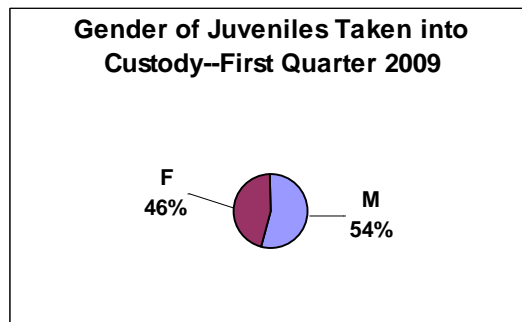
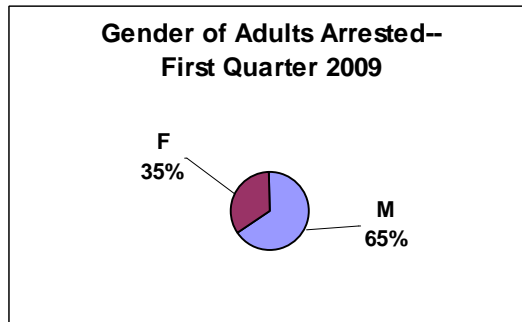
**Arrest and Juvenile Data:**

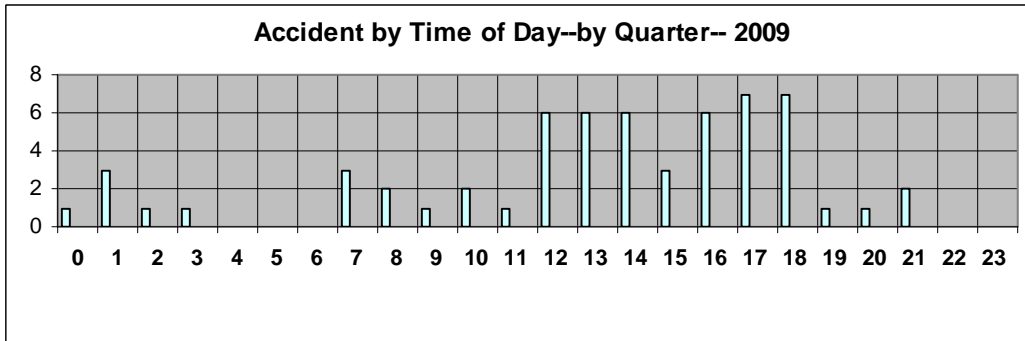

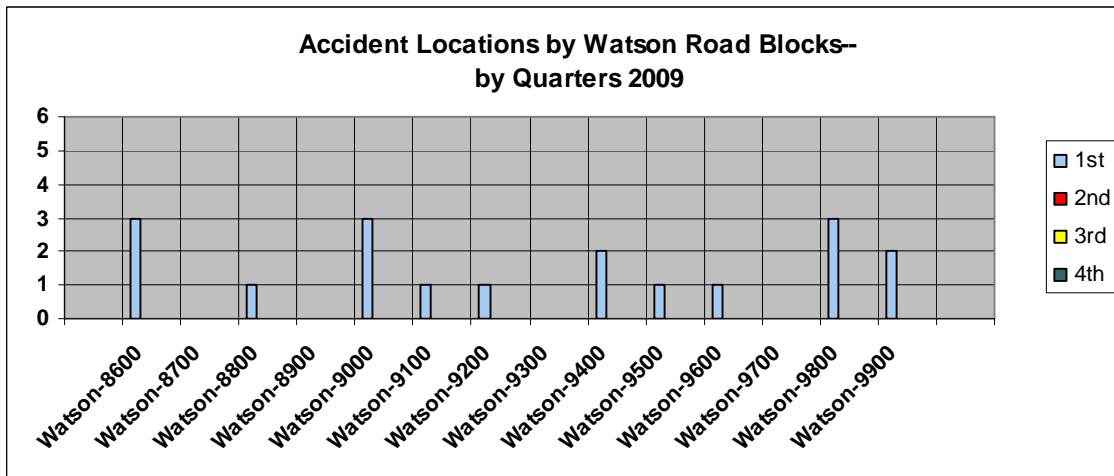

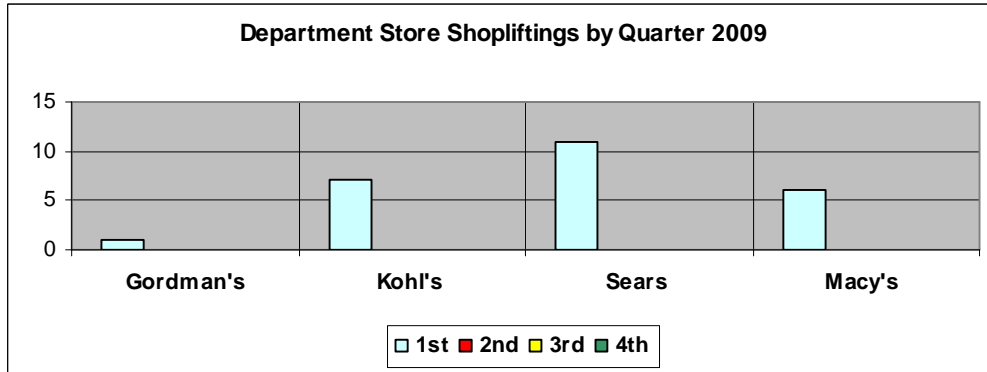
**Stealings:**
