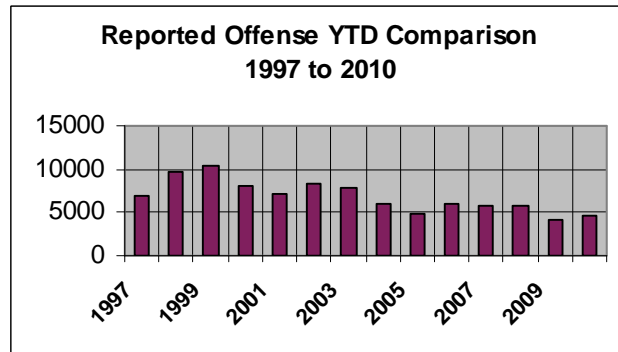


Offense and Activity Comparison:

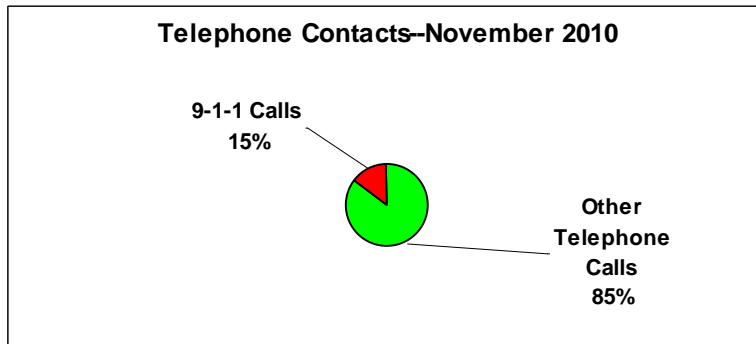


Years to Date:

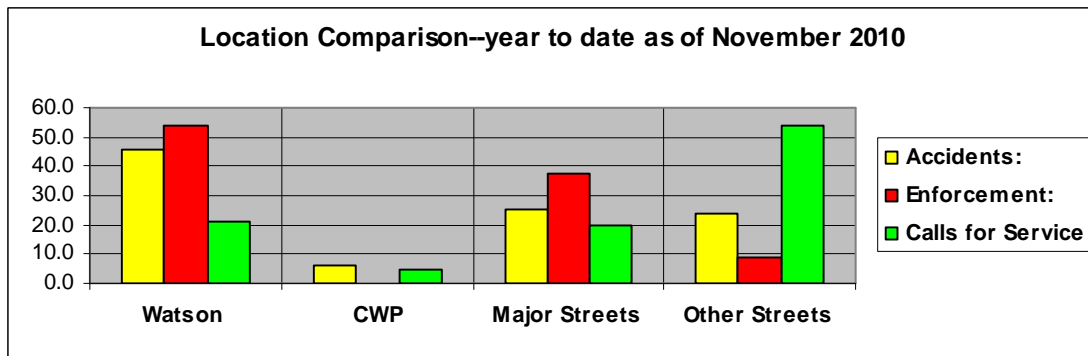


Location Comparison:

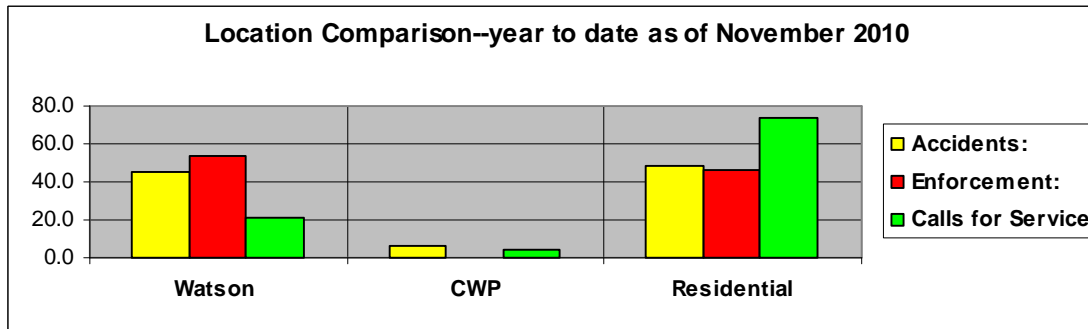
