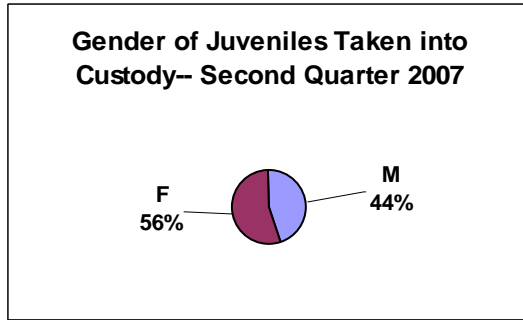
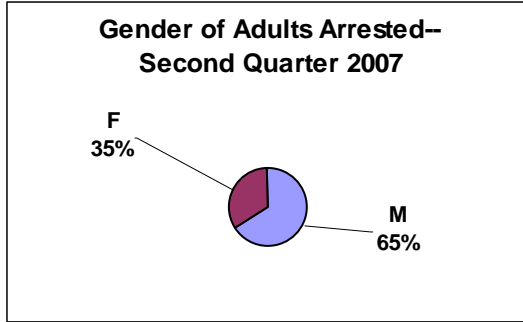
Arrest and Juvenile Data:

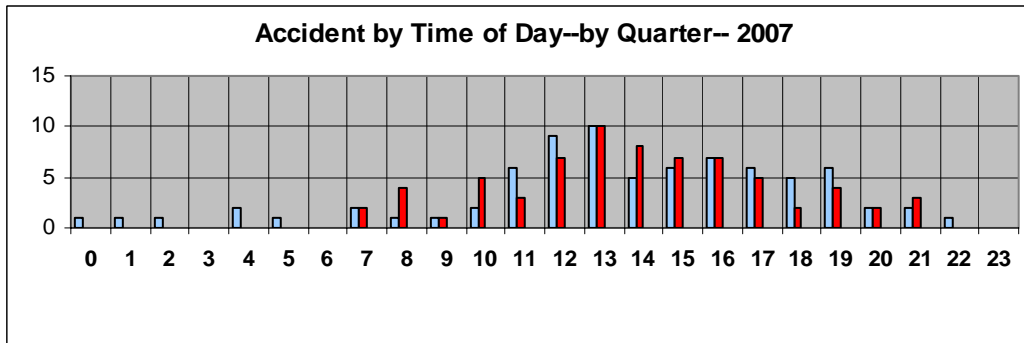

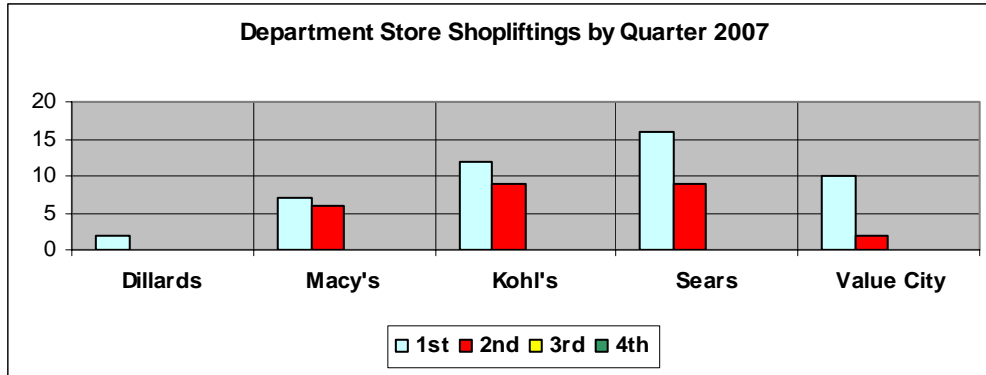
Stealings:

There were 64 shopliftings reported in the Second Quarter. This was 47% of the stealings. Shopliftings occurred at the following stores:

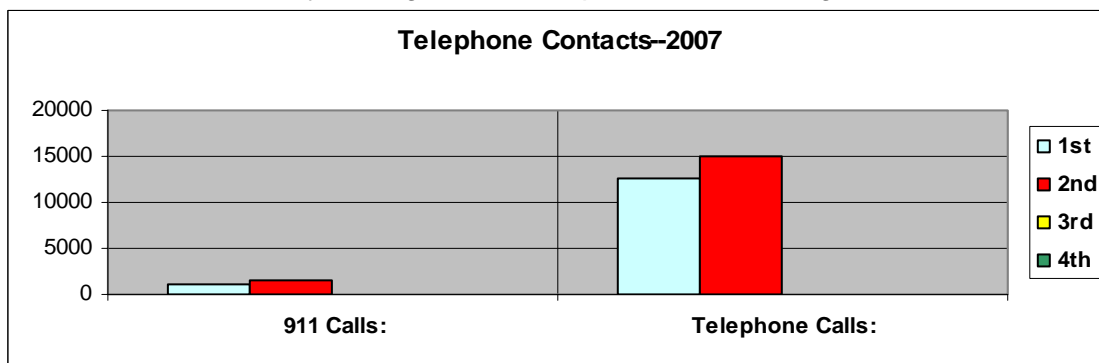


Fifty-nine percent of the shopliftings occurred at the Department Stores. The remaining 41% occurred at the following stores:

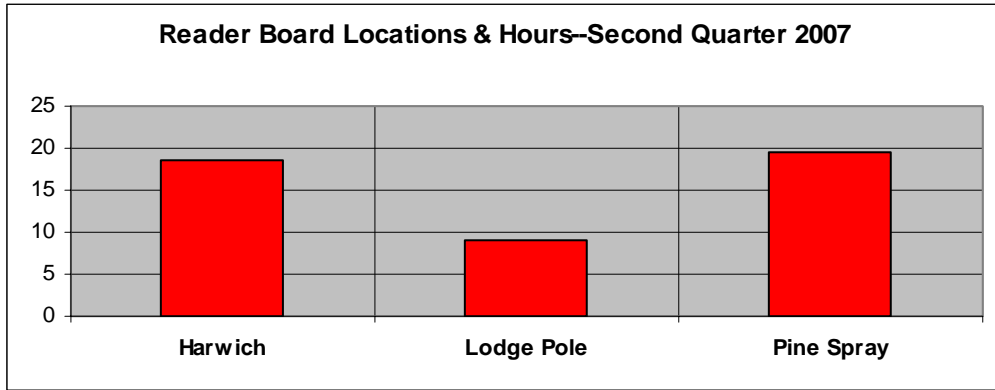
