Topic: July 2008 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of July 2008. In July 2008, there were 78 Part I offenses and 474 Part II offenses for a total of 552. This compares with 83 Part I offenses and 428 Part II offenses for a total of 511 in July 2007. The main difference was in the number of stealings and traffic stops.

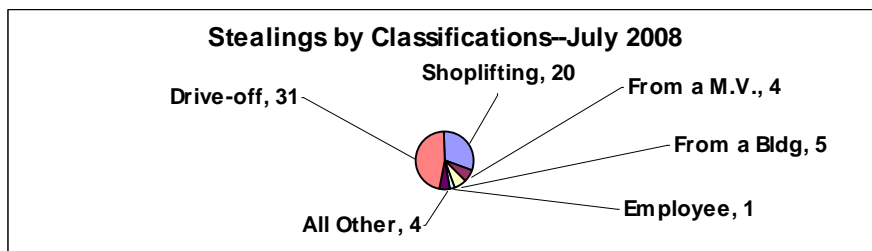
There was one sexual offense reported in July. Two girls had a lemonade stand on Old Sappington and Lodge Pole. A male drove up to the stand and when one of the girls went to see if the male wanted lemonade, the male was exposing himself to the girl. The male then drove east on Lodge Pole and the girl went home and reported the incident to her mother.

There were five assaults in July 2008 and four involved domestic violence. In four cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

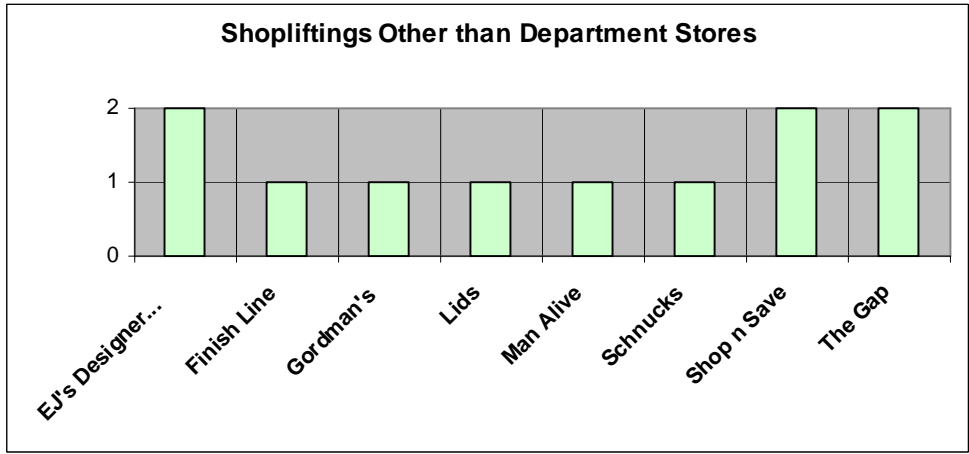
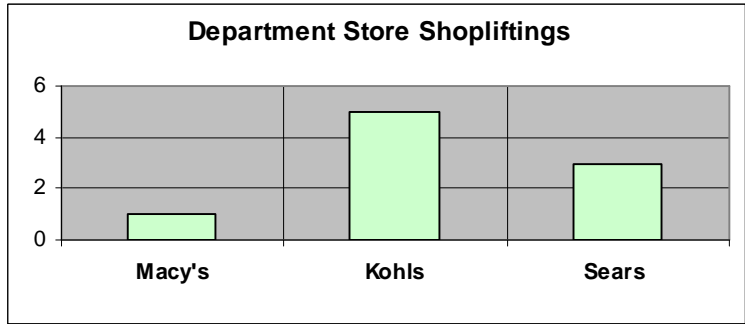
There was one burglary reported in July. On 07-09-2008, the victim on Tea Rose reported that a set of golf clubs were taken from the garage of the residence. There were no signs of forced entry.

Stealing offenses numbered 65 in July 2008.

Stealings were of the following classifications in July 2008:

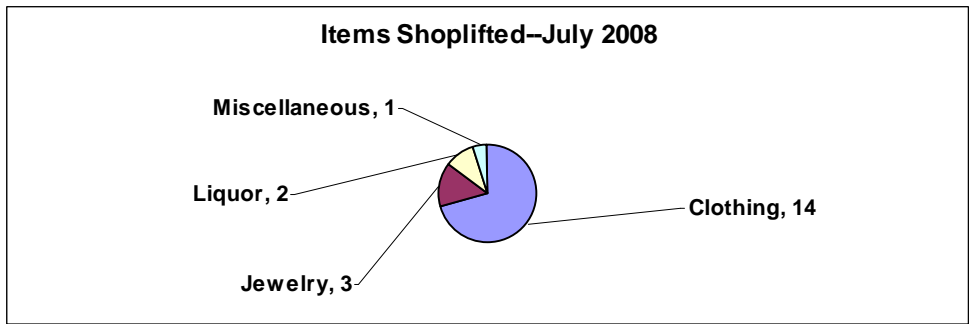


Shopliftings accounted for 20 of the 65 stealings in July 2008 or 31%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in July 2008:

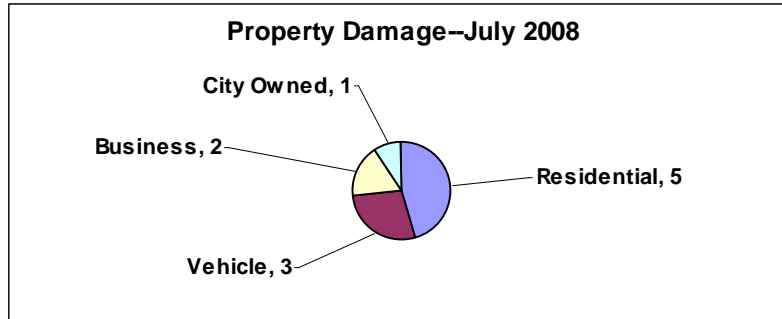


Of the shopliftings, 60% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 59%, adults and juveniles accounted for 8% and juveniles accounted for 33% of the clearances.

There were eleven property damages in July 2008 and they were of the following classifications:



The City-Owned property that was damaged was a toilet in the men's restroom in Whitecliff Park that may have been damaged by some type of fireworks.

There was one receiving stolen property involved stolen license plate tabs that had been stolen from St. Charles.

Part I offenses numbered 78 in July 2008.

**Part II:**

In July 2008, there were nine frauds reported, three frauds, two forgeries, two credit card frauds and two passing bad checks. The three offenses against public peace were one peace disturbance, one harassment and one trespassing. All 67 people related calls were medical emergencies.

In July 2008 in Ward One, there was one sexual offense, an exposing person and stealings numbered eight with four at addresses on Watson Road, one on Watson Industrial and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two, one at addresses along Watson Road and one in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud, four traffic accidents, 21 people related calls and one animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered sixteen and occurred on six different streets and there were 50 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Two in July 2008, stealings numbered 31 with 30 at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered four, one at addresses along Watson Road and Big Bend and three in the neighborhoods. There were five frauds reported, one offense against public peace, thirteen traffic accidents, seventeen people related calls and six animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered sixteen and occurred on ten different streets and there were 75 calls for miscellaneous police services.

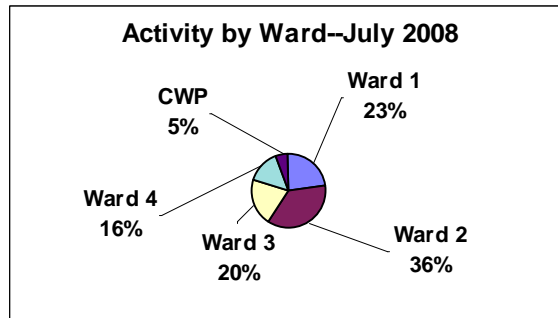
In July 2008 in Ward Three, stealings numbered fifteen with twelve at addresses on Watson Road, one in Whitecliff Park and two in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered three, one in Whitecliff Park and one in the neighborhoods. There was one fraud, one offense against public peace, three traffic accidents, eighteen people related calls and one animal related call.

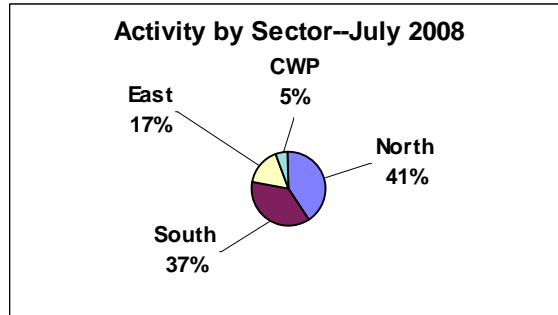
Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on five different streets and there were 48 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in July 2008, one burglary from a garage on Tea Rose and there was one stealing and one property damage. There was one fraud, one offense against public peace, three traffic accidents, eight people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered six and occurred on six different streets and there were 46 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered ten with nine shopliftings and one all other thefts. There was one fraud, three traffic accidents and three people related call. Suspicious activity calls numbered one and there were five police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

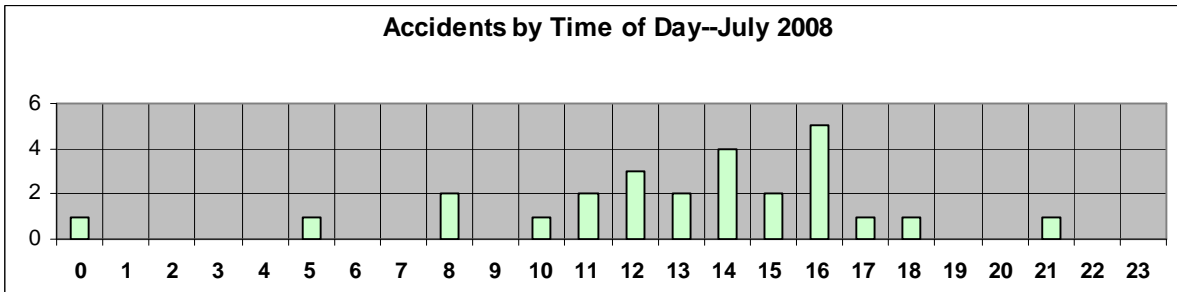

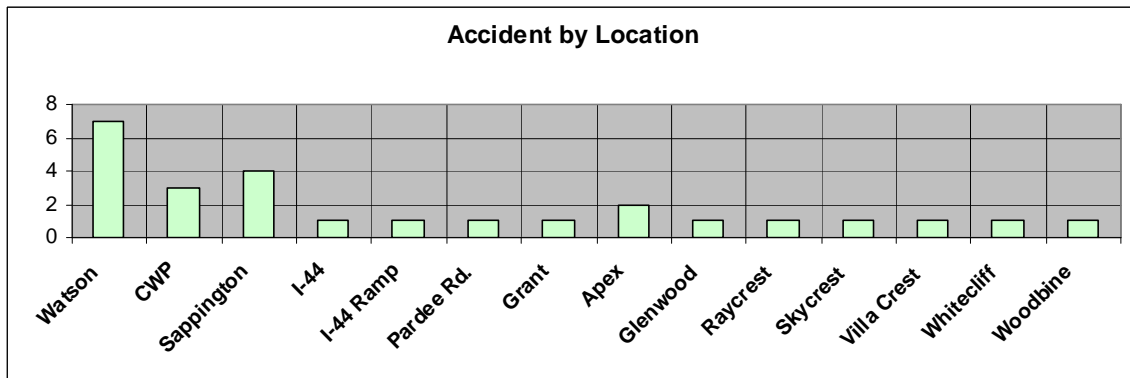
Accidents occurred on the following days of the week:



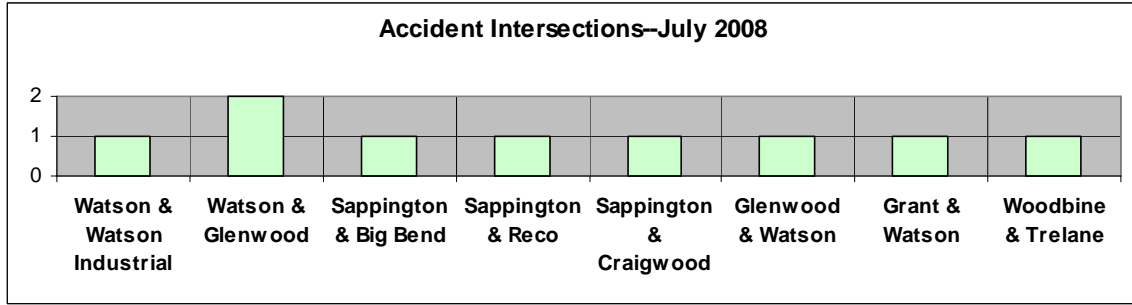
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



