Topic: September 2011 Public Report

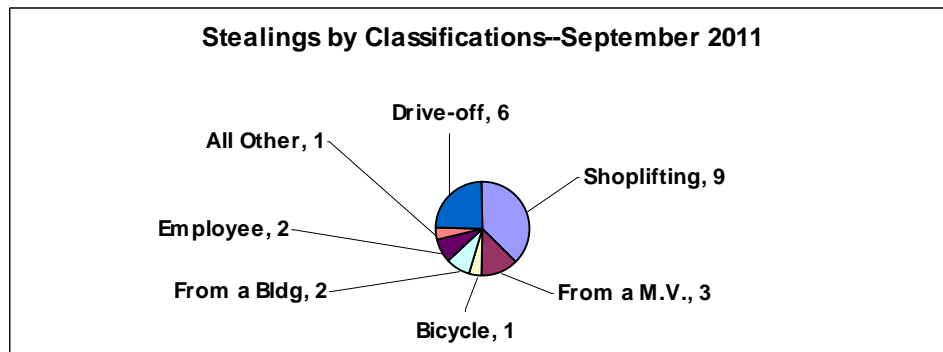
This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of September 2011. In September 2011, there were 25 Part I offenses and 394 Part II offenses for a total of 419. This compares with 37 Part I offenses and 415 Part II offenses for a total of 452 in September 2010. The main difference was in the number of burglaries and property damages.

There was one burglary reported in September. On 09-25-2011, a nail salon on Watson Road had someone break out the front window, enter the business and removed the petty cash. The Detective Bureau processed the scene.

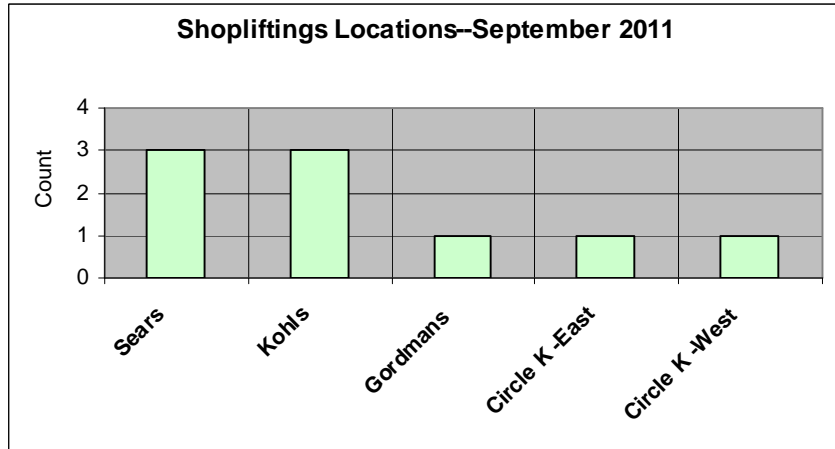
There were four assaults in September 2011 and three involved domestic violence. In three cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 24 in September 2011.

Stealings were of the following classifications in September 2011:



Shopliftings accounted for nine of the 24 stealings in September 2011 or 38%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in September 2011:



Of the shopliftings, 89% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 62%, adults and juveniles together accounted for 13% and juveniles accounted for 25% of the clearances.

The items shoplifted were found to be:



There were no property damages in September 2011 and this is the first month in a number of years with no property damages reported.

Part I offenses numbered 25 in September 2011.

Part II:

In September 2011, there were three frauds reported and there was one passing bad check, one credit card fraud and one all other type fraud. There were two drug cases, one a possession of marijuana and one possession of drug paraphernalia. The three offenses against public peace were two annoying telephone calls and one trespassing. There were two DWI cases, eighteen animal related calls and 73 people related including 71 medical emergencies and two sudden deaths. There were two juvenile offenses that included a minor in possession and a curfew violation. The two family

offenses were an ex-parte order violation and an endangering the welfare of a child case.

Part II offenses totaled 394 in September 2011.

In September 2011 in Ward One, stealings numbered four with two at addresses on Watson Road, one in an industrial park and one in the neighborhoods. There was one offense against public peace and one family offense. There were seven traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 44 miscellaneous police service calls.

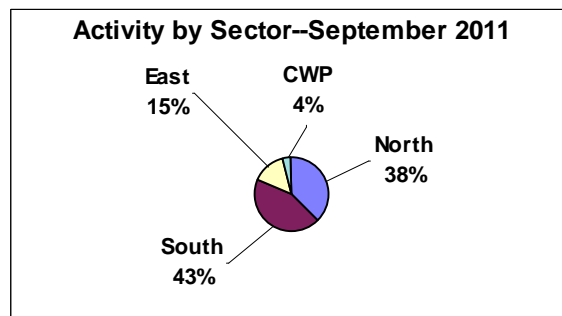
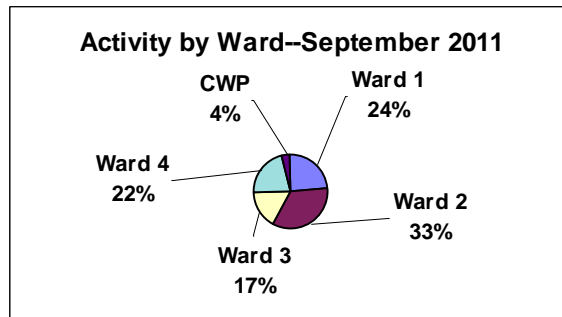
In Ward Two in September 2011, there was one burglary at a business along Watson Road and stealings numbered fifteen with fourteen at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. There were three frauds, two offenses against public peace and one family offense. There were two DWI, ten traffic accidents, 21 people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on five different streets and there were 61 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In September 2011 in Ward Three, there was one stealing that occurred at an address on Watson Road. There were two drug offenses and one juvenile related offense. There were three traffic accidents, eighteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 31 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in September 2011, stealings numbered one and there was one juvenile related offense. There were two traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and six animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered ten and occurred on nine different streets and there were 30 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered three with three shopliftings. There were two traffic accidents, two people related and eight police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

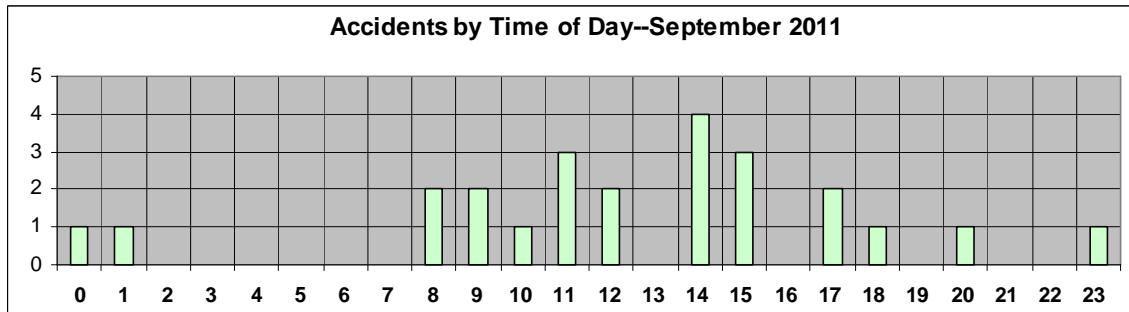

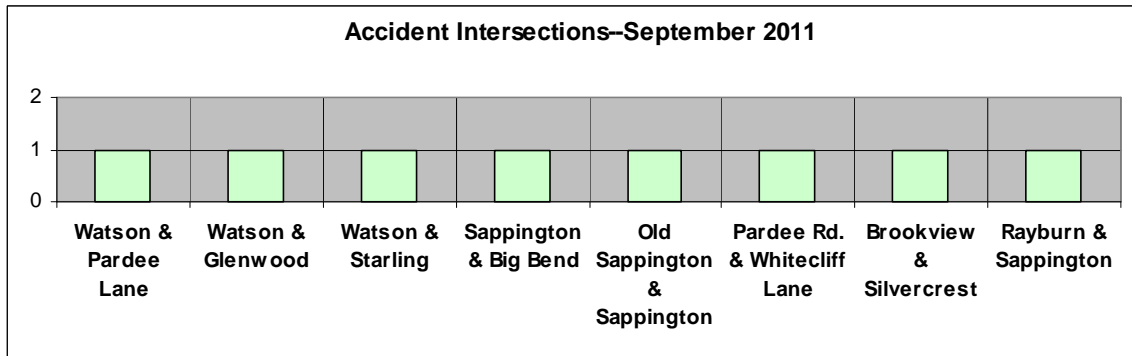
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



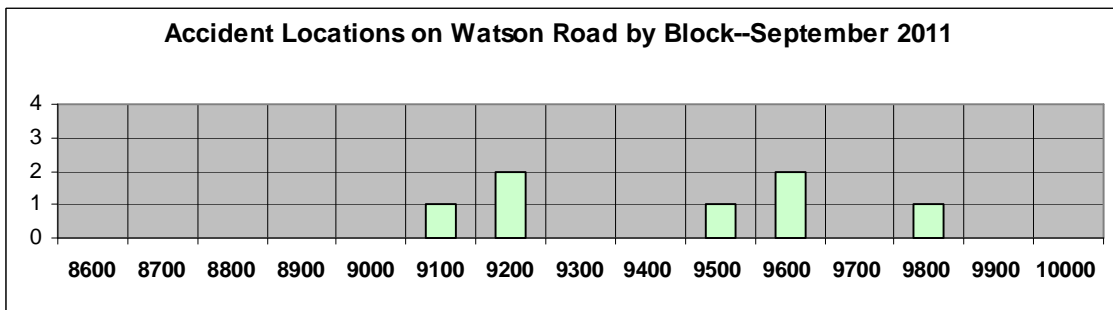

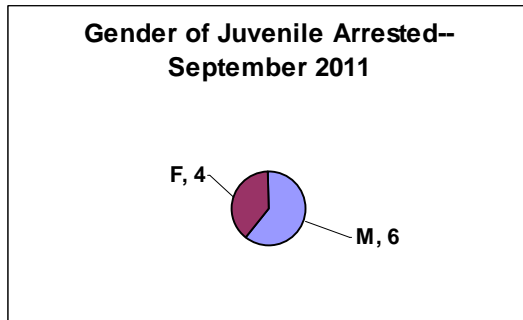
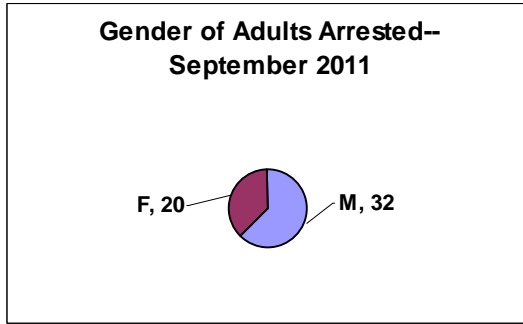
Arrest Information:

Fifty-two adults and ten juveniles were taken into custody in September 2011. Thirteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

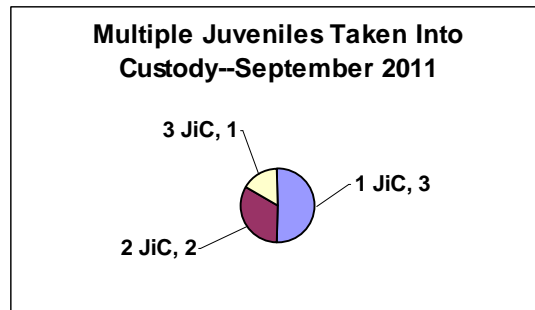
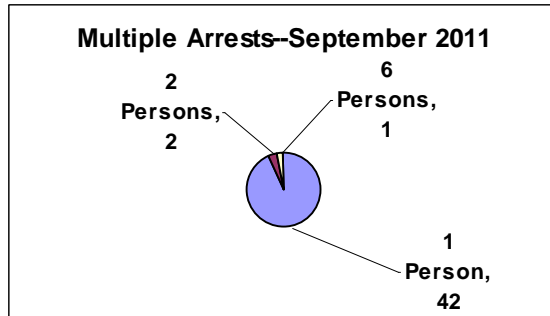
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



