Topic: January 2010 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of January 2010. In January 2010, there were 42 Part I offenses and 329 Part II offenses for a total of 371. This compares with 45 Part I offenses and 335 Part II offenses for a total of 380 in January 2009.

The two sexual offenses both involved minor family members and the investigation is continuing on both.

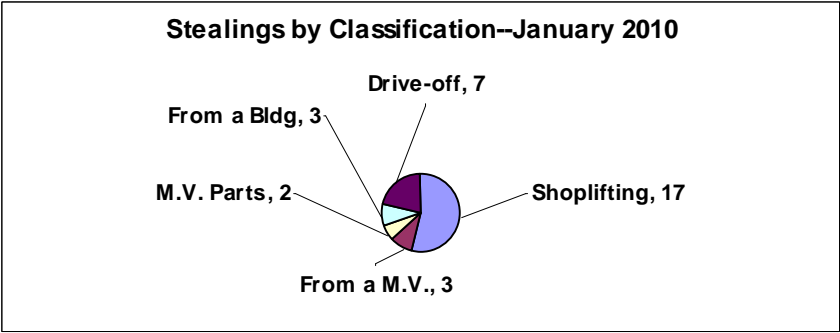
The robbery was reported on 01-16-2010 at an ATM at a bank on Watson Road. The victim had completed her transaction and suddenly an arm reached into her vehicle and attempted to grab her purse. The victim pulled away and called her father, who called the Police. There was no description of the suspect.

There were three assaults in January 2010 and two involved domestic violence. In two cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

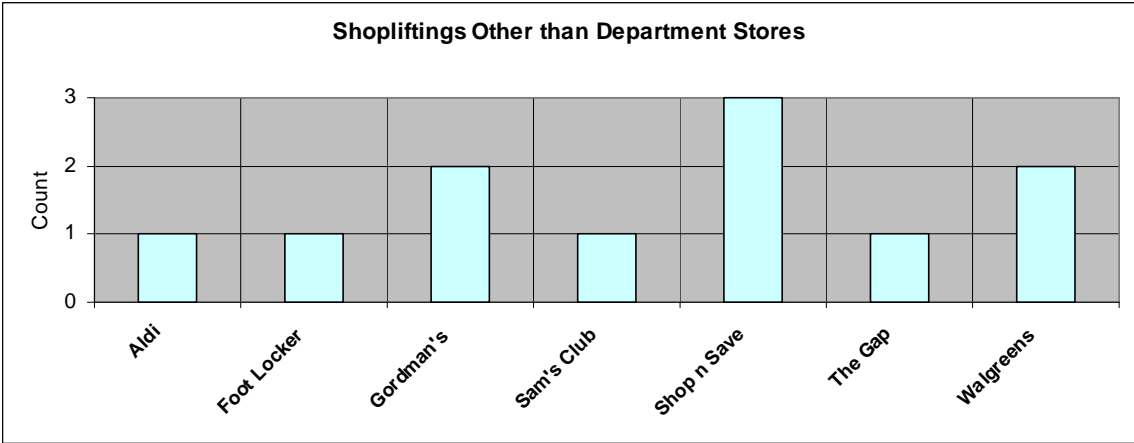
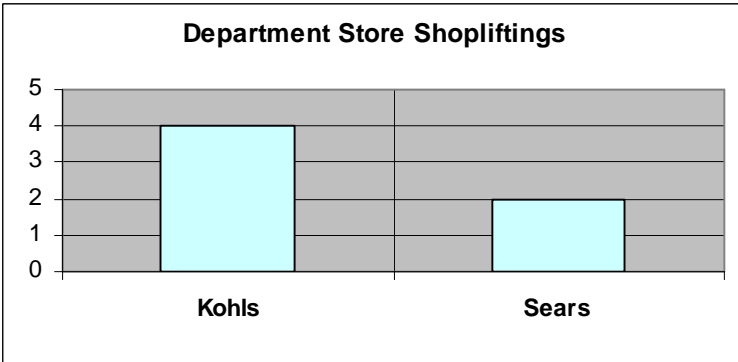
There were two burglaries reported in January. The first was reported on 01-15-2010 on Watson Industrial. Someone attempted to force open the door on a business overnight but did not gain entry. The second burglary was to a residence on Maple Grove and was reported on 01-17-2010. Someone entered an unlocked door and removed some jewelry and two game stations.

Stealing offenses numbered 32 in January 2010.

Stealings were of the following classifications in January 2010:

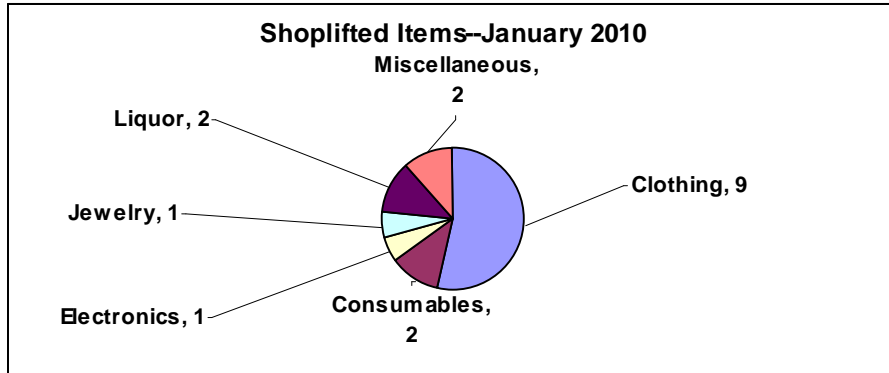


Shopliftings accounted for 17 of the 32 stealings in January 2010 or 53%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in January 2010:

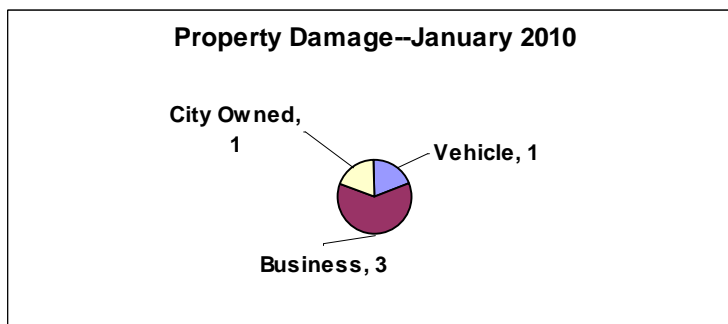


Of the shopliftings, 59% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 70%, adults and juveniles accounted for 20% and juveniles accounted for 10% of the clearances.

There were five property damages in January 2010 and they were of the following classifications:



Part I offenses numbered 42 in January 2010.

Part II:

In January 2010, there were nine frauds reported including four fraud involving credit cards, two identity thefts, two passing bad checks and one counterfeiting. The one drug case involved a small quantity of marijuana. The two offenses against public peace were both harassments. There were two DWI cases, 84 people related calls including 83 medical emergencies and one sudden death and 5 animal calls. The one juvenile offense was a minor in possession of alcohol.

Part II offenses totaled 318 in January 2010.

In January 2010 in Ward One, there was one burglary reported at a business on Watson Industrial. Stealings numbered five with three at addresses on Watson Road, one in an apartment complex and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one at an address along Watson Road. There were three frauds reported and one offense against public peace. There were nine traffic accidents, 28 people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on five different streets and there were 48 miscellaneous police service calls.

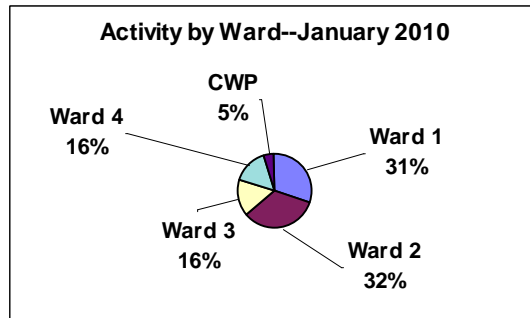
In Ward Two in January 2010, there was one robbery reported at an ATM at a bank on Watson Road. Stealings numbered nineteen with fifteen at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and four in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two both at addresses along Watson Road or in Watson Plaza. There were four frauds and one juvenile related offense. There was one DWI, one traffic accidents, twelve people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on three different streets and there were 74 calls for miscellaneous police services.

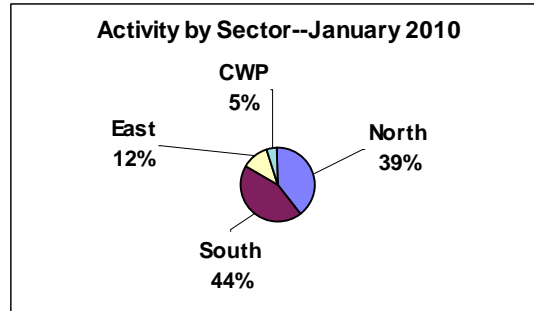
In January 2010 in Ward Three, stealings numbered four with four at addresses on Watson Road and property damages numbered one in Whitecliff Park. There was one fraud and one offense against public peace. There was one DWI case, three traffic accidents and 23 people related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered three and occurred on three different streets and there were 23 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in January 2010, there was one burglary reported on Maple Grove and there were no stealings in Ward Four in January and property damages numbered one. There was one fraud and one drug offense. There were two traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered three and occurred on three different streets and there were 25 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered four with four shopliftings. There were two traffic accidents and two people related calls. There were no suspicious activity calls and there were four police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

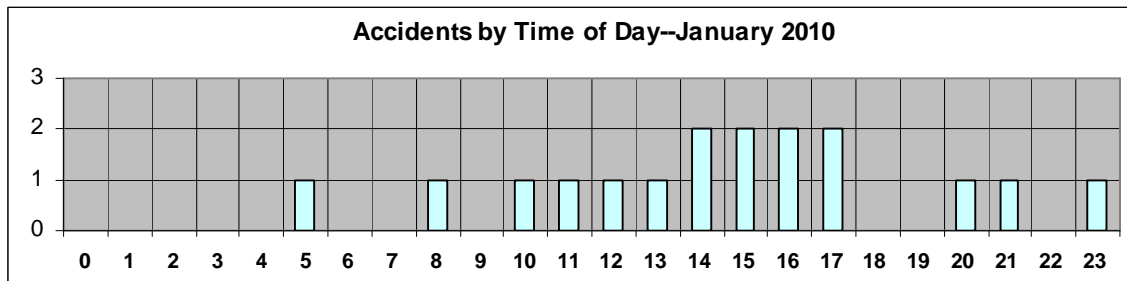

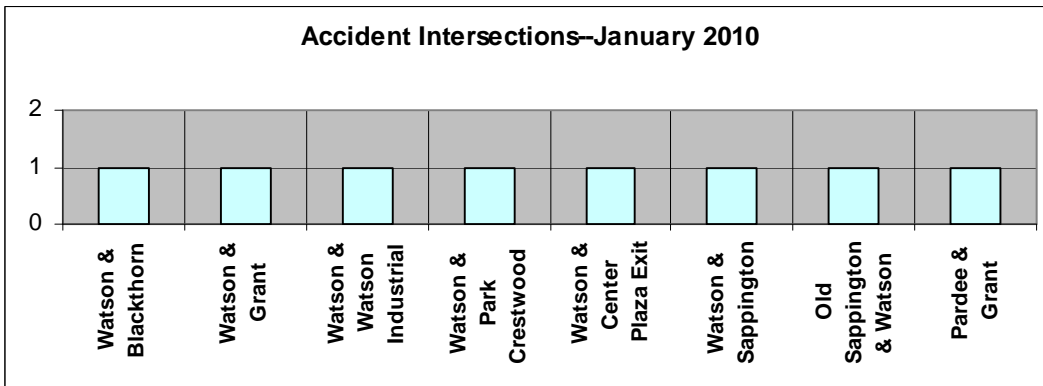
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



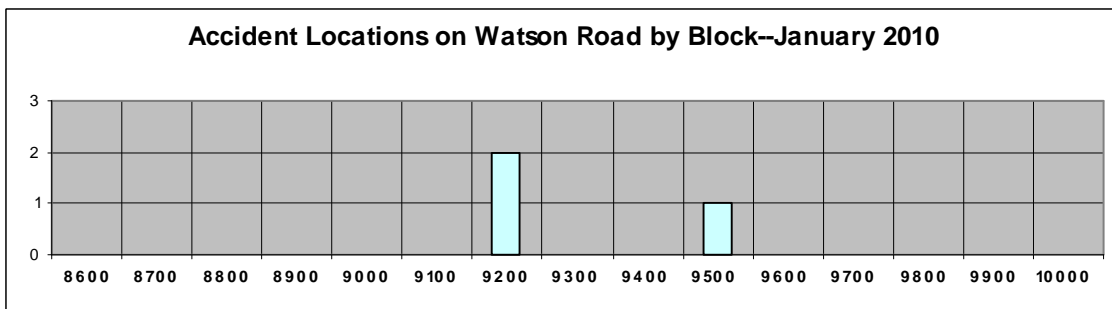

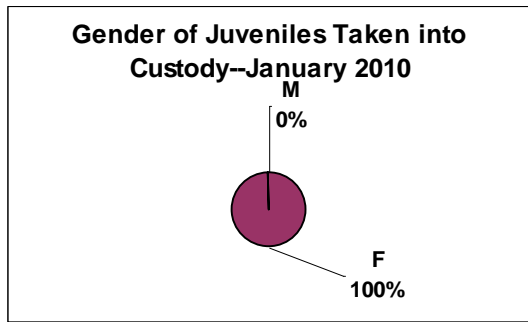
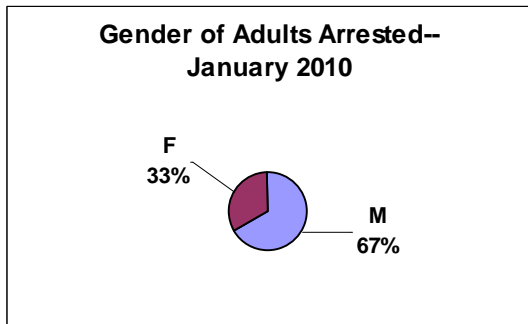
Sixty-nine adults and seven juveniles were taken into custody in January 2010. Thirty persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

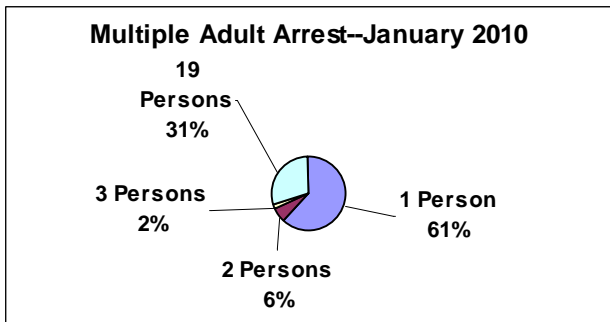


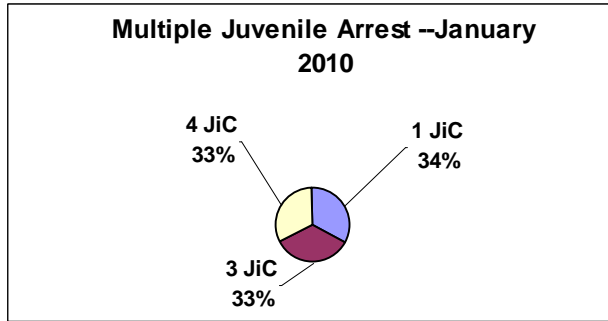


The gender of the persons taken into custody was:

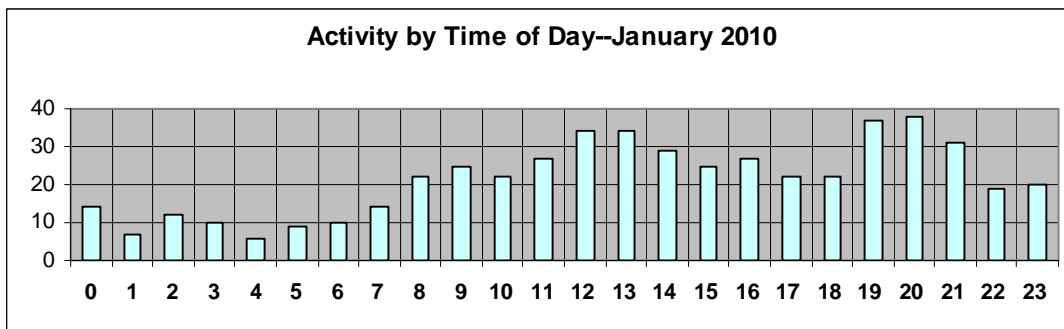
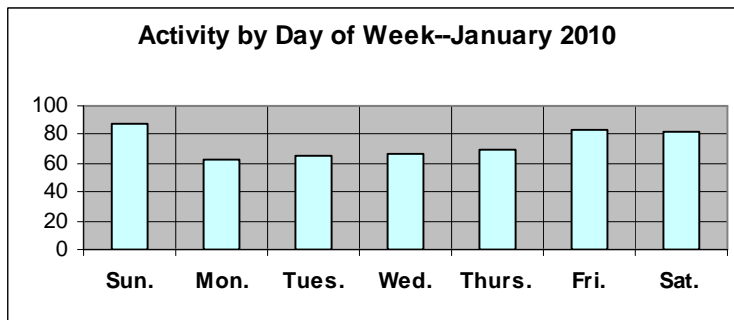




Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

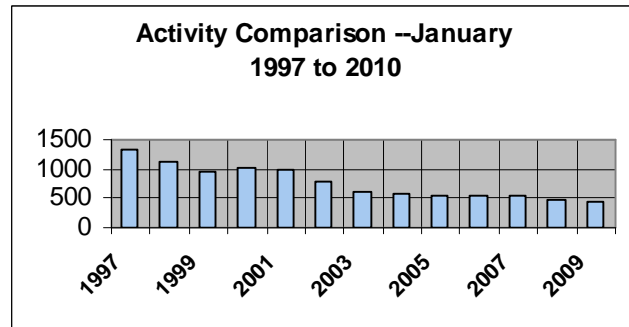
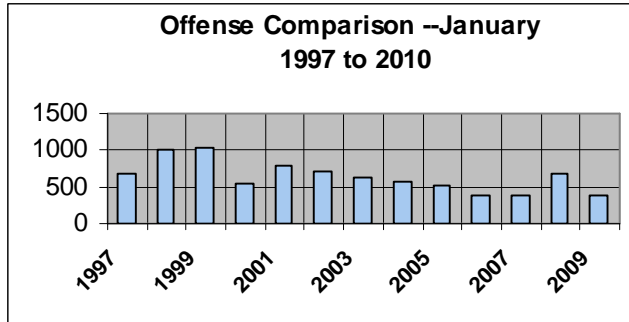

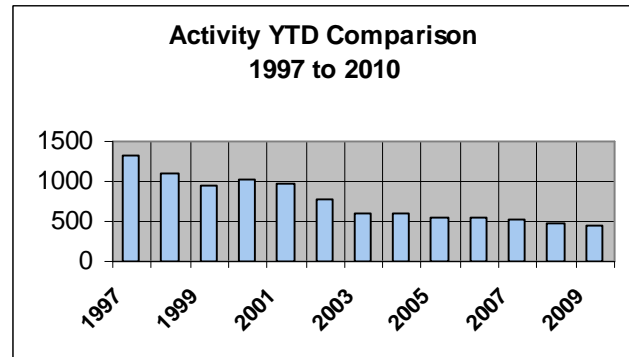
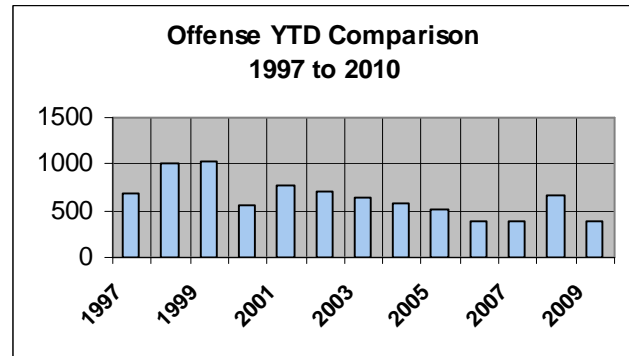


Offense and Activity Comparison:

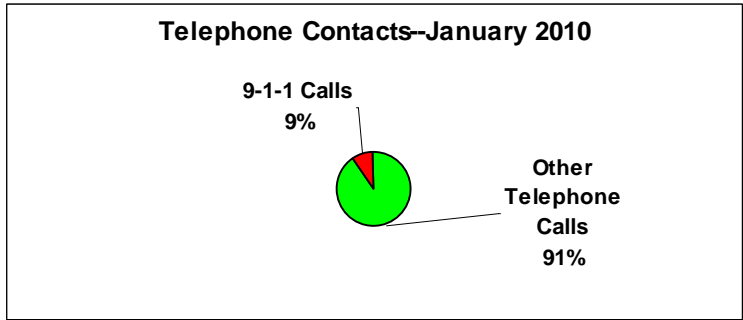


Years to Date:

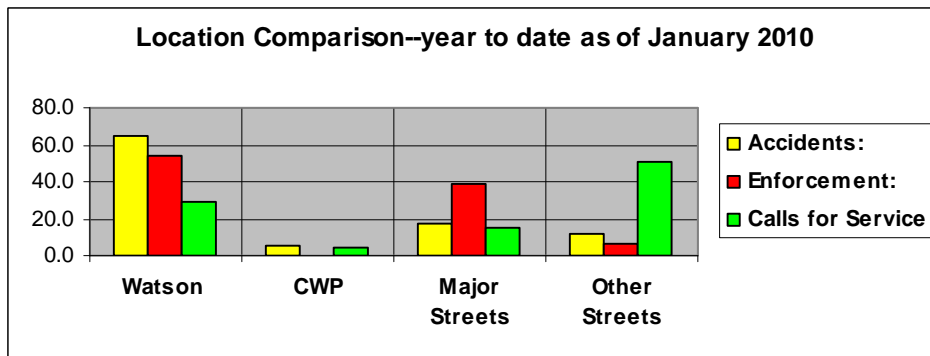


Location Comparison:

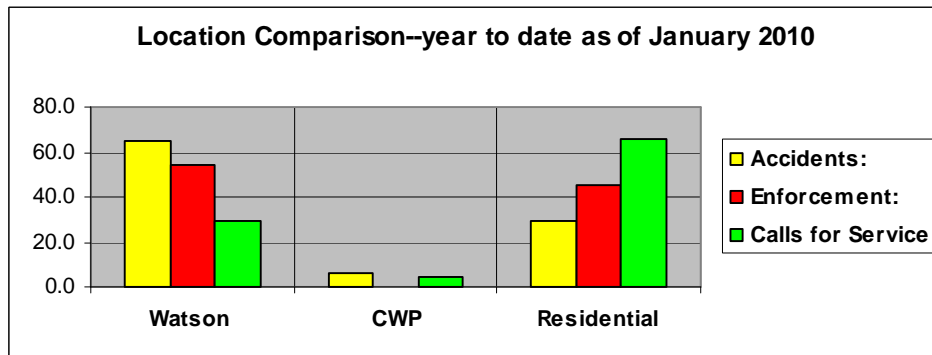