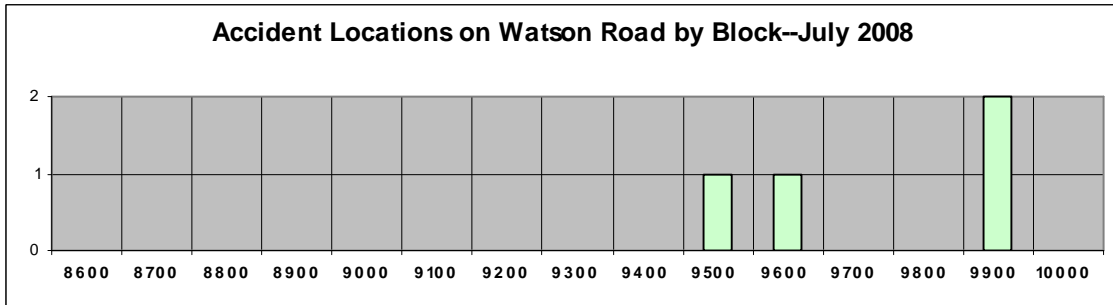

Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



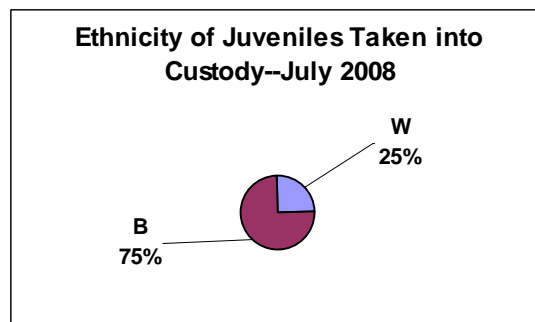
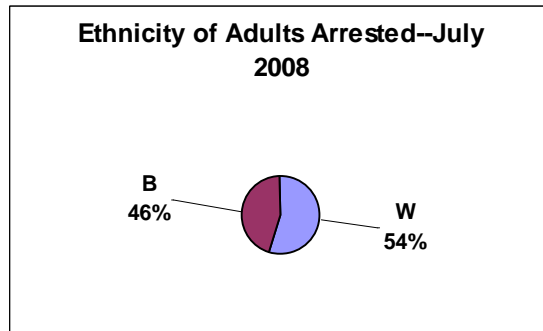

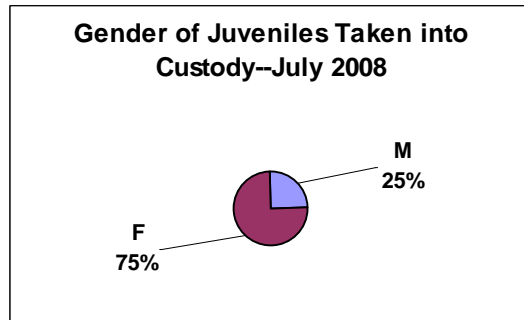
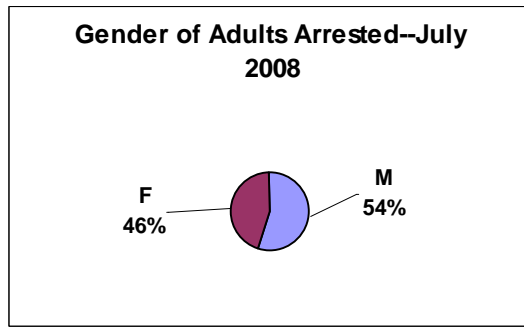
**Arrest Information:**

Fifty-two adults and twelve juveniles were taken into custody in July 2008. Sixteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

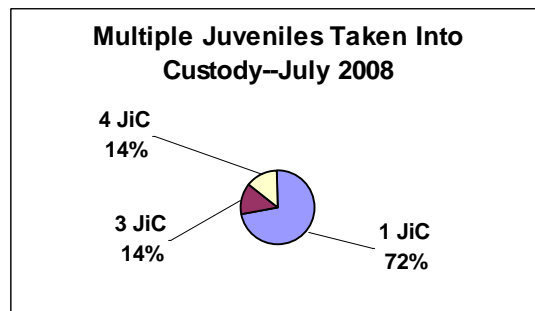
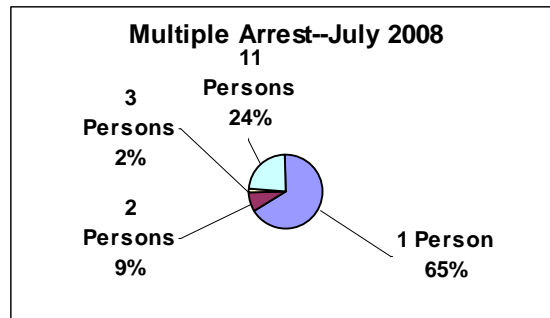
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



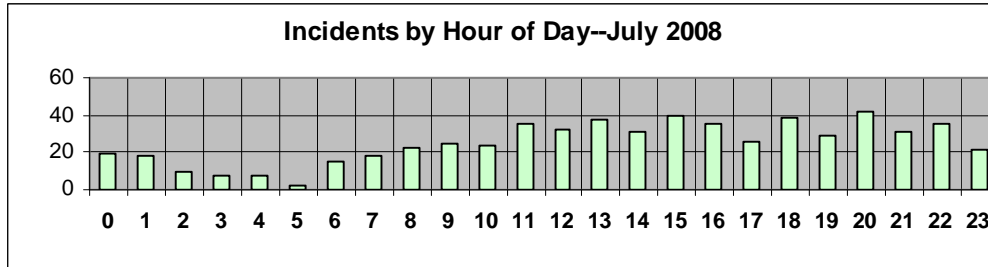
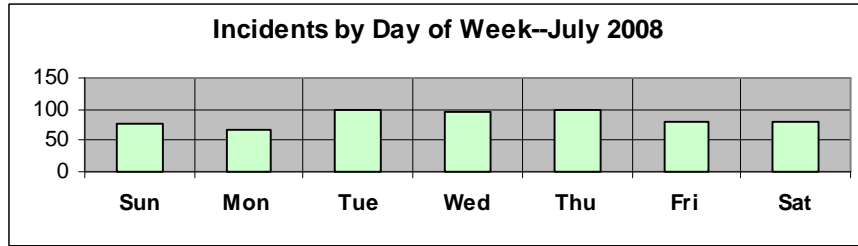
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

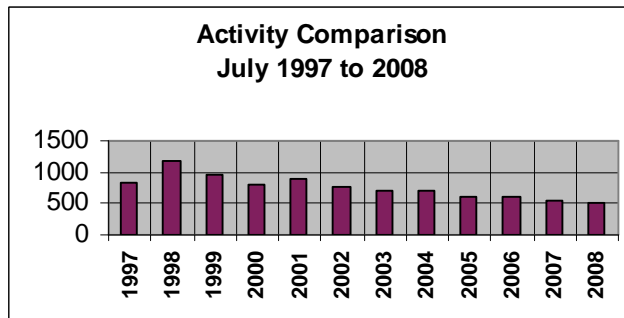
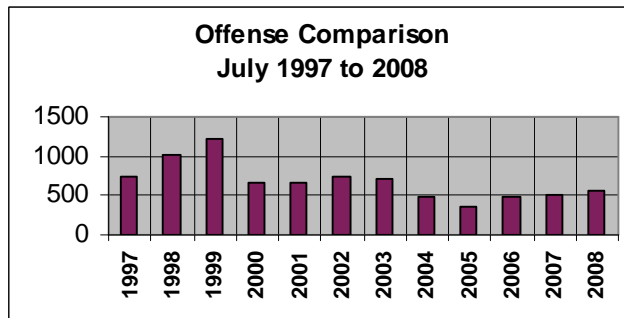

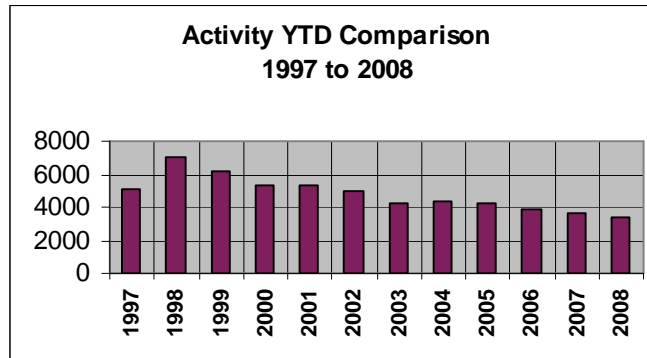
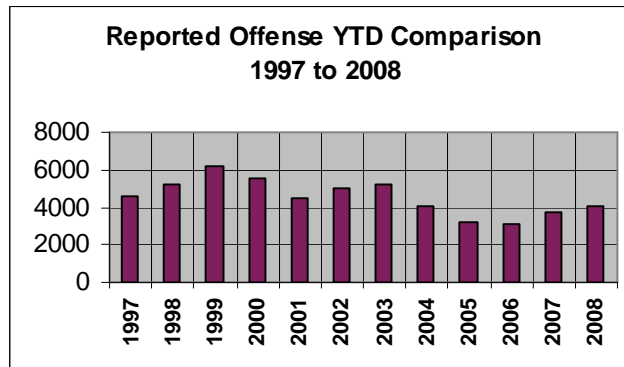


**Offense and Activity Comparison:**

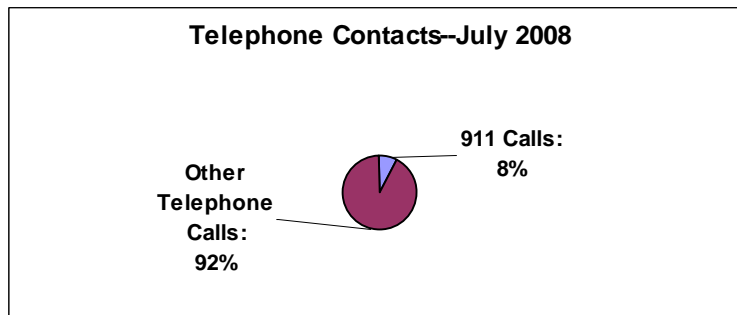


Years to Date:

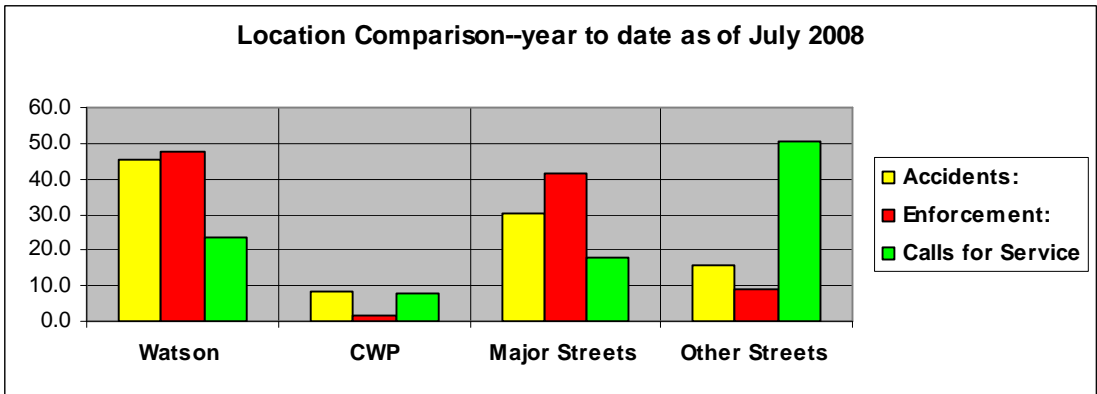


**Location Comparison:**
