Topic: June 2007 Public Report

This is the report of the activity of the Crestwood Police Department for the month of June 2007. In June 2007, there were 57 Part I offenses and 500 Part II offenses for a total of 557. This compares with 84 Part I offenses and 435 Part II offenses for a total of 519 in June 2006. The main difference was in the number of people related calls with the change in reporting procedures.

There was one robbery in June. On 06-29-07, the victim had someone attempt to take her purse in a restroom in CWP. After struggle over the purse, the thief let go of the purse and ran from the scene. There were no injuries involved.

There were two assaults in June 2007 and two involved domestic violence. In both cases, the parties knew each other prior to the assaults.

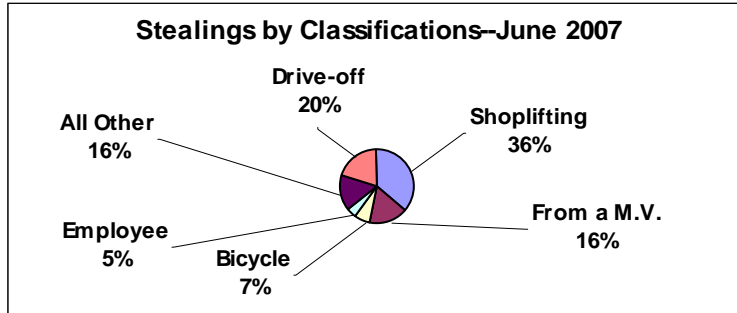
There were three burglaries reported in the month of June. The first occurred on 06-06-07 at a residence on Trelane. The residence was entered by breaking a window and stolen was a jewelry box. The second residential burglary occurred on 06-24-07 in the Forestview Apartments. There was no forced entry to the apartment and only some photographs were stolen. The one business burglary occurred on 06-11-07 in the 8600 blk. of Watson Road. A window was broken out and entry gained to the business and a roll of stamps was taken.

Stealing offenses numbered 45 in June 2007.

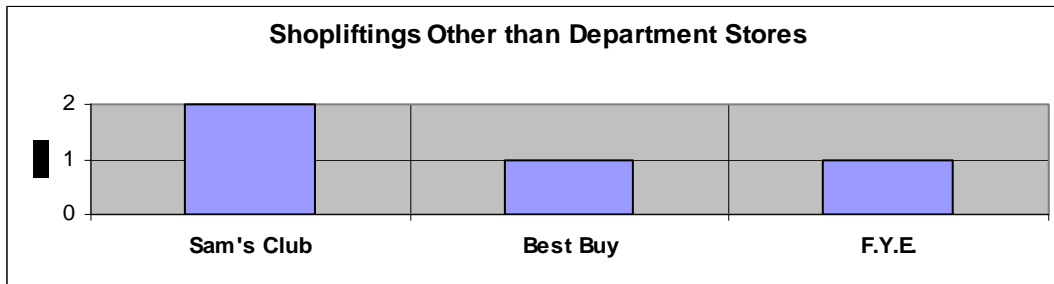
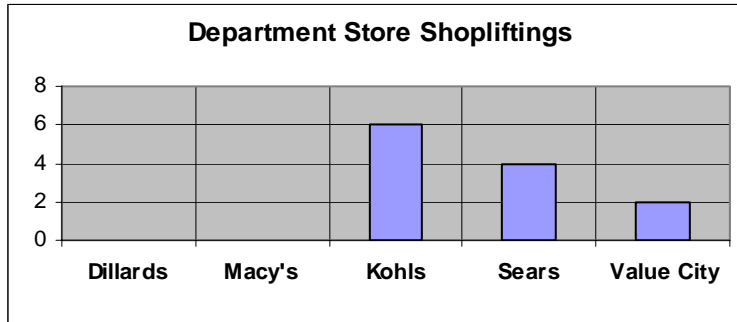
On 06-26-2007, three juvenile shoplifters were concealing merchandise in a department store. Store Security called for an Officer and one of the shoplifters returned to the vehicle that the shoplifters had arrived in and began to drive around the lot. The driver parked in a parking space and the responding Officer pulled up to speak with the driver and the driver drove into the police car and drove away. The Officer followed the vehicle off the lot and down Watson to Laclede Station to Rock Hill Road where the driver struck another vehicle and drove into a light pole and was ejected. The driver was treated at the scene and taken to the hospital in serious condition. The Officer was taken to the

hospital for treatment of the injuries that he had received and was treated and released. The vehicle was found to be stolen from St. Louis City. The other two shoplifters were taken into custody and later released to the Family Court.

Stealings were of the following classifications in June 2007:

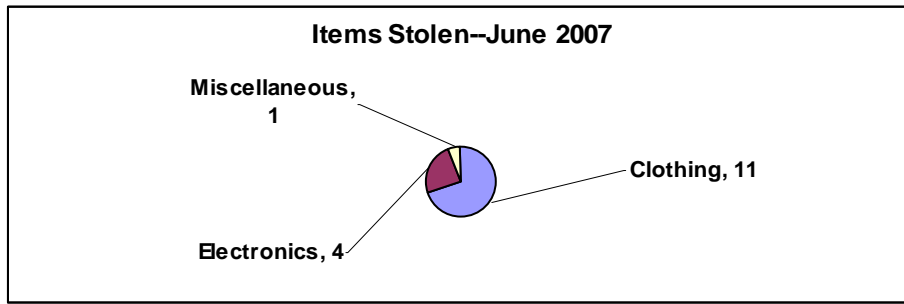


Shopliftings accounted for 16 of the 45 stealings in June 2007 or 36%. The shopliftings occurred at the following stores in June 2007:

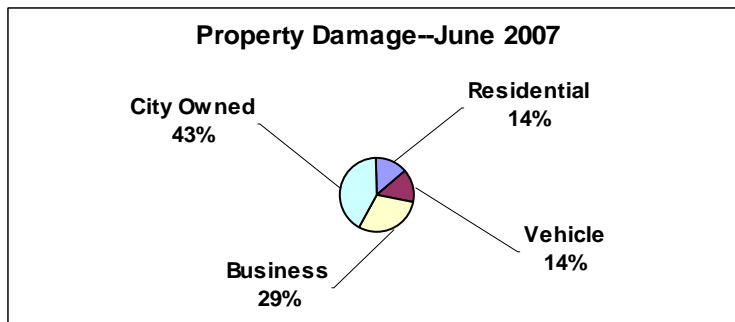


Of the shopliftings, 94% were cleared by arrest and adults accounted for 80%, adults and juveniles together for 7% and juveniles accounted for 13% of the clearances.

There were seven property damages in June 2007 and they were of the following classifications:



The three City Owned were damage to street signs, damage to the pavilion area in WCP and vandalism at the Aquatics Center. The residential was a damaged mailbox and the vehicle was broken window. The business property damages were to freshly poured concrete on a construction site and graffiti on a building.

There was one stolen vehicle and one recovered vehicle in June 2007. The stolen vehicle was a black 1995 Ford F-350 pickup truck that was later recovered in St. Louis City. The recovered stolen vehicle was a green 1993 Ford F-150 pickup truck that was reported stolen in St. Charles County. The victim responded and took possession of the vehicle.

Part I offenses numbered 58 in June 2007.

Part II:

In June 2007, there were eight frauds, four forgeries, two identity thefts, one bad check and one credit card fraud. There were two drug paraphernalia possession cases in June and were three offenses against public peace, two peace disturbances and one disorderly conduct. There were two DWI cases and fourteen animal related calls. There were seventy-six people related calls including 72 sick cases or accidental injuries, one sudden death and three suicides or attempt suicides. The five juvenile offenses included two curfew violations, two minors in possession of liquor and one contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

Part II offenses totaled 431 in June 2007.

In June 2007 in Ward One, there were two burglaries, one on Trelane and one in the Forestview Apartment Complex. Stealings numbered four with one at addresses on Watson Road and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered two, one at addresses along Watson Road, one on Watson Industrial and none in the neighborhoods. There were no stolen vehicles. There were four frauds and one offense against public peace. There was one DWI and five traffic accidents, eight people related calls and four animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twenty-one and occurred on thirteen different streets and there were 43 miscellaneous police service calls.

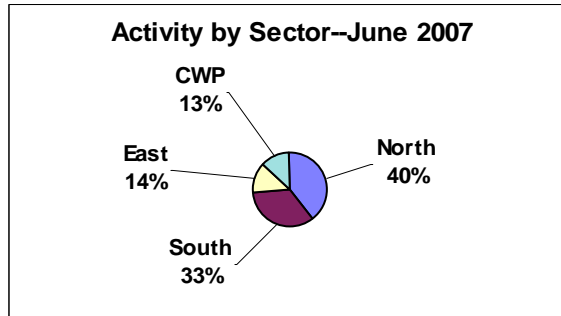
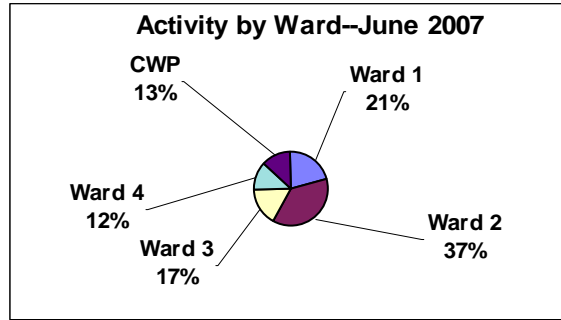
In Ward Two in June 2007, stealings numbered twenty-three with twenty at addresses on Watson Road, Watson Plaza and Big Bend and three in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered one, none at addresses along Watson Road and Big Bend and one in the neighborhoods. There was one stolen vehicle from on Reco drive and one recovered stolen auto, recovered on Watson Road. There was one fraud, two drug offenses, one offense against public peace and four juvenile related offenses. There was one DWI and ten traffic accidents, 29 people related calls and five animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eighteen and occurred on seven different streets and there were 93 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In June 2007 in Ward Three, there was one business burglary along Watson Road. Stealings numbered nine with five at addresses on Watson Road and four in the neighborhoods. Property damages numbered four, none at addresses along Watson Road, two in the neighborhoods and two in Whitecliff Park. There were no stolen vehicles in June. There were five traffic accidents, sixteen people related calls and two animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered twelve and occurred on five different streets and there were 36 miscellaneous police service calls.

In Ward Four in June 2007, stealings numbered one and there were no property damages or stolen vehicles. There were two frauds, and one juvenile related offense. There was one traffic accident, fourteen people related calls and three animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered eight and occurred on four different streets and there were 26 calls for miscellaneous police services.

In Crestwood Plaza, there was one robbery and stealings numbered eight with five shopliftings, one from vehicles and one employee thefts. There were no property damages or stolen vehicles. There was one fraud, one offense against public peace and one juvenile related offense. There were eight traffic accidents, nine people related calls and no animal related calls. Suspicious activity calls numbered two and there were 33 police service calls of a miscellaneous nature.

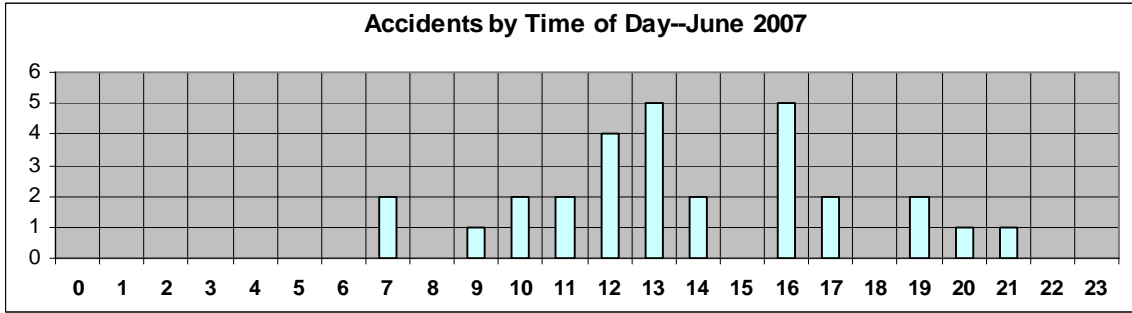

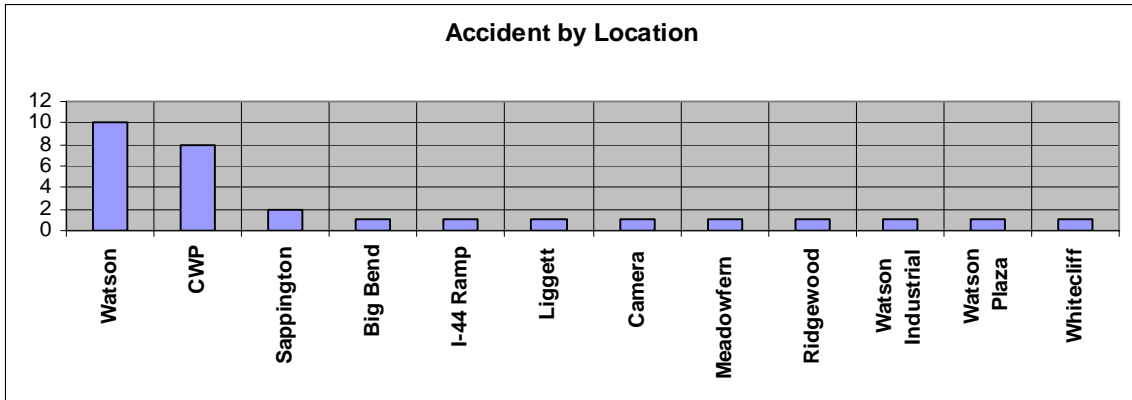

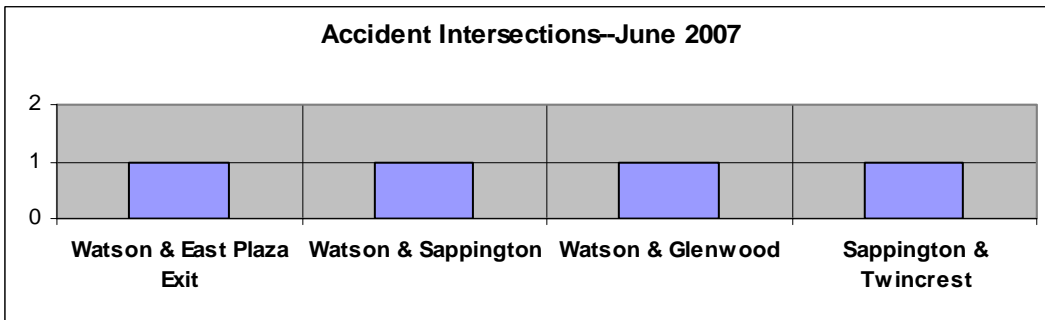
Accidents occurred during the following hours of the day:



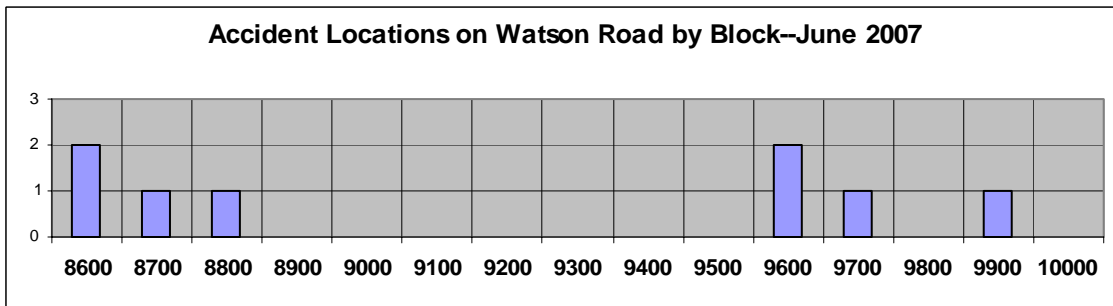
Accidents occurred on the following streets in June 2007:

Accidents occurred in the following blocks of Watson Road:



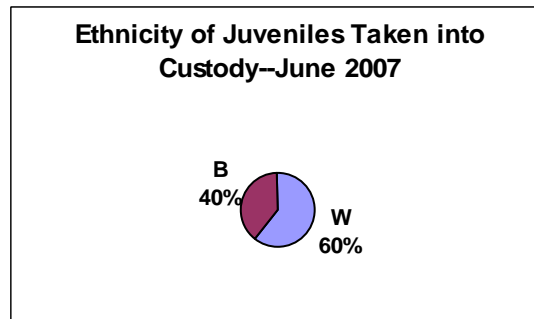
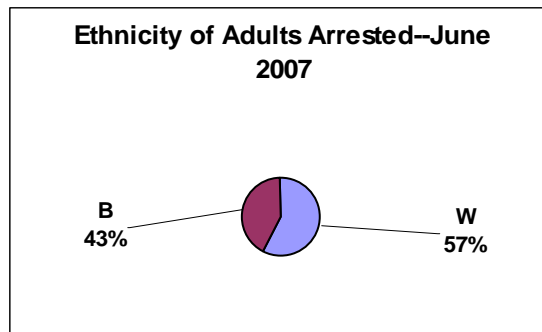

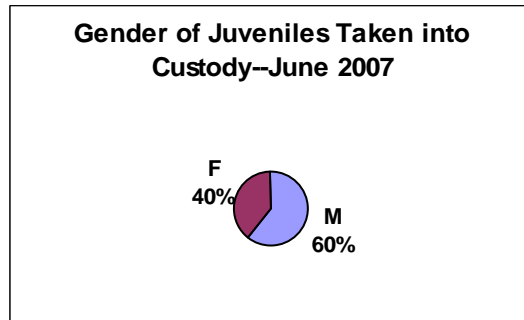
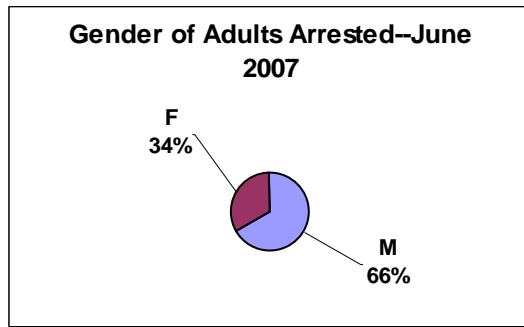
Arrest Information:

Seventy-four adults and ten juveniles were taken into custody in June 2007. Thirteen persons were issued summons in lieu of physical arrests.

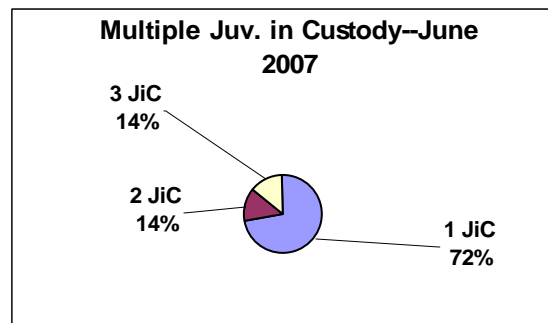
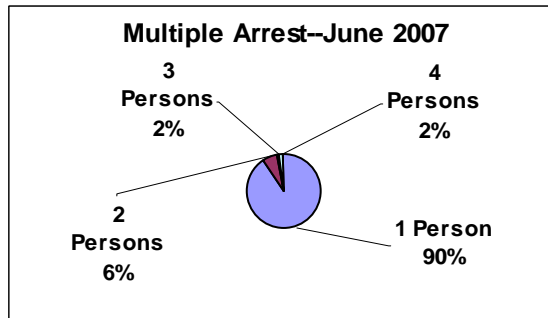
The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:



The gender of the persons taken into custody was:



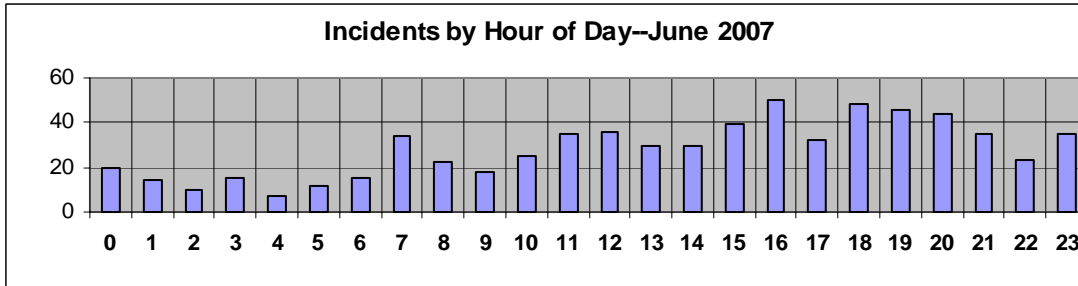
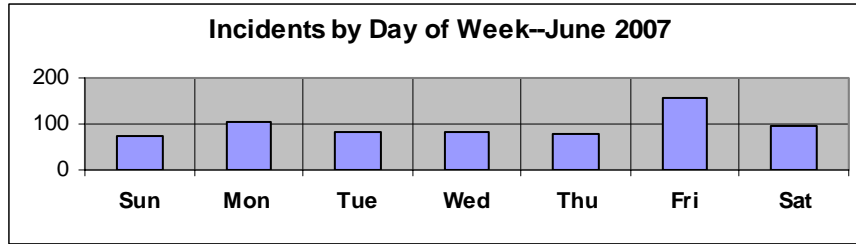
Multiple Arrests:



Multiple arrests are tracked due to the manpower and time required to safely transport and process multiple prisoners from the same incident.

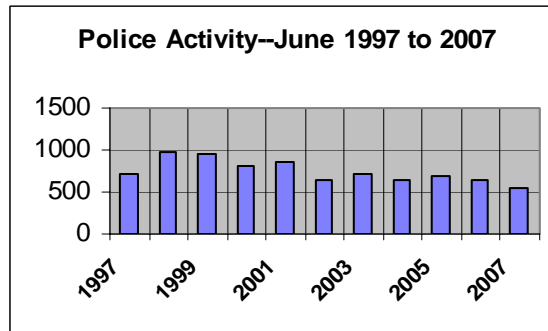
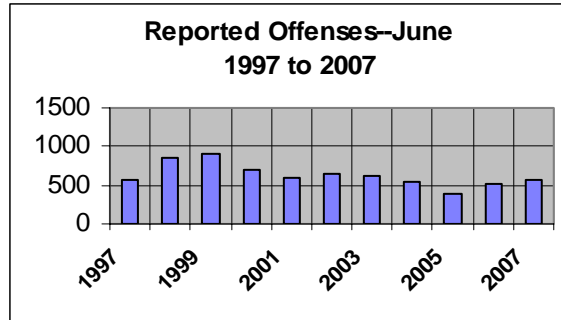

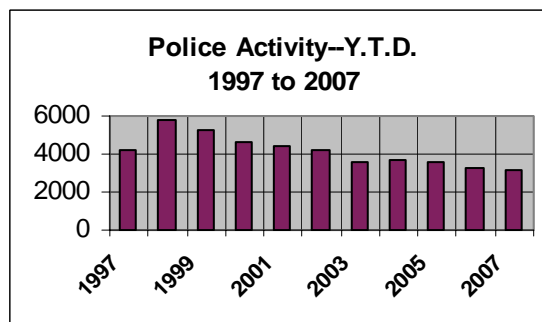
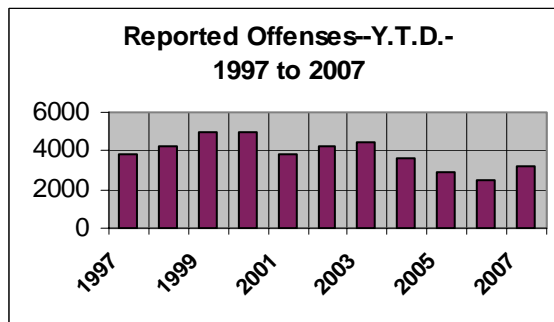


Offense and Activity Comparison:

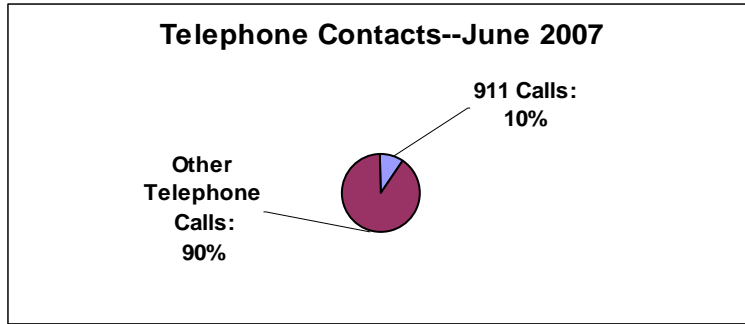


Years to Date:

Reader Board:

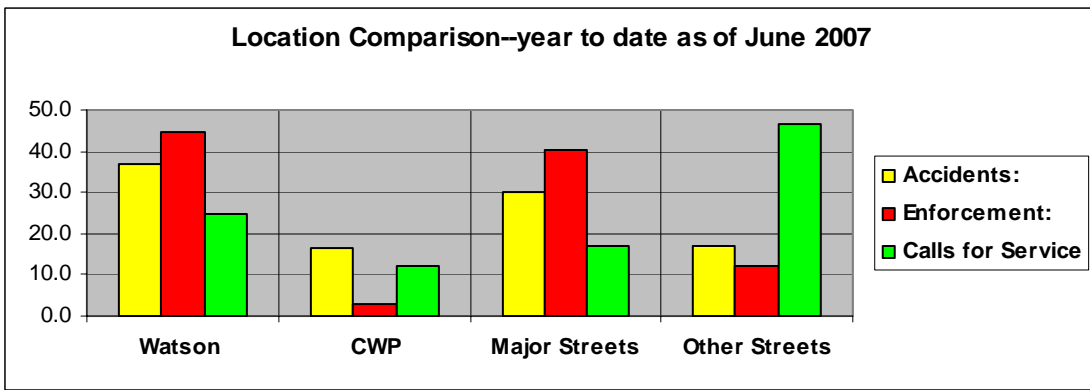
The speed measuring reader board was not used during the month of June 2007.
