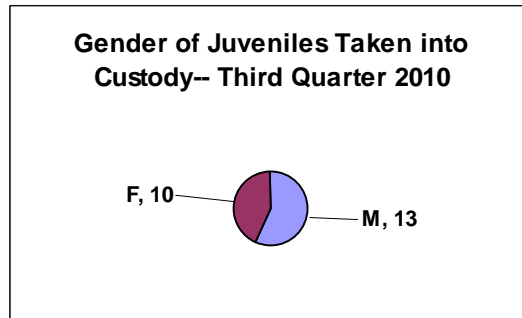
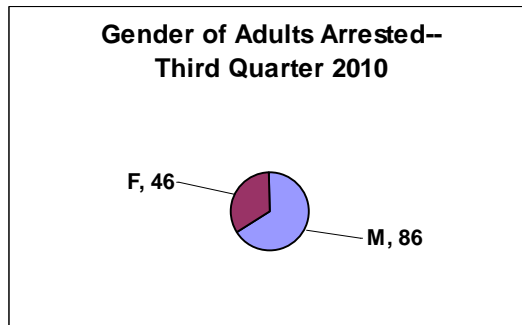
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

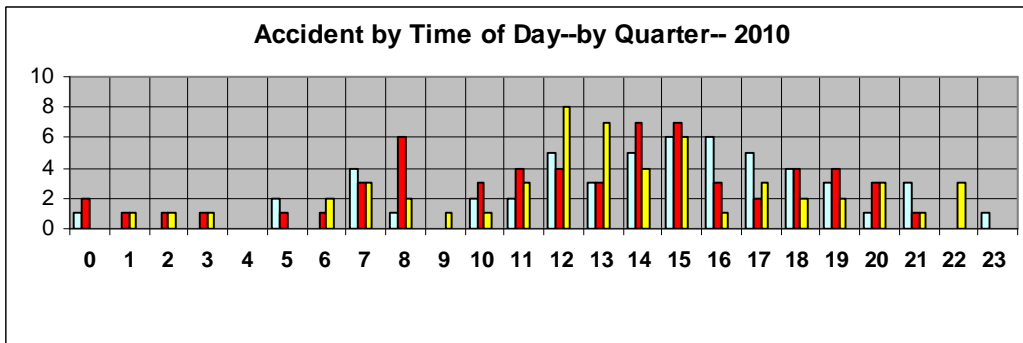

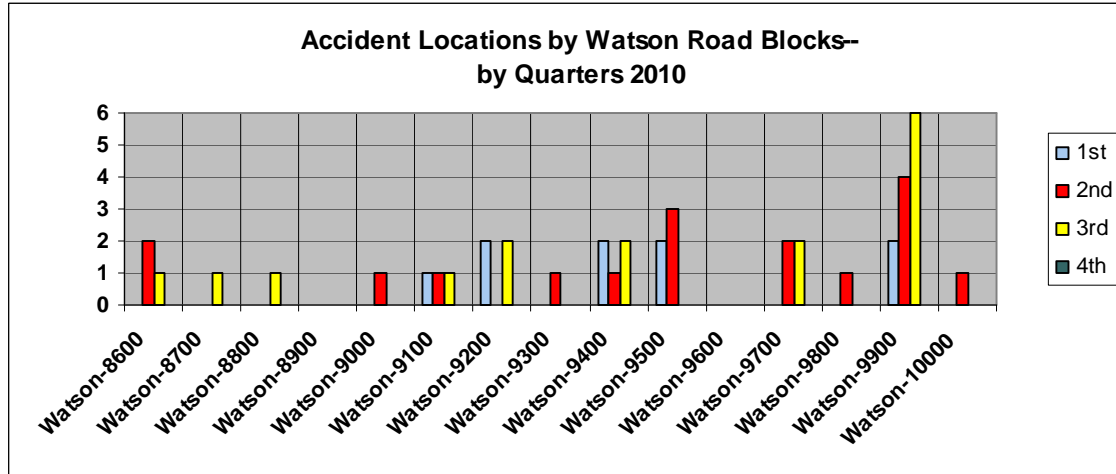

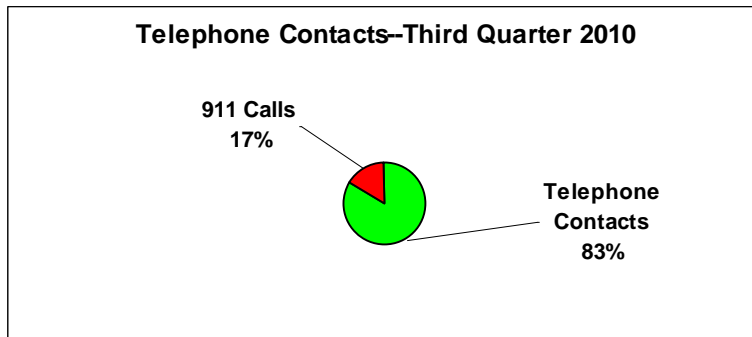
Shopliftings:

In the Third Quarter, Communications handled 8108 telephone contacts and 1620 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 88 telephone calls and eighteen 9-1-1 calls.

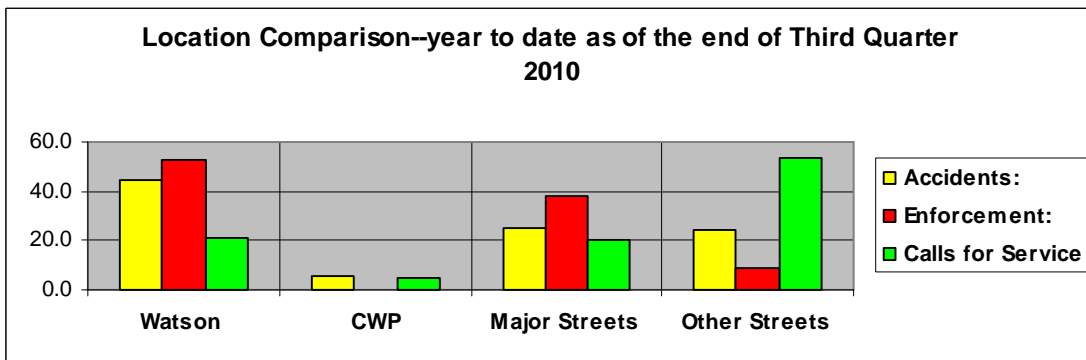

Location Comparison:
