Topic: December 2008 Public Report

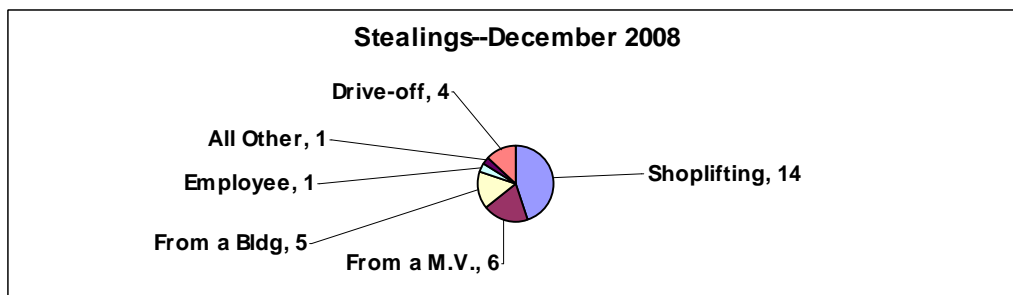
This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of December 2008. In December 2008, there were 38 Part I offenses and 384 Part II offenses for a total of 422. This compares with 68 Part I offenses and 472 Part II offenses for a total of 540 in December 2007. The main difference was in the number of stealings, frauds and traffic stops.

There were four assaults in December 2008 and four involved domestic violence. In all cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

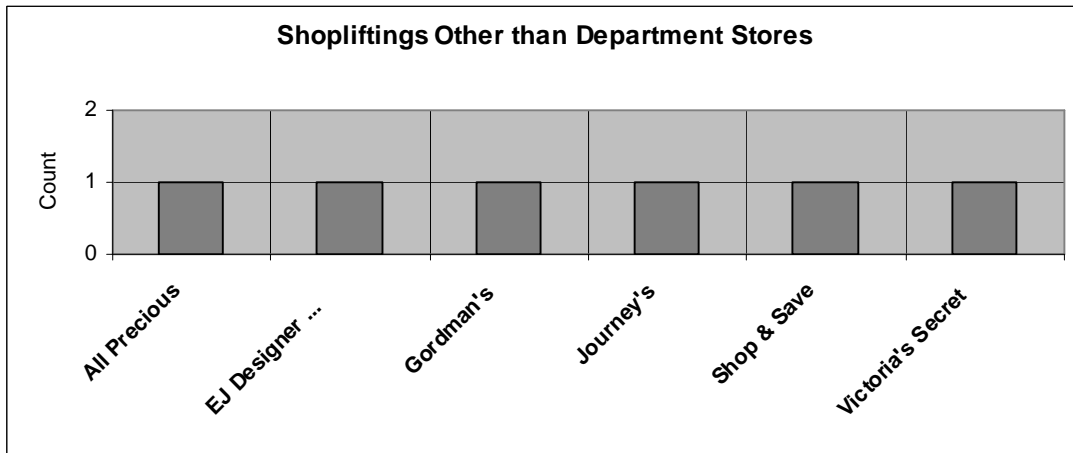
There was one burglary reported on 12-23-2008 to a business in the 10,000 blk of Watson Road. A window was broken out to gain entry to the building.

Stealing offenses numbered 31 in December 2008.

Stealings were of the following classifications in December 2008:

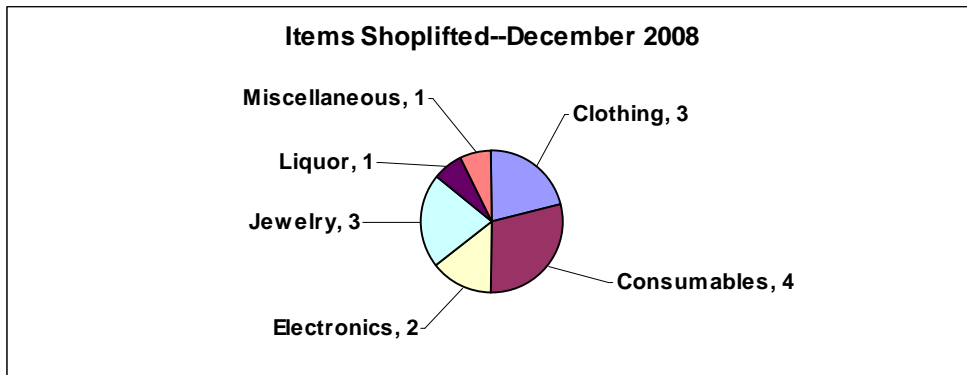


Shopliftings accounted for fourteen of the 31 stealings in December 2008 or 46%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in December 2008:

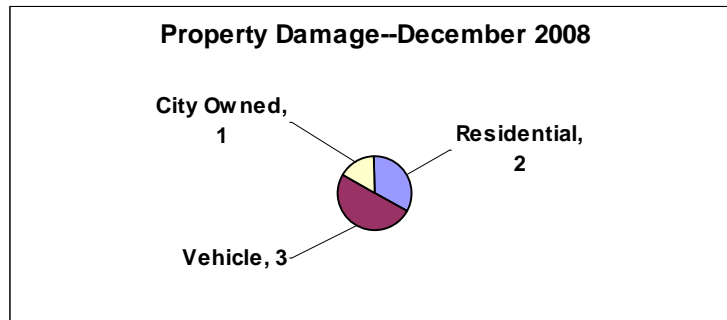


Of the shopliftings, 79% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 82% and juveniles accounted for 18% of the clearances.

There were six property damages in December 2008 and they were of the following classifications:



The City Owned property damage was two wooden signs in Whitecliff Park.

There was one receiving stolen properties that involved a stolen license plate.

Part I offenses numbered 38 in December 2008.

Part II:

In December 2008, there were five frauds, one passing bad check, one forgery, one fraudulent use, one identity theft and one other type fraud. There were two offenses against public peace, one disorderly conduct and one peace disturbance. There were six DWI cases, eight animal calls and 75 people related calls including 73 medical emergencies, one sudden death and one suicide or attempt suicide. There was one juvenile offense, a minor in possession and three family offenses including two ex-parte order violations and a criminal non-support.

Part II offenses totaled 347 in December 2008.

In December 2008 in Ward One, stealings numbered two with both at addresses on Watson Road. Property damages numbered one, in an apartment complex. There was one fraud, two DWI cases, twelve traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered seven and occurred on two different streets and there were 40 miscellaneous police service calls.

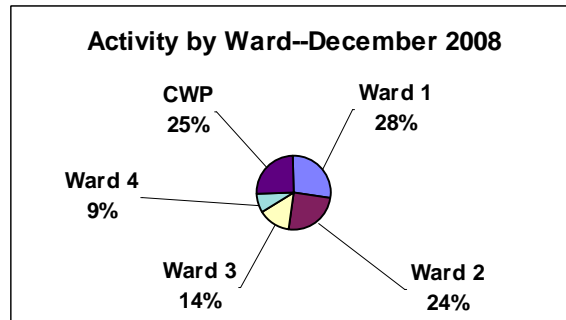
In Ward Two in December 2008, there was one business burglary with forced entry. Stealings numbered fifteen with ten at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and five in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one, in the neighborhoods. There were three frauds, one offense against public peace and one family offense. There were three DWI cases, seventeen traffic accidents, sixteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered sixteen and occurred on seven different streets and there were 54 calls for miscellaneous police services.

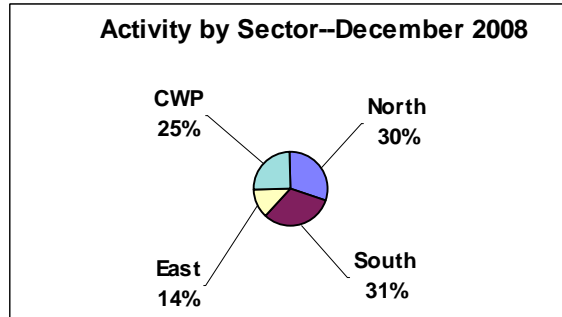
In December 2008 in Ward Three, stealings numbered three with all three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two, one at an address along Watson Road and one in Whitecliff Park. There were two family offenses, one DWI case, four traffic accidents, twenty-two people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eleven and occurred on nine different streets and there were 29 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in December 2008, there were no stealings and property damages numbered two. There was one fraud and one juvenile related offense. There were two traffic accidents, fifteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on seven different streets and there were sixteen calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered eleven with eleven shopliftings. There was one offense against public peace, seven traffic accidents and three people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and there were nineteen police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

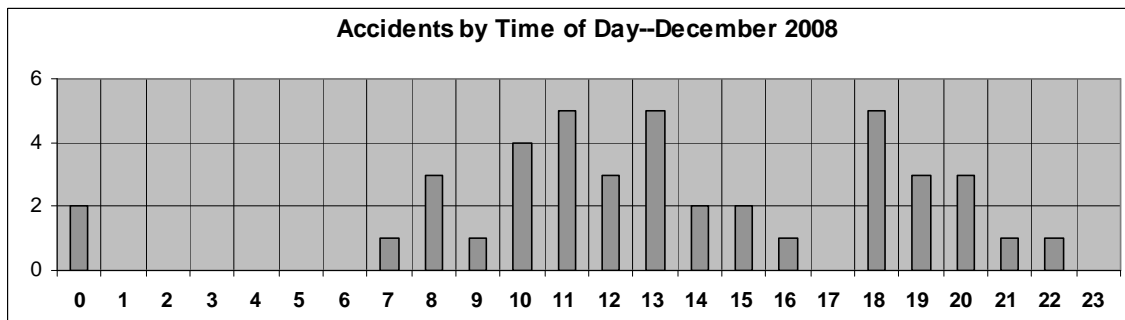

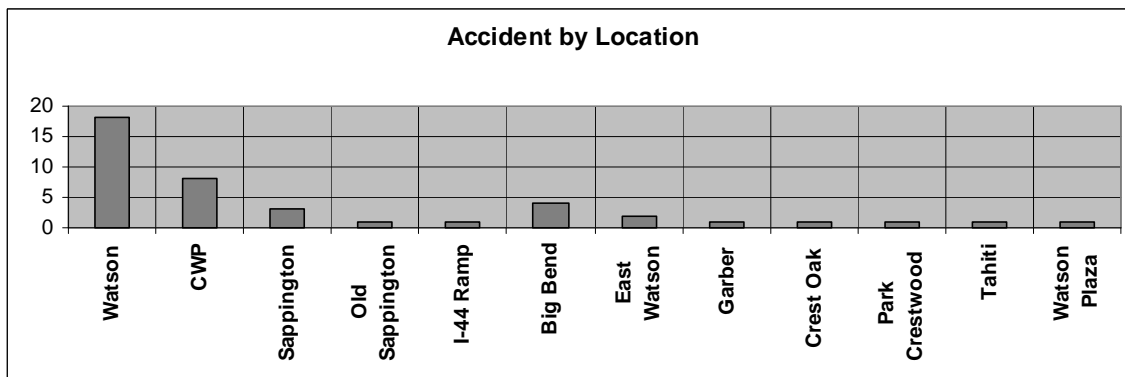

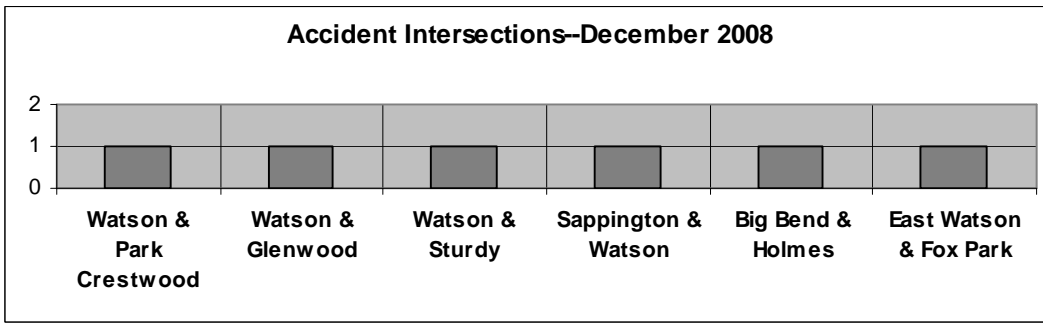
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



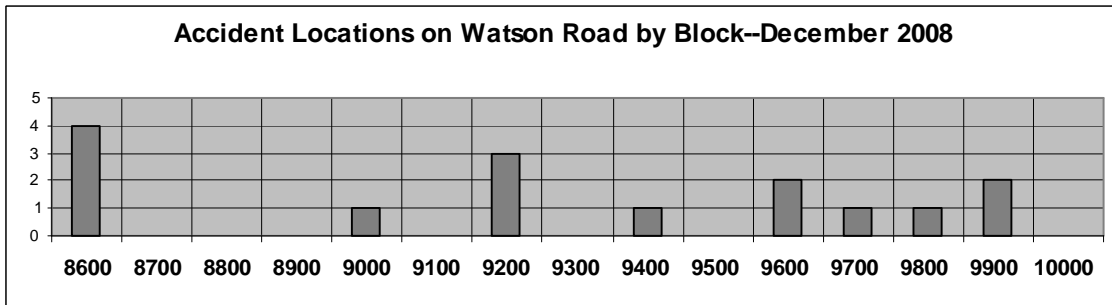
Accidents occurred on the following streets in December 2008:

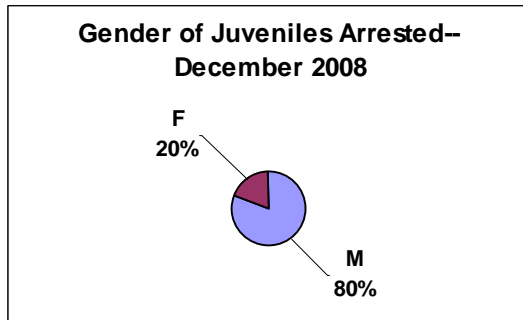
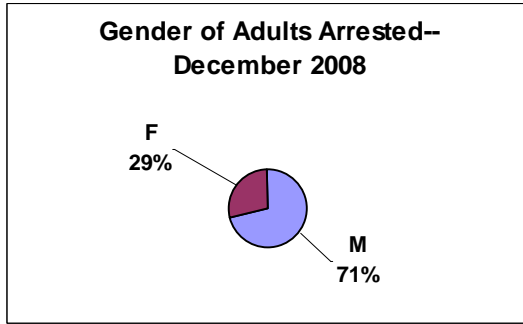
Arrest Information:

Sixty-six adults and five juveniles were taken into custody in December 2008. Five persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

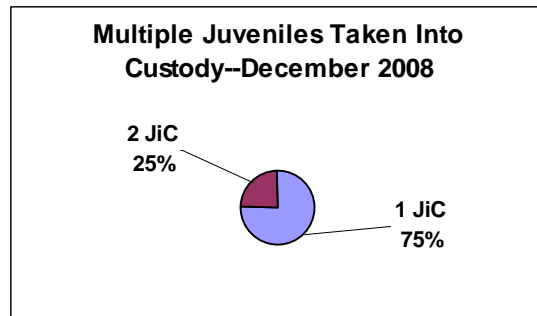
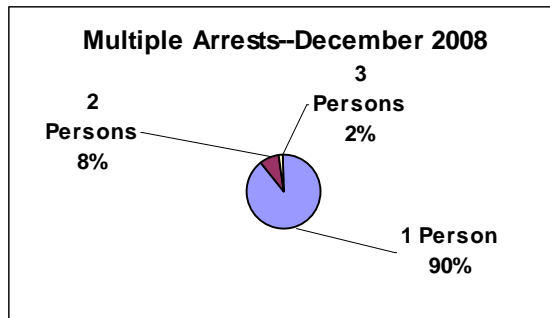
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



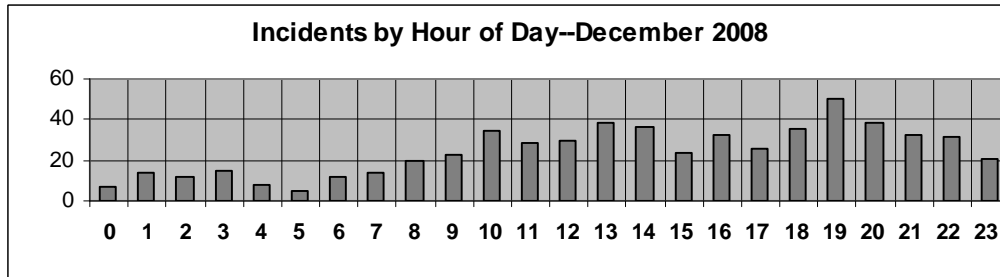
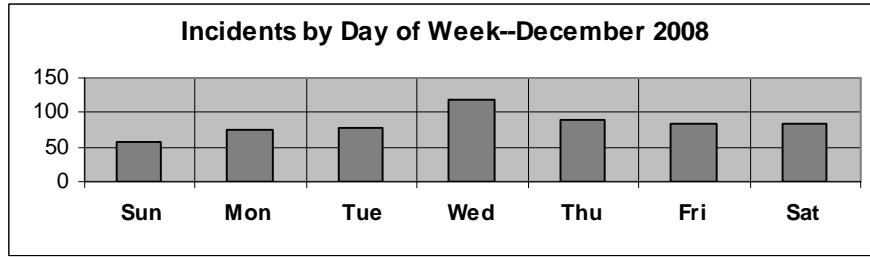
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

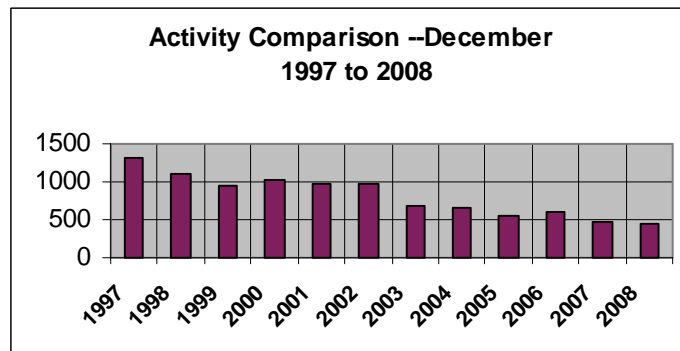
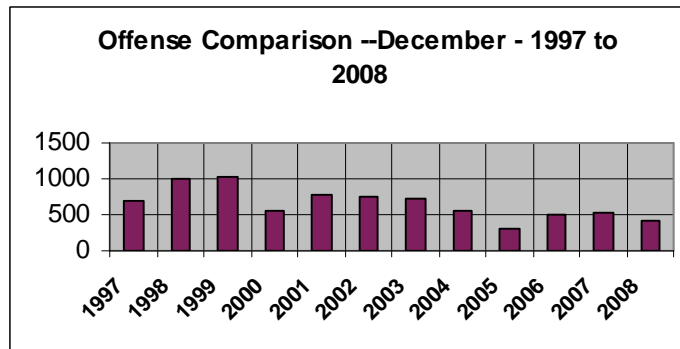

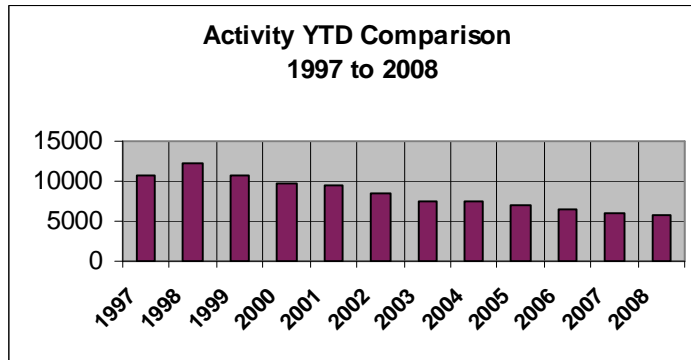
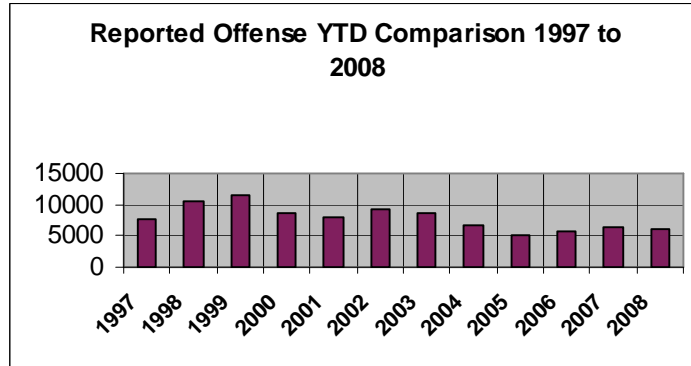


Offense and Activity Comparison:

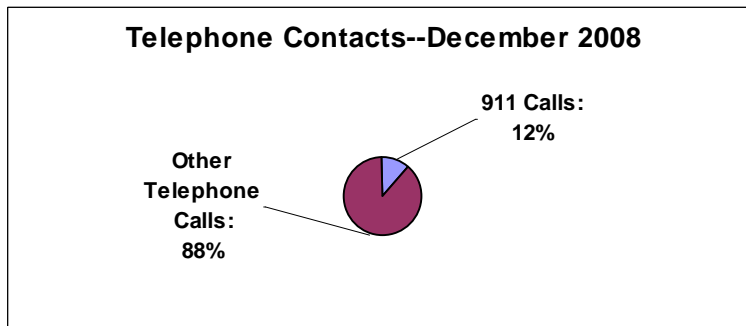


Years to Date:



Communications:

Communications handled over 4304 telephone contacts and 567 9-1-1 calls in December 2008. This is a daily average of 139 telephone contacts and eighteen 9-1-1 calls.

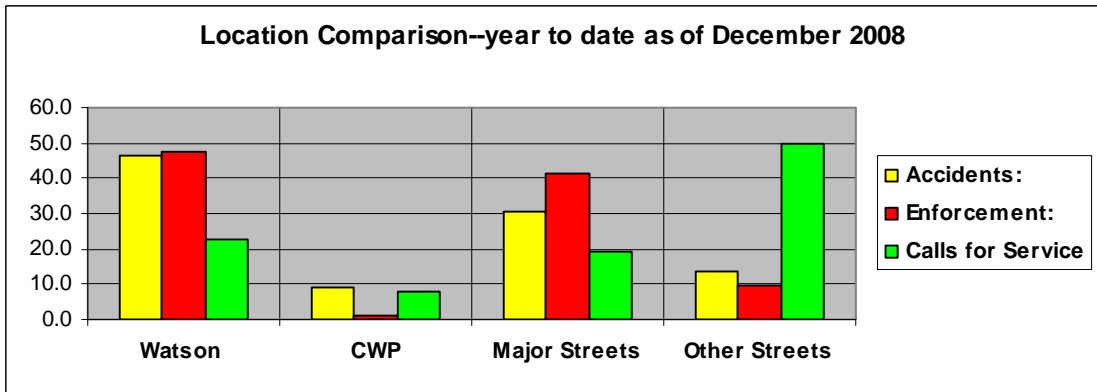


Location Comparison:
