Topic: July 2009 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of July 2009. In July 2009, there were 36 Part I offenses and 358 Part II offenses for a total of 394. This compares with 78 Part I offenses and 474 Part II offenses for a total of 552 in July. The main difference was in the number of stealings and traffic stops.

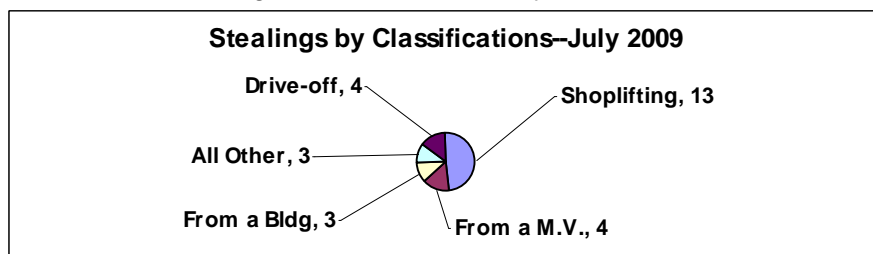
There was one robbery reported in July. On 07-21-2009, near the Sturdy and Crestwood Drives, a male was assaulted and robbed of his baseball hat by three males, who had been behind a fence. Victim suffered minor injuries but refused medical attention.

There were eight assaults in July 2009 and four involved domestic violence. In seven cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

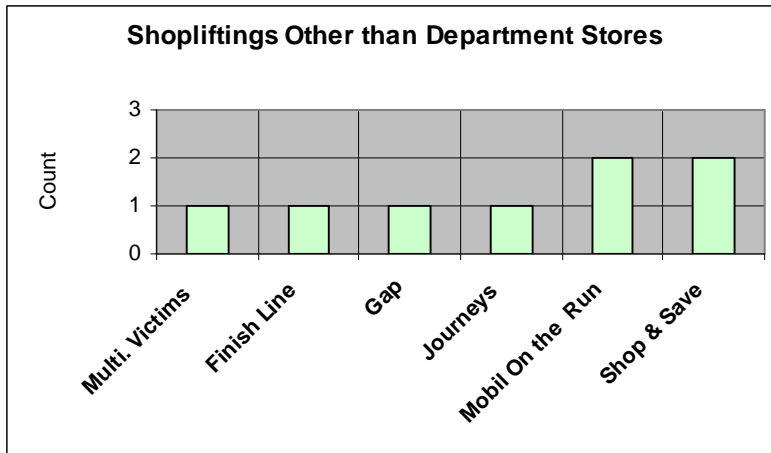
There were two burglaries in July. The first was reported on 07-04-2009 from a senior center. The victim's credit cards had been stolen from her room while she was in the hospital and the credit cards had been used. The second burglary occurred on 07-21-2009 on Grant Farm Trail. During the day, the suspect moved a BBQ pit under an atrium window and gained entry to the residence. Jewelry and coins were stolen. The Detective Bureau processed the scene.

Stealing offenses numbered 27 in July 2009.

Stealings were of the following classifications in July 2009:



Shopliftings accounted for thirteen of the 27 stealings in July 2009 or 48%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in July 2009:

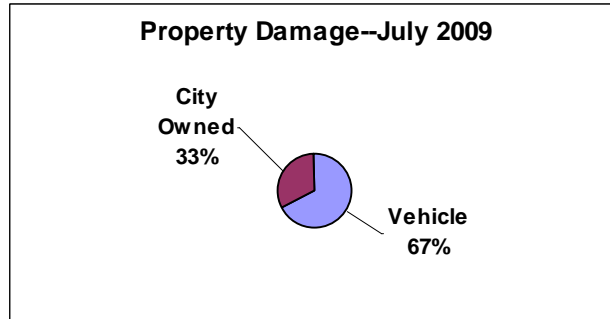


Of the shopliftings, 85% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 70%, adults and juveniles together accounted for 20% and juveniles accounted for 10% of the clearances.

