Topic: August 2009 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of August 2009. In August 2009, there were 51 Part I offenses and 329 Part II offenses for a total of 380. This compares with 63 Part I offenses and 405 Part II offenses for a total of 468 in August 2008. The main difference was in the number of stealings and traffic stops.

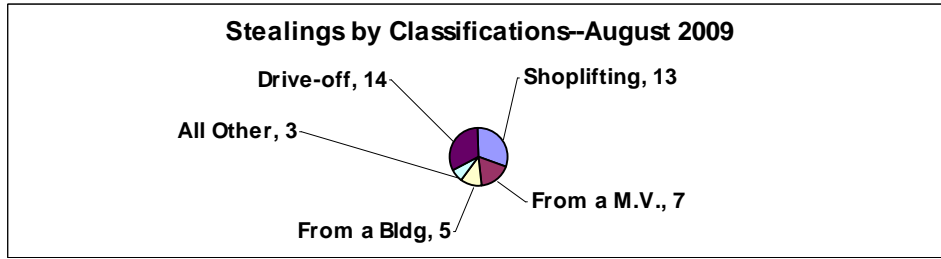
There were three sexual offenses reported in August. A rape was reported on 08-30-2009 and the investigation revealed that no rape occurred. A sexual assault was reported by DFS on 08-31-2009 and investigation into this offense is continuing. The third was an exposing person in Whitecliff Park, who was taken into custody.

There were three burglaries reported in August. The first was reported on 08-18-2009 from an apartment on Park Crestwood Dr. Someone had broken into the victim's apartment and stolen some photographs. Investigation led to an arrest and warrants being issued. The second burglary occurred on Cherry Brook on 08-22-2009 and involved someone entering an unlocked garage and getting into the attic and attempting to enter the residence. The garage ceiling collapsed and entry was not gained to the residence. The third burglary occurred on 08-23-2009 on Sappington Road and involved a dispute between the resident and another party over a girlfriend.

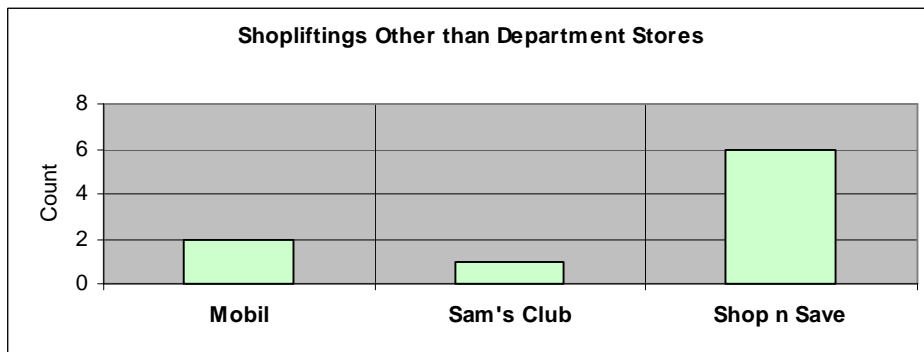
There were four assaults in August 2009 and four involved domestic violence. In all cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

Stealing offenses numbered 42 in August 2009.

Stealings were of the following classifications in August 2009:

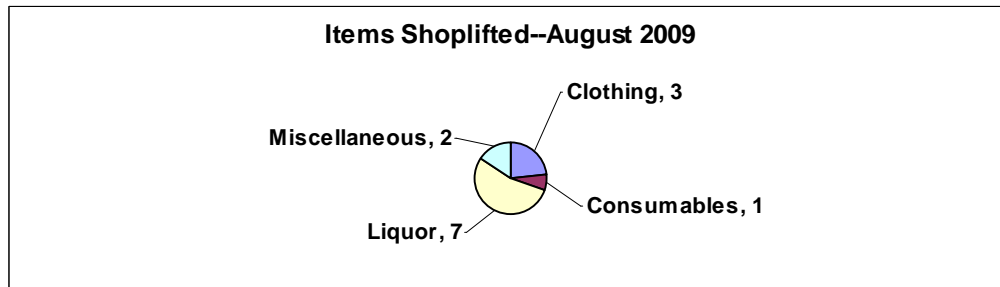


Shopliftings accounted for thirteen of the 42 stealings in August 2009 or 31%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in August 2009:

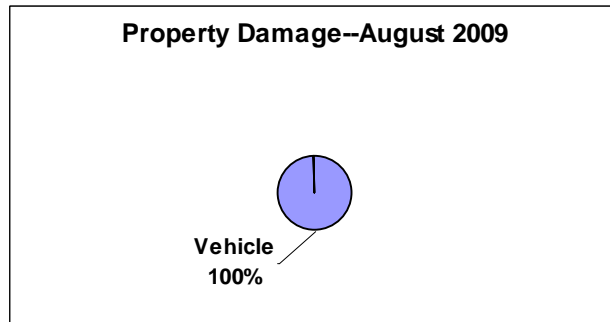


Of the shopliftings, 46% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 66% and juveniles accounted for 17% and adults and juveniles together accounted for 17% of the clearances.

There were three property damages in August 2009 and they were of the following classifications:



Part I offenses numbered 51 in August 2009.

Part II:

In August 2009, there were five frauds including two fraudulent use of credit cards, one passing bad check, one other type fraud and one failure to return leased property. There was one drug offense that involving a fraudulent prescription. There was one offense against public peace that was a trespassing. There were three DWI cases and 21 traffic accidents. People related calls numbered 63 with 59 medical emergencies, two missing persons and two sudden deaths and there were thirteen animal calls. There were two family offenses, both involving ex-parte order violations and 230 miscellaneous Police calls.

Part II offenses totaled 387 in August 2009.

In August 2009 in Ward One, there was an unfounded rape reported and one burglary on Park Crestwood. Stealings numbered seven with one at addresses on Watson Road and six in the neighborhoods. There were two frauds, four traffic accidents, seventeen people related calls and three animal calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on five different streets and there were 51 miscellaneous police service calls.

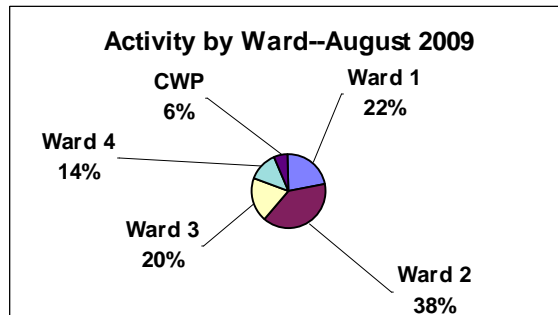
In Ward Two in August 2009, stealings numbered 20 with seventeen addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered three, two in the neighborhoods and one on the Sappington House lot that did not involve City property. There were three frauds, one drug offenses, two DWI cases and eleven traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nineteen and occurred on twelve different streets and there were 90 calls for miscellaneous police services.

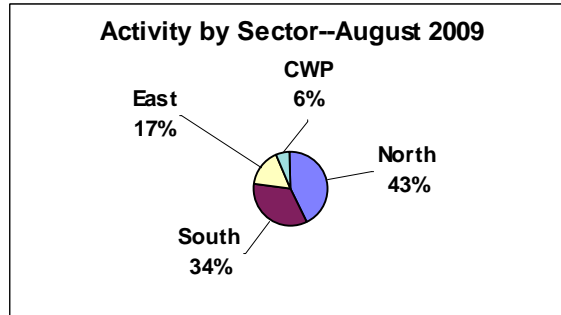
In August 2009 in Ward Three, there was one exposing person in Whitecliff Park. Stealings numbered eight with seven at addresses on Watson Road and one in Whitecliff Park. There was one offense against public peace, one DWI case and five traffic accidents, eighteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on five different streets and there were 40 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in August 2009, there was one sexual offense and one burglary on Sappington Road. Stealings numbered three. There was one traffic accident, eight people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fourteen and occurred on twelve different streets and there were 35 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered four with three shopliftings and one from a building. There was one people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and there were fourteen police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

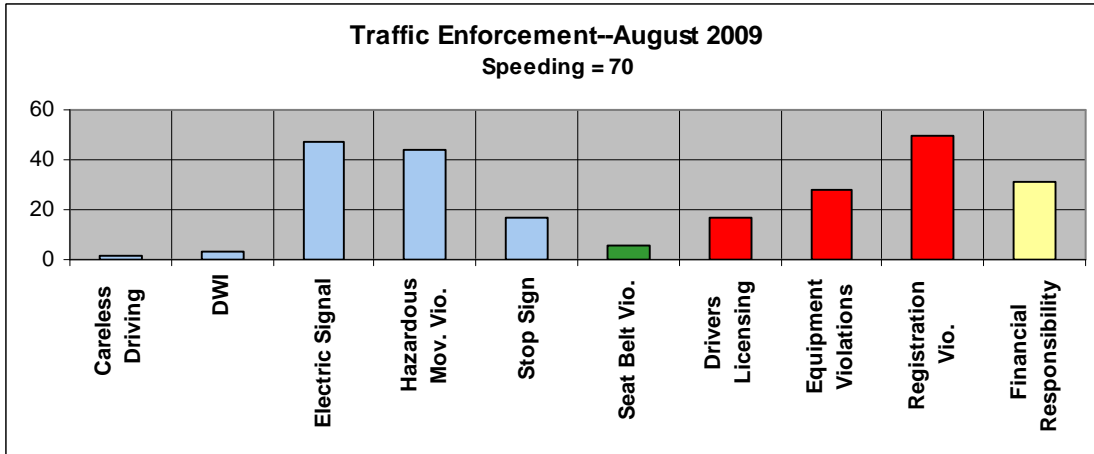

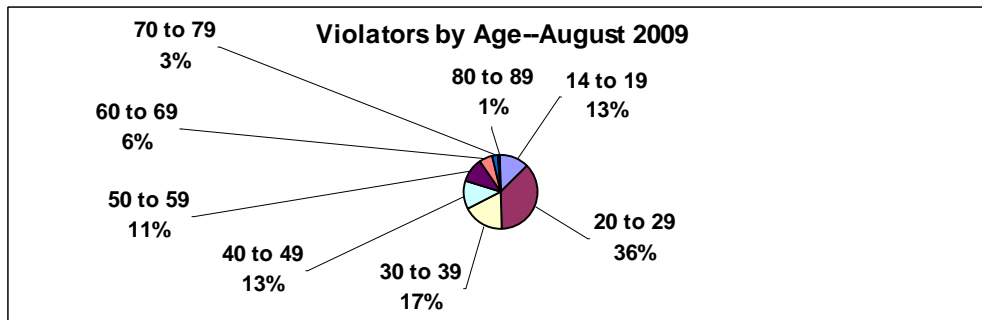

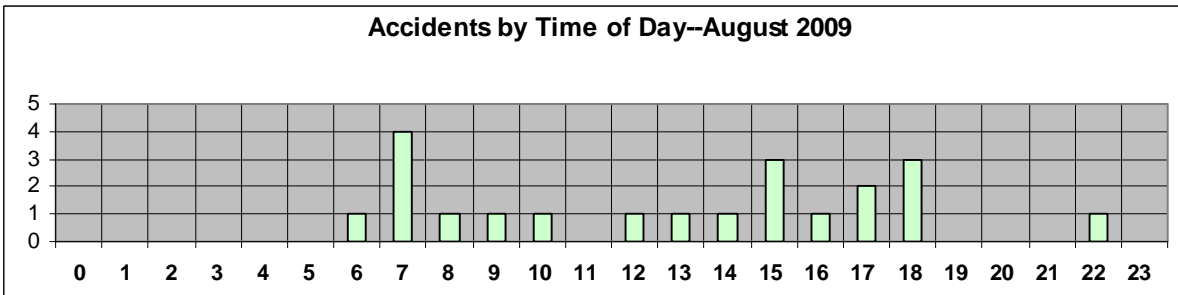

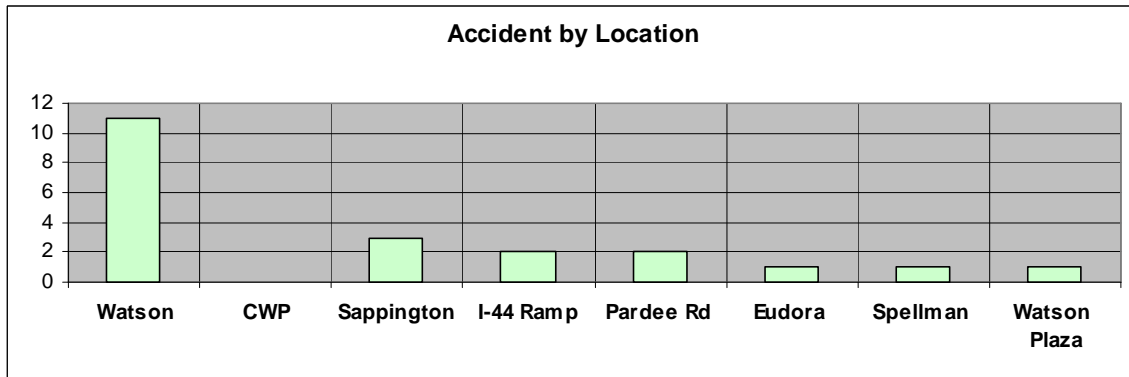

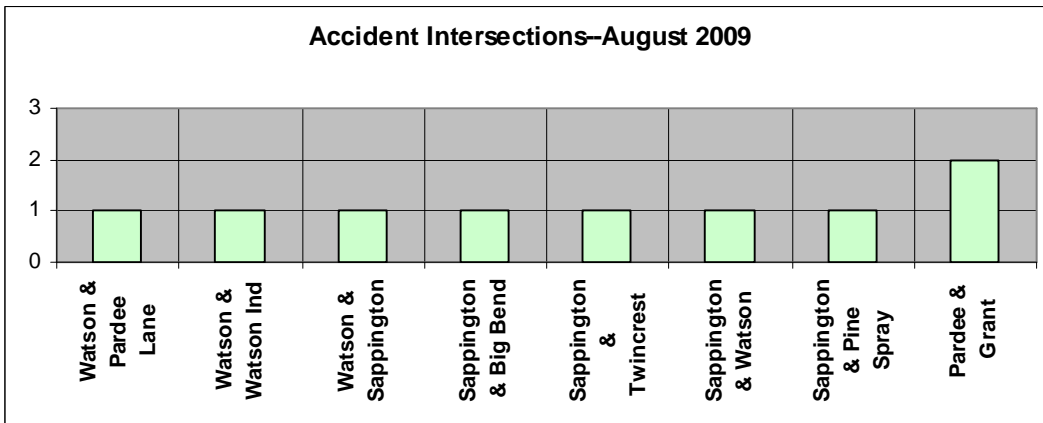
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



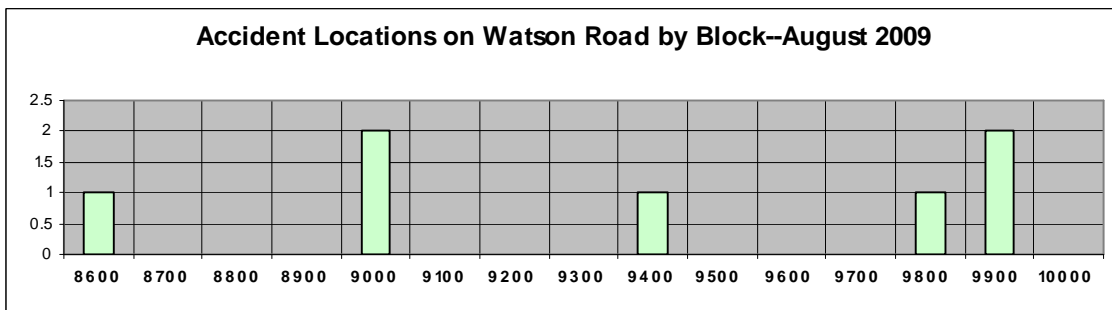

Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



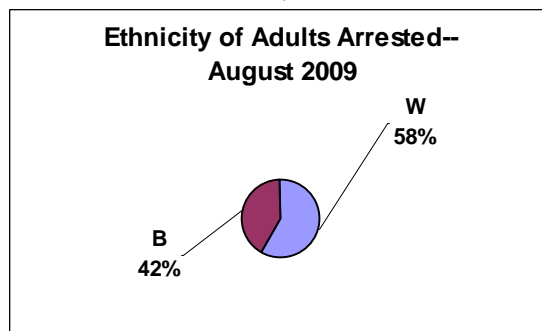

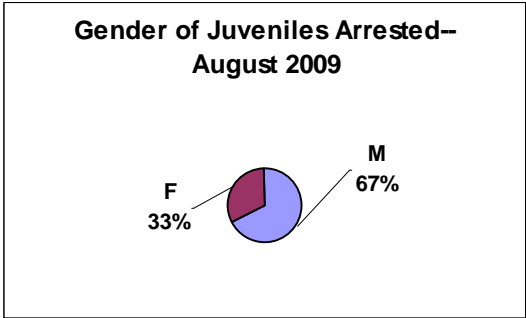
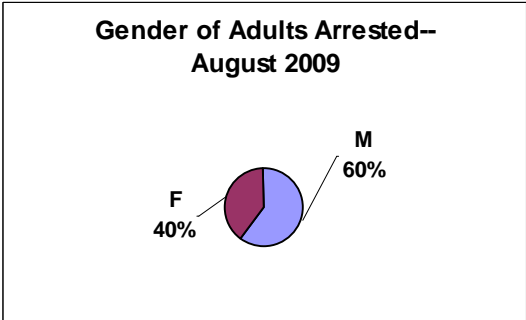
Fifty-two adults and six juveniles were taken into custody in August 2009. Nine persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

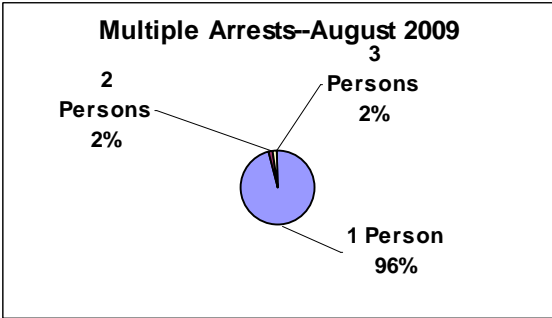


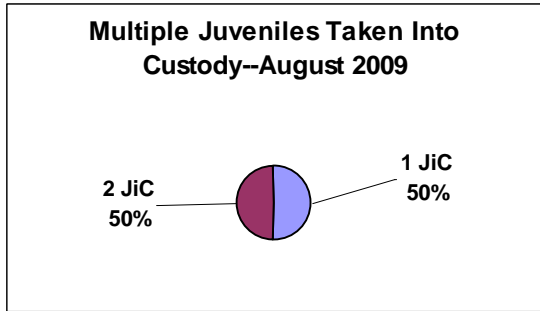


The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



Multiple Arrests:

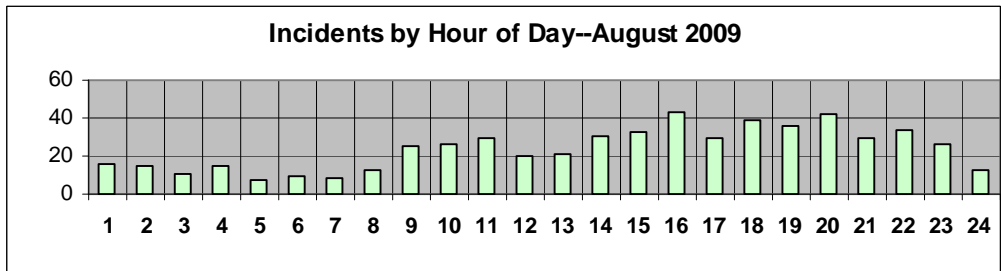
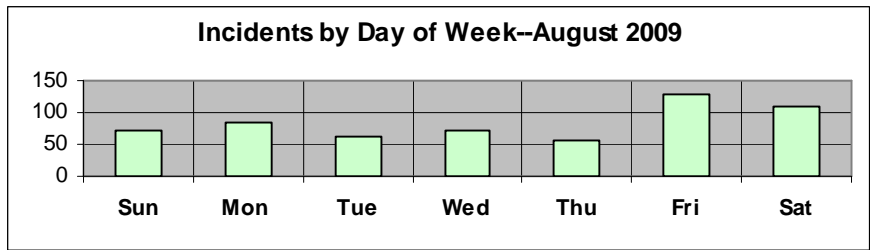




Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

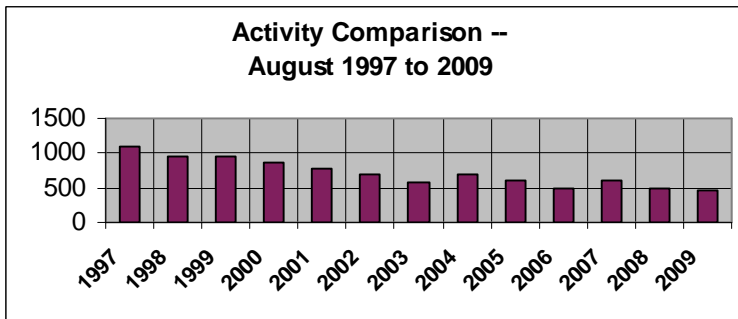
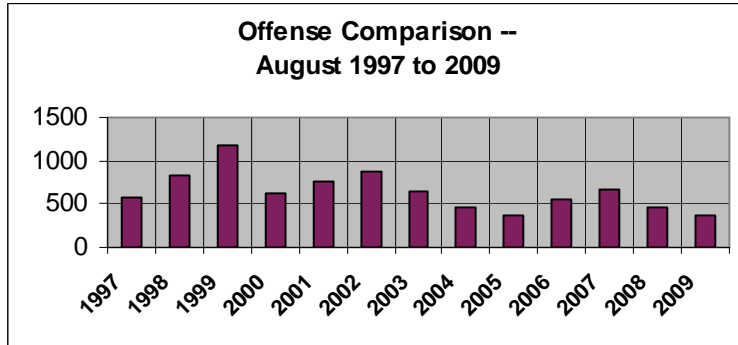

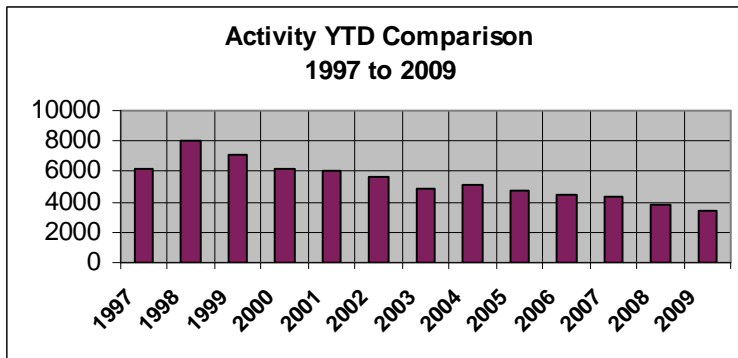
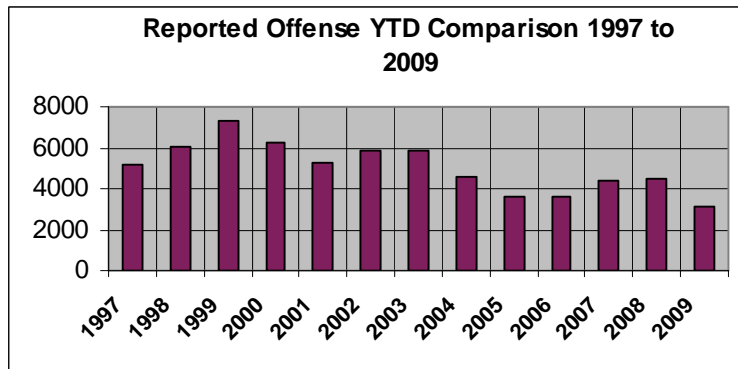


Offense and Activity Comparison:

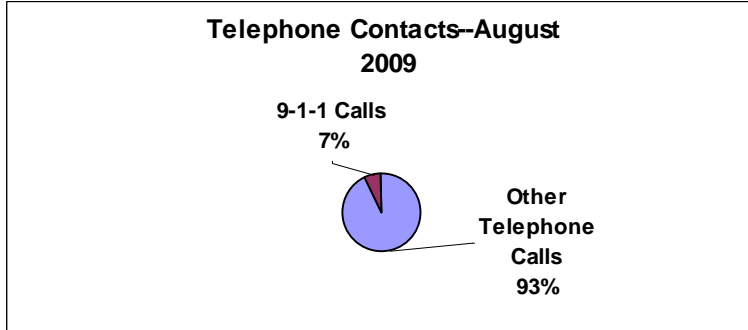


Years to Date:

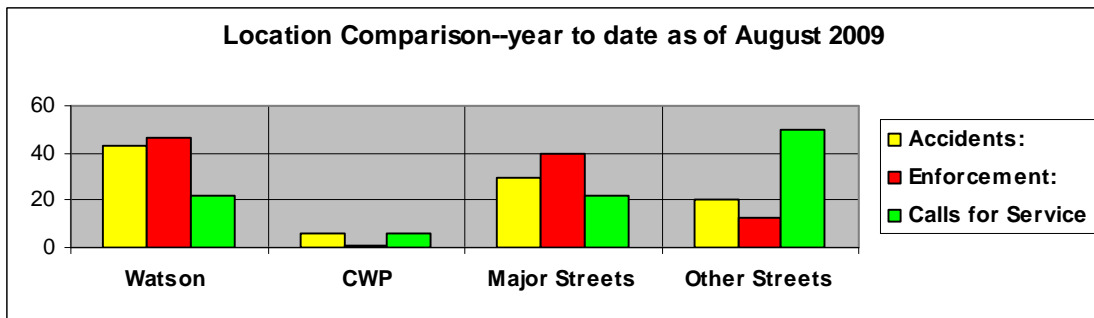


Location Comparison:
