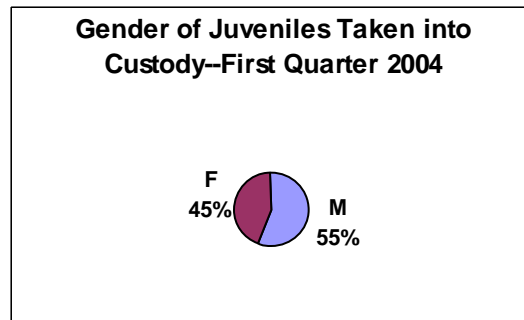
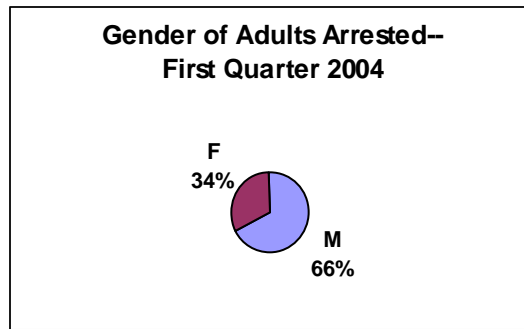


Arrest and Juvenile Data:

In the first quarter, there were 243 adults and 71 juveniles were taken into custody. The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

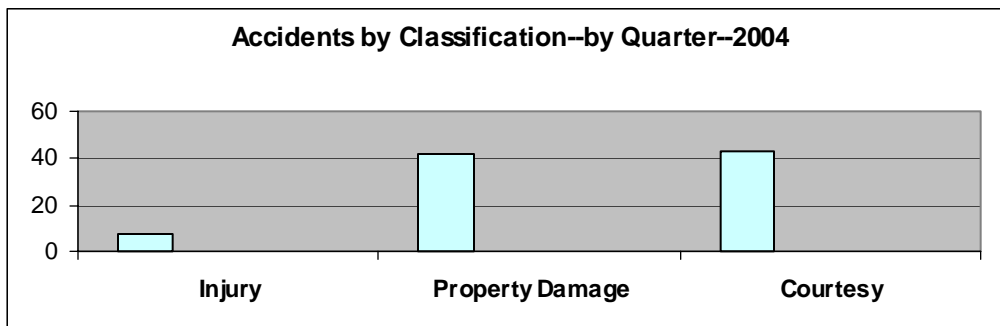

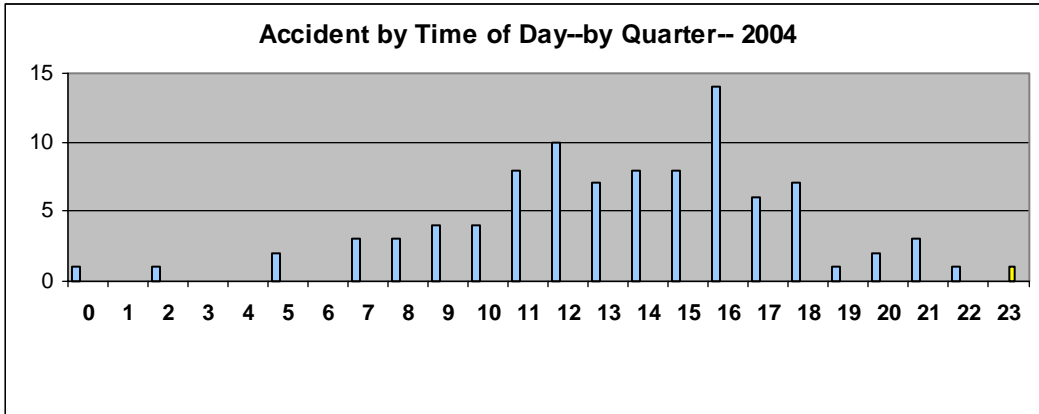

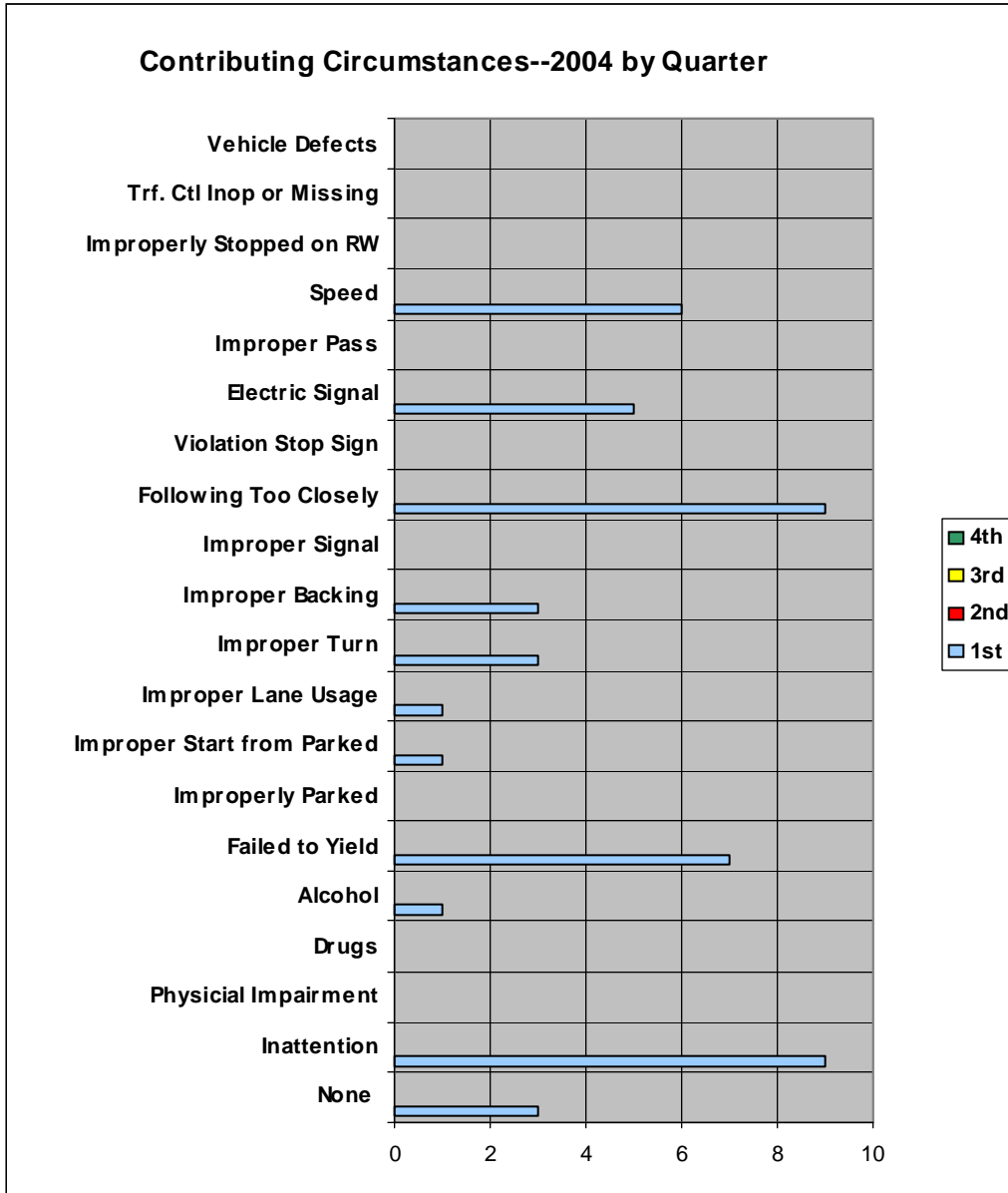


Accidents by Blocks on Watson Road:



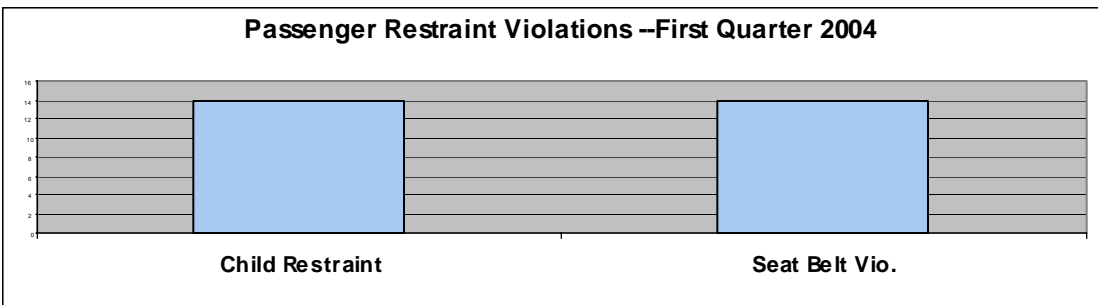
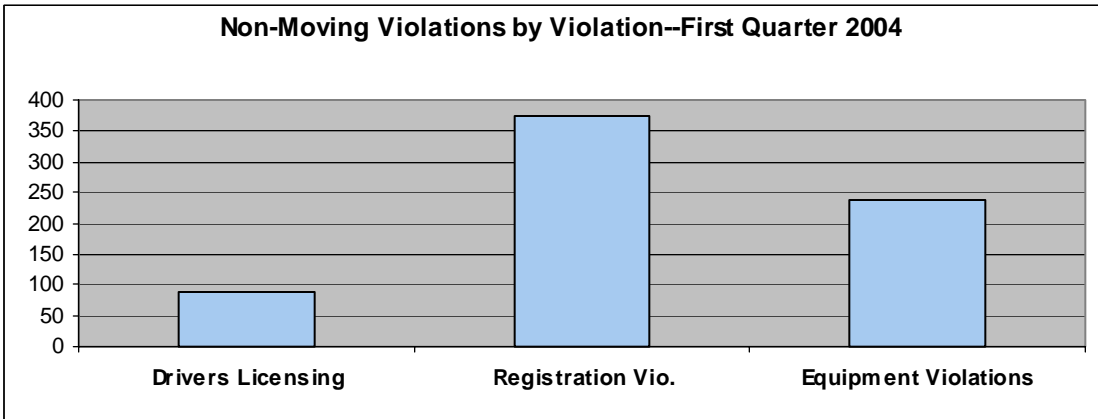
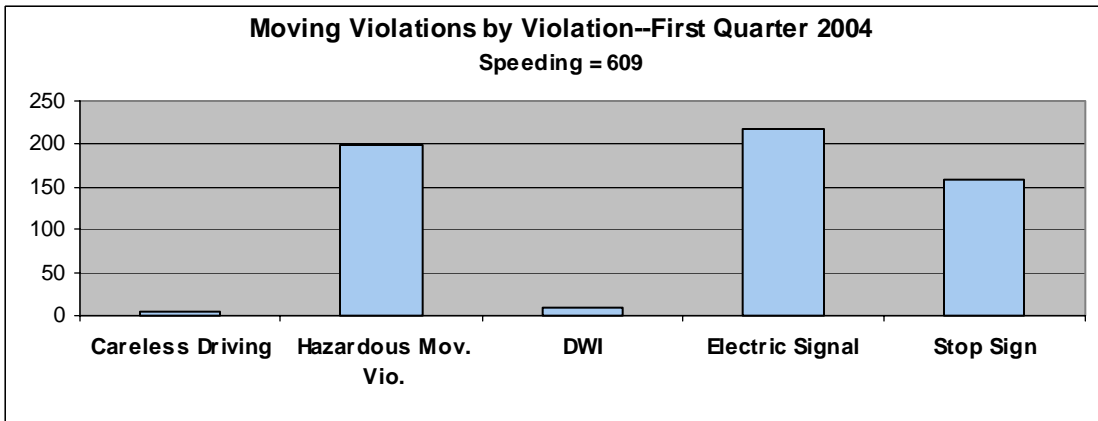
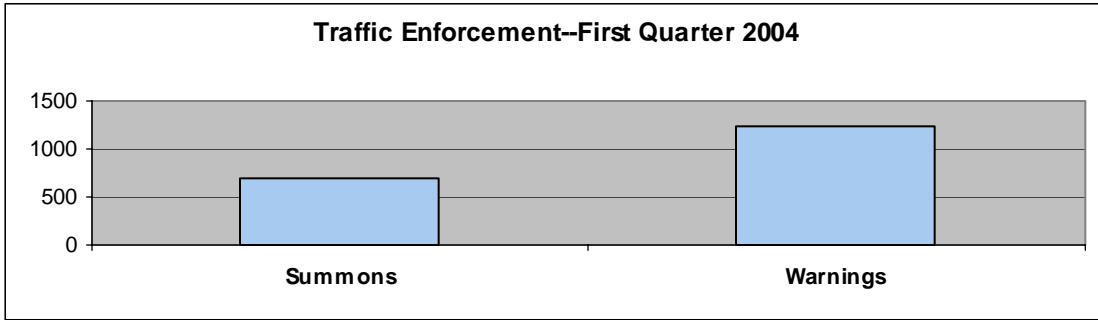

There were 1925 traffic enforcement actions taken in the first quarter. These actions were divided as follows:

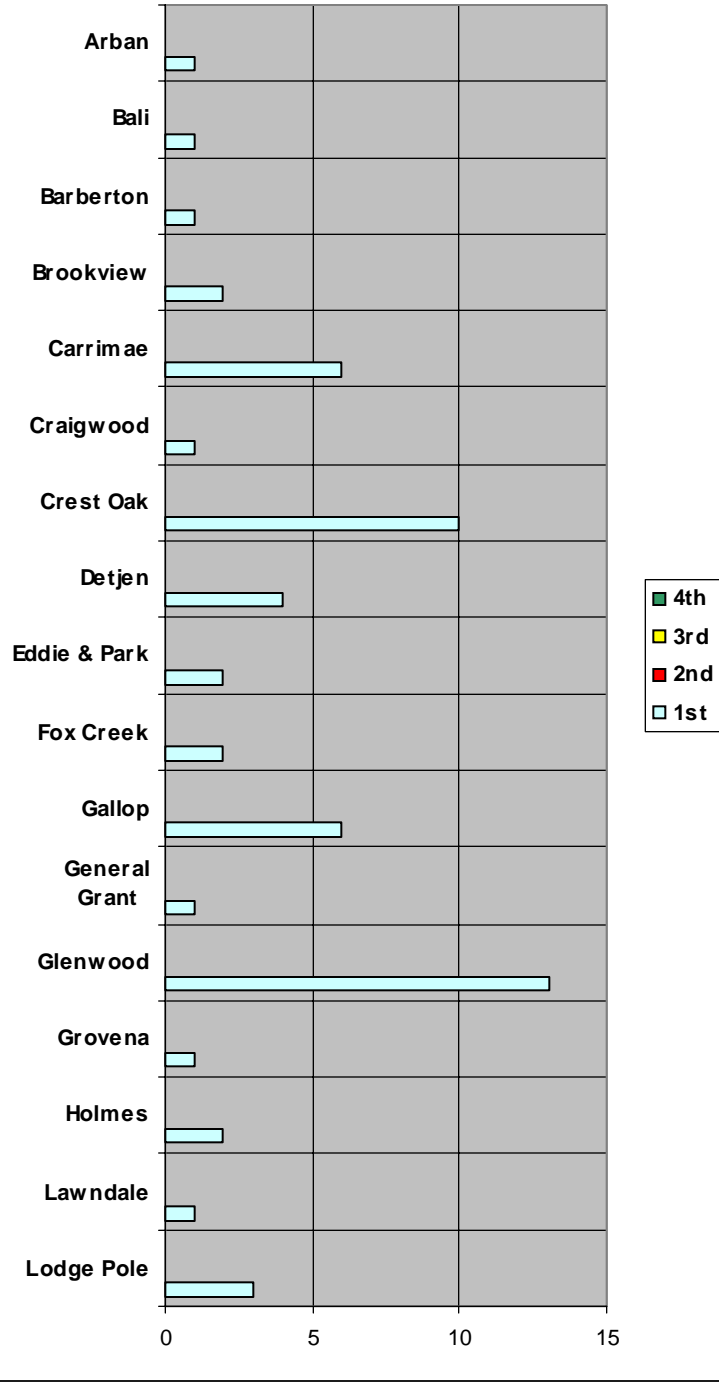

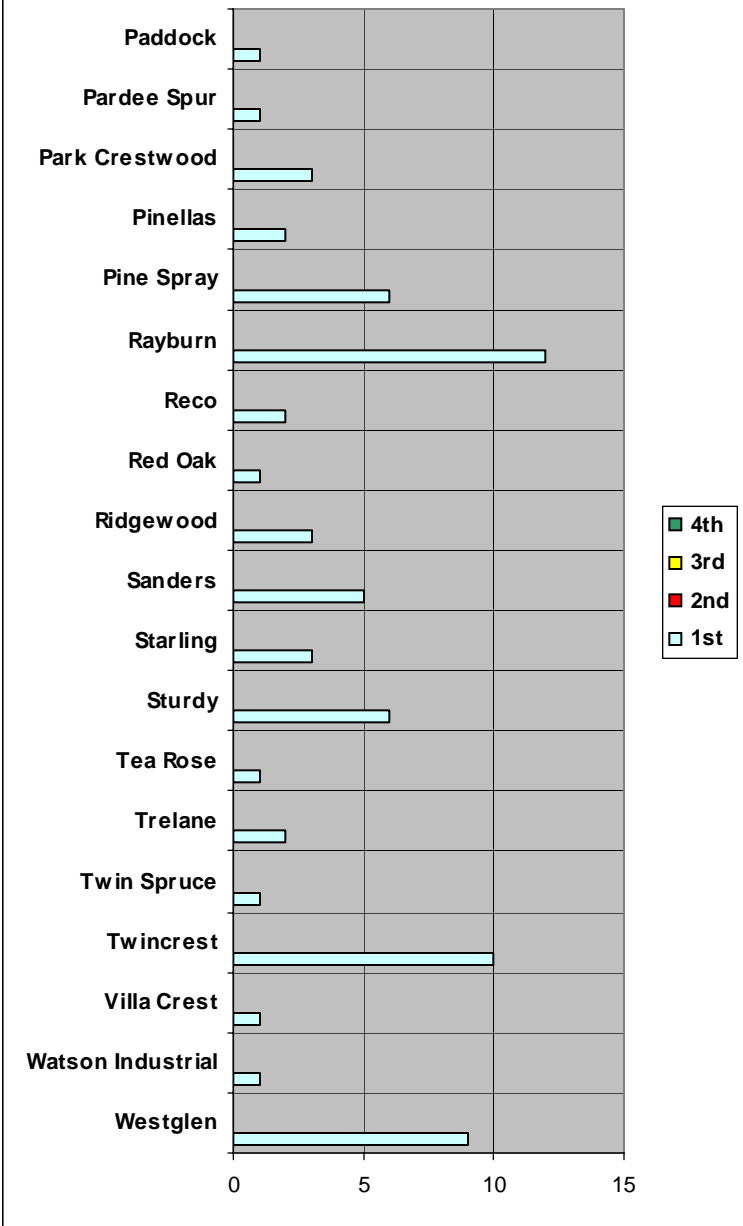

Traffic Enforcement on Other Streets: A to M-- 2004

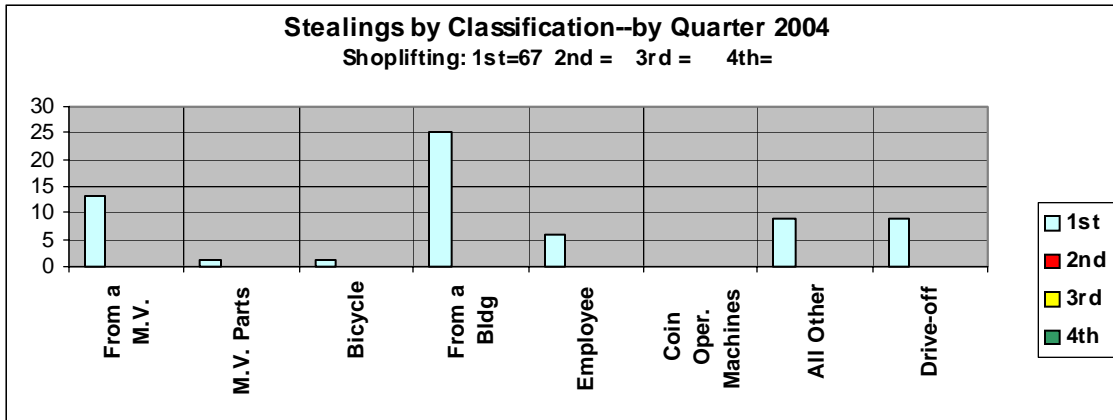


Traffic Enforcement on Other Streets: N to Z -- 2004



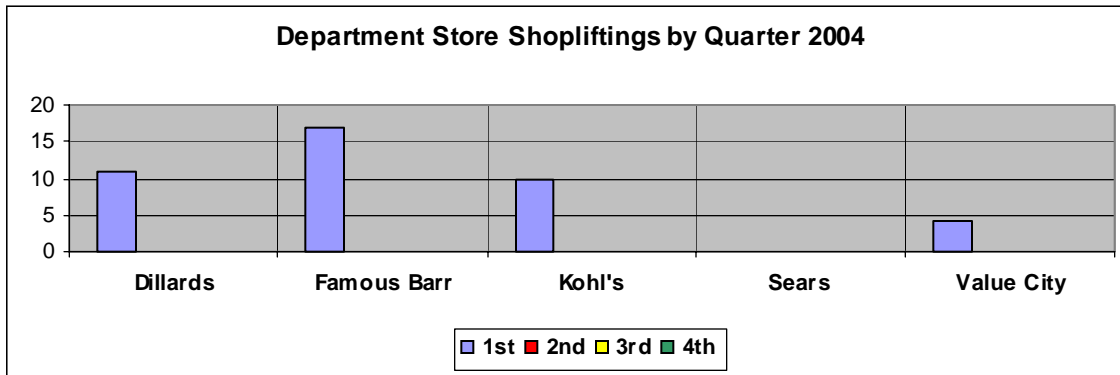
Stealings:

There were 131 stealings in the first quarter. These stealings were of the following classifications:



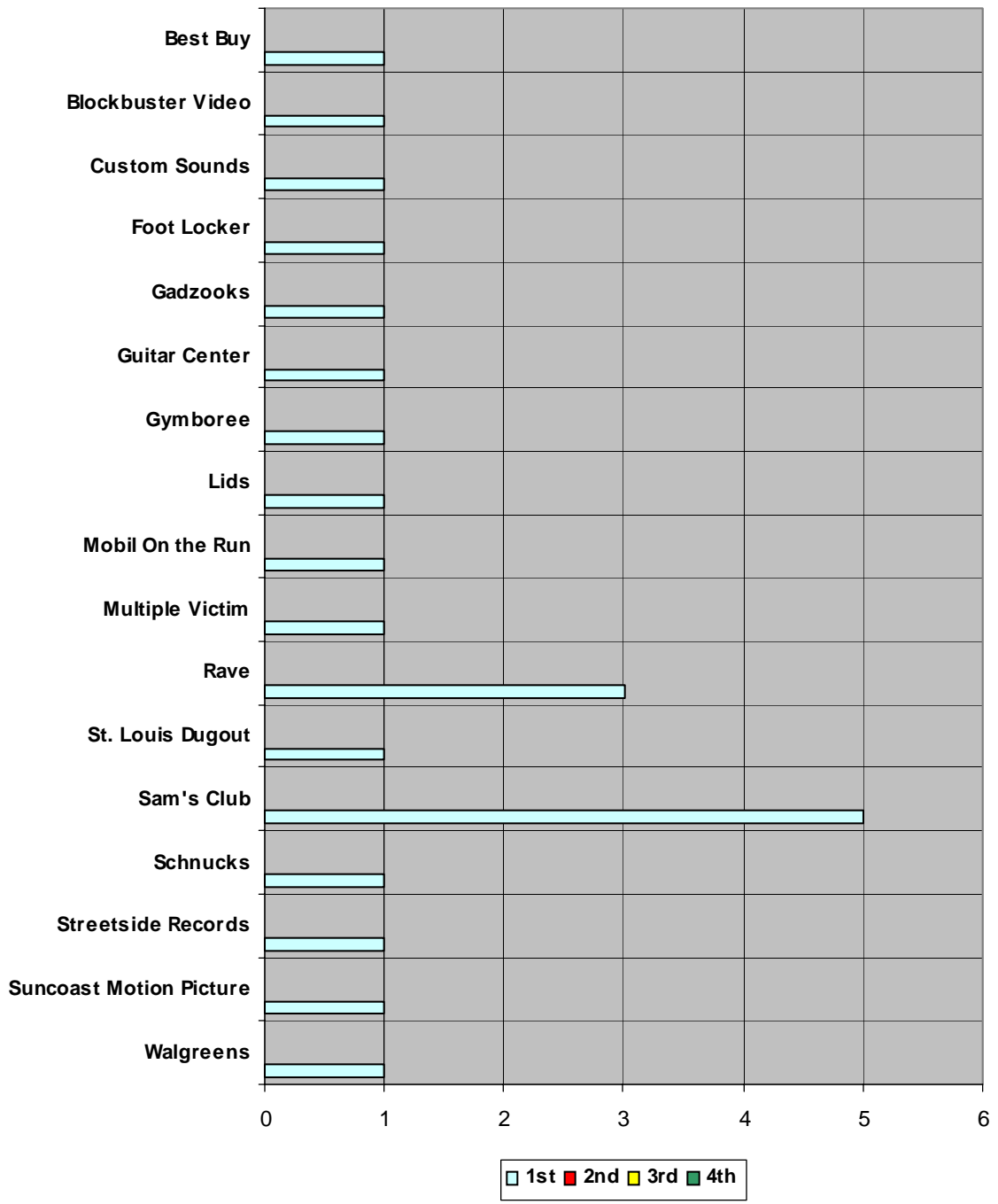
Shopliftings:

There were 67 shopliftings reported in the first quarter. This was 55% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:



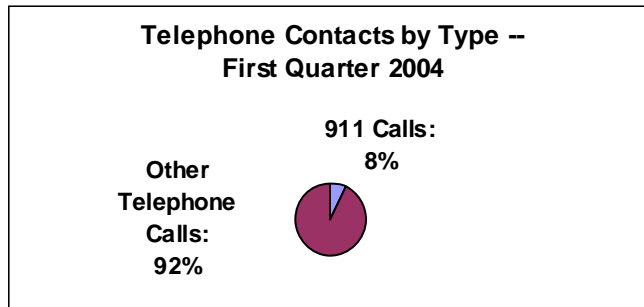
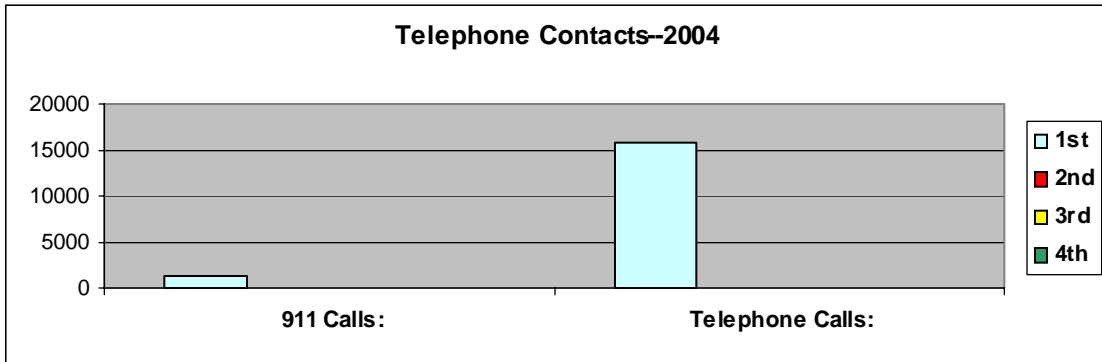
Sixty-three percent of the shopliftings occurred at the Department Stores. The remaining 37% occurred at the other stores and are displayed on the next page:

Shopliftings Other Than Dept. Stores--by Quarter 2004



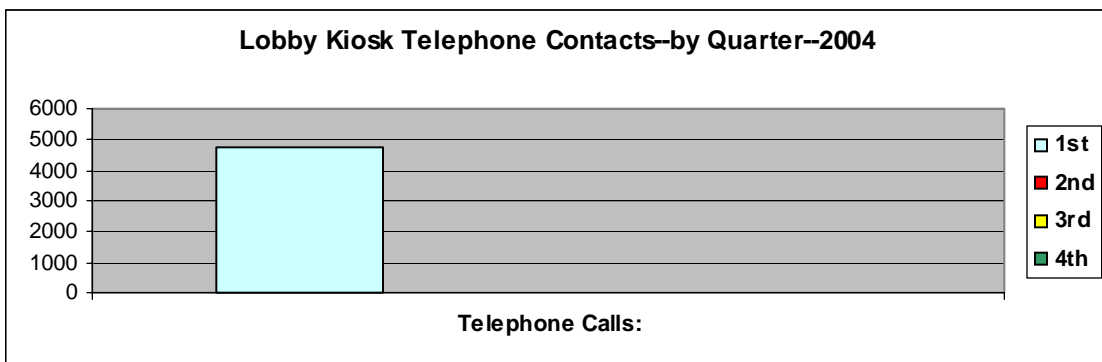
Communications:

In the first quarter, Communications handled 15829 telephone contacts and 1396 9-1-1 calls. This is a daily average of 174 telephone contacts and fifteen 9-1-1 calls.



Lobby Kiosk:

The lobby kiosk at the Government Center started on 02-07-03 to provide a high level of service to the public calling the Government Center and walking into the lobby. The first quarter is the fourth full quarter of operation. In the first quarter, the kiosk handled 4775 telephone contacts during the 63 business days in the quarter. This is a daily average of 76 telephone contacts.
