Incidents by Hour of Day --2009





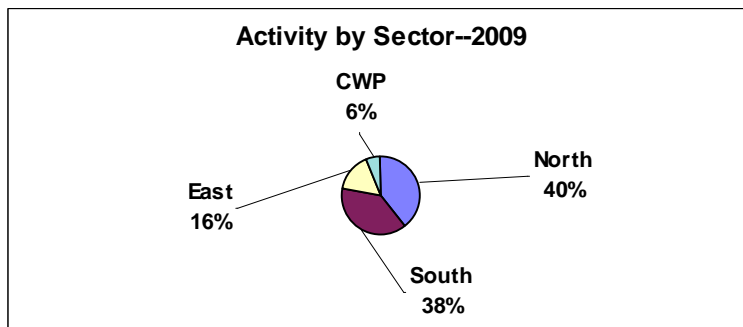
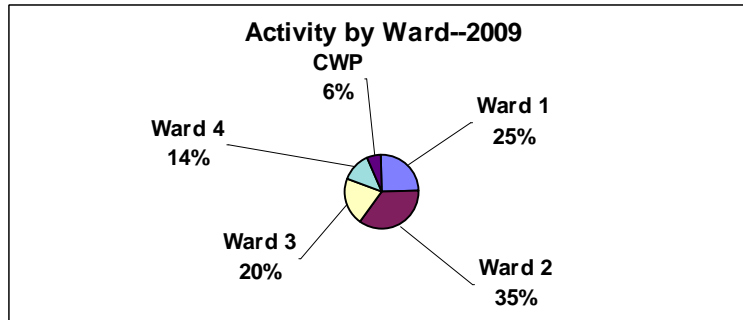

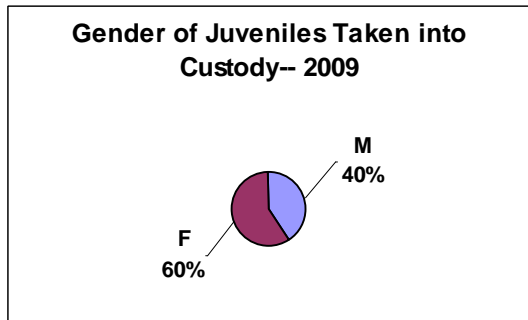
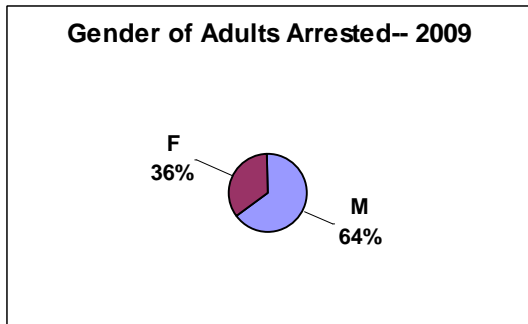
Five hundred eighty-two adults and 72 juveniles were taken into custody in the 2009. Eighty-seven persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrest.

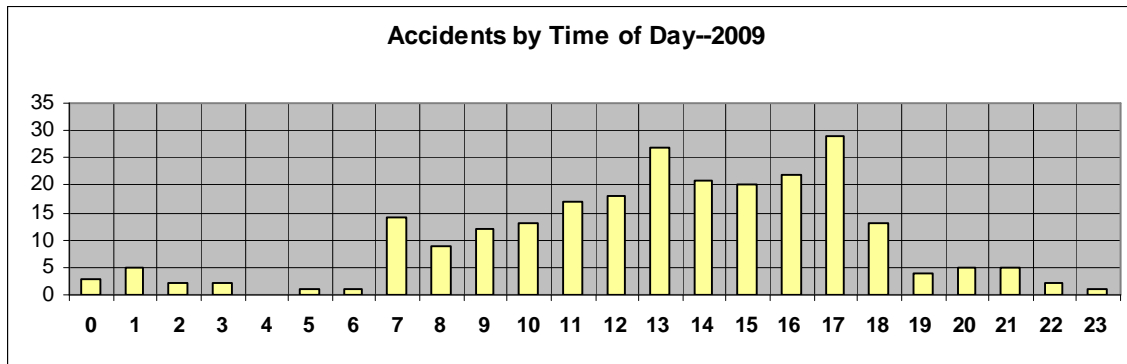

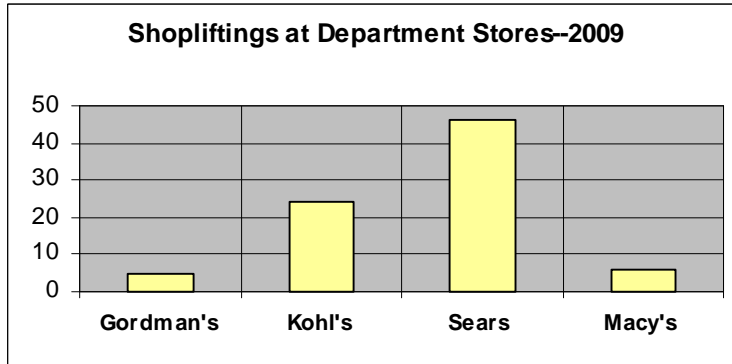
Stealings:

Shopliftings:

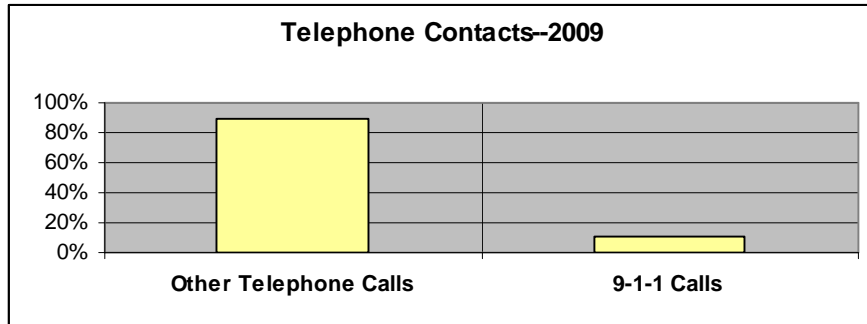
There were 150 shopliftings reported in 2009. This was 40% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:



Fifty-four percent of the shopliftings occurred at the Department Stores. The remaining 46% occurred at 22 different stores.

Communications:

In 2009, Communications handled 48,460 telephone contacts and 5628 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 133 telephone calls and fifteen 9-1-1 calls.

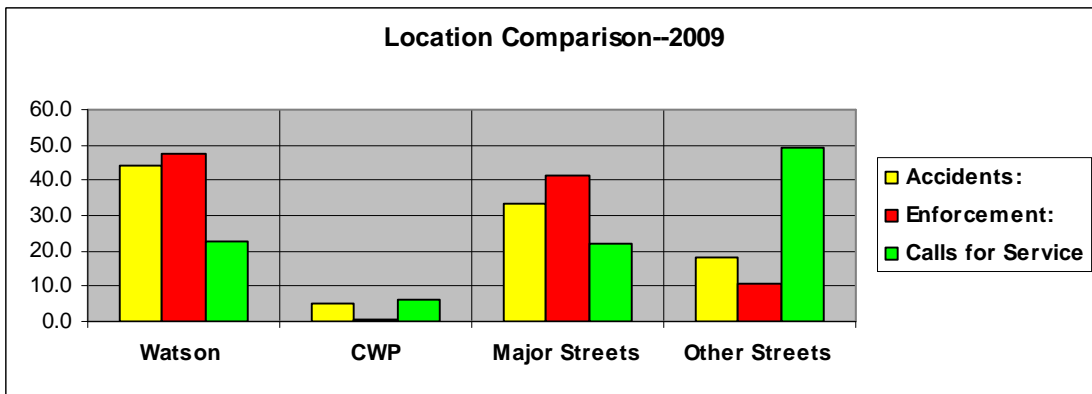


Location Comparison:

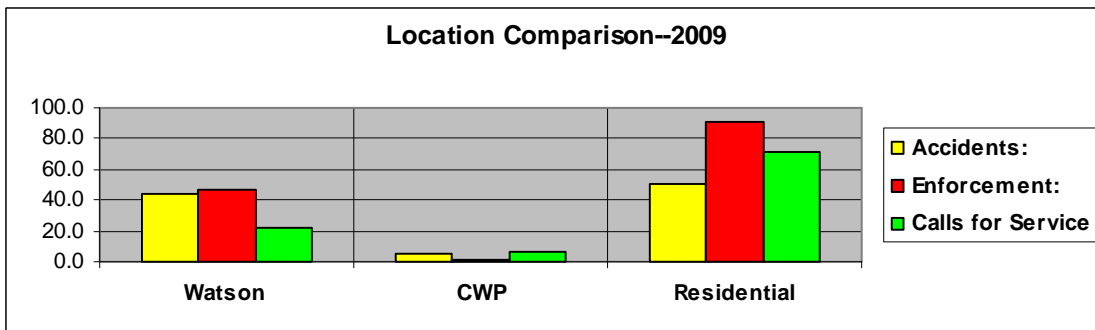