There were six property damages in July 2009 and they were of the following classifications:



The City Owned property damages were to sprinkler heads in Whitecliff Park and a lock on the restrooms in Crestwood Park.

Part I offenses numbered 36 in July 2009.

Part II:

In July 2009, there were four frauds, three credit card frauds and one forgery. There were two drug offenses, one possession of marijuana and one possession of drug paraphernalia. The five offenses against public peace were one disorderly conduct, one peace disturbance, one trespassing, one annoying telephone calls and one harassment. There were two DWI cases, eleven animal calls and 72 people related calls including 69 medical emergencies, two suicides or attempts and one sudden death. There were 51 suspicious activity calls and five juvenile offenses including two minors in possession, two runaways and one curfew.

Part II offenses totaled 358 in July 2009.

In July 2009 in Ward One, stealings numbered one with it being in the neighborhoods. There was one drug offense, one offense against public peace and two juvenile related offenses. There were four traffic accidents, thirteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fifteen and occurred on eight different streets and there were 66 miscellaneous police service calls.

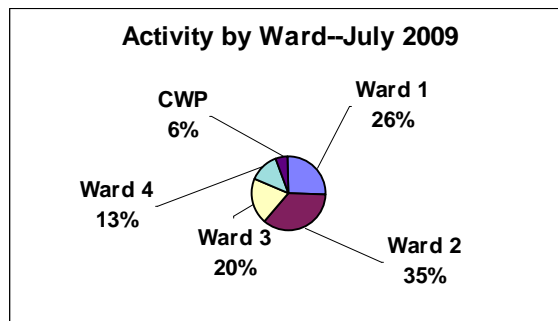
In Ward Two in July 2009, there was one robbery on the street near Sturdy and Crestwood Drives. Stealings numbered thirteen with thirteen at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered four with four in the neighborhoods. There were three frauds, one drug offenses and three offenses against public peace. There was one DWI case and twelve traffic accidents, 28 people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered fifteen and occurred on eleven different streets and there were 82 calls for miscellaneous police services.

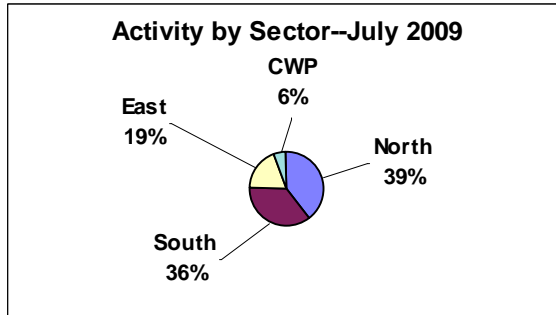
In July 2009 in Ward Three, two burglaries, one at a senior center and one on Grant Farm Trails. Stealings numbered three with one at addresses on Watson Road, two in Whitecliff Park and none in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one in Whitecliff Park. There was one offense against public peace. There was one DWI case, three traffic accidents, nineteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on six different streets and there were 41 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in July 2009, stealings numbered three and property damages numbered one in Crestwood Park. There was one fraud and three juvenile related offenses. There were two traffic accidents, ten people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered nine and occurred on eight different streets and there were 29 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, stealings numbered seven with five shopliftings and two from buildings. There were two people related calls and suspicious activity calls numbered three and there were ten police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

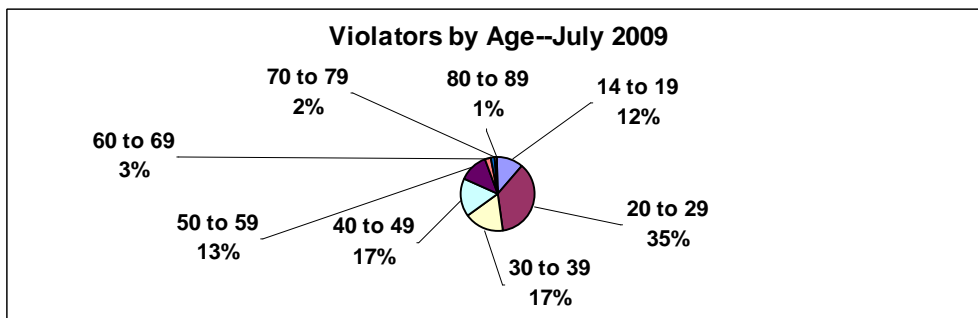

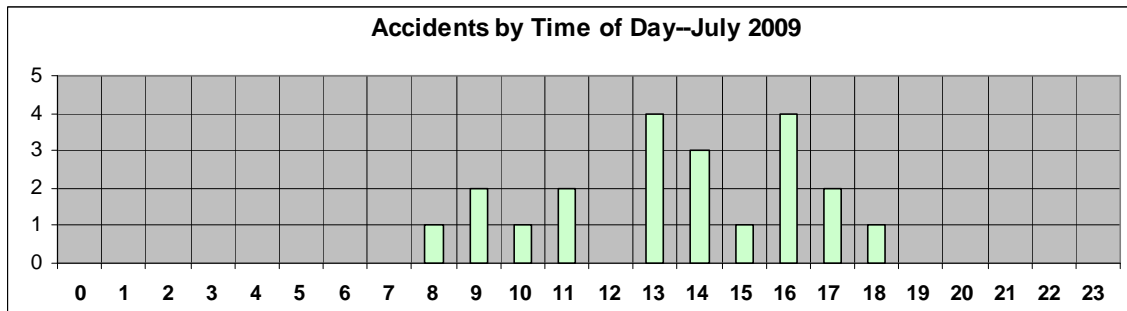

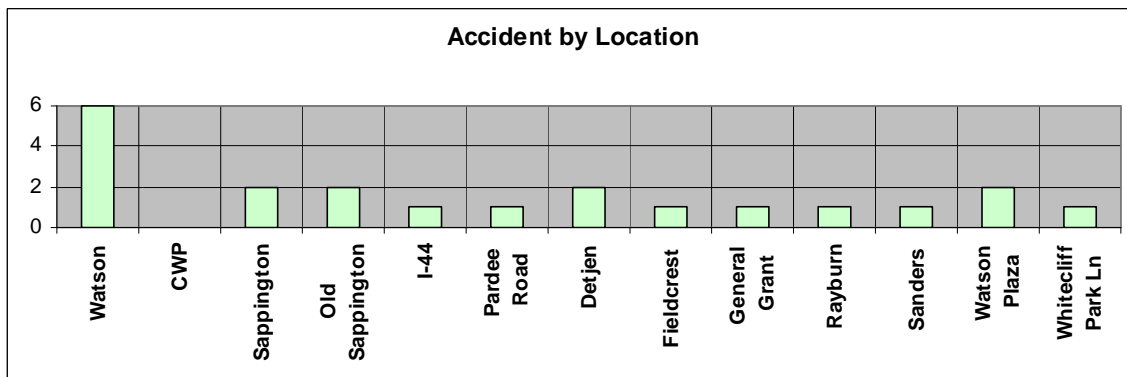
Accidents occurred on the following days of the week:



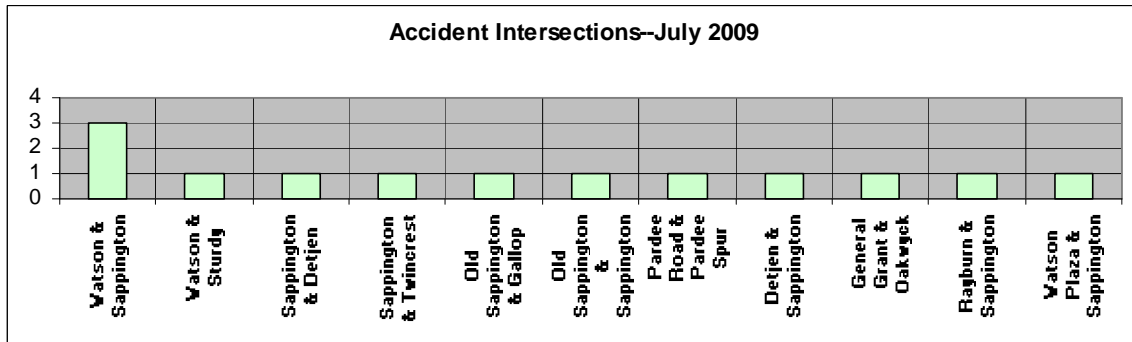
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



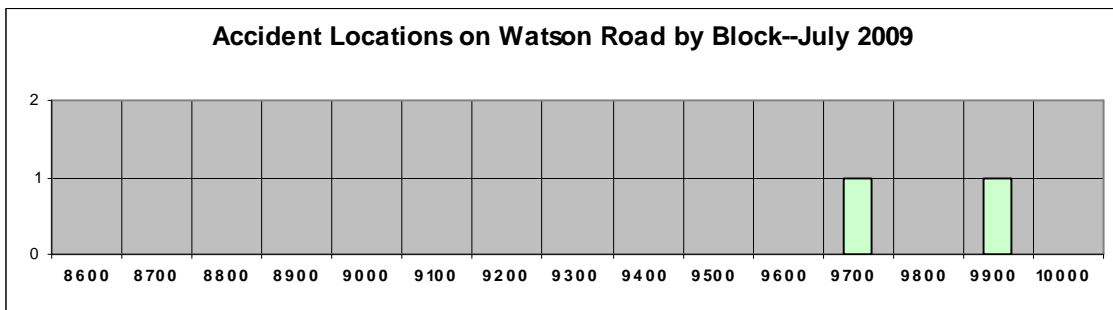
Accidents occurred on the following streets in July 2009:



Accidents occurred at the following intersections:



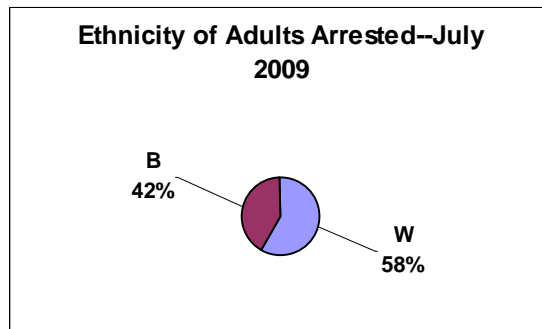

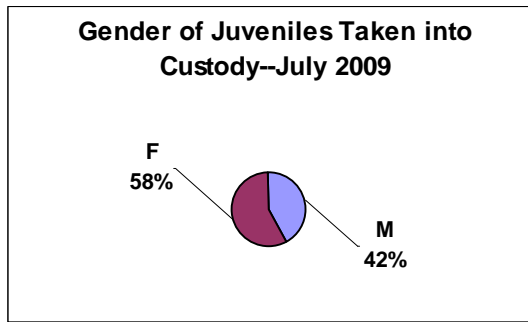
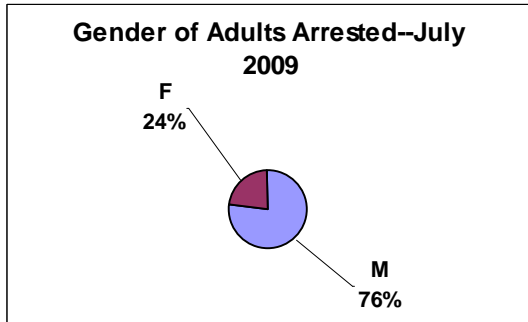
Fifty-five adults and twelve juveniles were taken into custody in July 2009. Thirteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

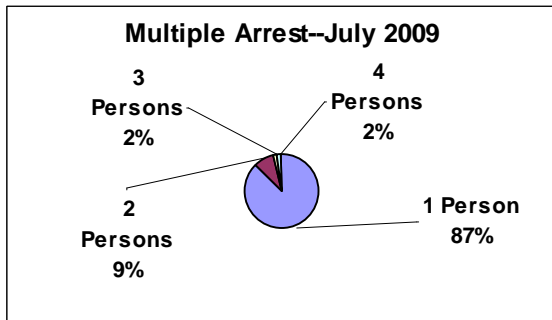


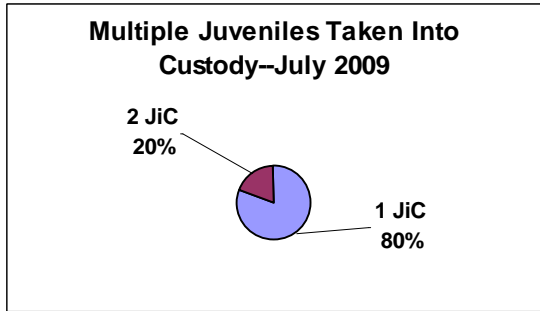


The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



Multiple Arrests:

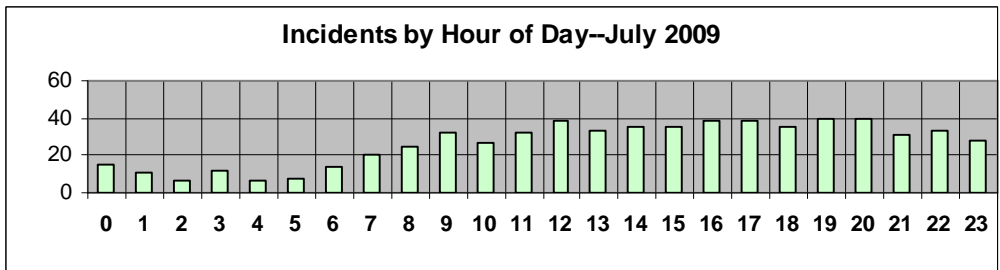
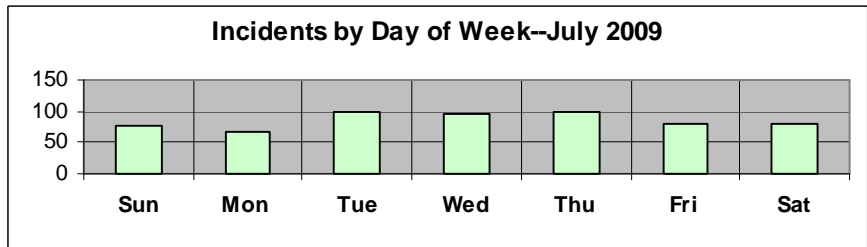




Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

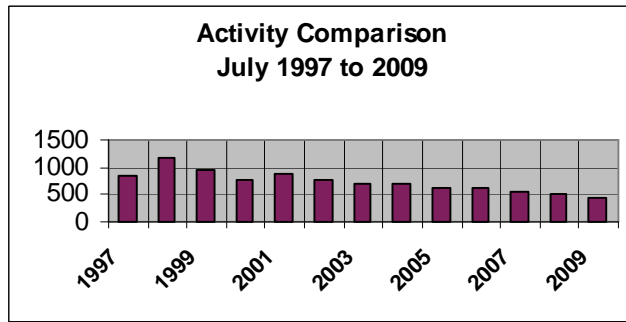
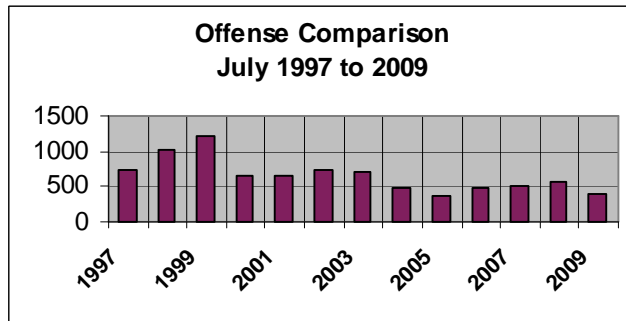

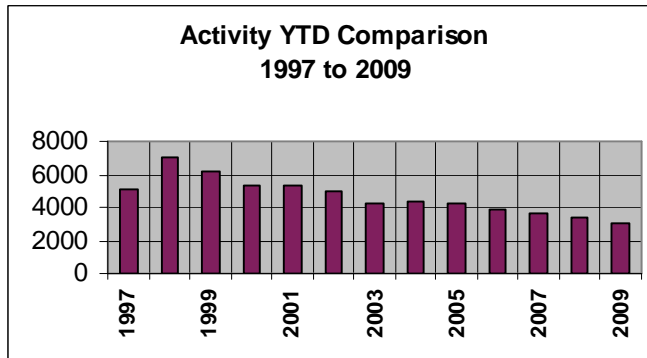
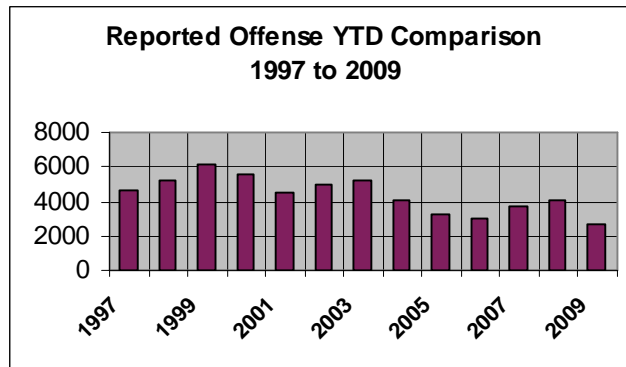


Offense and Activity Comparison:

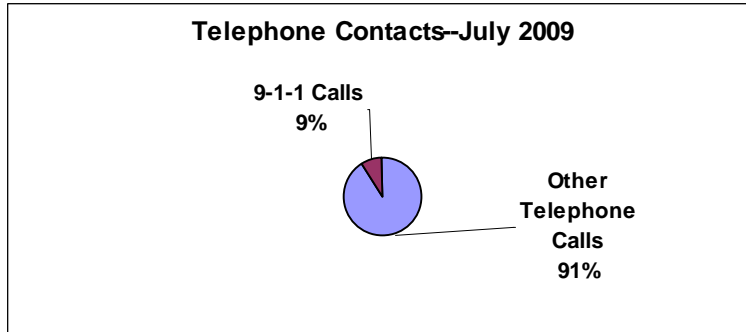


Years to Date:

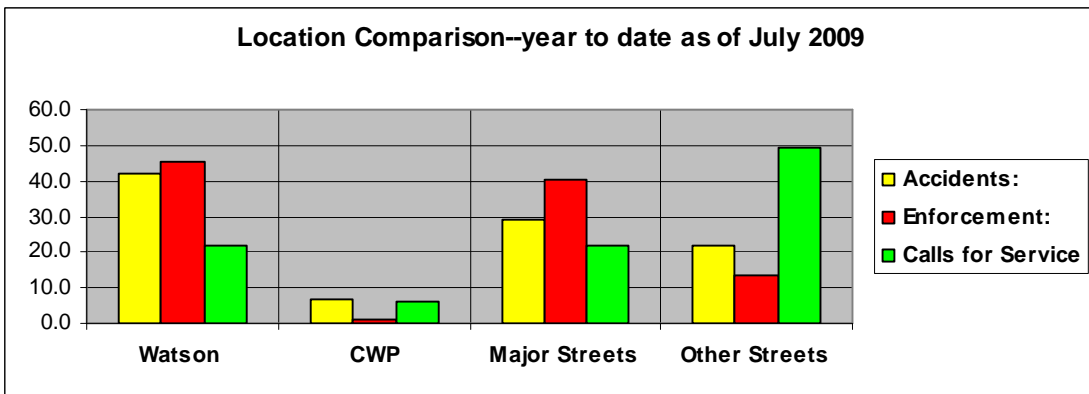


Location Comparison:
