Topic: August 2007 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of August 2007. In August 2007, there were 50 Part I offenses and 612 Part II offenses for a total of 662. This compares with 56 Part I offenses and 500 Part II offenses for a total of 556 in August 2007. The main difference was in the number of suspicious activity and people related calls.

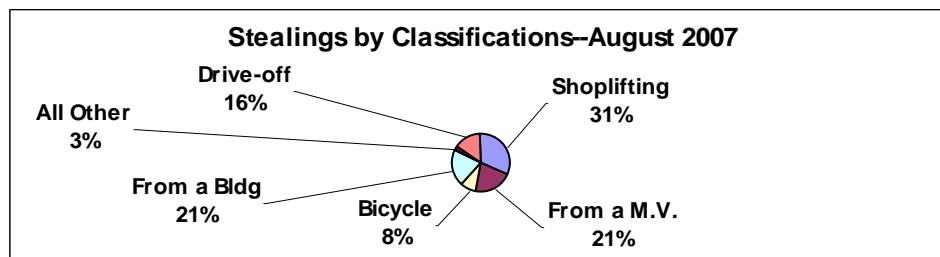
There was one sexual offense in August. A student on a school bus was inappropriately touched by another student. The student did not report the incident until she arrived at her residential center.

There was one robbery in August. The robbery involved an incident of shoplifting and an altercation between the two individuals involved in the theft and store security. The two individuals were taken into custody.

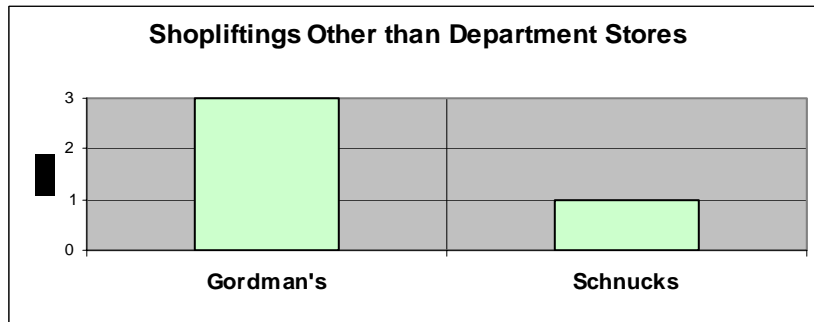
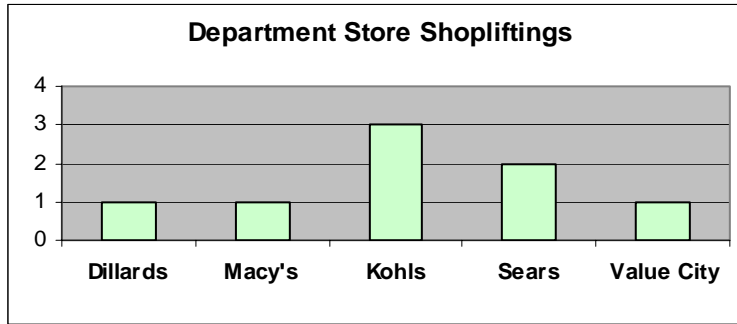
There were five assaults in August 2007 and three involved domestic violence. In three cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 38 in August 2007.

Stealings were of the following classifications in August 2007:

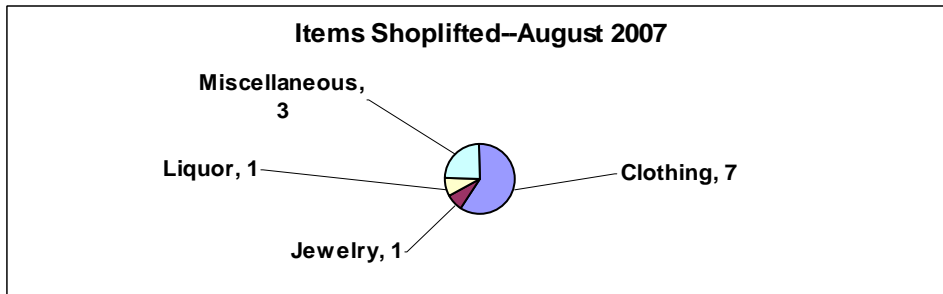


Shopliftings accounted for 12 of the 38 stealings in August 2007 or 31%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in August 2007:

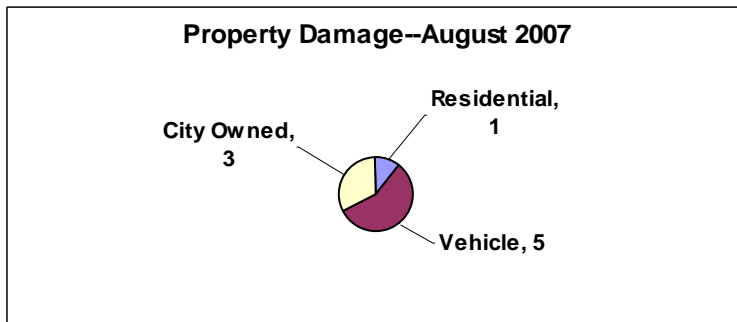


Of the shopliftings, 83% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 90% and juveniles accounted for 10% of the clearances.

There were nine property damages in August 2007 and they were of the following classifications:



The three City Owned property damages included damage to the vacant house by the quarry in Whitecliff Park on three different occasions. A contract will be let soon for the demolition of this structure.

There was one stolen vehicle in August 2007. On 08-25-2007, someone removed a gray 1988 Buick Century from the lot of a vehicle rental business on Watson Road. The vehicle was used by an auto repair shop to convey employees from the business to their shop.

Part I offenses numbered 50 in August 2007.

Part II:

In August 2007, there were seven frauds including four credit card frauds, one failure to return leased property, one bad check and one other fraud. There were five possessions of controlled substances and all involved possession of marijuana. There were four offenses against public peace including two trespassing, one disorderly conduct and one resisting arrest. There were seven DWI cases, eight animal related calls and 63 people related calls including 58 sick case / accidental injuries, three sudden deaths, one suicide or attempt suicide and one missing person. The two juvenile offenses included one curfew violation and one minor in possession of alcohol, and one family offense involved a child left unattended in a vehicle.

Part II offenses totaled 476 in August 2007.

In August 2007 in Ward One, stealings numbered eight with seven at addresses on Watson Road and one in an apartment complex. Property damages numbered three, one at addresses along Watson Road and two in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud and one drug offenses. There were three DWI cases and ten traffic accidents, twelve people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered 12 and occurred on 24 different streets and there were 60 miscellaneous police service calls.

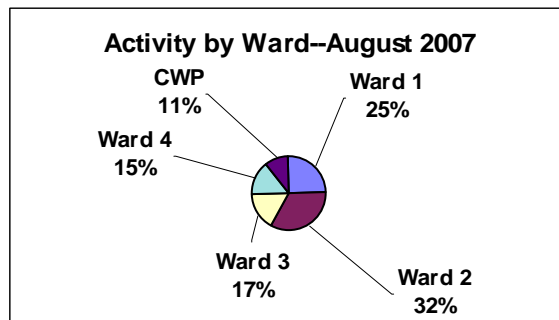
In Ward Two in August 2007, there was one sexual offense on a school bus and stealings numbered fifteen with eleven at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and four in the neighborhoods. There were no property damages. The one stolen vehicle was from a vehicle rental business on Watson Road. There were two frauds, one juvenile related and one family offense. There were two DWI cases and seventeen traffic accidents, twenty-five people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered 15 and occurred on 31 different streets and there were 76 calls for miscellaneous police services.

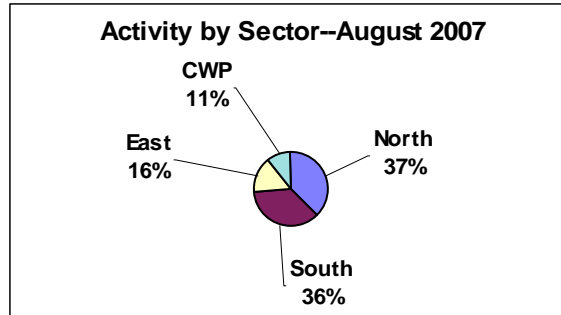
In August 2007 in Ward Three, there was one robbery at a department store and stealings numbered five with one at addresses on Watson Road and four in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered three, all in Whitecliff Park. There was one fraud, two drug offenses and three offenses against public peace. There was one DWI case and six traffic accidents and thirteen people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered 12 and occurred on 15 different streets and there were 45 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in August 2007, stealings numbered two and property damages numbered two. There were two drug offenses and one juvenile related offense. There was one DWI case and one traffic accidents, seven people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered 13 and occurred on 20 different streets and there were 38 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered eight with four shopliftings and four from buildings. Property damages numbered one. There were no stolen vehicles. There were three frauds and one offense against public peace. There were no DWI cases and three traffic accidents, six people related calls and one animal related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and there were 27 police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

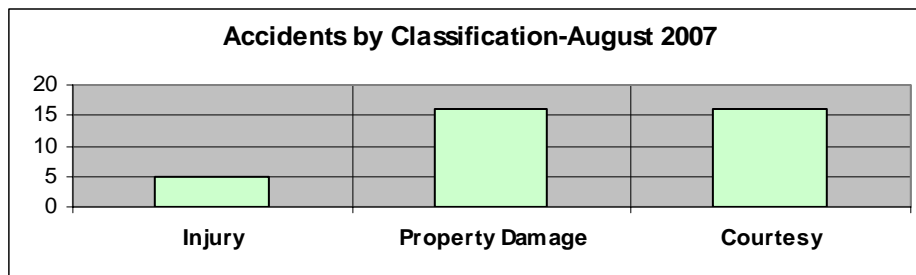

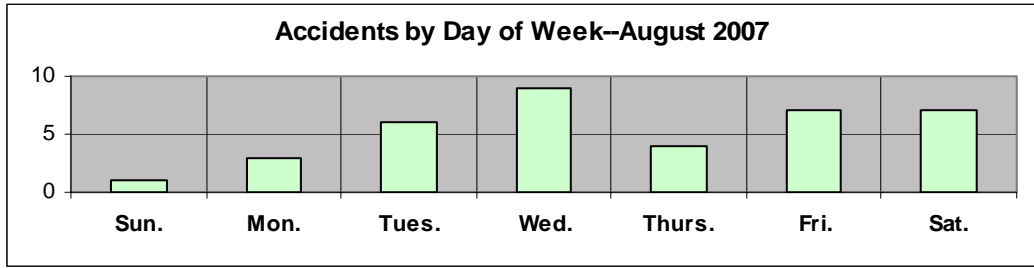
Traffic Accidents:

In August 2007, there were 37 traffic accidents reported. These accidents were of the following classifications:

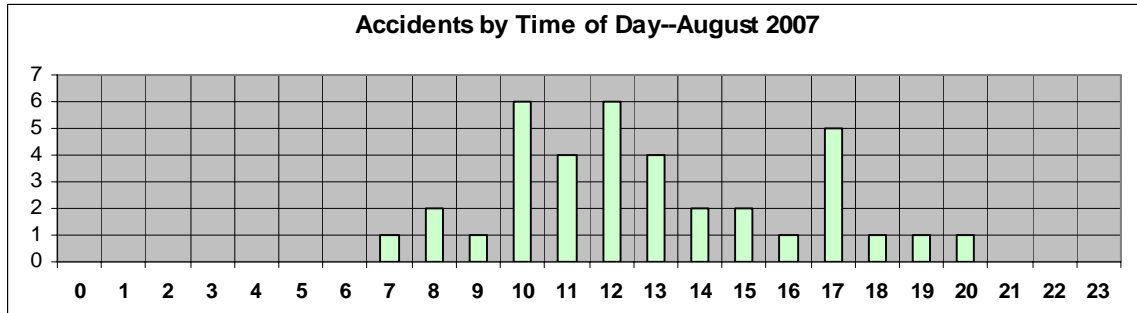

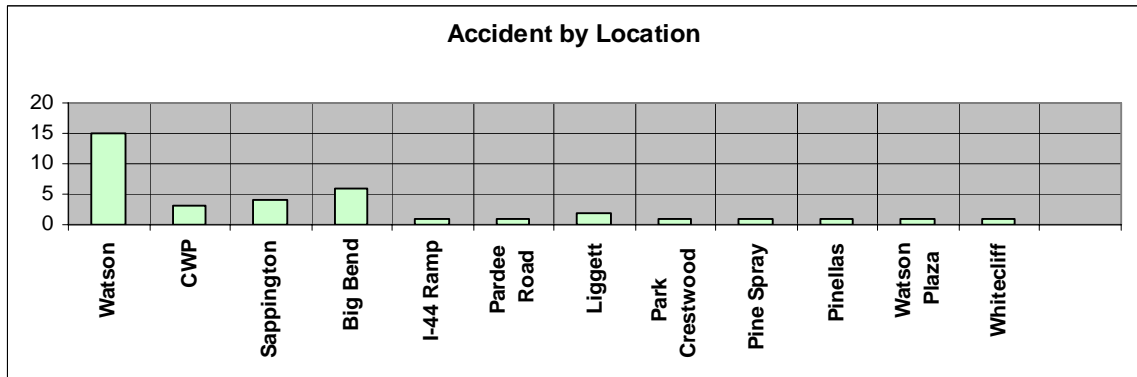

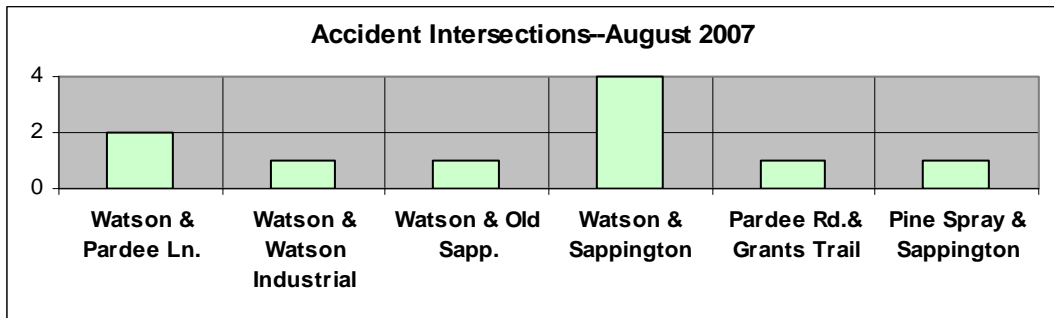
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



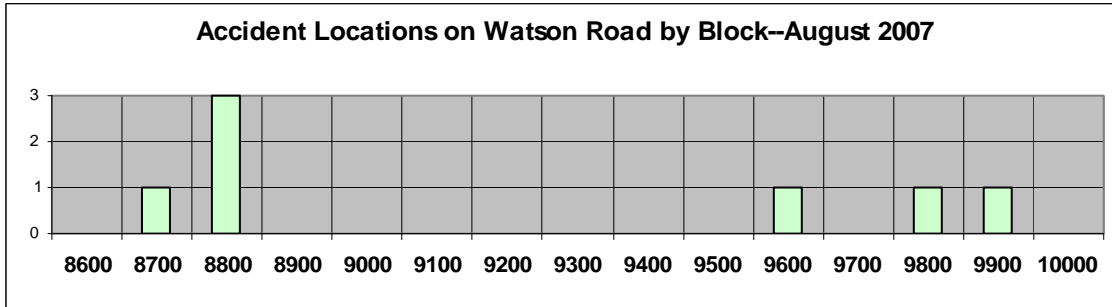
Accidents occurred on the following streets in August 2007:

Accidents occurred in the following blocks of Watson Road:



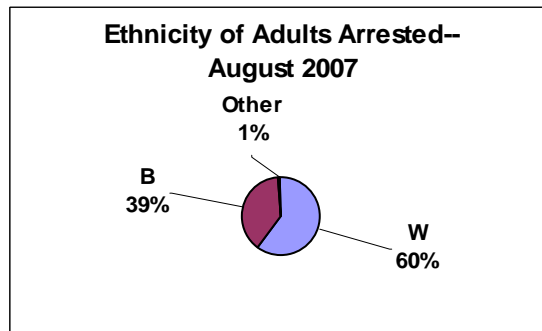

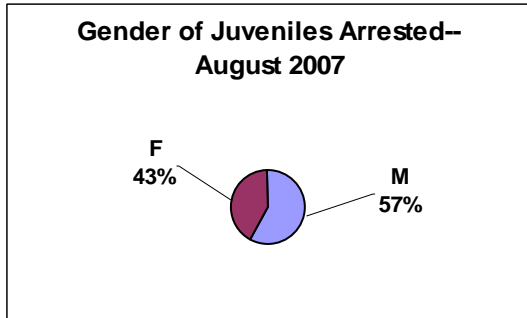
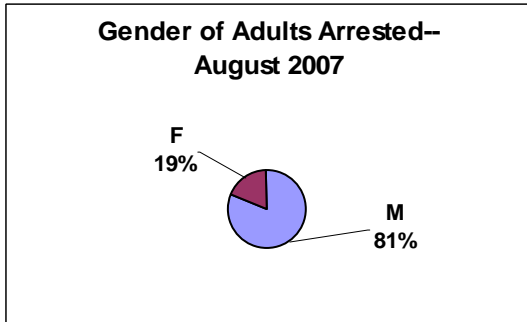
Eighty-four adults and seven juveniles were taken into custody in August 2007. Fifteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

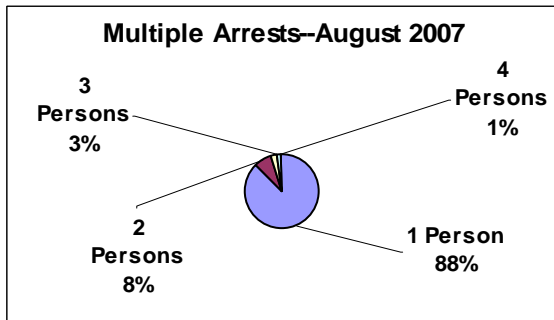


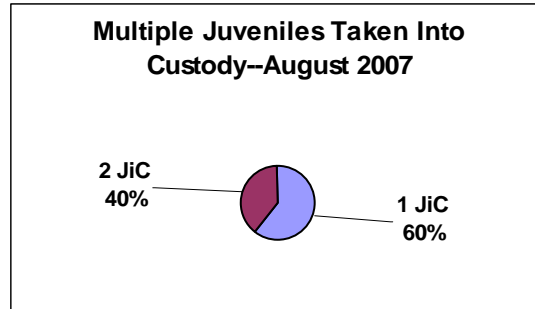


The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



Multiple Arrests:

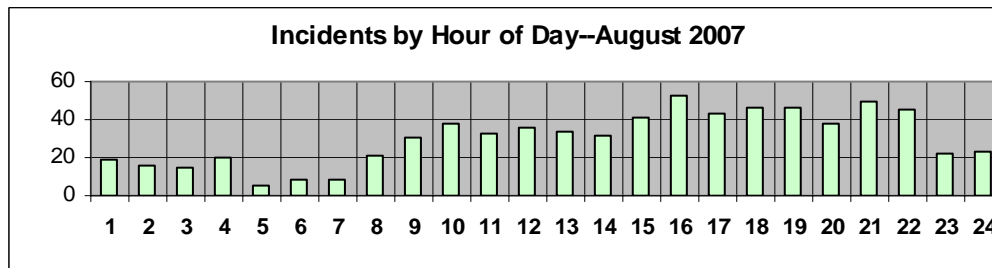
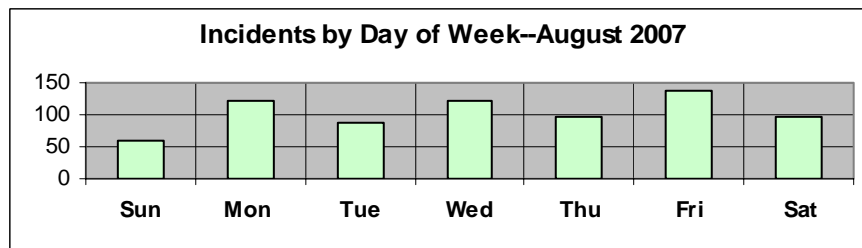




Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

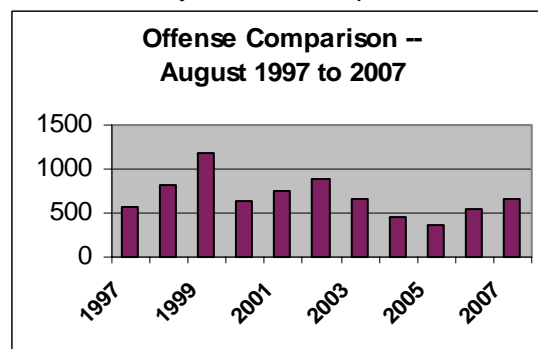

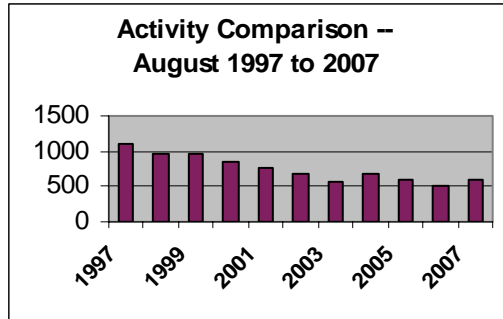
Activity occurred on the following days of the week and hours of the day:



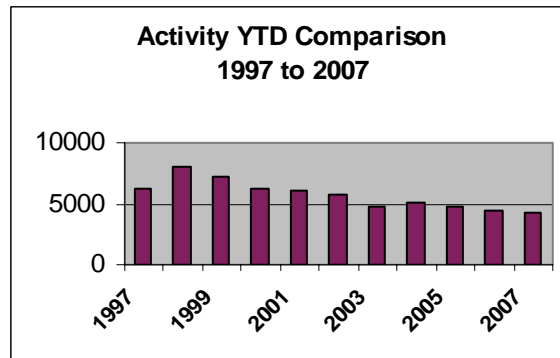
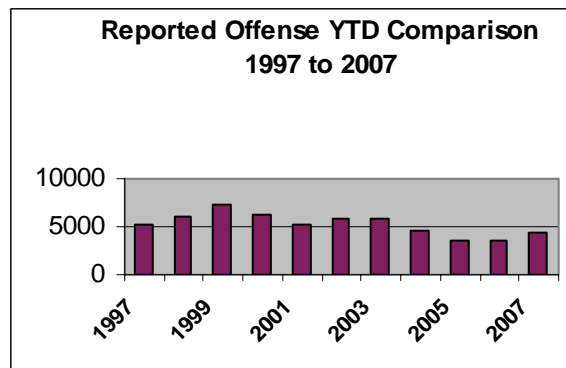
Offense and Activity Comparison:

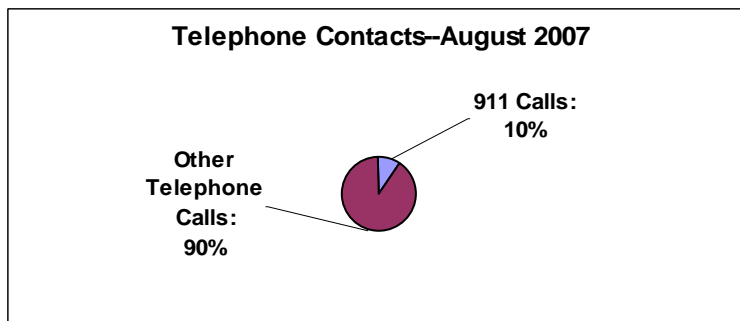


Years to Date:

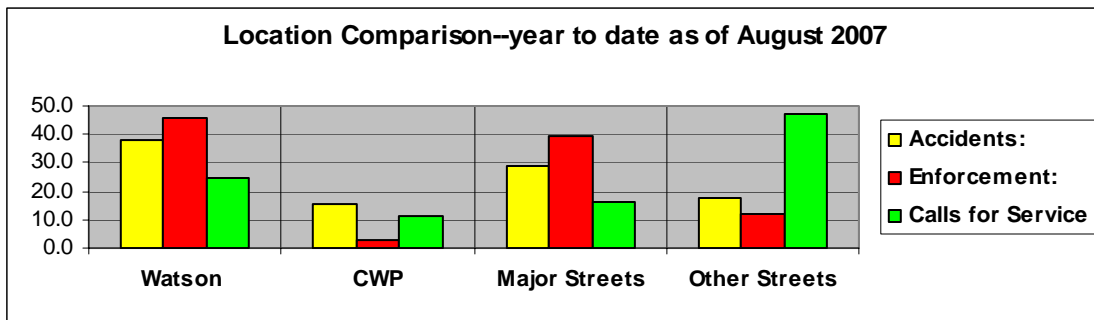


Location Comparison:
