Topic: February 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of February 2010. In February 2010, there were 27 Part I offenses and 415 Part II offenses for a total of 442. This compares with 32 Part I offenses and 311 Part II offenses for total of 343 in February 2009. The main difference was in the number of stealings and traffic stops.

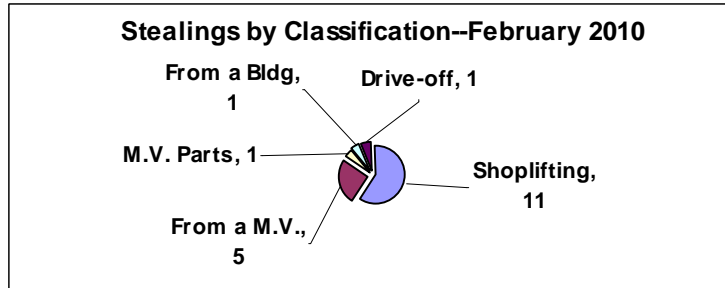
There was one sexual assault that was reported in February and involved a sexual assault between boyfriend and girlfriend in a private residence.

There were two assaults in February 2010 and one involved domestic violence. In both cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

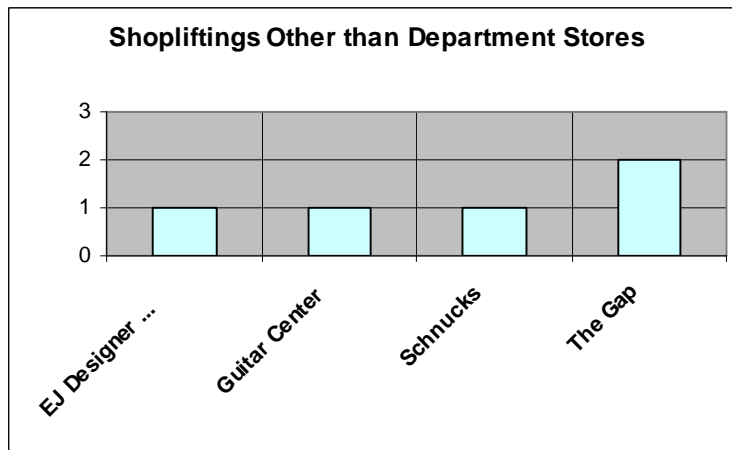
There were three burglaries reported in February, The first residential burglary occurred on 02-08-2010 to an apartment on Park Crestwood. Someone forced open a front door and removed cash and a ring from a strong box. The scene was processed by the Detective Bureau. The second residential burglary occurred on 02-10-2010 on Woodbine. The suspect knew the victim and broke into the residence to regain a cell phone. The victim heard someone breaking into the basement and fired a shotgun to scare off the burglar. Victim then called the Police. Burglar was arrested and released pending warrant application. Detective Bureau processed the scene. The third burglary was to a vacant business on Watson Road. Someone removed some plywood covering a damaged door and gained entry but nothing was taken.

Stealing offenses numbered nineteen in February 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in February 2010:

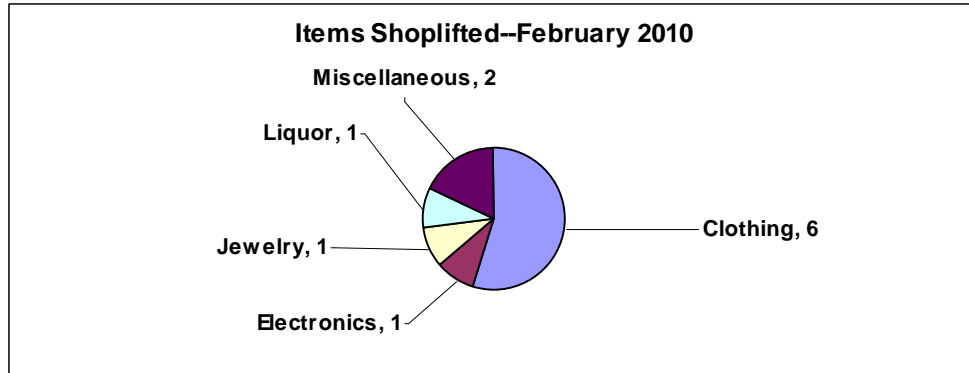


Shopliftings accounted for eleven of the nineteen stealings in February 2010 or 58%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in February 2010:

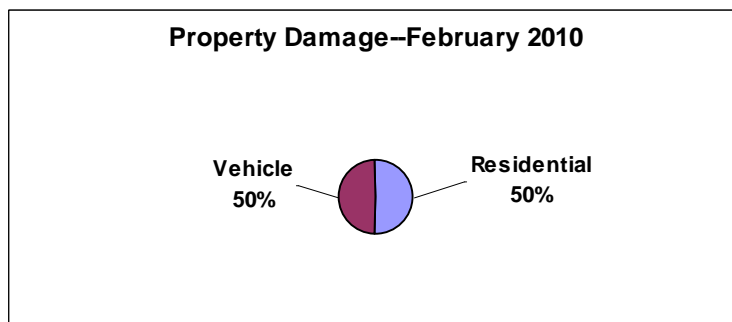


Of the shopliftings, 64% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 100% of the clearances.

Part I offenses numbered 27 in February 2010.

**Part II:**

In February 2010, there were two frauds, both were credit card frauds. There was one possession of drug paraphernalia and three DWI cases. People related calls numbered 77 with 72 medical emergencies, two missing persons, two sudden deaths and one suicide or attempt suicide. The one juvenile offense was a minor in possession of alcohol and the one family offense was an ex-parte order violation.

Part II offenses totaled 242 in February 2010.

In February 2010 in Ward One, there was one sexual assault and two burglaries, one on Woodbine and one on Park Crestwood. Stealings numbered four with two at addresses on Watson Road and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address in the neighborhoods. There was one DWI case, nine traffic accidents, sixteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 28 miscellaneous police service calls.

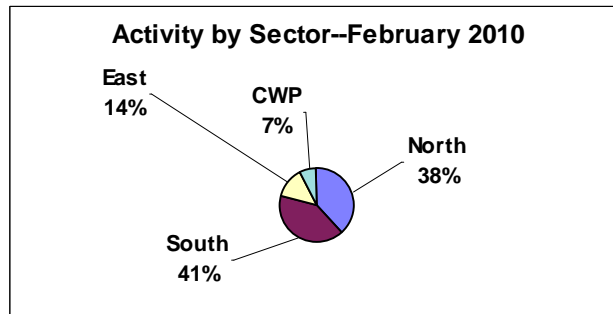
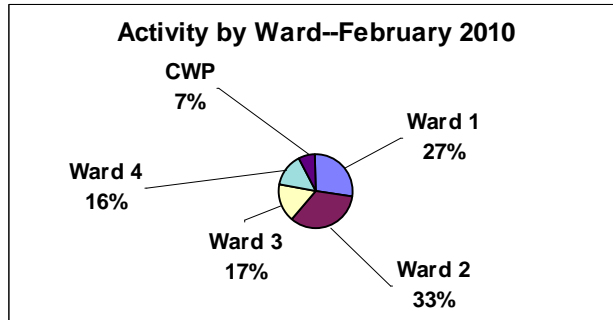
In Ward Two in February 2010, stealings numbered seven with six at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud, one drug offense, and one family offense. There were two DWI cases, eight traffic accidents, 26 people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on seven different streets and there were 37 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In February 2010 in Ward Three, there was one burglary at a vacant business on Watson Road. There was one fraud and one juvenile related offense. There were 20 people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on three different streets and there were seventeen miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in February 2010, stealings numbered two and property damages numbered two. There was one traffic accident, fourteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered five and occurred on four different streets and there were eighteen calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered six with six shopliftings. There was one traffic accident. Suspicious activity calls numbered one and there were five police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

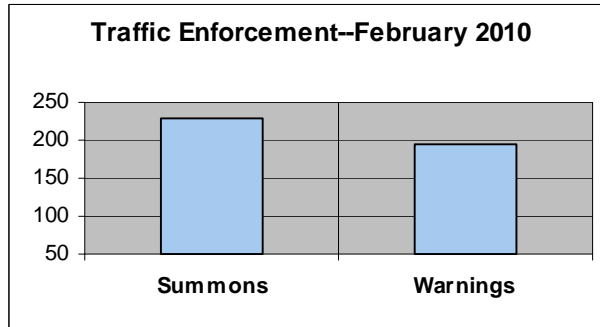

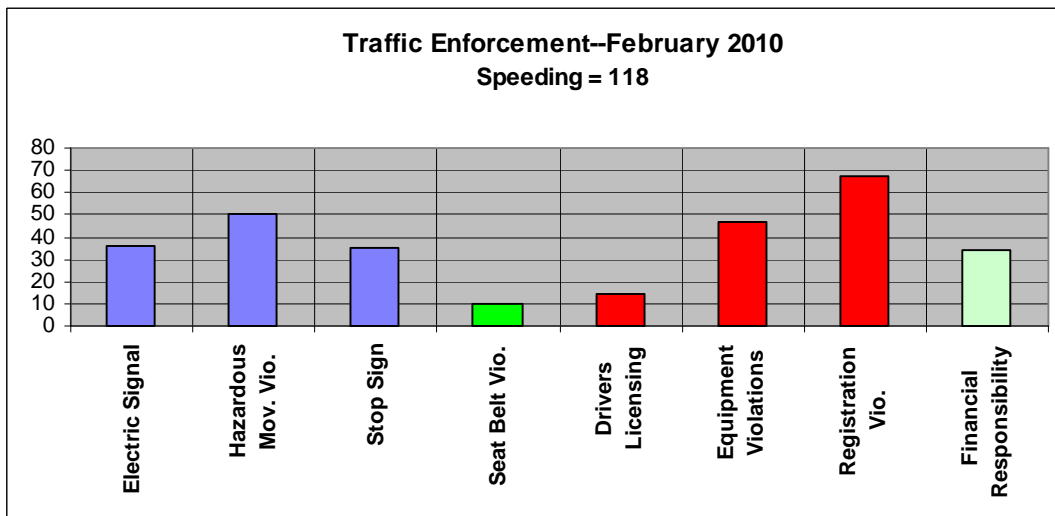

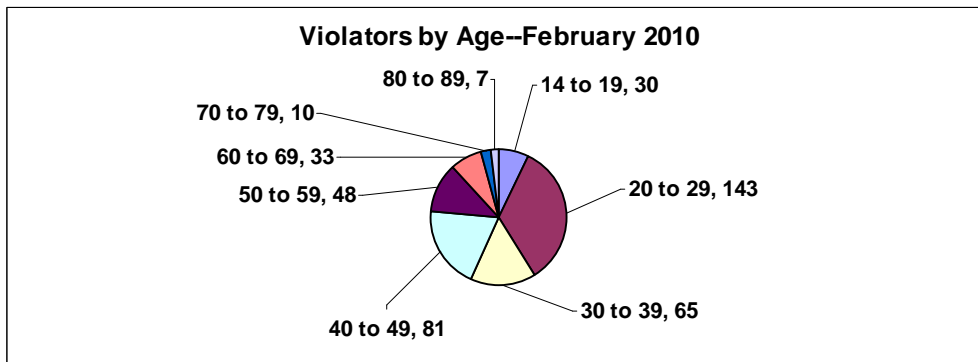
There were 417 traffic enforcement actions taken in the month of February 2010. These actions were divided as follows:



There were six parking summons and 117 parking warnings issued for vehicles parked on the incorrect side of the street after a snowfall in the month of February. This season the ordinance covering parking on the streets after snow or ice has changed to an even year at the start of winter parking is allowed on the even side and in the odd year at the start of winter parking is allowed on the odd side. Since this winter season started in 2009, parking is allowed on the odd side of the street.

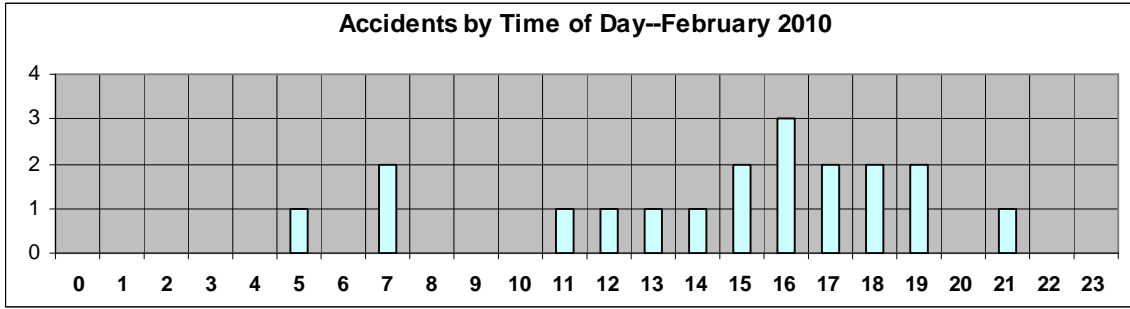

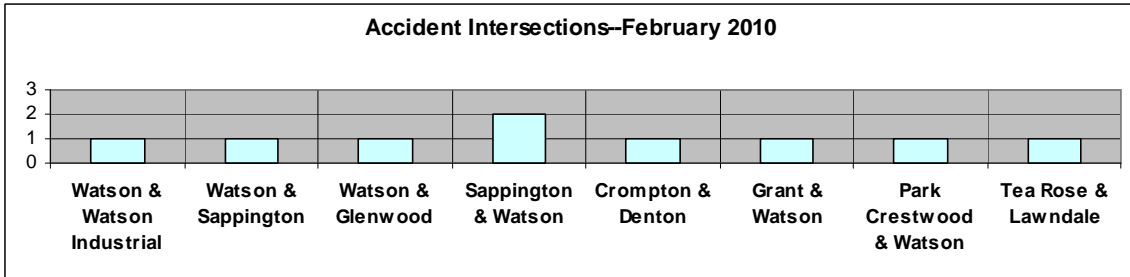
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



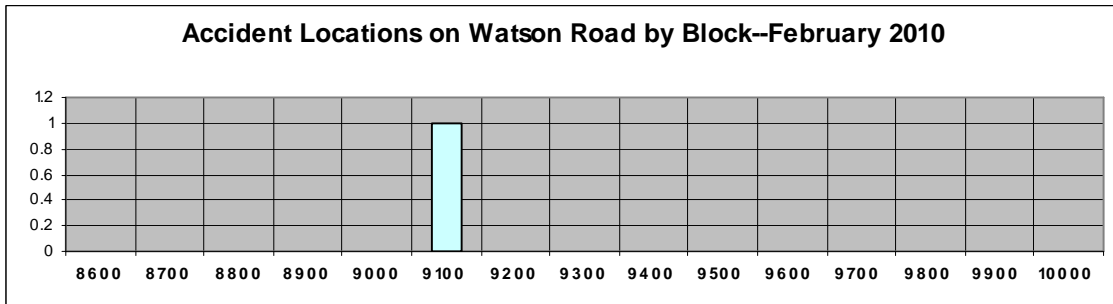

Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



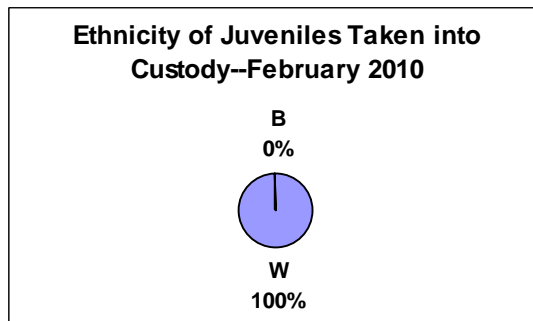
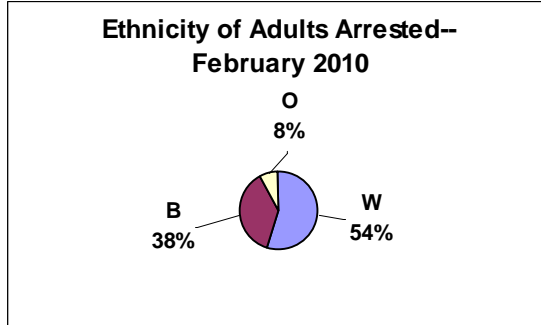

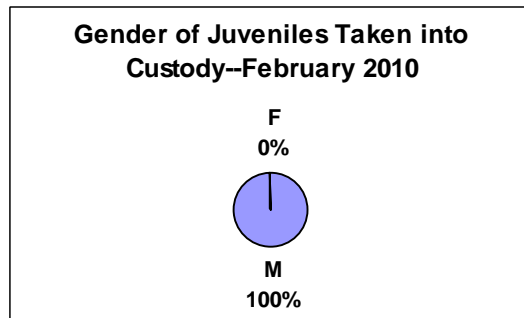
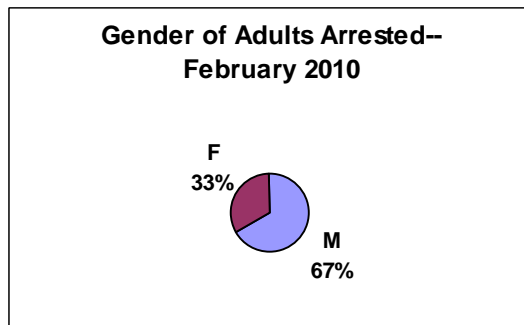
**Arrest Information:**

Thirty-nine adults and three juveniles were taken into custody in February 2010. Nine persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

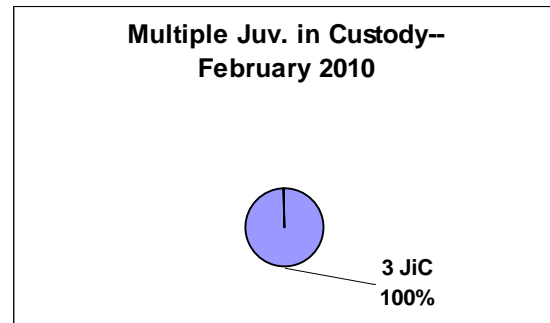
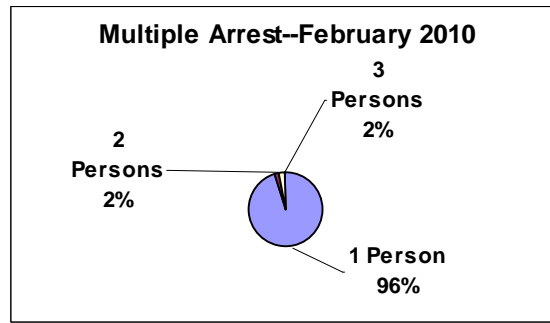
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



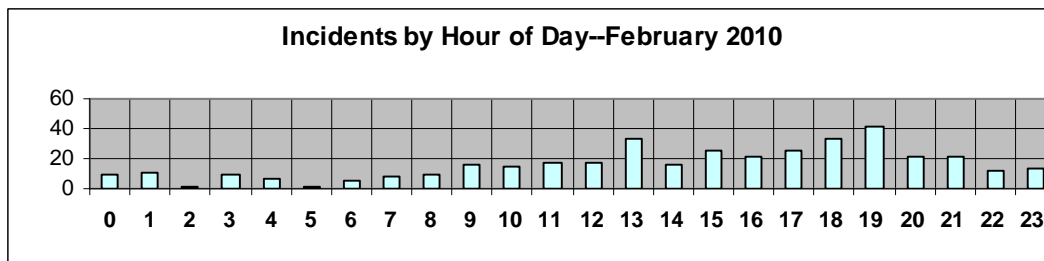
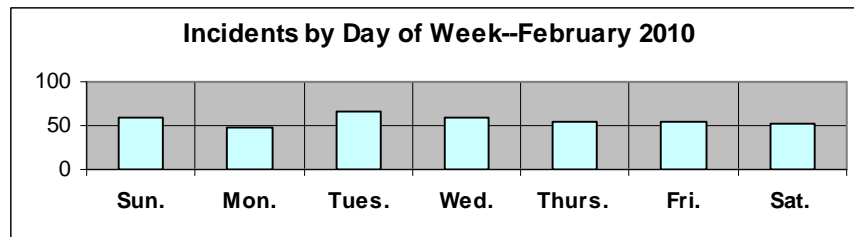
**Multiple Arrests:**



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

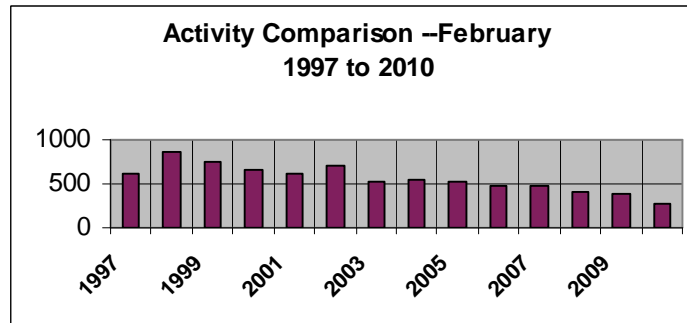
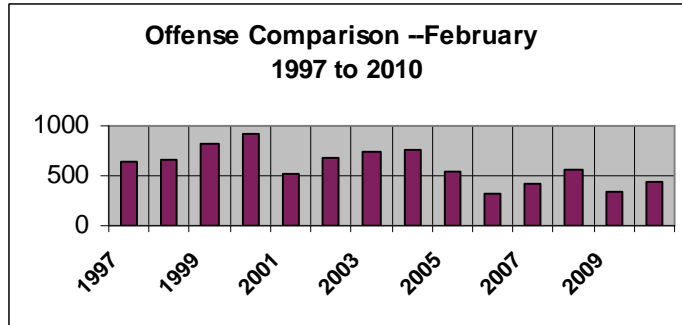

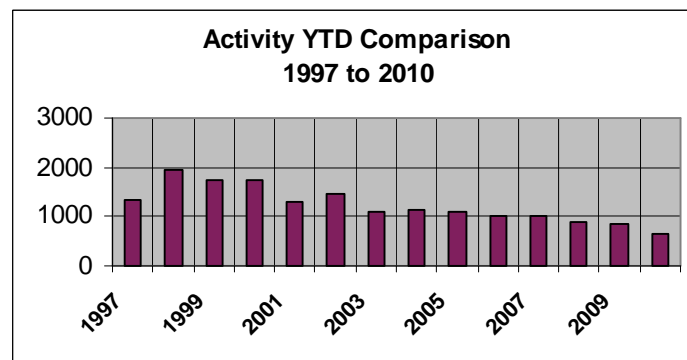
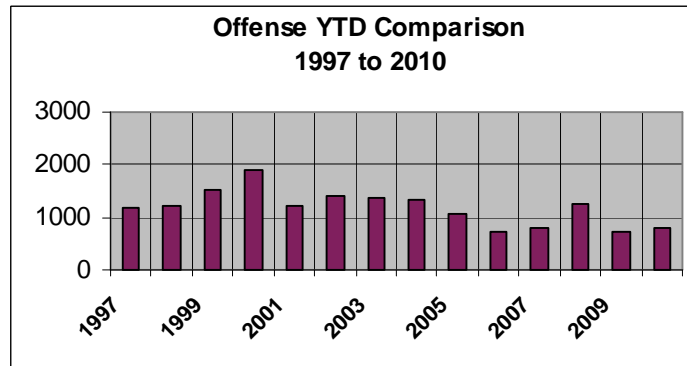


**Offense and Activity Comparison:**

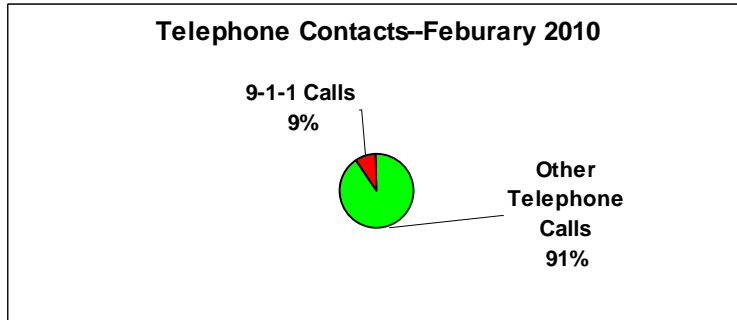


Years to Date:

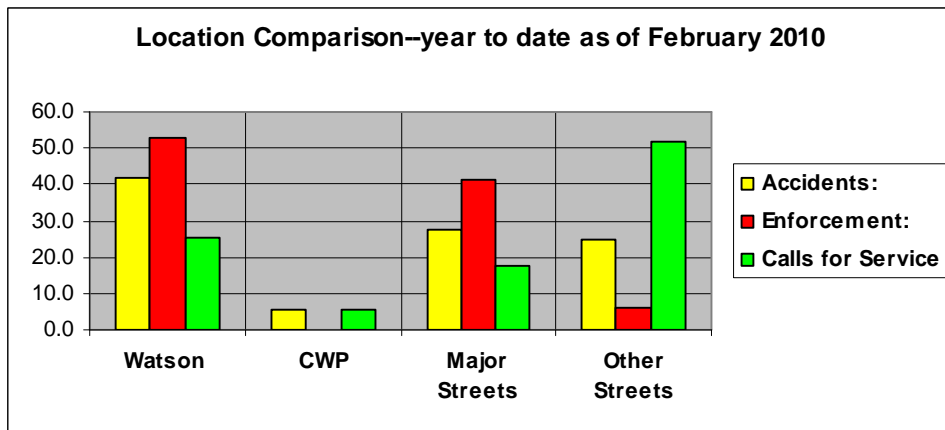


**Location Comparison:**

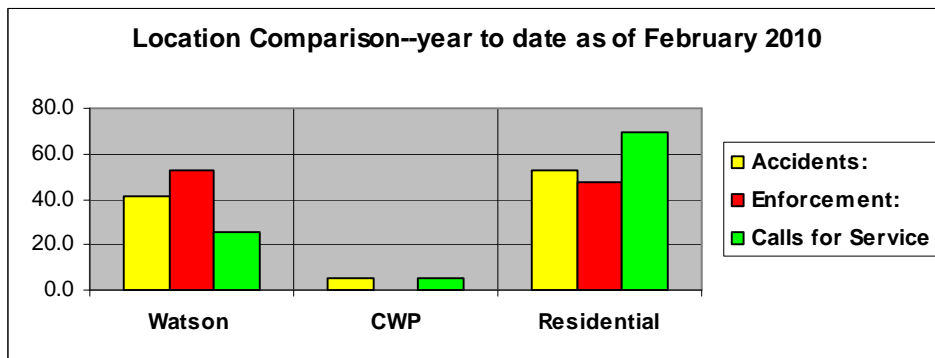
