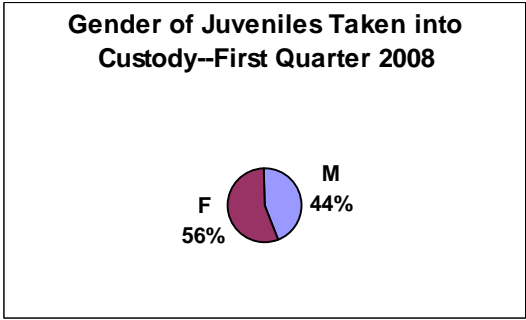
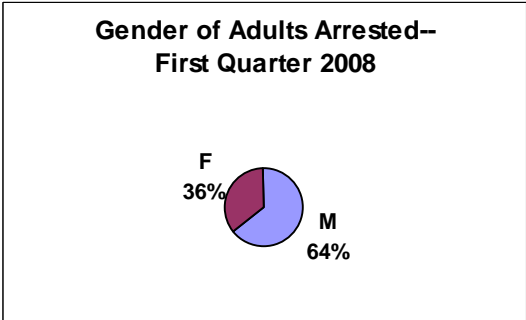
One hundred eighty-seven adults and thirty-two juveniles were taken into custody in the First Quarter. Fourteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrest.

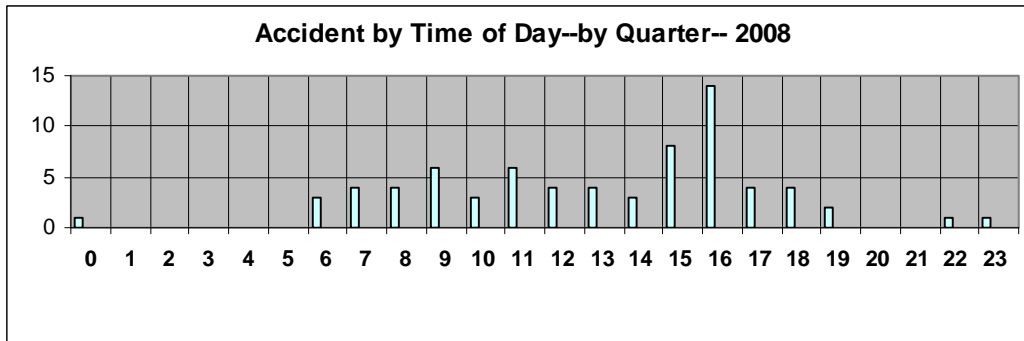

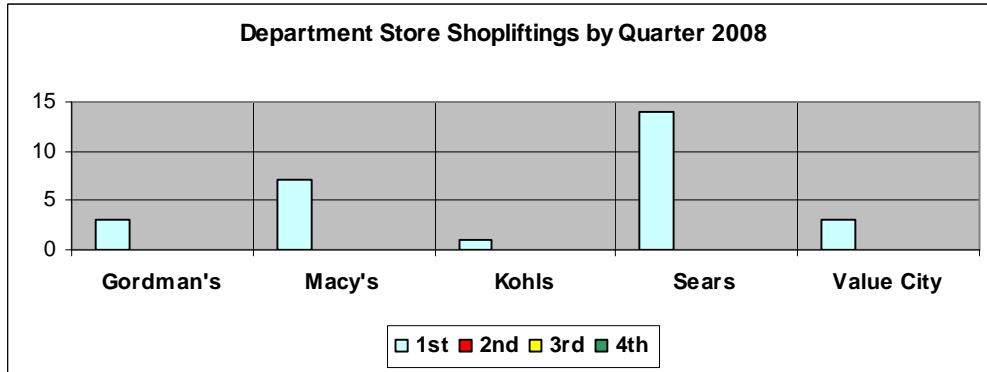
Stealings:
