Activity by Day of Week and Time of Day:



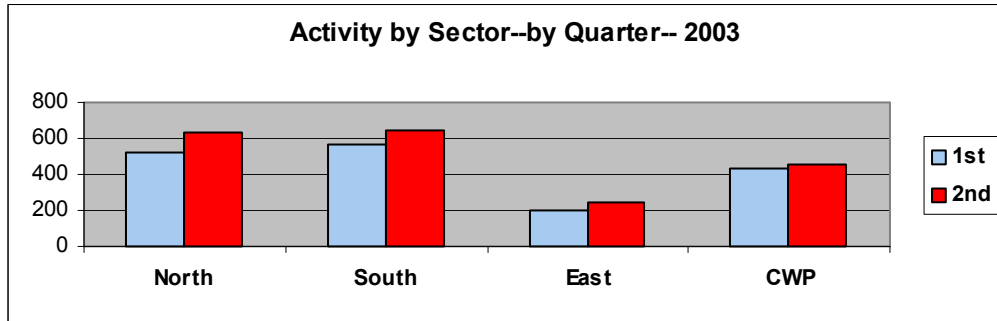
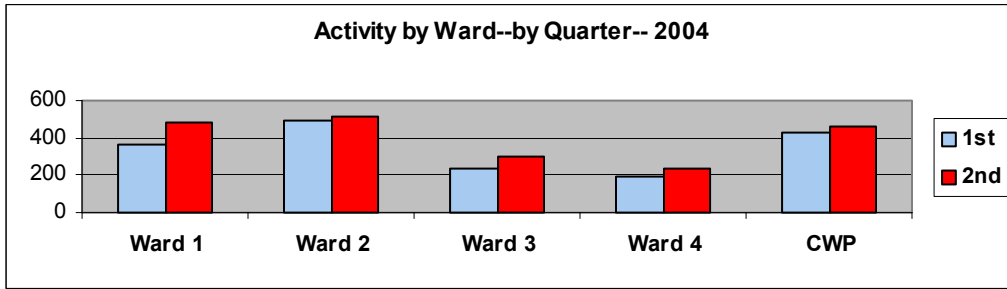

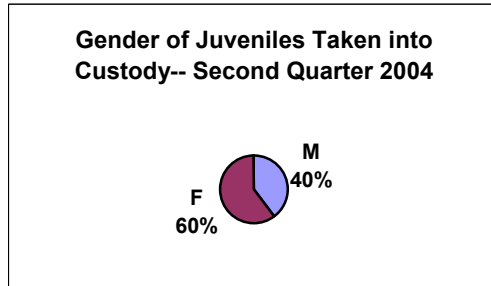
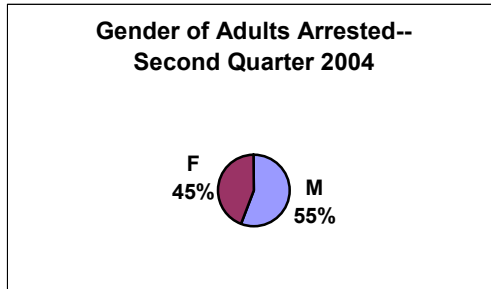


Arrest and Juvenile Data:

In the first quarter, there were 247 adults and 73 juveniles were taken into custody. The ethnicity of the person taken into custody was:

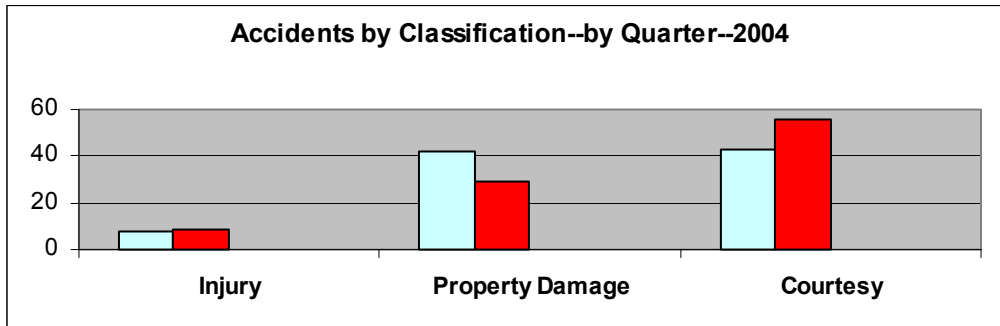

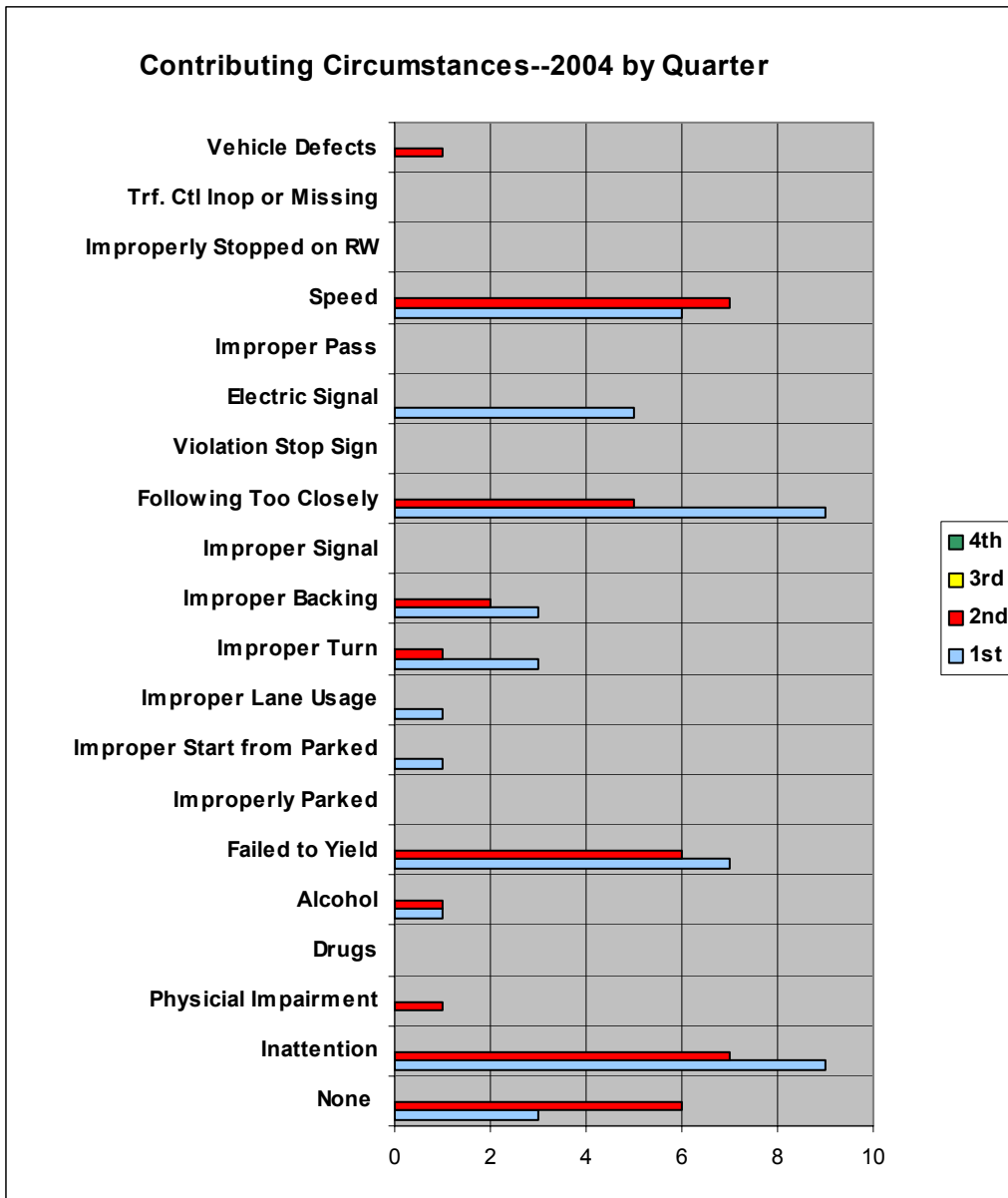


Accidents by Blocks on Watson Road:



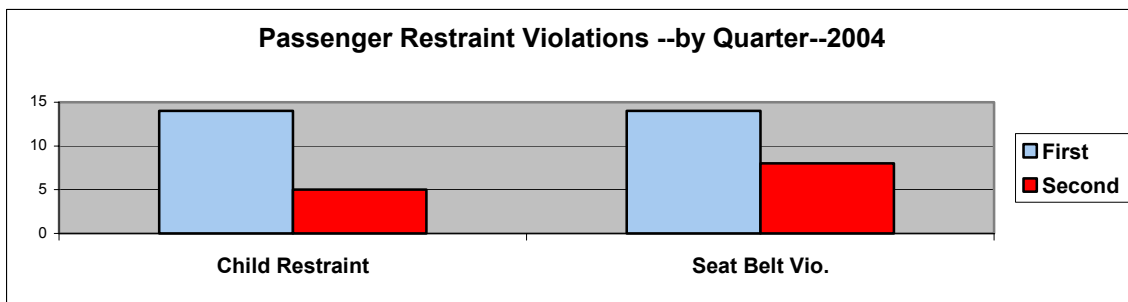
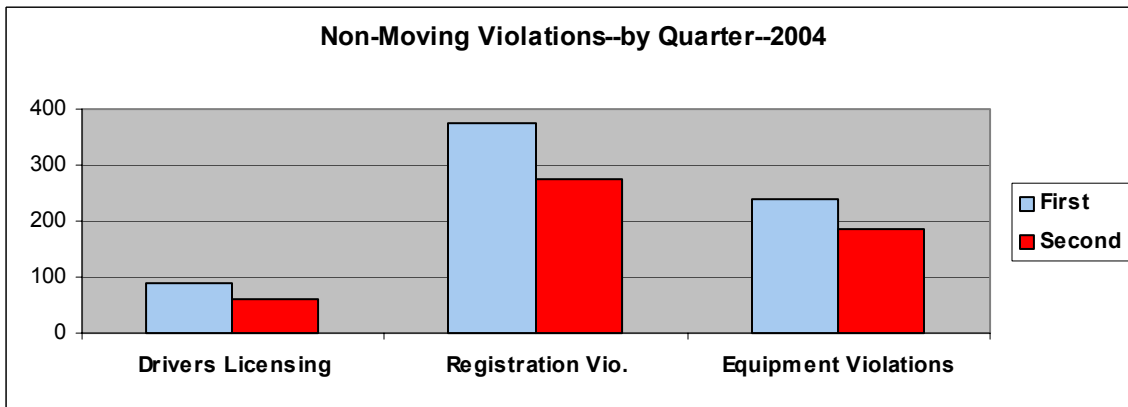
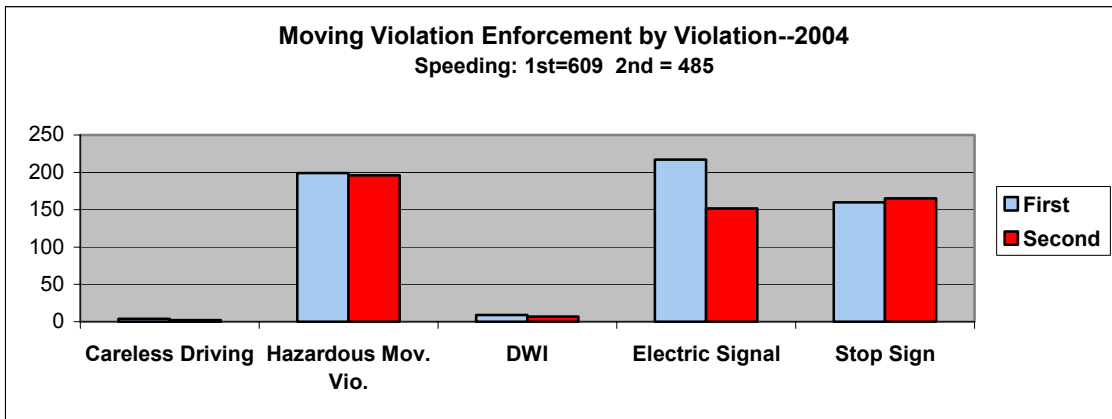
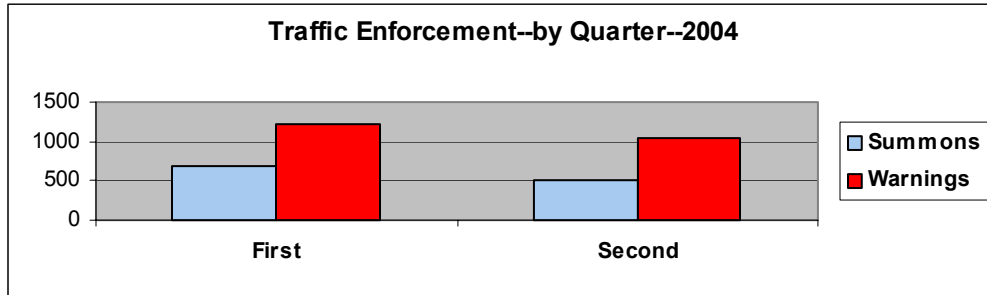

There were 1550 traffic enforcement actions taken in the second quarter. These actions were divided as follows:

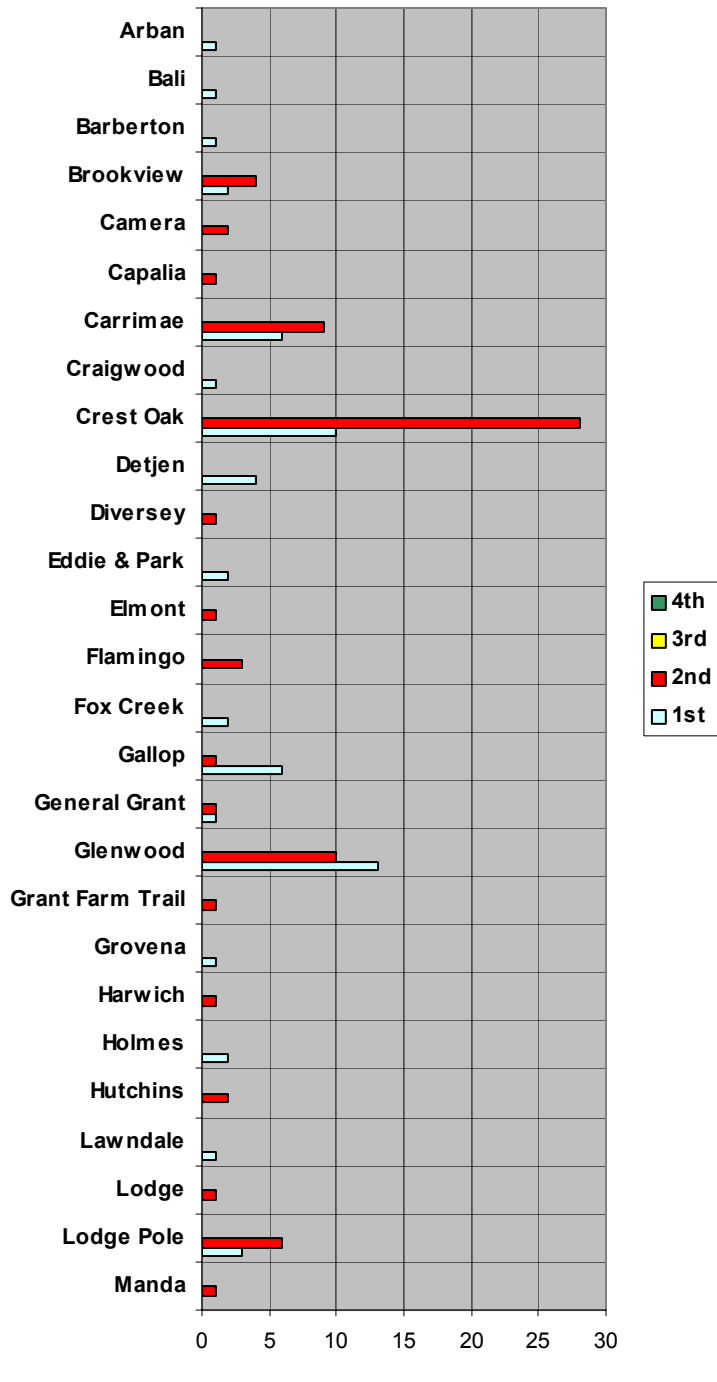

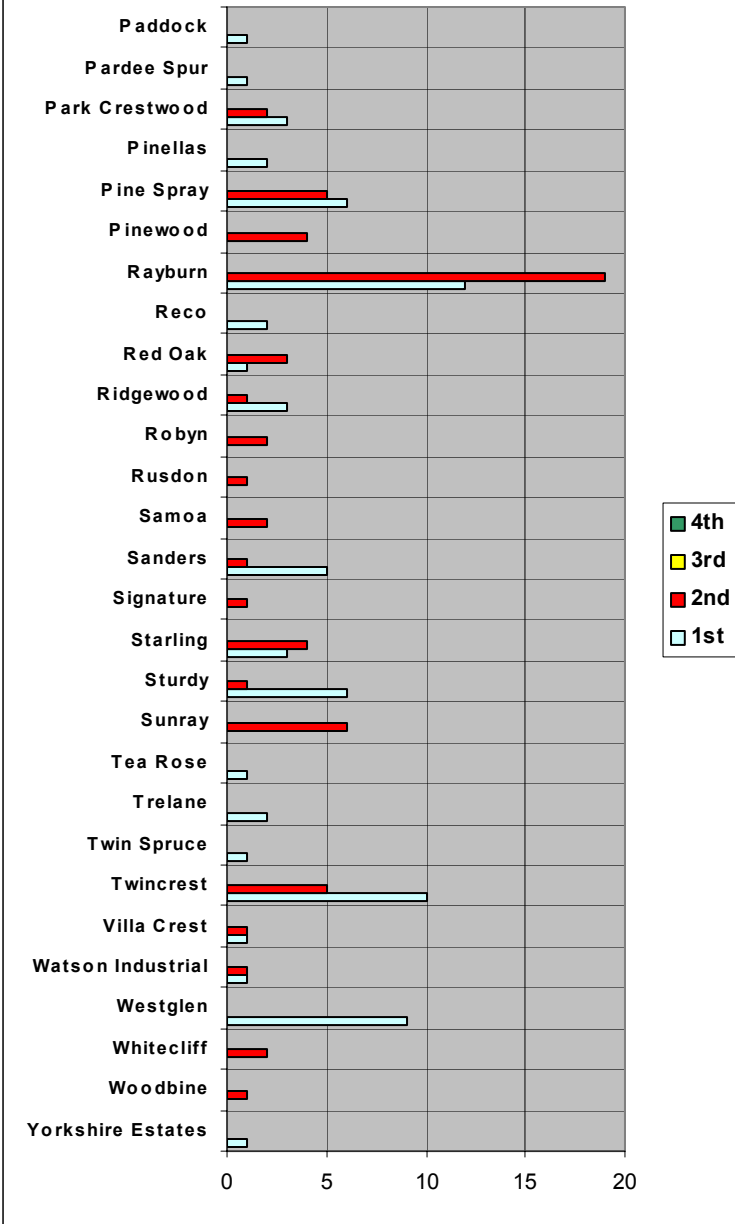

Traffic Enforcement on Other Streets: A to M-- 2004

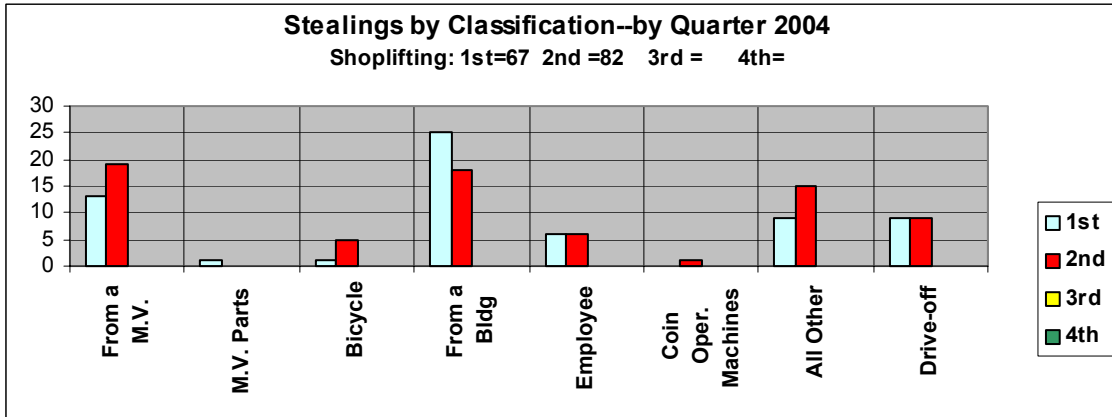


**Traffic Enforcement on Other Streets: N to Z --

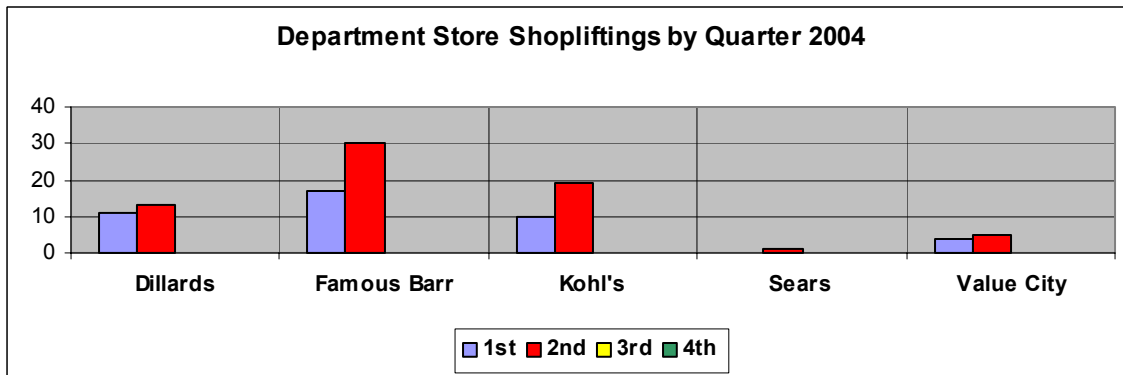