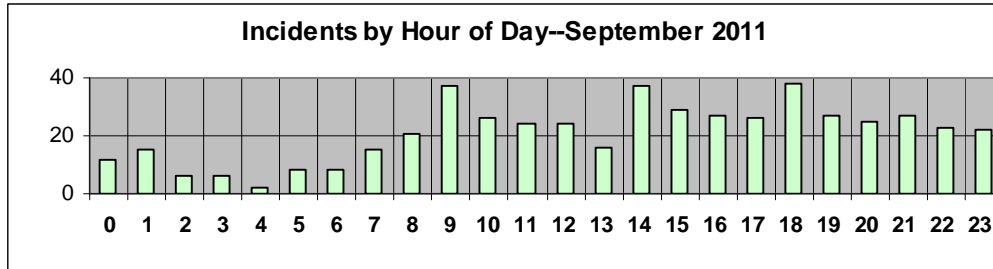
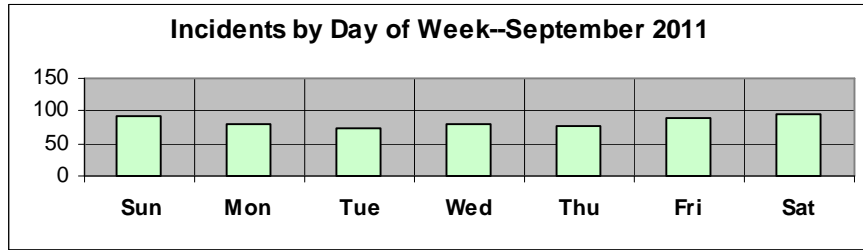
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

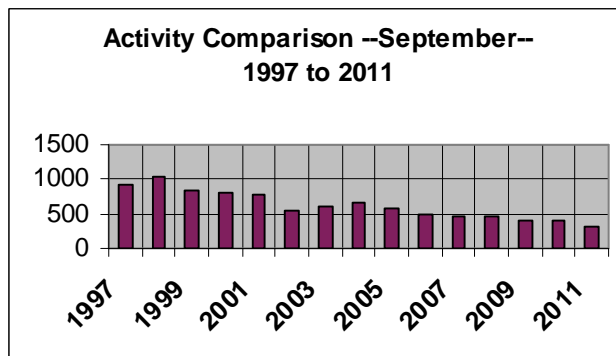
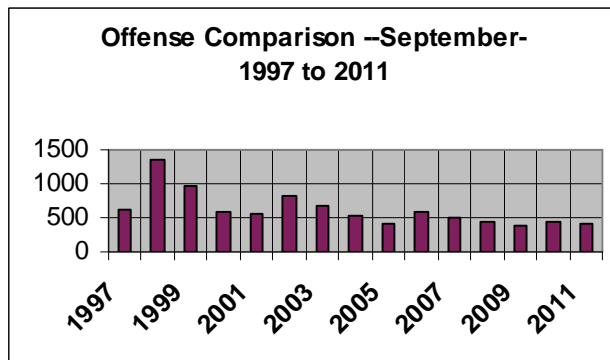

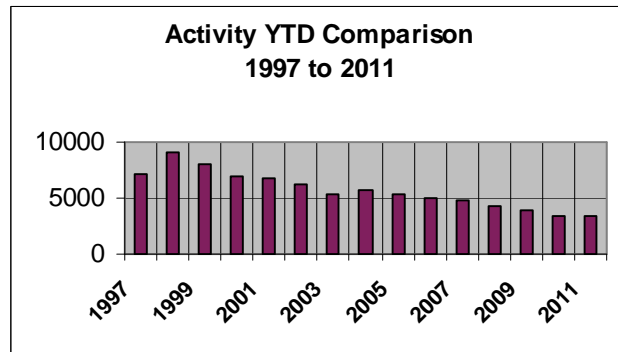
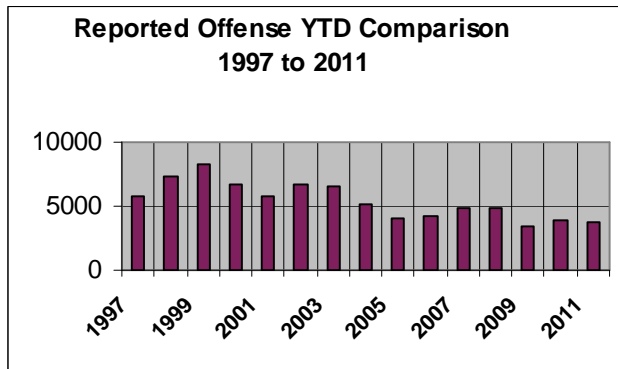


Offense and Activity Comparison:

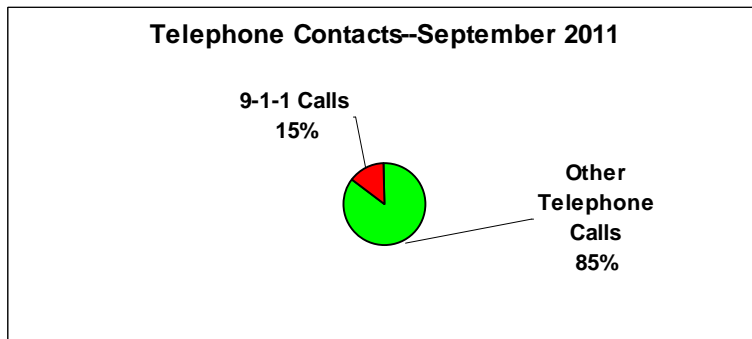


Years to Date:

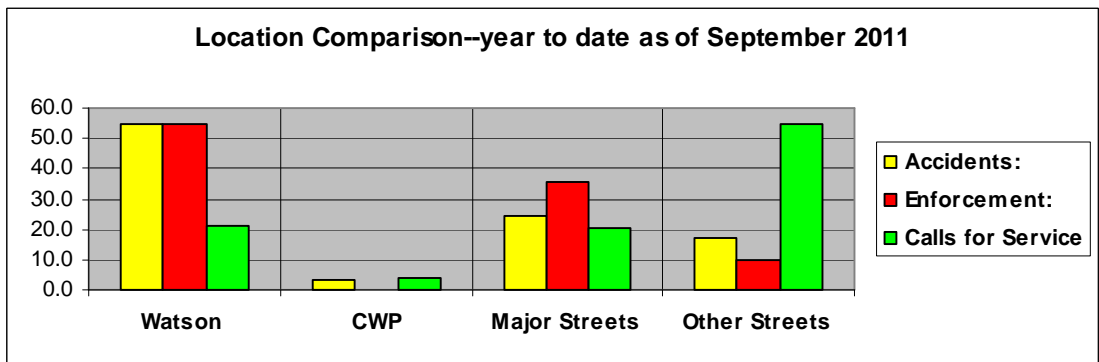


Location Comparison:

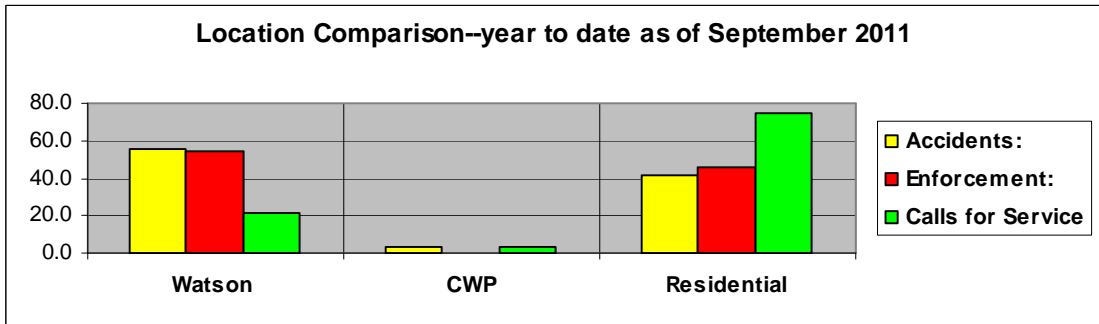
