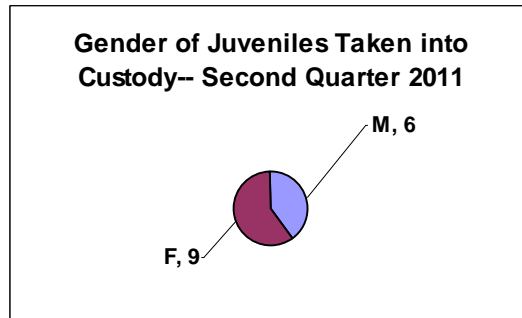
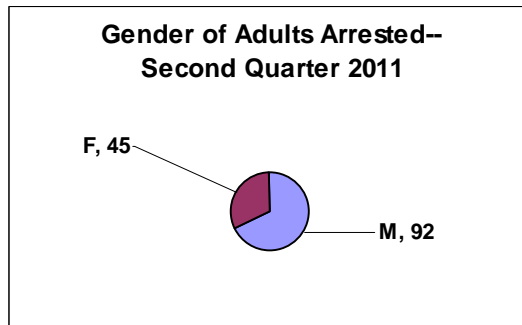
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

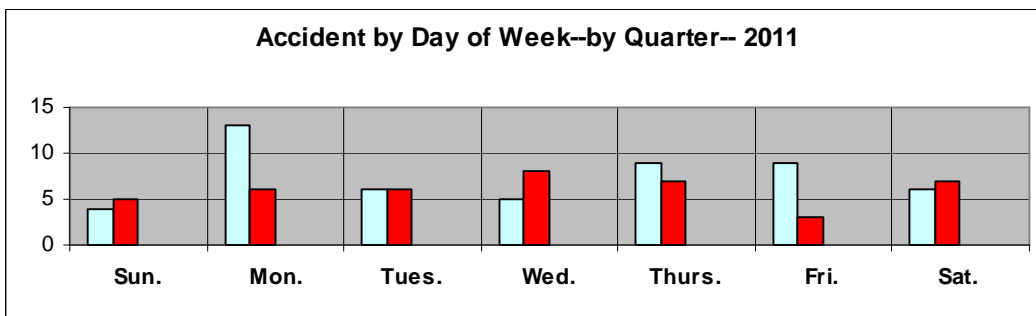

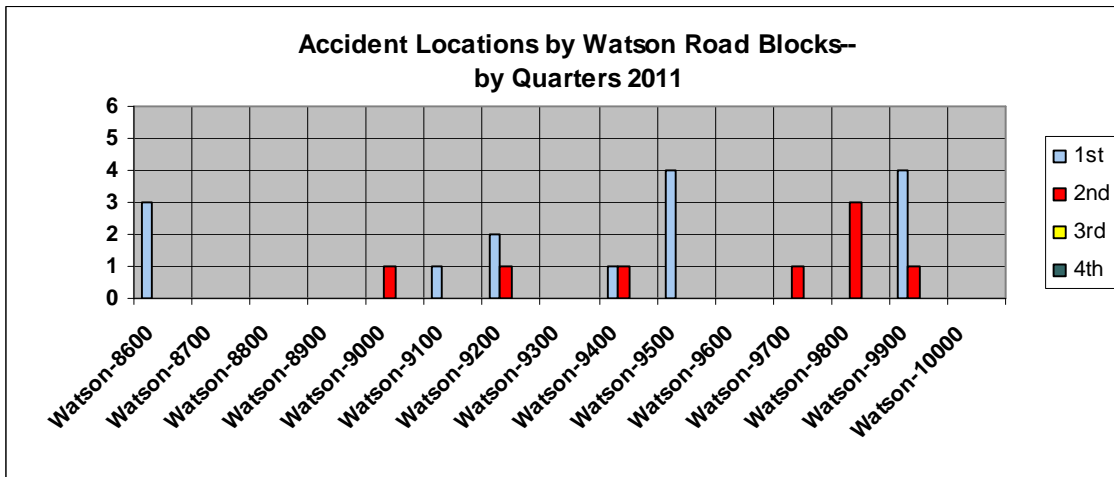

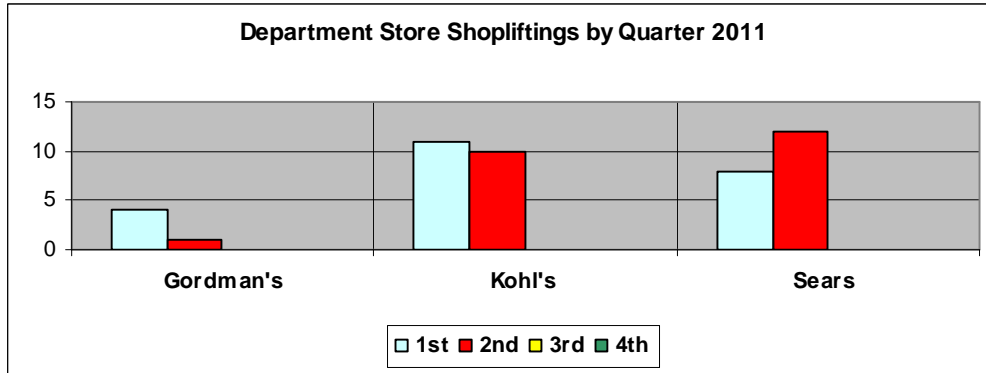
Stealings:

There were 32 shopliftings reported in the Second Quarter. This was 36% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:

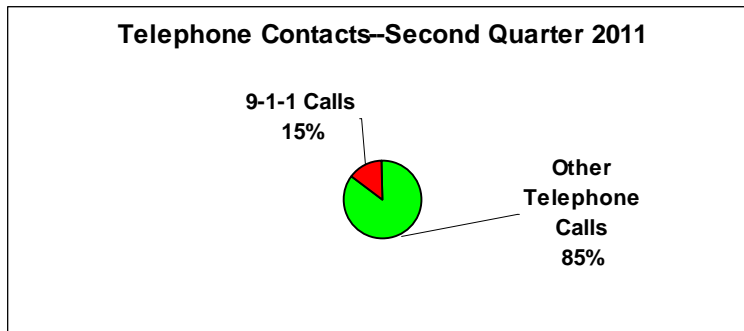

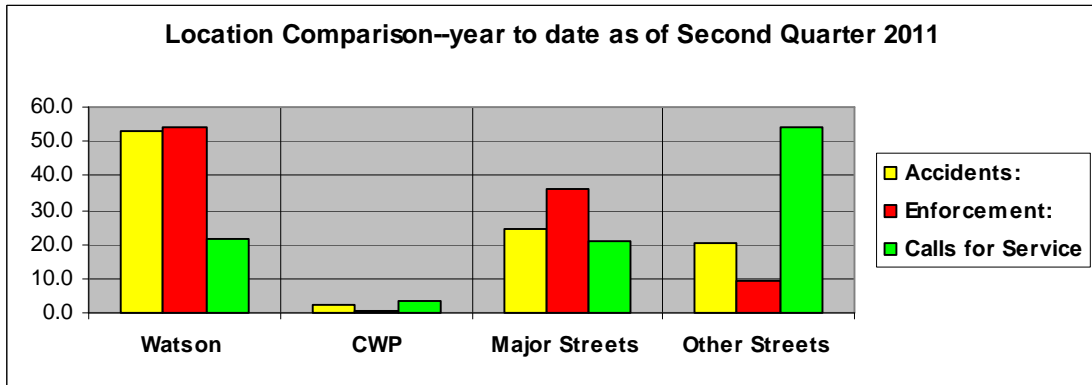

Location Comparison:

Watson is activity along Watson Road and CWP is activity in Crestwood Plaza. Major streets are the following streets that have been used to track accidents and enforcement for a length of time.