Stealings:

There were 155 stealings in the second quarter. These stealings were of the following classifications:



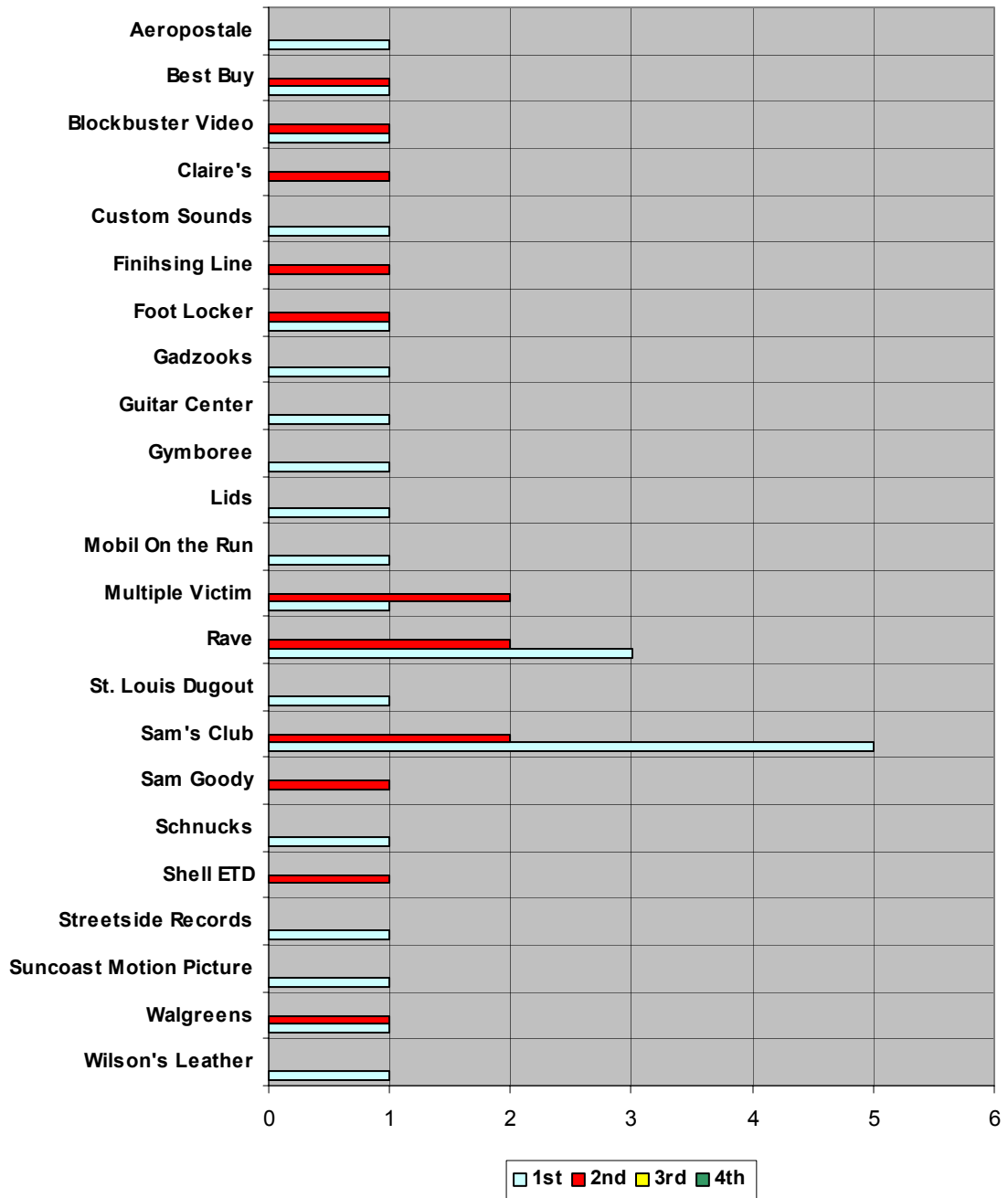
Shopliftings:

There were 82 shopliftings reported in the second quarter. This was 53% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:



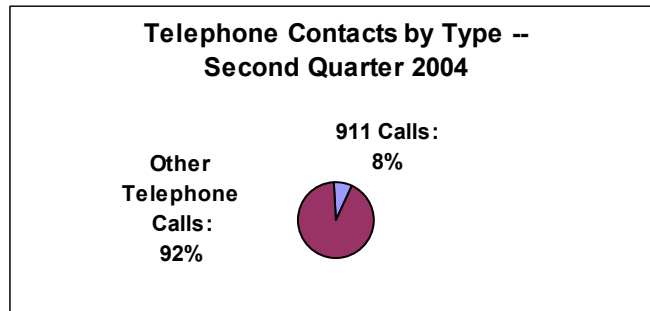
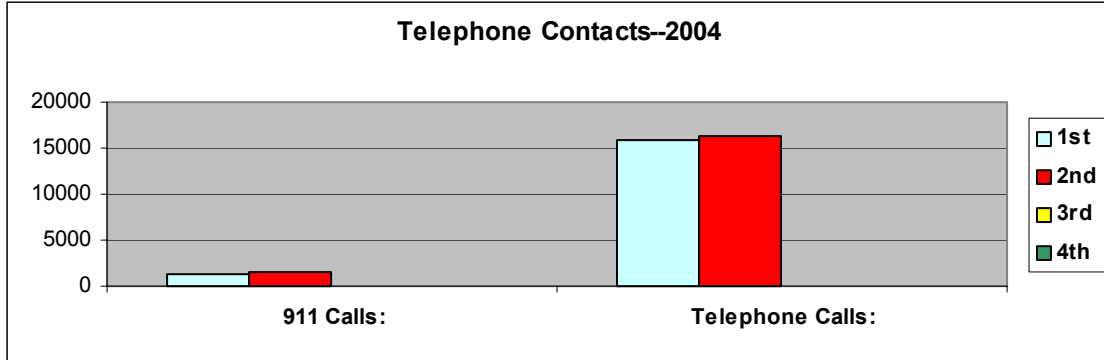
Eighty-three percent of the shopliftings occurred at the Department Stores. The remaining 17% occurred at the other stores and are displayed on the next page:
