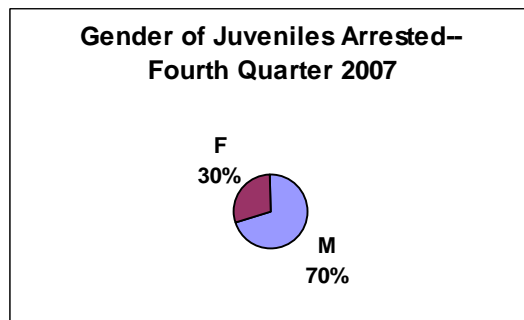
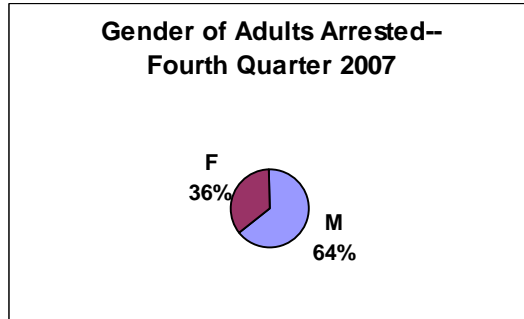
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

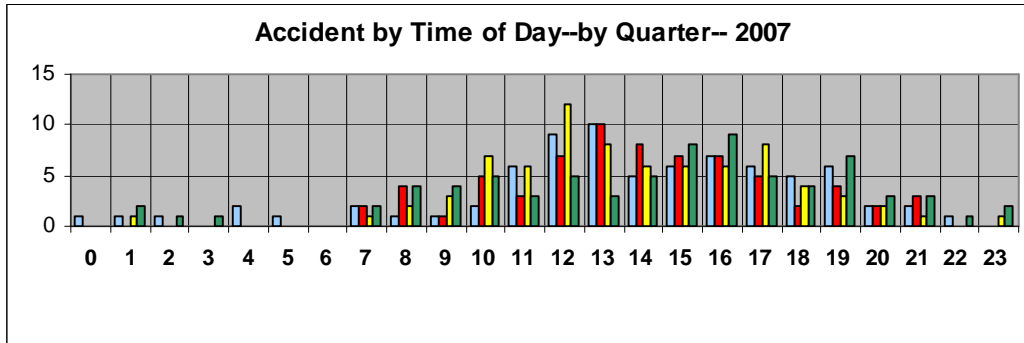

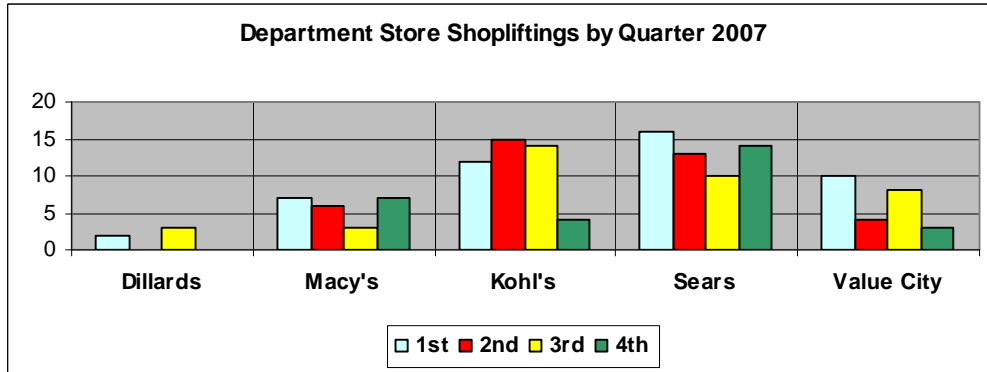
Stealings:

Communications:
