Activity by Day of Week and Time of Day:



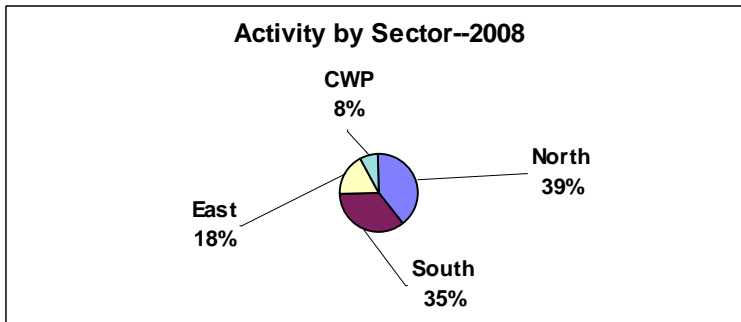
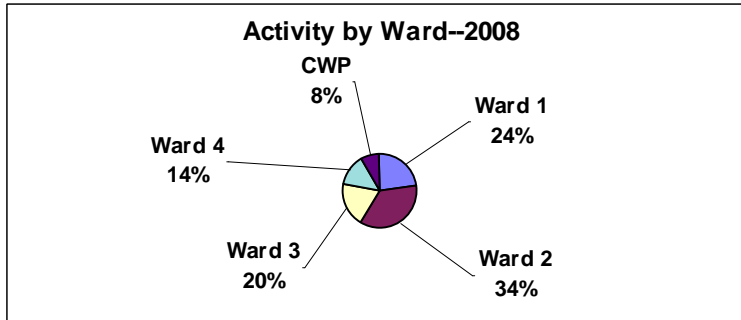

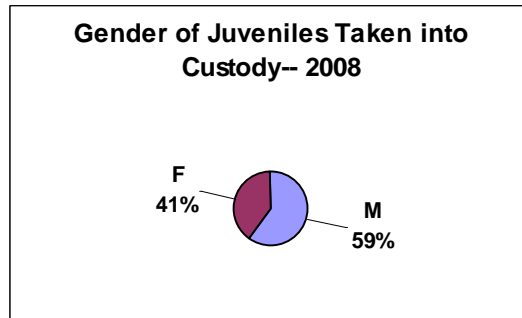
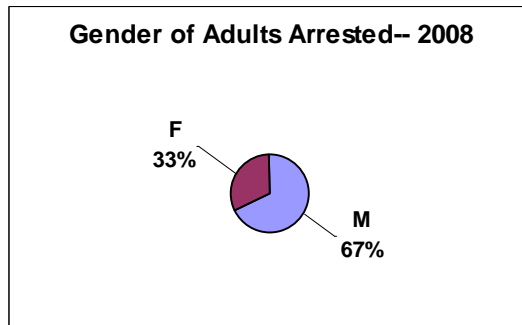
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

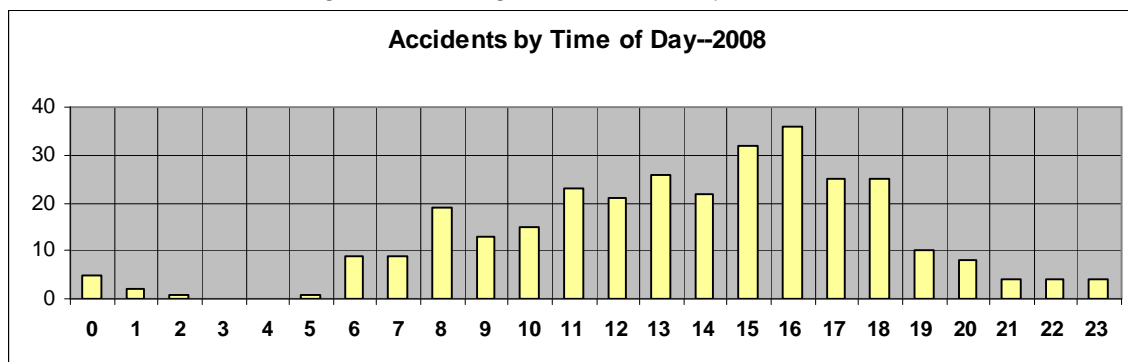

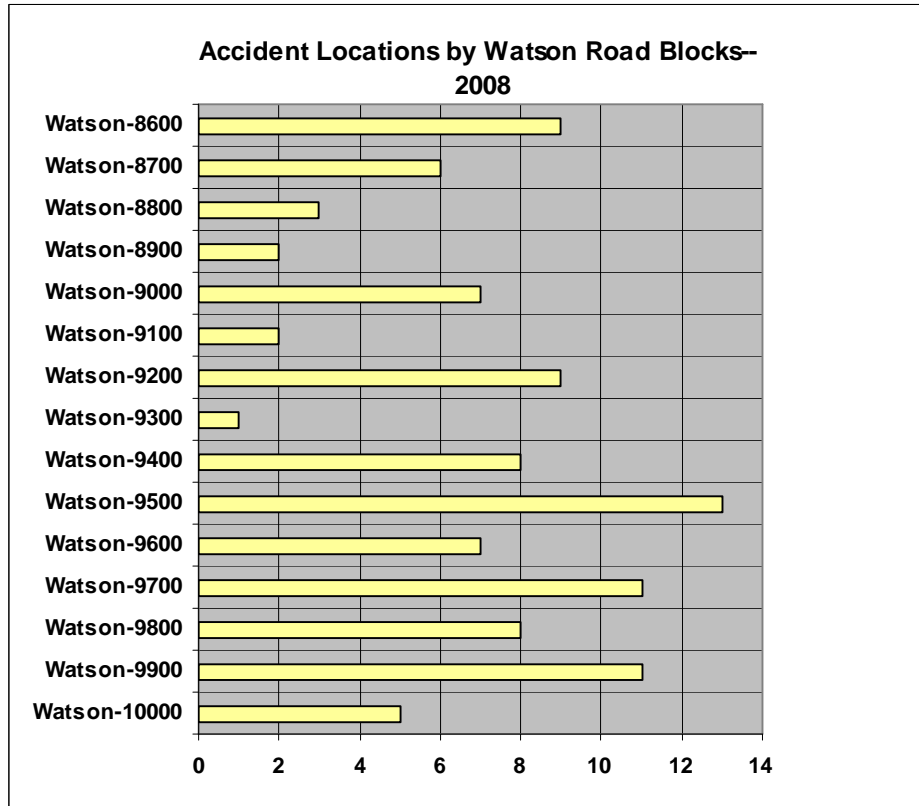

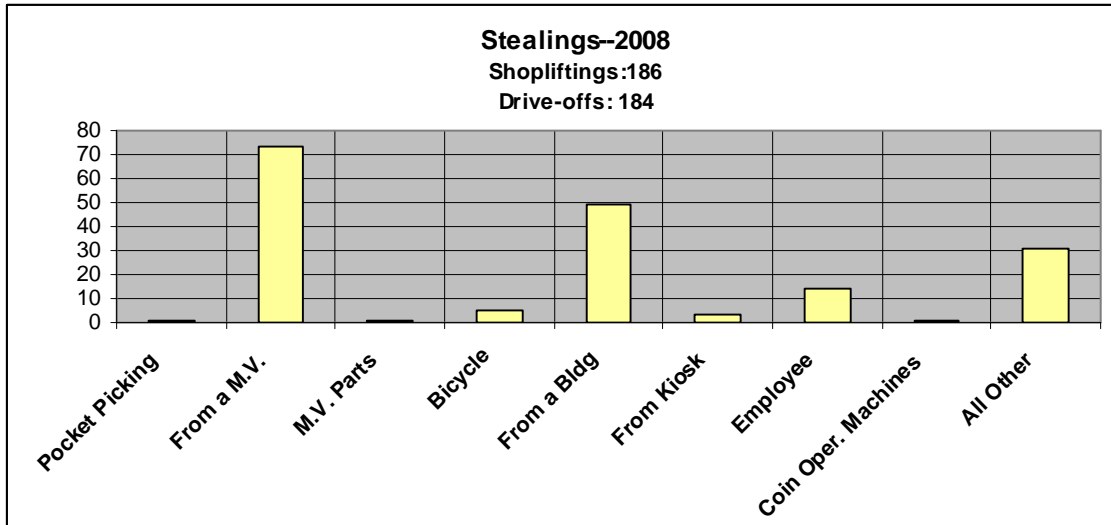

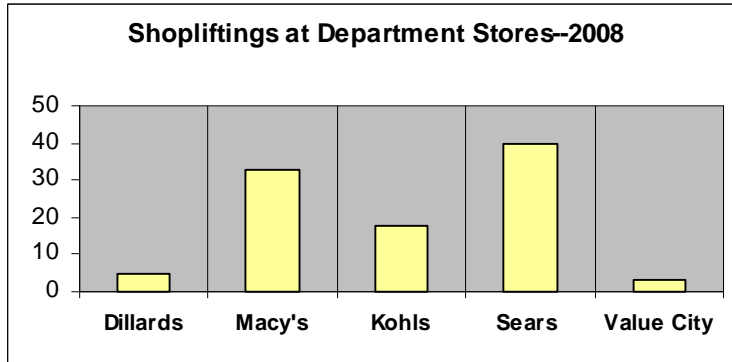
Stealings:

Shopliftings:

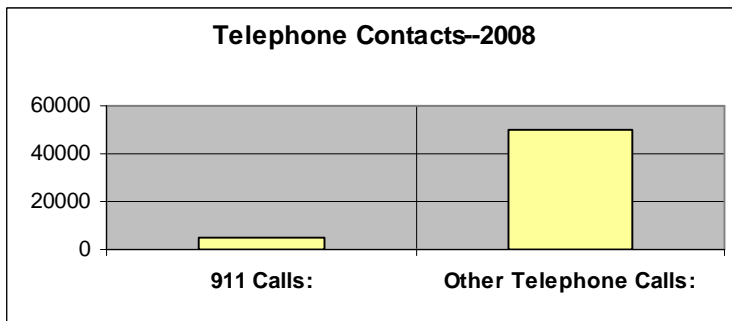
There were 186 shopliftings reported in 2008. This was 34% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:



Fifty-three percent of the shopliftings occurred at the Department Stores. The remaining 47% occurred at 28 different stores.

Communications:

In 2008, Communications handled 49,778 telephone contacts and 5003 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 136 telephone calls and fourteen 9-1-1 calls.

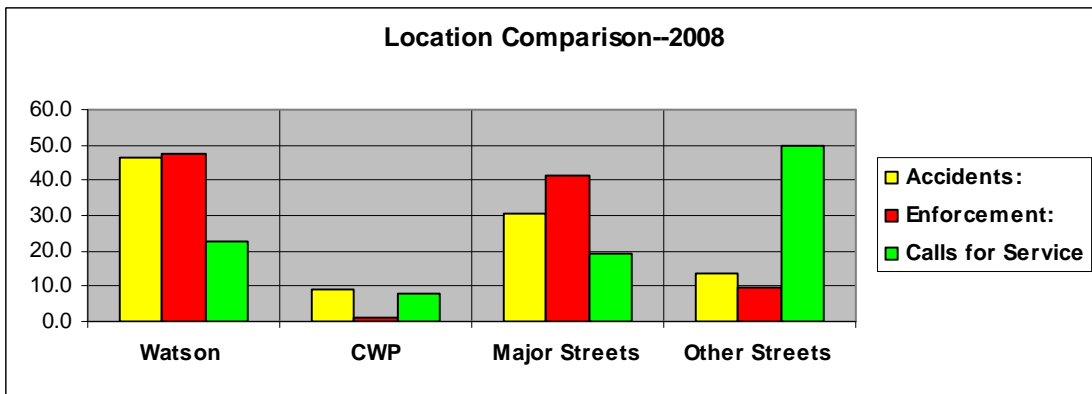


Location Comparison:

This chart is a comparison of the percentage of accidents, enforcement and calls for service by the four major tracking areas in the city year to date for 2008. Watson is activity along Watson Road and CWP is activity in Crestwood Plaza. Major streets are the following streets that have been used to track accidents and enforcement for a length of time. They are:
